NOTE AND RECOMMENDATIONS.

You can crochet from any yarn and a suitable hook for it.

The size of the toy depends on your yarn, the hook number and the crochet density, as well as the crochet method.

When crocheting with ticks (the first and second capture of the thread from the bottom), the toy will turn out more than if you crochet with half-crosses (the first capture of the thread from the top, second from the bottom).

first capture of the thread from the top, second from the bottom

To carefully pull the hole, grab only the front half-loops.

All parts are crocheted in a spiral, unless otherwise specified. Use a marker or contrast thread to avoid losing the beginning of the row.

All parts are filled in during the crocheting process, unless otherwise specified.

At the end of each row in (...) the total number of loops or the number of rows is specified.





MATERIALS AND TOOLS

-yarn alize cotton gold 330m/100 gr

 \mathbb{N}° 533 light gray for elephant

- yarn art jeans 160m/50 gr

№ 85 orange for the jumpsuit

- hook 2 mm (B)
- safety eyes d= 12 mm d= 12 mm
- filler, scissors, long needle, pins
- fine thread for decoration, dark gray and white color
- 15 cm trunk wire and Band-aid
- 2 pcs buttons d= 11 mm for jumpsuit
- 2 disks d=25 mm T shaped cotter pin 2,5 * 2 mm, needle-nose pliers

The size of the finished toy, taking into account the specified materials, is 22 cm or 8.66 inches. The method of crocheting half-crosses.

ABBREVIATIONS

MR- magic ring ch – chain

sc – single crochet inc – increase (two sc in one stitch)

dc – double crochet dec – decrease (two stitches crocheted together)

st- stitch dec dc- decrease double crochet

dc5tog- 5 double crochet together (Bobble stitch)

slst- slip stitch BLO- Back loop crochet FLO- front loop crochet

trunk

Crochet in light gray color. The trunk is not filled tightly.

1 rnd- 6 sc in MR

2 rnd- 6 inc (12)

3-8 rnds- 12 sc (6 rnds)

9 rnd- (2 sc, inc)*4 (16)

10-13 rnds- 16 sc (4 rnds)

14 rnd- (3 sc, inc)*4 (20)

15-18 rnd- 20 sc (4 rnds)

19 rnd- (4 sc, inc)*4 (24)

Take the wire, make loops on both sides,

isolate it with a Band-Aid. Insert it into the trunk.

Stuff the trunk

20-23 rnds- 24 sc (4 rnds)

24 rnd- 18 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc (26)

25-27 rnds- 26 sc (3 rnds)

28 rnd- 18 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc (28)

29 rnd- 18 sc, inc, 8 sc, inc (30)

30 rnd- 30 sc

Fasten and trim the thread. Use additional markers to mark 1 st and 18 st.

1 rnd- 6 sc in MR

2 rnd- 6 inc (12)

3 rnd- (sc, inc)*6 (18)

4 rnd- (2 sc, inc)*6 (24)

5 rnd- (3 sc, inc)*6 (30)

6 rnd- (4 sc, inc)*6 (36)

7 rnd- (5 sc, inc)*6 (42)

8 rnd- (6 sc, inc)*6 (48)

9rnd - (7 sc, inc)*6 (54)


10 rnd- 54 sc

11 rnd- 9 sc, (2 sc, inc)*3, 18 sc, (inc, 2 sc)*3, 9 sc (60)

12-13 rnds- 60 sc (2 rnds)

14 rnd- 24 sc, 12 sc together with the inside of the trunk, 24 sc (60)






15 rnd- 24 sc, 18 sc on the remaining trunk stitch, 24 sc (66) 16 rnd- (6 sc, dec)*3, 18 sc, (dec, 6 sc)*3 (60) 17-22 rnds- 60 sc (6 rnds)

Insert the eyes between the 17 and 18 rows, for a distance of 16 st. Insert the disc with the cotter pin into the amigurumi ring, start stuffing. If you do not plan to use cotter pin, skip the previous step.







Pull the hole only by the front loops. Fasten and trim the thread. Hide the end of the thread inside the part. Make tightening, as shown in the photo below. Embroider eyes with white thread






















ears (2 pcs)

Crochet in rotating rows

1 row- 6 sc in MR

2 row-ch, turn, 6 inc

3p- ch, turn, (sc, inc)*6

4p- ch, turn, 6 sc, 6 inc, 6 sc

(12)

(18)

(24)

5 row- ch, turn, 6 sc, (sc, inc)*6, 6 sc (30)
6p- ch, turn, 6 sc, (2 sc, inc)*6, 6 sc (36)
7p- ch, turn, (5 sc, inc)*6 (42)
8p- ch, turn, (6 sc, inc)*6 (48)

Fold the part in half and on both sides crochet 6-7 sc. Fasten the thread and cut it off, leaving the end for sewing. Sew the ears between the 16 and 22 rows.







body

Crochet in light gray color. Body for cotter pin mounting. Crochet from top to bottom.

ı rnd- 6 sc in MR

2 rnd- 6 inc (12) 3 rnd- (sc, inc)*6 (18)

4 rnd- (2 sc, inc)*6 (24)

5 rnd- (3 sc, inc)*6 (30)

6-7 rnds- 30 sc (2 rnds)

Insert the cotter pin into the amigurumi ring,

put the disk on and secure it, using needle-nose pliers.

8 rnd- (4 sc, inc)*6 (36)(2 rnds) 9-10 rnds- 36 sc 11 rnd- (5 sc, inc)*6 (42)12-13 rnds- 42 sc (2 rnds) (48)14 rnd- (6 sc, inc)*6 15-16 rnds- 48 sc (2 rnds) 17 rnd- 15 sc, (2 sc, inc)*6, 15 sc (54)(8 rnds) 18-25 rnds- 54 sc



26 rnd-54 sc, crochet the tail, 9 ch, starting from the 2nd st from

the hook, 8 slst by chain

Start stuffing, pay special attention to the neck.

27 rnd-	(7 sc, dec)*6	(48)
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28 rnd- 48 sc

35 rnd- 6 dec



Pull the hole only by the front loops. Fasten and trim the thread. Hide the end of the thread inside the body.

If you crochet without cotter pins, the body is crocheted from the bottom up.

1 rnd- 6 sc in MR

$$3 \text{ rnd} - (sc, inc)*6$$

9 rnd- 48 sc

10 rnd- (7 sc, inc)*6 Bcrochet the tail, 9 ch, starting from the 2nd st from the hook, 8 slst by chain

Start stuffing.

29-30 rnds- 30 sc

Fasten the thread and cut it off, leaving the end for sewing. Sew on the head.

arms (2 pcs)

Crochet in light gray color.

1 rnd- 6 sc in MR

2 rnd-6 inc (12)

(18)3 rnd- (sc, inc)*6

4 rnd- BLO 18 sc

(2 rnds) 5-6 rnds- 18 sc


7 rnd- 6 sc, 3 dec, 6 sc (15)

Start stuffing.

(14 rnds) 8-21 rnds- 15 sc

22 rnd- (3 sc, dec)*3 (12)

23 rnd- 12 sc



Pull the hole only by the front loops. Fasten and trim the thread. Hide the end of the thread inside the part.

legs (2 pcs)

Crochet in light gray color.

1 rnd-6 ch, starting from the 2nd st from the hook, 4 sc, 3 sc in 1 st,

(7 rnds)

(12)

on the other side 3 sc, inc (12)

2 rnd- inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 3 sc, 2 inc (18)

3 rnd- sc, inc, 3 sc, (sc, inc)*3, 3 sc, (sc, inc)*2 (24)

4 rnd- (3 sc, inc)*6 (30)

5 rnd- BLO 30 sc

(2 rnds) 6-7 rnds- 30 sc

8 rnd- 7 sc, 6 dec, 11 sc (24)

9 rnd- (6 sc, dec)*3 (21)

10 rnd- (5 sc, dec)*3 (18)

(3 rnds) 11-13 rnds- 18 sc

14 rnd- 2 dec, 4 sc, 4 inc, 4 sc, dec

15 rnd- 19 sc

17-23 rnds- 18 sc

16 rnd- 2 inc, 4 sc, 4 dec, 4 sc, inc

24 rnd- (4 sc, dec)*3

(15)

25 rnd- (3 sc, dec)*3



Pull the hole only by the front loops. Fasten and trim the thread. The end is hidden inside the part.

Attach the legs and arms to the body, using a thread attachment.

(the diagram is shown below). If you used a cotter pin, then the thread runs in the body between the 8 and 9 rows for the arms and between 27 and 28 rows for the legs. In the arms and legs, the thread runs in 3 rows from the end of the crochet.


If you have not used a cotter pin, the thread runs in the body between the 27 and 28 rows for the arms and between the 9 and 10 rows for the legs.

Use a thin dark gray thread to embroider the eyebrows and stripes on the trunk.











jumpsuit

Crochet in orange color, from bottom to top.

Start with pant legs

1 rnd-30 ch, close in a circle, using slst

2 rnd- ch, 30 sc, slst

3-6 rnds- 2 ch, 30 dc, slst

Fasten and trim the thread. On the second pant leg, do not cut the thread and continue to crochet

7 rnd-2 ch, 15 dc on the one pant leg, 30 dc on the second, 15 dc on the first,slst Sew the hole between the pant legs.

8 rnd- 2 ch, (dc5tog, 5 dc)*10, slst

9 rnd- 2 ch, 60 dc, slst

10 rnd- 2 ch, 4 dc, (dc5tg, 5 dc)*9, dc5tog, dc, slst

11 rnd- 2 ch, 60 dc, slst

12 rnd- 2 ch, (dc5tog, 5 dc)*10, slst

13 rnd- 2 ch, 60 dc, slst

14 rnd- 2 ch, 4 dc, (dc5tog, 5 dc)*9, dc5tog, dc, slst

15 rnd- 2 ch, (13 dc, dec dc)*4, slst

16 rnd- 2 ch, 2 dc, dc5tog, 4 dc, dc5tog,

3 dc, dec dc, dc5tog, 4 dc, dc5tog,

5 dc, dc5tog, dc, dec dc, 2 dc,

dc5tog, 4 dc, dc5tog, 3 dc, dec dc,

dc5tog, 4 dc, dc5tog, 3 dc, dec dc,

dc5tog, 3 dc, slst

17 rnd- 2 ch, (11 dc, dec dc)*4, slst

18 rnd- ch, (10 sc, dec)*4, slst

Fasten and trim the thread.

Fold the part in half. Notice

side points, for a distance of 22 st.

Attach the thread, crochet the front

part of the rotating rows

1 row- 2 ch, 9 dc, 2 dec dc, 9 dc

2 row- 2 ch, turn, (3 dc, dec dc)*2, (dec dc,

3 dc)*2

3 row- 2 ch, turn, (2 dc, dec dc)*2, (dec dc,

2 dc)*2





4 row- ch, turn, 12 sc

Fasten and trim the thread. Sew 2 buttons.

Crochet 2 straps, to do this, dial 24 ch, starting from the 10th st from the hook, crochet 15 slst. Sew on the back in the center.
