## You will need...

- ▷ Krea Deluxe, Organic Cotton (50 g = 160 m)
  - ▷ Powder, 07
  - ▷ Rose, 12
  - ▷ Warm dark grey, 19
  - ▷ Black, 28 (eyes/brows)
  - ▷ Off white, 01 (eyes)
- ▷ Crochet hook 2.00mm and 2.50\*
- ▷ Fiberfill
- ▷ Yarn needle
- ▷ Pins
- ▷ Scissors
- ▷ Blush + make up brush

*\* Or the size that suits your yarn/crochet tension*

You can use any yarn of your choosing, but be aware that the finished item varies in size according to the yarn and hook you use.

For this pattern I am using Krea Deluxe, Organic Cotton and Tulip Etimo Rose crochet hooks.

I chose to work with x-stitches (yarn under single crochet).

My Piglet measures 12cm from the top of his ears to the bottom of his feet.

## Abbreviations

In US crochet terms:

st(s) = stitch(es)

sc = single crochet

MR = magic ring

slst = slip stitch

hdc = half double crochet

Rnd(s) = round(s)

R(s) = row(s)

BLO = back loops only

FLO = front loops only

\*..\* = repeat

(...) = number of stitches in round

dec = decrease

inc = increase

[...] = photo reference



# Head and body

## Powder and rose

From the top of the head using crochet hook 2.00mm.

Begin in powder.

Rnd 1: 6sc in MR (6)

Rnd 2: \*inc\* x6 (12)

Rnd 3: \*1sc, inc\* x6 (18)

Rnd 4: \*2sc, inc\* x6 (24)

Rnd 5: 24sc (24)

Rnd 6: \*7sc, inc\* x3 (27)

Rnd 7-10: 27sc (27) (4 rnds)

Rnd 11: 7sc, \*inc\* x4, 5sc, \*inc\* x4, 7sc (35)

Rnd 12-14: 35sc (35) (3 rnds)

Rnd 15: 7sc, \*dec\* x4, 5sc, \*dec\* x4, 7sc (27)

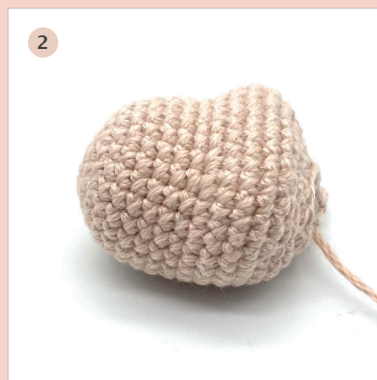
Rnd 16: \*7sc, dec\* x3 (24)

Rnd 17: 3sc, dec, \*6sc, dec\* x2, 3sc (21)

Stuff the head. Make sure to stuff the cheeks thoroughly [1, 2].

Rnd 18: 2sc, \*dec\* x9, 1sc (12)

Change yarn to rose in the last st of Rnd 18 [3]. The color change should be in the center of the backside - if you are not there, crochet the number of sc(s) you need until you are, before changing color.



You will crochet the body alternating between working in both loops and FLO, which creates the “stripes” of the body.

Rnd 19: in FLO: \*1sc, inc\* x6 (18)

Rnd 20: \*2sc, inc\* x6 (24)

Rnd 21: in FLO: 24sc (24)

Rnd 22: 1sc, inc, \*3sc, inc\* x5, 2sc (30)

Rnd 23: in FLO: 30sc (30)

Rnd 24: 30sc (30)

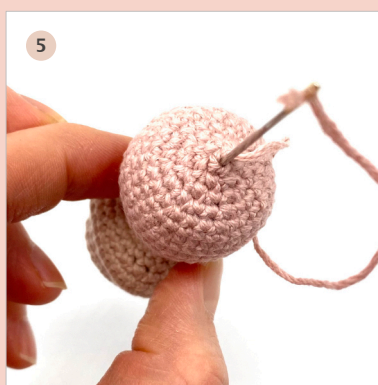
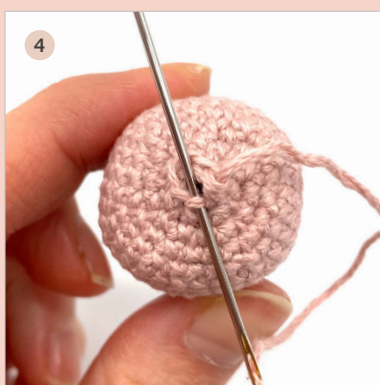
Rnd 25: in FLO: 30sc (30)

Rnd 26: \*4sc, inc\* x6 (36)

Rnd 27: in FLO: 36sc (36)

Rnd 28: 36sc (36)  
 Rnd 29: in FLO: 36sc (36)  
 Rnd 30: 2sc, dec, \*4sc, dec\* x5, 2sc (30)  
 Rnd 31: in FLO: 30sc (30)  
 Rnd 32: \*3sc, dec\* x6 (24)  
 Rnd 33: \*2sc, dec\* x6 (18)  
 Stuff the body.  
 Rnd 34: \*1sc, dec\* x6 (12)  
 Rnd 35: \*dec\* x6 (6)

Cut the yarn leaving a tail. Use your yarn needle to weave the tail through the front loops of the 6sts Rnd 35 [4]. Pull the yarn gently to close the ring and weave in the end [5, 6].

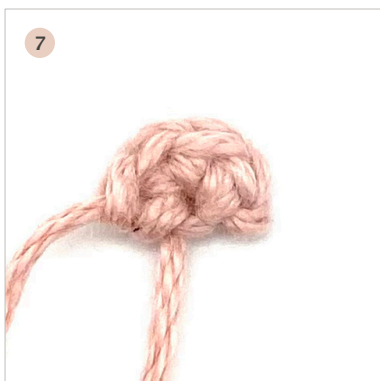

## Snout

### Rose



The snout is made in a MR using crochet hook 2.00mm.

Rnd 1: 4sc in MR (4)

Make sure the sts are on one side of the MR making half a circle.  
 Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly [7].

# Ear

## Make 2 in rose

From the top of the ear using crochet hook 2.00mm.

Rnd 1: 4sc in MR (4)

Rnd 2: \*1sc, inc\* x2 (6)

Rnd 3: \*1sc, inc\* x3 (9)

Rnd 4: \*inc, 2sc\* x3 (12)

Rnd 5: \*3sc, inc\* x3 (15)

Rnd 6-7: 15sc (15) (2 rnds)

Rnd 8: \*3sc, dec\* x 3 (12)

Rnd 9: \*2sc, dec\* x3 (9)

Ch1, flatten the ear to crochet 4sc through both layers [8, 9].

Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly [10].

## Arm

**Make 2 in powder**

From the hand using crochet hook 2.00mm

Rnd 1: 6sc in MR (6)

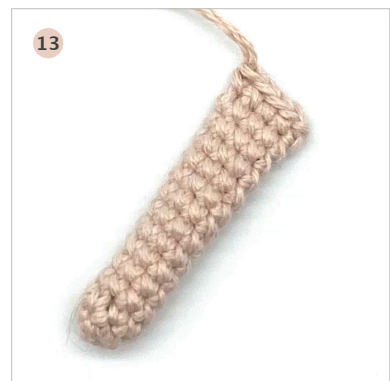
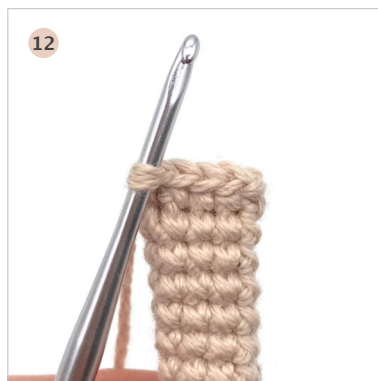
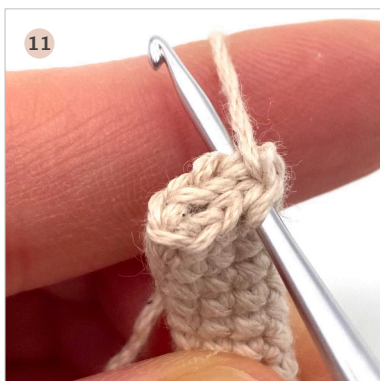
Rnd 2: \*2sc, inc\* x2 (8)

Rnd 3-14: 8sc (8) (12 rnds)

Stuff the hand until Rnd 6 and leave the rest of the arm unstuffed.

Ch1, flatten the top of the arm to crochet 4sc through both layers [11, 12].

Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly [13].



# Leg

## Make 2 in powder

From the bottom of the foot using crochet hook 2.00mm.

Rnd 1: 6sc in MR (6)

Rnd 2: \*inc\* x6 (12)

Rnd 3: \*1sc, inc\* x6 (18)

Rnd 4-6: 18sc (18) (3 Rnds)

Rnd 7: 5sc, \*dec\* x4, 5sc (14)

Rnd 8: 5sc, \*dec\* x2, 3sc, dec (11)

Stuff the foot firmly [14].

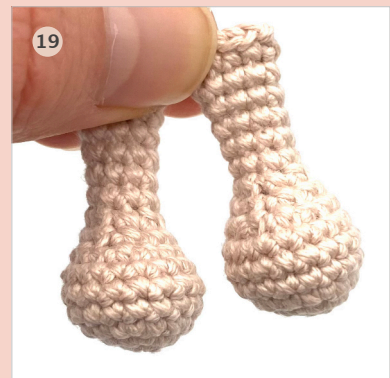
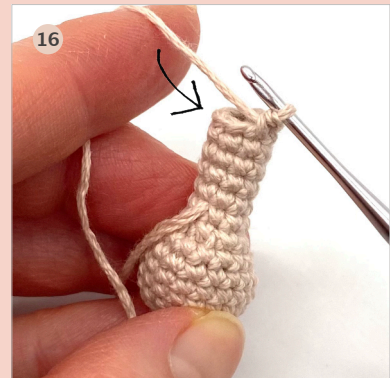
Rnd 9: dec, \*1sc, dec\* x2, 3sc (8) [15]

Rnd 10-14: 8sc (8) (5 Rnds)

Stuff the leg lightly until Rnd 12.

Crochet 3sc - or the number you need - to reach the side of the leg [16]. Ch1, flatten the top of the leg to crochet 4sc through both layers [17].

Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly [18, 19].





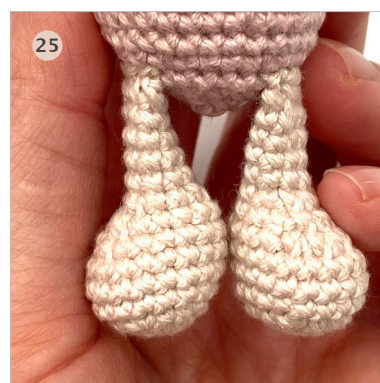
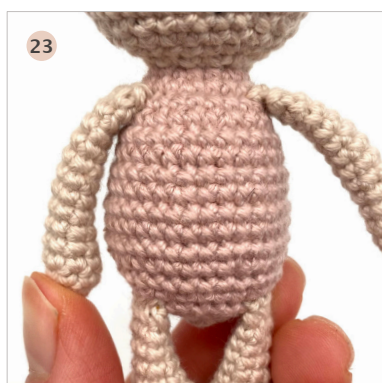
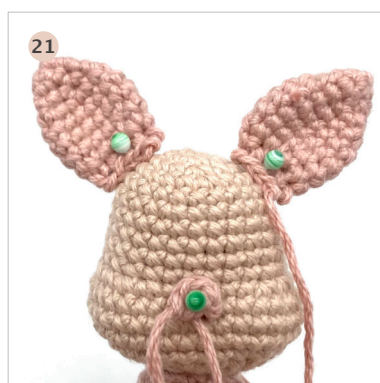
# Assembly

Yarn needle, pins and scissors

Place the ears on top of the head from Rnd 3 to Rnd 6 and sew them in place [20, 21]. Attach the snout in the center of the face from Rnd 11 to Rnd 12 with the curved part of the snout pointing upwards [21].

Place the arms on either side of the body with the upper arm at Rnd 21 and a distance of 7sc in the front. Sew the top of the arms in place [22, 23].

Place the legs on Rnd 33 with a distance of 5sc in the front. Sew the top of the legs in place [24, 25].

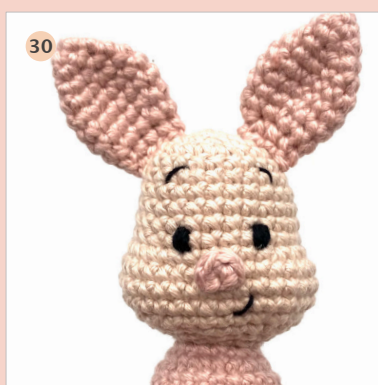
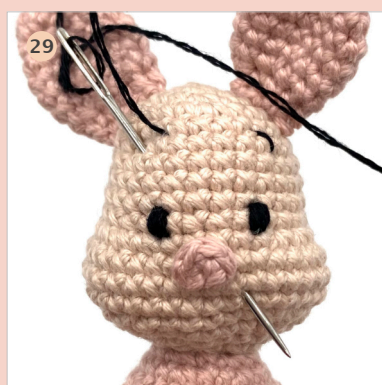
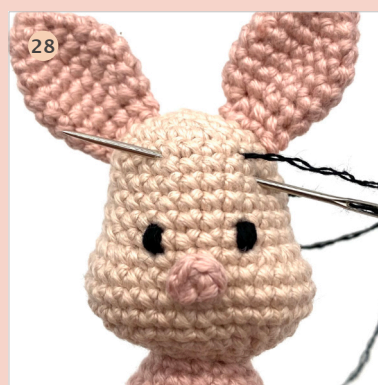
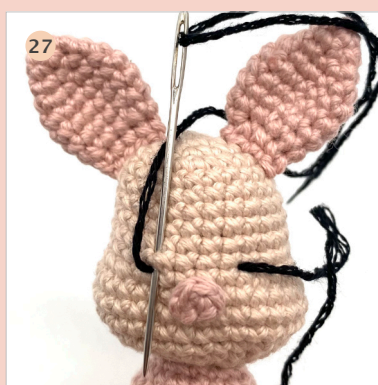
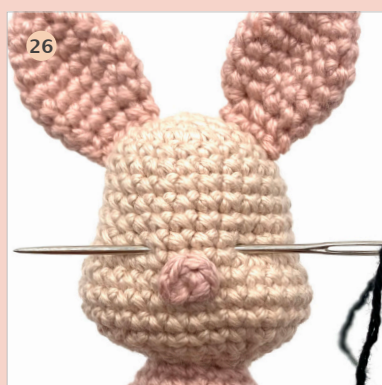
# Facial details

**Black and off white yarn, and blush + brush**

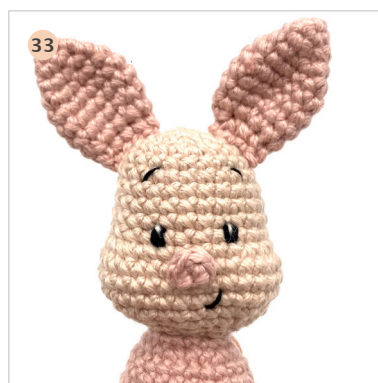
Begin in black yarn. Split the yarn in two and embroider the eyes over Rnd 10 with a distance of 4sts in between [26, 27, 28].

Split the yarn one more time to embroider the eyebrow at an oblique angle over 1sc of Rnd 6 with a distance of 4sts in between [29, 30].

Embroider a mouth at an oblique angle over 1sc of Rnd 14 [30].



Now split the off white yarn in two and embroider a point of reflection in each eye [31, 32, 33]. Lastly apply blush on the cheeks [33].

# Scarf

Dark warm grey

Crochet hook 2.50mm.

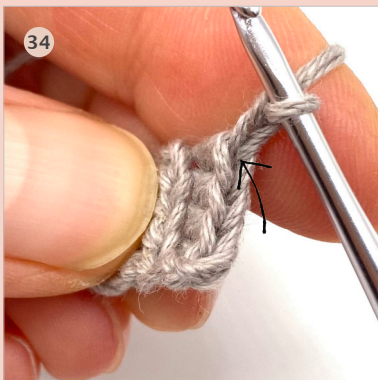
The scarf is crocheted going back and forth in rows. Each row begins with ch2, that doesn't count as a st, which means that the first hdc of each row is made in the same st as the ch2 [34].

Ch6, turn

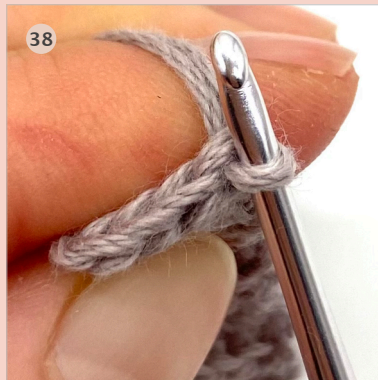
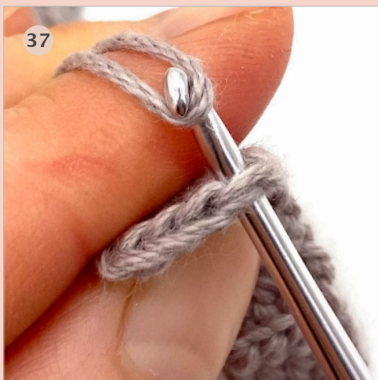
R1: begin in the third st from the hook [35], 4hdc, turn

R2-44: ch2, in BLO: 4hdc [36], turn (42 Rs)

Cut the yarn and weave in ends.



Make fringes in both ends of the scarf by cutting 8 pieces of yarn. Then use your crochet hook to pull them through and tie knots in each of the 4sts in either end of the scarf [37, 38, 39]. Split the yarn ends (fringes) with your yarn needle and trim them in your desired length [40, 41]
