

# Lulu's wardrobe

# Celebration days - Clothes to dress and change




4 doll outfits (and accessories) to dress Lucile, Lise and the doll "Back to school" or any other doll from 28 to 32 cm.

### Materials:

- Various color yarns (I use cotton yarn 8/4)
- Various color Sport weight soft yarn (alpaca or soft cotton)
- · Glitter or silver cotton
- A small amount of "fluffy" wool for the hand muff
- A small amount of thicker yarn of your choice for the snood
- 2,5 mm or 2,75 mm crochet hook (depending on your tension)
- Needles for sewing up
- Two 60 cm x 12 cm tulle fabric rectangles for the dresses
- A fabric rectangle (30 cm x 12 cm) for the birthday dress
- A toothpick and a skewer pick
- · Sewing thread
- Polyester toy stuffing

Clothes crocheted with the described material can dress a doll of about 30 cm.



### Stitches and abbreviations:

This pattern uses American standard abbreviations

ch: chain stitch or chain space

slst: slip stitch
sc: single crochet
hdc: half double crochet
dc: double crochet
tr: treble crochet

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bbl: bobble stitch (4 double crochet closed together in the same stitch)

inc: increase (2 stitches into 1 stitch of previous round)

dec: decrease (crochet 2 stitches together)

(...): repeat until endrd(s): round(s)

Each piece is crocheted in a continuous spiral, not in joined rounds, starting off with a magic loop- or in rows. Use a stitch marker to mark the end of each round.

At the end of each line, you will find in brackets the number of stitches you should get at the end of your row.

Notes: Color change: Always change your yarn in the last step of the last stitch, which means:

Work in previous color until 2 loops of the last stitch remain on the hook. Use the new color to complete the stitch.

The next stitch you make will be the first stitch in the new color.

Try not to cut off any yarn tails that will be needed later on, for example for stripes.

Bobble stitch: 4 double crochet closed together in the same stitch:

Yarn over. Insert the hook into the next stitch. Yarn over again and pull the yarn through the stitch (3 loops on the hook). Yarn over and draw the yarn through the first 2 loops on the hook (2 loops remaining on the hook).

Repeat the previous steps 3 times in the same stitch (you now have 4 half closed double-crochet stitches into one stitch). Yarn over and pull the yarn through all 5 loops on the hook.

# Happy birthday: dress and vest - lollipop, balloon and party hat

### Dress: (with cotton yarn, 2 colors - 2,5mm hook)

The dress is made by crocheting the bodice then using fabric to form the skirt.

1	With dark gray Chain 19	(19)
2	18 sc along the chain, ch2 turn	(18)
3	18 (hdc)inc, ch2 turn	(36)
4	36 hdc, ch1 turn Join the silver yarn	(36)
5	Silver: 36 sc, ch1 turn	(36)
6	Dark gray (through back loop only): 4sc, ch 6, skip 10 stitches, inc, (3sc, inc) x2, ch 6, skip 10 stitches, 4sc, ch1 turn	(32)
7	Through 2 loops: inc, 3sc, 6sc (along the chain), 12sc, 6sc (along the chain), 3sc, inc	(34)





### Skirt:

Cut a fabric rectangle of approximately 30cm x 12cm.

Form the skirt by stitching a running stitch at the top of the fabric and gather it until it measures the same size as the bodice (approx. 13 cm).

Fold the fabric in half (right sides facing) and sew the skirt close leaving an opening of 4cm at the top. Sew the skirt and bodice together then hem the bottom of the skirt.

Crochet little loops at the top of the back of the bodice to close it.

### Vest: (with sport yarn - 2,5mm hook)

\* see note "bobble stitch " page 2.

2	25 sc along the chain, ch2 turn	(25)
3	1 (hdc)inc, 11hdc, 1 (hdc)inc, 11hdc, 1 (hdc)inc, ch2 turn	(28)
4	4hdc, ch 6, skip 5 stitches, 10hdc, ch 6, skip 5 stitches, 4hdc, <i>ch2 turn</i>	(30)
5	3hdc, 1 (hdc)inc, 6hdc, 1 (hdc)inc, 8hdc, 1 (hdc)inc, 6hdc, 1 (hdc)inc, 3hdc, ch2 turn	(34)
6	4hdc, 1 (hdc)inc, (5hdc, 1 (hdc)inc) x4, 5hdc, ch1 turn	(39)
7	(4sc, 1 bobble stitch) x 7, 4sc, ch2 turn	(39)
8	19hdc, 1 <i>(hdc)</i> inc, 19 hdc, <i>ch1 turn</i>	(40)
9	2sc, 1 bbl st., (4sc, 1 bbl st.) x 7, 2sc, ch2 turn	(40)
10	10hdc, 1(hdc)inc, 18hdc, 1(hdc)inc, 10hdc	(42)



Do not cut the yarn and crochet the <u>picot</u>: Ch 2, [2hdc (in the same st.), ch 2, 2hdc (in the same st.), 1slst] x7, 2hdc, ch 2, 2hdc. Cut the yarn and fasten off.

Take the silver yarn and crochet sc all around the border.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

# Party hat: (with cotton yarn (glitter and pink) - 2,5mm hook)

2	2 sc, inc (x2)	(8)
3	3 sc, inc (x2)	(10)
4	4 sc, inc (x2)	(12)
5	5 sc, inc (x3)	(15)
6	15 sc around	(15)
7	4 sc, inc (x3)	(18)
8	18 sc around	(18)
9	5 sc, inc (x3)	(21)
10	21 sc around	(21)
11	6 sc, inc (x3)	(24)
12	24 sc around	(24)
13	7 sc, inc (x3)	(27)
14	Pink: 27 sc around	(27)



Cut the yarn and fasten off.

Make a pompom about 2 cm in diameter and sew it on the top.

Attach an elastic thread or two strands of wool to hold the hat on the head.

# Lollipop: (with cotton yarn (2 colors) - 2,5mm hook - toothpick)

Consists of two strips assembled together.

### The pink stipe:

1	Chain 53	(53)
2	52 sc along the chain Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.	(52)

### The white stripe:

1	Chain 41	(41)
2	40 sc along the chain  Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.	(40)

### Assembly:

Place the white part on the pink one and roll up to form a snail. Sew together with the remaining threads. Cut the yarn and fasten off. Slide a stick at the bottom of the lollipop.







# Balloon: (with cotton yarn - 2,5mm hook)

1	6 sc in magic ring	(6)
2	inc (x6)	(12)
3	1 sc, inc (x6)	(18)
4	18 sc around	(18)
5	2 sc, inc (x6)	(24)
6-10	24 sc around, 5 rounds	(24)
11	2 sc, dec (x6)	(18)
12	18 sc around	(18)
13	1 sc, dec (x6)	(12)
14	12 sc around	(12)
15	dec x6	(6)
16	2 hdc in each st around	(12)



Stuff the ballon firmly as you go.
Fasten off and weave in ends by tightening the round 15.
For the balloon's string you can use a skewer pick or a piece of yarn.

# Fairy tale: Dress - crown, wings and magic wand

### Dress: (with cotton yarn - 2,5mm hook)

The dress is made by crocheting the bodice then using tulle fabric to form the skirt.

1	Chain 21	(21)
2	20 sc along the chain, ch2 turn	(20)
3	(1hdc, 1 (hdc)inc) x10, ch2 turn	(30)
4	1 (hdc)inc, 28 hdc, 1 (hdc)inc, ch1 turn	(32)
5	4 sc, ch 6, skip 8 stitches, 8 sc, ch 6, skip 8 stitches, 4 sc, ch1 turn	(28)
6	3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc)x3, 3 sc, ch1 turn	(32)
7	5 sc, (inc, 10 sc)x2, 5 sc, ch1 turn	(34)
8	inc, 32 sc, inc	(36)
9	36 sc, <i>ch1 turn</i>	(36)
10	(11 sc, inc) x3, ch1 turn	(39)
11-12	39 sc, ch1 turn, <b>2 rows</b>	(39)
13	Picot: Start with 1slst, then crochet (3 dc in same stitch, 1slst in next stitch) x18. Slst. (19 "picots" in total)	

Fasten off, leave a tail to sew the bodice onto the skirt.



# <u>Picot around the sleeves</u>: Join the yarn with a slst on the side of the armholes and crochet (3 dc *in same stitch*, 1slst *in next stitch*) x4. Fasten off and weave in the yarn with a needle join method. Proceed in the same way for the other sleeve.

### Skirt:

Trace and cut two tulle rectangles of approximately 30cm x 12cm. Form the skirt by stitching a running stitch at the top of the fabric and gather it until it measures the same size as the bodice (16cm). Sew the skirt and bodice together. You can either add ties (or button + strap) at the back of the neckline and at the bottom of the bodice to close the dress, or sew the bottom of the bodice on one centimeter (in order to be able to still put on the dress) and add only a tie at the neckline. The back of the skirt remains open.

### Crown: (with glitter cotton yarn - 2,5mm hook)

1	Chain 63, make sure the chain isn't twisted and join with a slst.	(63)
2	Continue working in rounds 63 sc	(63)
3	63 sc around	(63)
4	[3 hdc (in same stitch), ch 3, 3 hdc (in next stitch) skip 2 stitches, 1slst, skip 2 stitches] x9	

Join with a slst in the fist hdc. Cut the yarn and fasten off.



Consists of two pieces of wings assembled together (make 4)

1	Chain 10	Start in 2nd ch from hook :	(10)
2		, (5dc <i>in same stitch</i> ), rotate and continue e side of chain : 2dc, 3hdc, 3sc, <i>ch1 turn</i>	(21)
3	3sc, 3hdc, [1de	c, 1(dc)inc] x4,1dc, 3hdc, 3sc, ch1 turn	(25)
4	3sc, 3hdc, [1de	c,1(dc)inc] x6, 1dc, 3hdc, 3sc	(31)

Do not cut the thread and continue crocheting along the side : **inc** (in the corner), **3sc**, **slst**. Cut the yarn and fasten off.

<u>Assembling the wings</u>: Sew the wings into pairs on the straight edge. Layer them back to back and crochet **a border** around each pair of wings (in back loop only):

Insert the hook through the corresponding stitches of both layers to crochet them together (start in the pair seam): 6sc, (inc, 2sc) x2, 1(hdc)inc, (2hdc, 1(hdc)inc) x2, (2sc, inc) x2, 6sc + 2sc in the seam and continue the same pattern on the other side. Finish with a slst. Cut the yarn and fasten off.

Crochet 60 ch to hold the wings to the doll: Sew it in the middle at the top of the wing joint and each end at the bottom to form straps.


### Magic wand: (with glitter cotton yarn - 2,5mm hook)

Crochet two identical stars and assemble them one on top of the other by sewing the edges with a needle.

1	5 sc in magic ring	(5)
2	inc (x5)	(10)
3	1 sc, inc (x5) Close the circle with a slst	(15)
4	Ch 5, then crochet along the chain: (1sc, 1hdc, 1dc, 1tr, skip 2 stitches, slst in next st) x5	(24)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Insert a skewer pick as a stick.





# Halloween party: Witch hat and dress - pumpkin bag, lollipop and mushroom

Dress: (with cotton yarn - 2,5mm hook)

The dress is made by crocheting the bodice then using tulle fabric to form the skirt.

Crocheted in the same way as the  $\underline{Fairy\ dress}$  (page 5) round 1 to 12, only the **picot** changes :

13 Picot: Start with a slst, then crochet: (53) (2hdc, ch2, 2hdc, slst) x7, 2hdc, ch2, 1hdc, slst (8 "picots" in total)

Fasten off, leave a tail to sew the bodice onto the skirt.

On this version, there is no picot around sleeves.

### Skirt:

Repeat the explanations of the fairy dress page 5.



# Pumpkin bag: (with cotton yarn - 2,5mm hook)

1	6 sc in magic ring	(6)
2	inc (x6)	(12)
3	1 sc, inc (x6)	(18)
4	2 sc, inc (x6)	(24)
5	3 sc, inc (x6)	(30)
6	4 sc, inc (x6)	(36)
7-8	36 sc around, 2 rounds	(36)
9	4 sc, dec (x6)	(30)
10-11	30 sc around, 2 rounds	(30)
12	8 sc, dec (x3)	(27)
13	27 sc around	(27)
14	7 sc, dec (x3)	(24)
15	24 sc around	(24)

Finish the round with a slst and continue with the handle: Chain 58. Cut the yarn and sew the handle on the top of the bag. Fasten off and weave in ends.



Using a black thread, embroider the eyes in the shape of a triangle on round 11 with 5 sts between each eye and the mouth in the shape of a zigzag on round 8 (about 8 stitches long).

Weave in ends.

Hat: (with cotton yarn (2 colors) - 2,5mm hook)

16-17	30 sc around, 2 rounds	(30)
18	4 sc, inc (x6)	(36)
19-20	36 sc around, 2 rounds	(36)

Attach an elastic thread or two strands of wool to hold the hat on the head.

Finish the work with a slst, cut the yarn and close the round invisible.





### Mushroom: (with cotton yarn (2 colors) - 2,5mm hook)

### Start with the base:

1	Natural 6 sc in magic ring	(6)
2	inc (x6)	(12)
3-5	12 sc around, 3 rounds	(12)
6	dec, 4 sc (x2)	(10)
7-8	10 sc around, 2 rounds	(10)
9	dec, 3 sc (x2)	(8)
10	8 sc around	(8)
11	dec, 2 sc (x2)	(6)
12-13	6 sc around, 2 rounds	(6)
14	inc <i>(x6)</i>	(12)
15	Through back loop only: 1 sc, inc (x6)	(18)
16	Through back loop only: 2 sc, inc (x6)	(24)
17	Through back loop only: 3 sc, inc (x6)	(30)
18	Through 2 loops: 30 sc around	(30)



Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.



### Mushroom hat:

1	Rust 6 sc in magic ring	(6)
2	inc (x6)	(12)
3	1 sc, inc (x6)	(18)
4	2 sc, inc (x6)	(24)
5	24 sc around	(24)
6	3 sc, inc (x6)	(30)
7	30 sc around	(30)

Stuff the mushroom base firmly then cover it with the hat. Sew the hat on the base by passing the thread through each stitch from top to bottom. Fasten off and weave in ends.



# Merry Christmas: Dress and hand muff - snood, headband and teddy bear

# Dress: (with cotton yarn - 2,5mm hook)

1	Chain 22	(22)
2	21 sc along the chain, ch2 turn	(21)
3	2hdc, (2hdc, 1 (hdc)inc) x5, 4hdc, ch2 turn	(26)
4	2dc, (3dc, 1 (dc)inc) x5, 4dc, ch2 turn	(31)
5	4hdc, ch7, skip 6 stitches, 5hdc, 1 (hdc)inc, 5hdc, ch7, skip 6 stitches, 4hdc, ch2 turn	(34)
6	34hdc, ch2 turn	(34)
7	34hdc, ch1 turn	(34)
8	34sc, ch1 turn	(34)
9	ch2, 1hdc, 33 <i>(hdc)</i> inc	(68)
	Sequences between ( ) are crocheted in the same stitch:	
10	(ch3, 1dc), skip 1st, [(1dc, ch1, 1dc), skip 1st] x32, (1dc, ch1, 1dc)	
11	Join both ends with a slst in the start ch and continue working in rounds: 1sc in the 1°ch space, [ch3, 1sc in the next space] repeat more times. Close the round with a slst.	
12	Shell stitch: start with slst to reach the first space, (ch3, 2dc, ch1, 3dc) in the 1°ch space, 1sc in the next space, [(3dc, ch1, 3dc) in the next space, 1sc in the next space] repeat until the end of the round, slst.	
13	Hem stitch: (ch4, 1dc, ch1, 1dc) in the 1°ch space, ch2, 1sc in the tip of the shell point, [ch2, (1dc, ch1, 1dc, ch1, 1dc in the sc of the previous rd) ch2, 1sc in the tip of the shell point] repeat until the end of the round, ch2, slst.	
14	1sc (in the middle dc of the 3dc of the previous rd), [ch2, (1dc, ch1, 1dc, ch1, 1dc) in the sc of the previous rd, ch2, 1sc in the middle dc of the 3dc] repeat until the end of the round, slst.	
15	(ch4, 1dc, ch1, 1dc) in the sc of the previous rd, ch2, 1sc (in the middle dc of the 3dc), [ch2, (1dc, ch1, 1dc, ch1, 1dc) ch2, 1sc (in the middle dc of the 3dc)] repeat until the end of the round, ch2, slst.	
	Repeat one more time rounds 14 and 15 (4 rounds in total).	

Finish the work with a slst, cut the yarn and close the round invisible. Crochet two 12 ch tie on each side of the back of the neckline to attach it or sew a small button.










# Hand muff: (with "fluffy" wool - 2,5mm hook)

1 Crochet a loosely ch 16, make sure the chain isn't (16) twisted and join with a slst.

2-11 16 sc around, *12 rounds* (16)


Finish the work with a slst, cut the yarn and close the round invisibly. Crochet a ch 55 to make a handle and sewing it at the top of each side of the hand muffs.



56 ch. Starting in the 3rd chain from hook: 54dc along the chain. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Make a pompom about 4 cm in diameter and sew it on one of the ends. At the other end, make a loop to close the snood.

It wraps twice around the neck.



1	Chain 68	(68)
2	66 hdc along the chain, ch2 turn	(66)
3-4	66 hdc, <i>ch2 turn</i> , <b>2 rows</b>	(66)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Sew a button on one of the ends. At the other end, make a loop to close the headband in the neck.

### Ears: Make 2

1	6 sc in magic loop	(6)
2	inc <i>(x6)</i>	(12)
3-6	12 sc around, 4 rounds	(12)
7	2 sc, dec (x3)	(9)
	Flatten the ears and close the opening. Fold the end together and sew the edge. Leaving a long tail for sewing the ears onto the headband.	

Antler: (with dark color - 2,5mm hook)

Work separately, the large branch and then the small branch (make two of each). Large branch:

1	7 sc in magic loop	(7)
2-10	7 sc around, 9 rounds	(7)

### Small branch:

1	7 sc in magic loop	(7)
2-4	7 sc around, 3 rounds	(7)







Stuff the antler lightly. Sew the small branch onto the large one at round 6.

Sew the two antler parts on both sides of the headband just above the ears.

### Teddy bear: (with cotton yarn (or sport yarn ) - 2,5mm hook)

The head, the body and the legs are worked in a single piece (from head to leg). Stuff firmly, adding more as you go.

1	6 sc in magic ring	(6)
2	inc (x6)	(12)
3	1 sc, inc (x6)	(18)
4	2 sc, inc (x6)	(24)
5-8	24 sc around, 4 rounds	(24)
9	2 sc, dec (x6)	(18)
10	1 sc, dec (x6)	(12)
11	dec x6	(6)
12	6 sc around	(6)
13	inc (x6)	(12)
14	12 sc around	(12)
15	2 sc, inc (x4)	(16)
16-19	16 sc around, 4 rounds	(16)

To make the legs, divide the work identifying 1 st for the front central space between the legs, 1 st for the back and 7 sts for each leg. Join the last st for the leg on the back side to the front side, with a slst. The stitches of the first leg are now forming a circle:

20-23	7 sc around, 4 rounds	(7)
24	dec x3, 1 slst	(3)

<u>Second leg</u>: Join the yarn again in the second unworked st at the back of round 19 and repeat rounds 20 to 24. Finish stuffing the leg. Fasten off and close remaining sts, weaving in ends. Sew the opening between the legs with a needle.



Arms: 5 sc in magic ring.
2-6 5 sc around, 5 rounds (5)
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing the arms onto the body.

Ears: 6 sc in magic ring.

Tighten the ring but do not join it in a circle.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing the ears onto the head.

**Embroider the eyes** at round 7 leaving a space of 6 sts between them and a nose in the middle.
