MATERIALS AND TOOLS

- 1. Yarn
 - Alize Cotton Gold of red (56) and blue (141) colors
 - Yarn Art Jeans of white (62) and black (53) colors
- 2. The hook Clover №2 (2.0 mm)
- 3. Stuffing (hollofayber)
- 4. A thick needle for sewing of the details
- 5. Scissors

ABBREVIATIONS

- MR magic ring
- ch chain
- sl st slip stitch
- sc single crochet
- hdc half double crochet
- dc double crochet
- inc increase (crochet two sc in 1 stitch)
- dec decrease (crochet two sc together)
- bk lp back loop
- (...) the number in brackets indicates the number of stitches in a row

Crochet in a spiral without sl st. At the beginning of the row use a marker or thread of different color, which help mark the first loop of each new row.

The finished toy is 17 cm = 6,7".

HEAD

Crochet with the red thread, stuff tightly in the course of crocheting.


1 rnd: 6 sc in MR	12-22 rnd: 66 sc (11 rows)
2 rnd: 6 inc (12)	23 rnd: (9 sc, dec)*6 (60)
3 rnd: (1 sc, inc)*6 (18)	24 rnd: 4 sc, dec, (8 sc, dec)*5, 4 sc (54)
4 rnd: 1 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc)*5, 1 sc (24)	25 rnd: (7 sc, dec)*6 (48)
5 rnd: (3 sc, inc)*6 (30)	26 rnd: 3 sc, dec, (6 sc, dec)*5, 3 sc (42)
6 rnd: 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc)*5, 2 sc (36)	27 rnd: (5 sc, dec)*6 (36)
7 rnd: (5 sc, inc)*6 (42)	28 rnd: 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec)*5, 2 sc (30)
8 rnd: 3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc)*5, 3 sc (48)	29 rnd: (3 sc, dec)*6 (24)
9 rnd: (7 sc, inc)*6 (54)	30 rnd: 1 sc, dec, (2 sc, dec)*5, 1 sc (18)
10 rnd: 4 sc, inc, (8 sc, inc)*5, 4 sc (60)	31 rnd: (1 sc, dec)*6 (12)
11 rnd: (9 sc, inc)*6 (66)	32 rnd: 6 dec (6)

Cut the thread, tighten the opening, hide the end of the thread in the detail. How to tighten the opening look at the link <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=IzGgdXIv8bo</u>.



LEGS (2 details)

Start to crochet with the red thread. 1 rnd: 6 sc in MR 2 rnd: 6 inc (12) 3 rnd: (1 sc, inc)*6 (18) 4-6 rnd: 18 sc (3 rows) Cut red thread, change color to blue. 7-12 rnd: 18 sc (6 rows)





BODY

Start to connect the legs. To do this make chain 6 ch from the second leg and insert the hook in the first loop of the first leg and crochet according to the scheme:

1 rnd:


On the 1^{st} leg: (7 sc, inc)*2, 2 sc

On the chain: 5 sc, inc

On the 2nd leg: (7 sc, inc)*2, 2 sc

On the other side of the chain: 5 sc, inc

In total, in the 1st row of the body, there should be 54 sc. Stuff the legs.



Further stuff the body tightly in the course of crocheting.

2-8 rnd: 54 sc (7 rows)

Crochet additional 11 sc, further cut the blue thread, change color to red.

9-11 rnd: 54 sc (3 rows)

12 rnd: (7 sc, dec)*6 (48)

13 rnd: 48 sc

14-15 rnd: 3 sc with the blue thread, 17 sc with the red thread, 28 sc with the blue thread (48) (2 rows) 16 rnd: 3 sc with the blue thread, (dec, 6 sc, dec, 7 sc) with the red thread, dec, 5 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec, 3 sc) with the blue thread (42)

17-19 rnd: 3 sc with the blue thread, 15 sc with the red thread, 24 sc with the blue thread (42) (3 rows) 20 rnd: 3 sc with the blue thread, (2 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 4 sc) with the red thread, (1 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec) with the blue thread (36)

21-23 rnd: 3 sc with the blue thread, 13 sc with the red thread, 20 sc with the blue thread (36) (3 rows)

24 rnd: 3 sc with the blue thread, (dec, 3 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec) with the red thread, (4 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 2 sc) (30)


Cut the blue thread, we won't need it anymore. Further crochet with the read thread.


25-26 rnd: 30 sc (2 rows)

27 rnd: (3 sc, dec)*6 (24)

28 rnd: 24 sc

Cut the thread, leaving a long end for sewing.





ARMS (2 details)

Start to crochet with the red thread. Stuff not tightly up to the 10th row.

1 rnd: 5 sc in MR

2 rnd: 5 inc (10)


3-7 rnd: 10 sc (5 rows)

8-19 rnd: 4 sc with the blue thread, 6 sc with the red thread (12 rows)

20 rnd: 10 sc

21 rnd: (3 sc, dec)*2 (8)

Crochet additional 4 sc. After that fold the detail in half and connect the edges by 4 sc. Cut the thread, leaving a long end for sewing.



EYES


Start to crochet with the white thread. Make chain 10 ch, insert the hook in the 2nd loop from the hook and crochet according to the scheme: 1 rnd: 8 sc, 3 sc in the last loop of the chain, further crochet on the other side of the chain 1 sc, 1 hdc, 3 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc, inc (20) 2 rnd: inc, 7 sc, 3 inc, 2 sc, 3 hdc, 2 sc, 2 inc (26) Cut the white thread, change color to black. 3 rnd: 26 sl st 4 rnd: 26 sl st for the bk lp of the 3rd row and loops of the 2nd row together How to make this row look at the link https://youtu.be/S69TROusHE4. Cut the thread, leaving a long end for sewing. It'll be the right eye (looking at the back of the head). Crochet the second eye mirrored, i.e. make chain 10 ch, insert the hook in the 2nd loop from the hook and crochet according to the scheme: 1 rnd: inc, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 3 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc, 3 in the last loop of the chain, further crochet on the other side of the chain 8 sc(20)2 rnd: 2 inc, 2 sc, 3 hdc, 2 sc, 3 inc, 7 sc, inc (26) Cut the white thread, change color to black. 3 rnd: 26 sl st 4 rnd: 26 sl st for the bk lp of the 3rd row and loops of the 2nd row together

Cut the thread, leaving a long end for sewing. It'll be the left eye (looking at the back of the head).



DESIGN OF THE BODY

Sew the head to the body. In the course of sewing stuff the neck very tightly, so as the head doesn't dangle because of its heaviness. How to sew the head to the body look at the link https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Xf6KTpVSKCE.



Sew the arms between the 26th and 27th rows of the body (I recommend steaming them first). How to sew the arms look on example at the link <u>https://youtu.be/NxPpn2gngxU</u>.





Sew or glue the eyes (I sew).





It's left to crochet the spider. To do this we should make 2 circles: small circle for the head and big circle for the body.

For small circle crochet 6 sc in MR, sl st to join in the end, cut the thread, leaving a long end for sew-

ing.

For big circle: 1 rnd: 6 sc in MR 2 rnd: 6 inc, sl st Cut the thread, leaving a long end for sewing. Sew the ready circles to the body at the center. After that embroider the spider legs (I use Alize Cotton Gold, 1 thread of 4).





Our Spiderman is ready!

I hope, it will bring a lot of joy to little (and maybe not so much) Marvel fans!
