

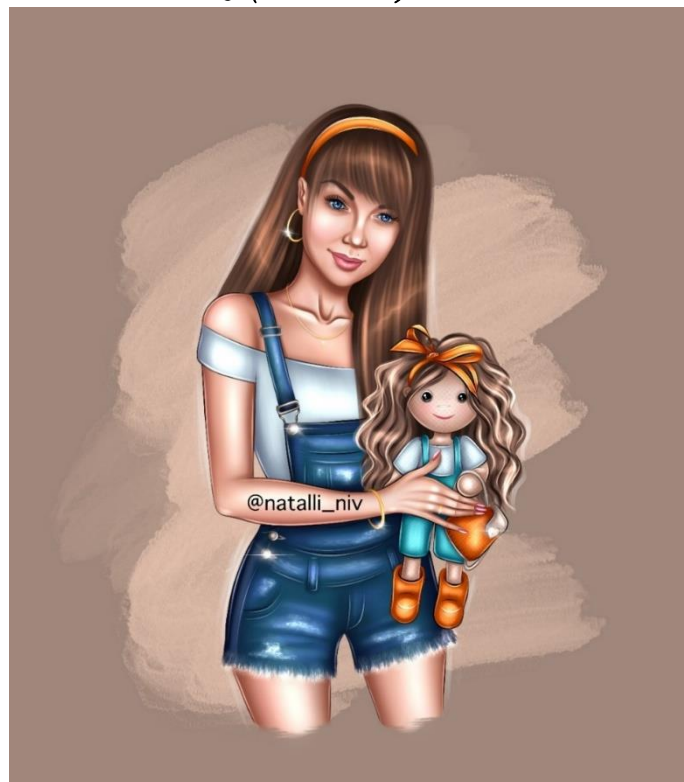

- The finished product using the materials indicated in this pattern is 30 cm tall.
- Choose the right hook size for the yarn you are using.
- Stuff all pieces as you go.
- You are allowed to share the images of your ready toy that you make with this pattern but please give me a credit as the designer and tag #crochet\_with\_natalli\_niv

## THE REQUIRED MATERIALS

### 1. Yarn colors:

Sport weight/4ply yarn Yarnart Jeans: 55 % cotton, 45 % acrylic. 50g/160m.



62 – white

07 – beige

75 – denim blue

26 – red

29 – pistachio green

36 – pink

Lace weight/1ply yarn Yarnart Iris: cotton – 100%. Weight – 20g. Length 138m.



935 – black

Sport weight/4ply yarn Alize cotton gold: 55 % cotton, 45 % acrylic. 100g/330m.



83 – orange

2. Tapestry needle
3. Polyester toy stuffing material
4. 1.75 mm crochet hook
5. Safety eyes D=12 mm
6. Glue
7. Scissors
8. Wire 0.3 mm for body frame
9. Adhesive bandage (to isolate wire ends)
10. Stitch marker (to mark the first stitch in a round)
11. Needles (for needle sculpting)
12. Cardboard or plastic (for the sole)
12. Jute (for a circle)

## ABBREVIATIONS (US)

**MR** - magic ring

**Sc** - single crochet

**Ch** - chain

**Inc** - increase (2 sc in one stitch)

**Dec** - decrease (2 sc together)

**Sl st** - slip stitch

**BLO** – back loops only



- The number at the end of the round indicates the total number of stitches.
- (..) \* N – repeat the instruction in brackets N times as directed.
- **Follow the marker** – start following from the first stitch, the marker should go straight. If there are extra stitches, align the marker (by crocheting / loosening stitches).
- **Do not follow the marker** – ignore marker shifting.

## Extra (shifting) stitch

Very often, the “extra stitch” confuses crafters.

In fact, everything is simple.

You can ignore the extra stitch altogether and work according to the pattern, but then the part may turn out to be a little wry. These are features of crocheting in a spiral.

In order to avoid curve, in addition to the round that we finished, crochet 1 or 2 sc of the next round and do not count them, but simply move the marker 1 or 2 sc to the left!

I.e. **the extra stitch is always the first stitch of the round** (work like a regular sc).

Please note that the extra stitch is not included in the total number of stitches!

When using an extra stitch, work with a marker. This will make it easier for you to determine when and how many extra stitches to use.

The extra stitch is needed to ensure all bulges on the toy are in the right place.

This stitch is especially necessary when crocheting difficult toys, when there are a lot of increases in one place, and in the next round there are more increases and the description says that they should be above the previous ones.

## Stitch marker

### Thread

With a thread, I mark the first stitch of the round.

When we reach the end of the round, do not need to crochet the marked stitch, because we have already worked it, as the first.

After finishing the round to the end (the thread marked the 1st stitch of the same round), threw the thread, which we use as a marker and crochet the first stitch of the new round. The picture clearly shows how the thread marker should look like.

At the end, you simply pull out the thread and done!

### Thread in a contrasting color

Each toy consists mainly of parts that are crocheted in a spiral, and this is where the marker is needed.

- A marker usually marks the beginning of rounds.
- A marker marks important places on the part, for example, where to sew on eyes, arms, etc.





## Color change

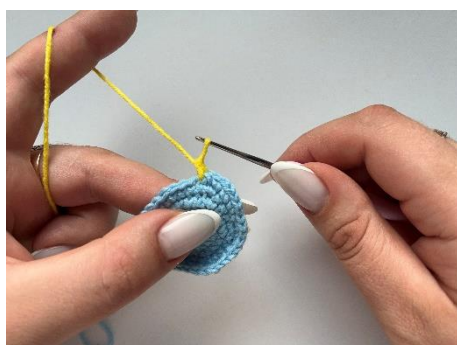
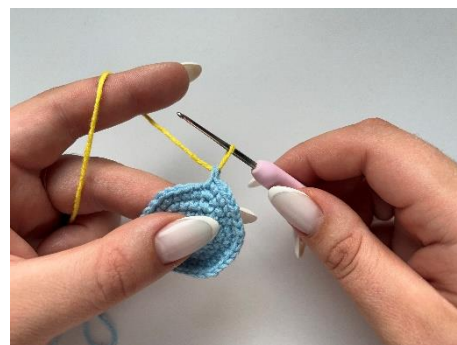
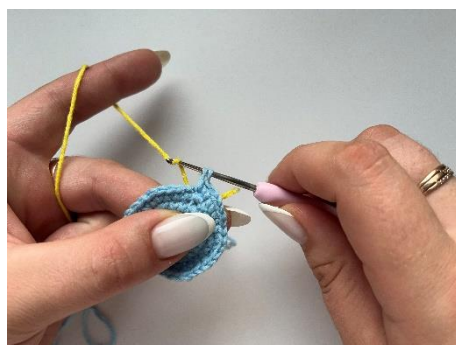
- Before changing color, do not finish the last stitch, leave 2 loops on the hook.
- Take a thread of a different color, use a hook to pull it through 2 loops.
- Work the round in a new color as usual in a spiral.

## STUFFING

Toys should be well and firmly stuffed. In the description there are always notes, whether we stuff the part tightly or do not stuff at all.

Dense stuffing helps keep the shape of the part well.

Depending on what crocheting technique you have, the stuffing of the toy will also depend. If you crochet loosely and there are holes in the fabric, then try to stuff it not very tightly, as the fiberfill will be visible.

Stuff the toy gradually, as you go.

Scissors or wooden sticks will help you stuff it.

Since we have frame toys, we begin to stuff after we have inserted the wire. The fiberfill is evenly distributed over the entire part around the wire.



## FINISHING

The pattern always indicates what we are doing with a working yarn.

In some parts, tighten the hole and cut the yarn.

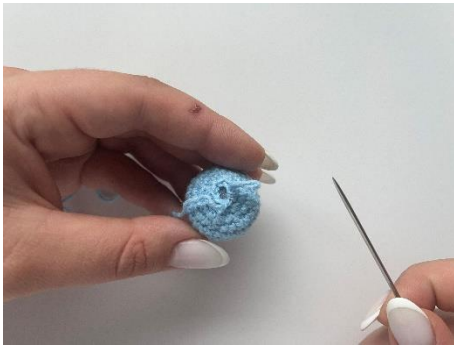
In others parts, cut the yarn, fasten off and hide it, or maybe cut the yarn, fasten off and leave a long end for sewing.

- **How to secure the working yarn**

1. Work the round to the end
2. Cut the yarn (be sure to look whether you need to leave the end for sewing or not)
3. Thread the hook into the loop
4. Pull out the working thread.

• **How to pull off the hole to close**

1. After the parts are done, cut the yarn, leaving the end 10 cm long.
2. Take a needle with a large eye, thread the end into the needle.
3. Grab the front loop of each stitch with a needle and pull the thread through.
4. Pull the yarn end.
5. Insert the needle into the middle of the tightened hole.
6. Exit it through the opposite side.
7. Cut the excess yarn end.



## **WIRE FRAME FOR THE LEGS.**

You will need:



- Galvanized steel wire with a diameter of 1-1.5 mm, about 4 m long;
- Adhesive bandage 3 cm wide for wrapping the wire and insulating sharp ends;
- Wire cutters.

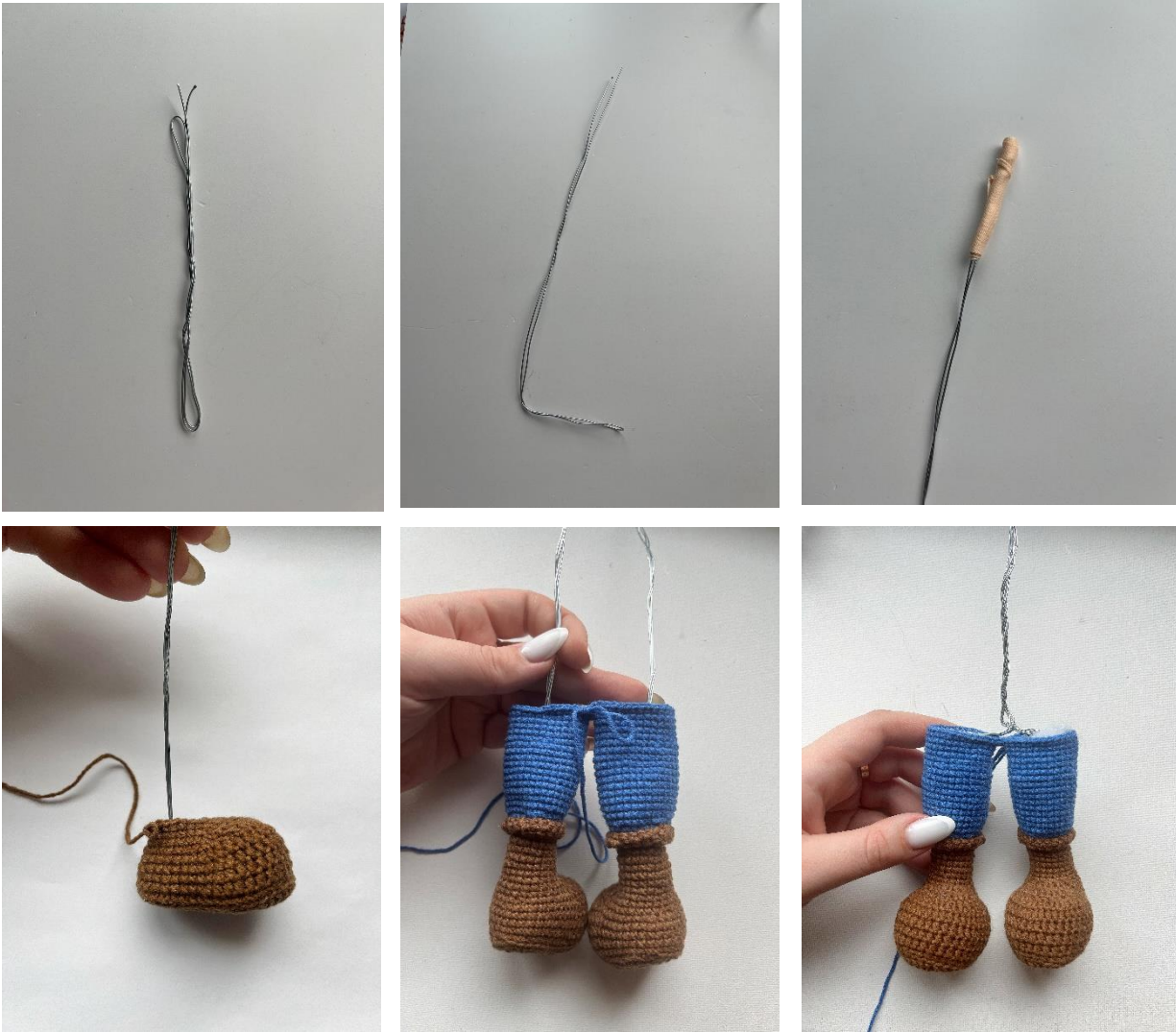
Make the frame in the process of crocheting the toy.

Legs wire frame:

Cut two pieces of wire so that each is about 2 times longer than the crocheted part - they will create a frame for the legs.

1. Take a piece 90 cm long. Fold it in half and twist.
2. Fold over one side of each of the leg pieces to form a support for the foot, as shown in photo.
3. Bend and isolate the sharp end of the wire with adhesive plaster.
4. Insert the wire into the leg (shoe) so that the toy stands independently.
5. Stuff the leg (boot) tightly with fiberfill.

Repeat this for both legs.



After connecting the two legs, we will have a common frame that will run along the entire body to the he.

### **Common wire frame:**

6. In two parts, bend the wire in half so as to outline the hip joint.
7. On both pieces, step back a little from the bend and bend the wire up again.
8. Connect the wires and twist together. The wire should be located in the center of the body.

In the photo you can see how the frame looks without the toy.

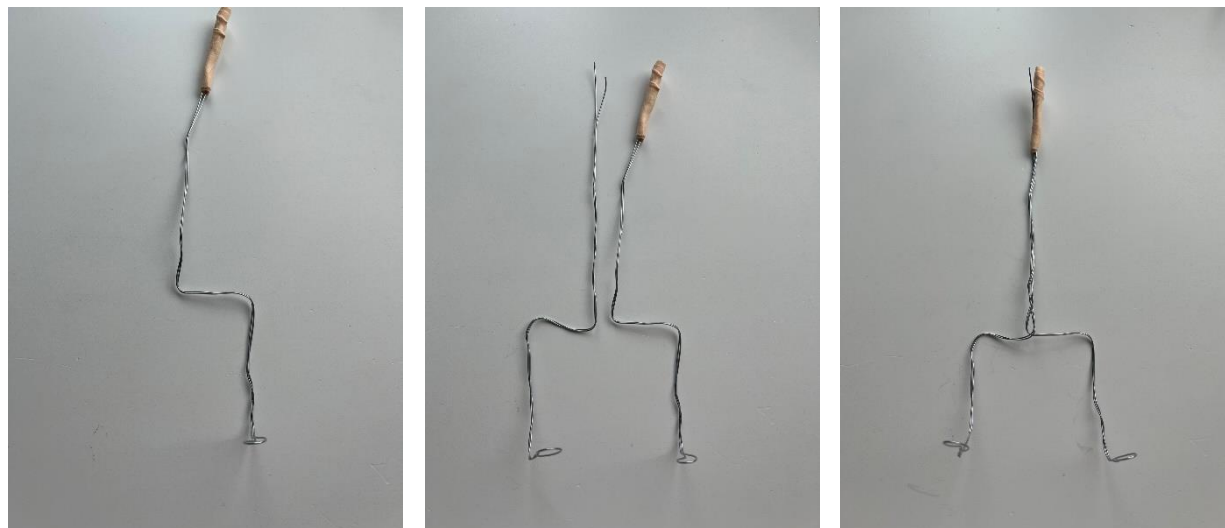

**It is better to prepare the frame for the arms only after they are crocheted into the body. Then:**

9. Take a piece 60 cm long. Fold it in half and twist it as shown in the photo.
10. Isolate the sharp end of the wire with adhesive plaster.
11. In two parts, bend the wire in half so as to outline the shoulder joint.
12. On both pieces, step back a little from the bend and bend the wire up again.
13. Insert the wire into the arm.
14. If it is indicated in the pattern to stuff with fiberfill, then stuff the arm.
15. Twist the doll's main frame to secure the wire in place.

The frame is ready! It remains to put on only the head on the doll - for this:

16. Leave 5-10 cm of wire on top, cut off the excess.
17. Isolate all ends of the wire with adhesive plaster.

A doll turns out to be movable and stable.

In the photo you can see how the frame looks without the toy.

## HEAD

**!!! TIP. Do not follow the marker. The head is crocheted from top to bottom. Stuff with polyfill.**

Begin crocheting with yarn No.07 (beige).

1. 6 sc in MR
2. inc \*6 /12
3. (1 sc, inc) \*6 /18
4. (2 sc, inc) \*6 /24
5. (3 sc, inc) \*6 /30
6. (4 sc, inc) \*6 /36
7. (5 sc, inc) \*6 /42
8. (6 sc, inc) \*6 /48
- 9-10. 48 sc (2 rounds)
11. (7 sc, inc) \*6 /54
12. (8 sc, inc) \*6 /60
13. 60 sc
14. (9 sc, inc) \*6 /66
- 15-16. 66 sc (2 rounds)
17. (10 sc, inc) \*6 /72
18. 72 sc

**If you insert safety eyes, then crochet round 19 according to this description. If you use cabochon eyes, then work 72 sc.**

19. 28 sc, ch1, skip 1 sc, 14 sc, ch1, skip 1 sc, 28 sc /72
- 20-25. 72 sc (6 rounds)

**!!! ATTENTION. If you use safety eyes, then insert them into the holes in round 19. See page 27 how to install eye.**

26. (7 sc, dec) \*8 /64
27. (6 sc, dec) \*8 /56
28. (5 sc, dec) \*8 /48



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29. (4 sc, dec) \*8 /40

30. (3 sc, dec) \*8 /32

31. (2 sc, dec) \*8 /24

32. (2 sc, dec) \*6 /18

33. (1 sc, dec) \*6 /12



**Stuff with polyfill. Do NOT pull off the hole.**

Fasten off, cut the yarn and weave in ends. Photo 1.

## **EARS.**

**!!! TIP. Do not follow the marker.**

**Crochet 2 similar pieces.**

Begin crocheting with yarn No.07 (beige).

1. 6 sc in MR

Fasten off, and cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing. Photo 2.



# DECORATION

## 1. EYES NEEDLE SCULPTING

### 1.1. NEEDLE SCULPTING FOR CABOCHON EYES

You will need:

- Needle with a large eye;
- Sewing pins (8 pcs.);
- Scissors.

**Make the needle sculpting with yarn No.07 (beige).**

Prepare 8 pins.

Count 17 rounds down from the amigurumi ring **DOWN**.

Points 3 and 4, 7 and 8 between rounds 17 and 18. **Photo 3.**

Points 1 and 2, 5 and 6 between rounds 20 and 21. **Photo 3.**

**Focus on rounds 17-18.**

**The distance between the legs of the eyes 12 sc. Photo 3.**

**Between points 1 and 5 the distance - 12 sc (focus on round 20). Photo 3.**

**Between points 3 and 7 the distance - 12 sc (focus on round 17). Photo 3.**

Between points 1 **RIGHT** and 2 there is a distance of 3 sc. **Photo 4.**

Between points 1 **UP** and 3 there is a distance of 3 sc. **Photo 4.**



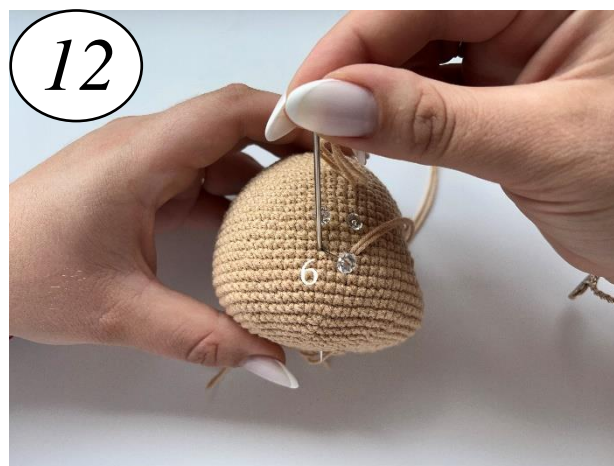


Insert the needle into the base of the head and exit it through point 5. Next, insert it at point 6 and exit it through the base of the head. Pull. **Photo 11-12.**

Insert the needle into the base of the head and exit it through point 5. Next, insert it at point 7 and exit it through the base of the head. Pull. **Photo 13-14.**

Insert the needle into the base of the head and exit it through point 6. Next, insert it at point 8 and exit it through the base of the head. Pull. **Photo 15-16.**

Repeat several times. Pull.



*Fasten off, cut the yarn and weave in ends.*

When tightening, pull the thread tightly, but do not overdo it, as the thread may break. **Photo 17-18.**



## 1.2. NEEDLE SCULPTING FOR SAFETY EYES

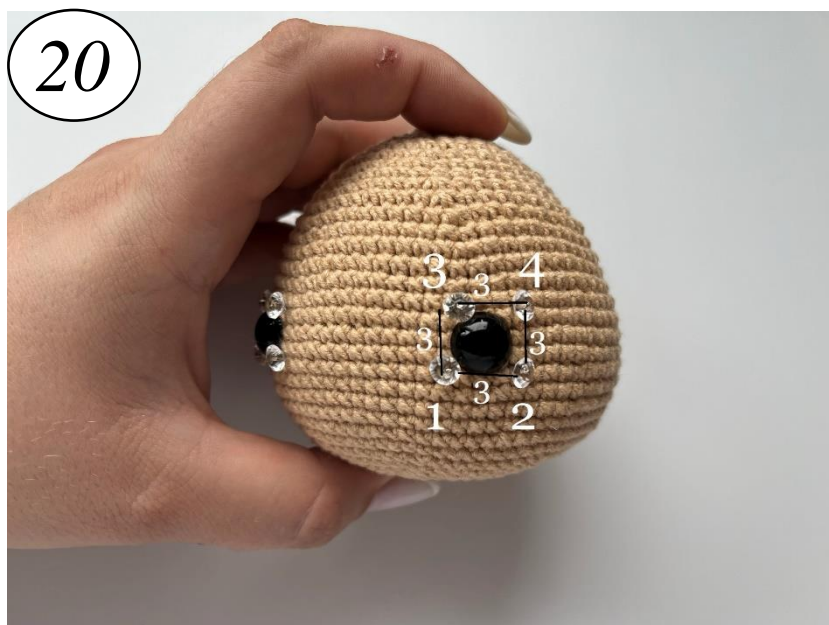
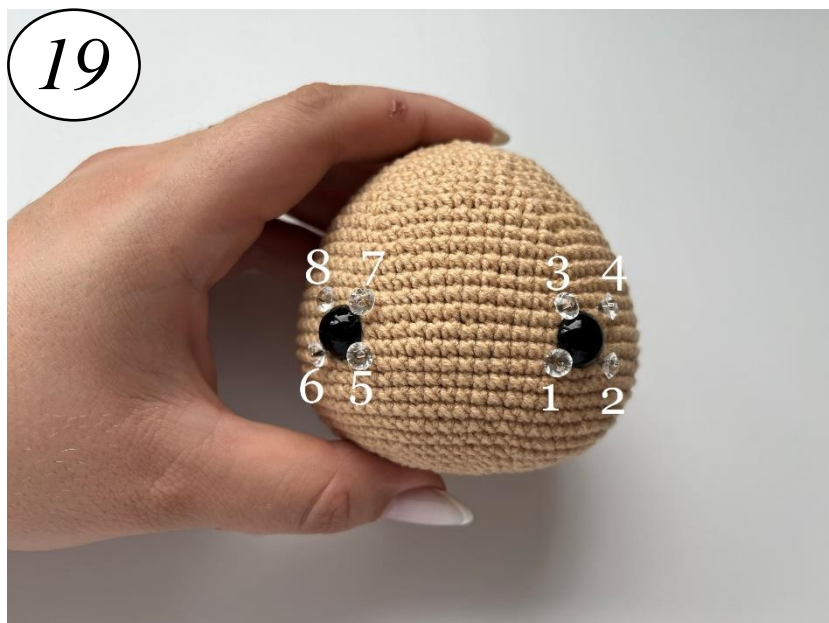

**Place pins in the same way as for the cabochon eyes. Only we no longer need to determine where the eyes will be. The pins are located at the corners of the eyes. Photo 19-20.**



Insert the needle into the base of the head and exit it through point 1. Next, insert it at point 2 and exit it through the base of the head. Pull. **Photo 21-22.**

Insert the needle into the base of the head and exit it through point 1. Next, insert it at point 3 and exit it through the base of the head. Pull. **Photo 23-24.**

Insert the needle into the base of the head and exit it through point 2. Next, insert it at point 4 and exit it through the base of the head. Pull. **Photo 25-26.**

Repeat several times. Pull.



Insert the needle into the base of the head and exit it through point 5. Next, insert it at point 6 and exit it through the base of the head. Pull. **Photo 27-28.**

Insert the needle into the base of the head and exit it through point 5. Next, insert it at point 7 and exit it through the base of the head. Pull. **Photo 29-30.**

Insert the needle into the base of the head and exit it through point 6. Next, insert it at point 8 and exit it through the base of the head. Pull. **Photo 31-32.**

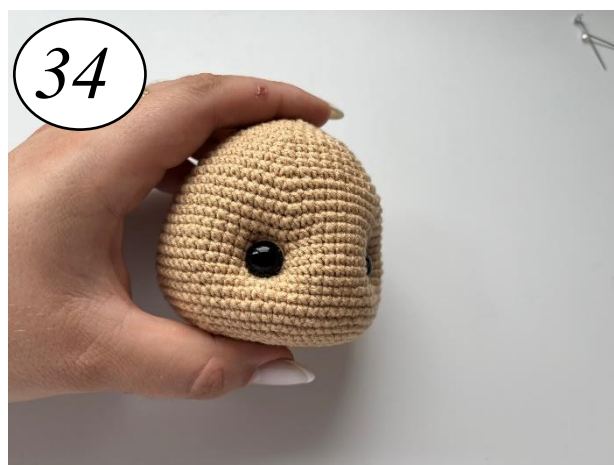
Repeat several times. Pull.





Fix the thread and cut the excess ends.

When tightening, pull the thread tightly, but do not overdo it, as the thread may break. **Photo 33-34.**



## 2. HOW TO GLUE THE EYES

You will need: **Photo 35.**

- Cabochon eyes;
- Super Glue.

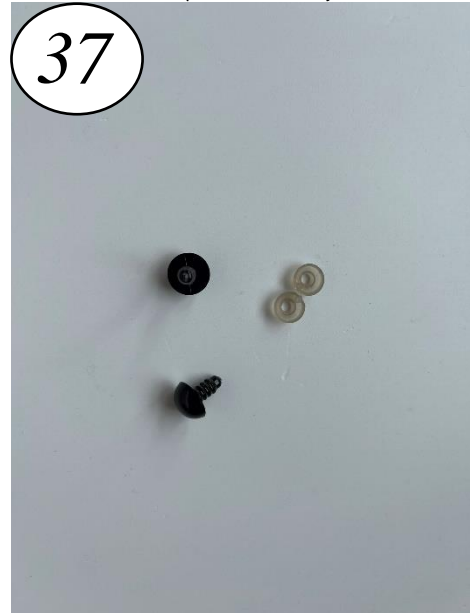
1. Apply glue well to the back side of the eye.
2. Glue the eye in place of the tightening.
3. Hold for a couple of seconds. Done. **Photo 36.**



### 3. HOW TO INSTALL SAFETY EYES.

You will need: **Photo 37.**

- Safety eyes with washers;
- Pliers.



1. Insert eyes into the holes that we left when crocheting the head.

2. Secure the washers with pliers from the wrong side. **Photo 38-40.**



## 4. HOW TO DESIGN THE FACE AND MAKE A NEEDLE SCULPTING OF THE MOUTH

### 4.1. Face Design. Photo 41.

Before you tighten the mouth, design the face of your doll. Each toy has its own nuances of face design, you will see this in the process, but you can see the basic points in this video.

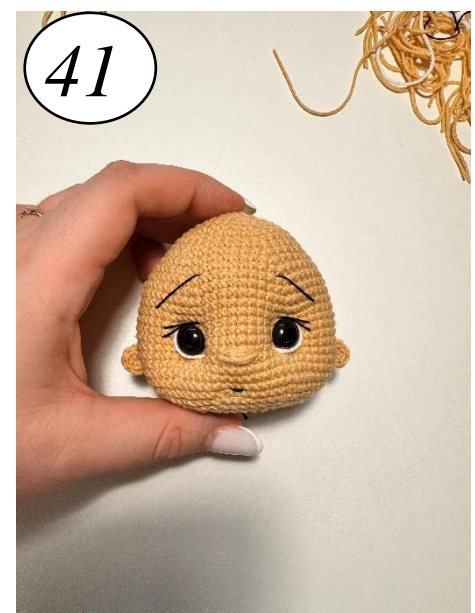

- Glue on eyes (if you use half beads).
- Embroider whites of the eyes with white yarn No 62 (white).
- Embroider eyebrows with black yarn No.935. Move 2 rounds up from the eyes (rounds 14-15), width - 5 sc obliquely (or straight), distance between the eyebrows - 7 sc
- Embroider eyelids with black yarn No. 935 above and under the eyes and embroider lashes.
- Embroider a nose with yarn No. 07 (beige) in rounds 20-21. Step 1 round down from the eyes and embroider a nose 4 sc wide.
- Sew on the ears in rounds 20-21. Move 6 sc to the sides from the eyes.



## 4.2. Mouth Needle Sculpting

You will need:

- Scissors;
- Needle;
- Sewing pins (2 pcs.)

**Make the needle sculpting with yarn No. 07 (beige).**

Prepare 2 pins.

Count 4 rounds down from the nose. **Photo 42.**

**Between points 1 and 2 the distance - 2 sc. Photo 42.**

Points 1 and 2 between rounds 24 and 25.

Insert the needle into the base of the head and exit it through point 1. Next, insert it at point 2 and exit it through the base of the head. Pull. **Photo 43-44.**

Repeat several times. Pull. **Photo 45.**





Embroider a smile with yarn No. 935 (black) in the place of tightening. **Photo 46.**

## **STRANDS.** Photo 47.

**!!! TIP. Do not follow the marker.**

Begin crocheting with yarn No.83 (orange).

1. ch46, from the 2nd chain on the hook: 45 sc

Fasten off, and cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.

2. ch56, from the 2nd chain on the hook: 55 sc

Fasten off, and cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.

3. ch36, from the 2nd chain on the hook: 35 sc

Fasten off, and cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.



## HAIR BUN.

**!!! TIP. Do not follow the marker.**

**Crochet 2 similar pieces.**

Begin crocheting with yarn No.83 (orange).

1. 7 sc in MR
2. inc \*7 /14
3. (1 sc, inc) \*7 /21
4. (2 sc, inc) \*7 /28
5. (3 sc, inc) \*7 /35
- 6-9. 35 sc (4 rounds)
10. (3 sc, dec) \*7 /28
11. (2 sc, dec) \*7 /21

Fasten off, and cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing. Photo 48-49.



# HAIR WIG.

**!!! TIP. Do not follow the marker.**

Begin crocheting with yarn No. 83 (orange).

1. 8 sc in MR
2. inc \*8 /16
3. (1 sc, inc) \*8 /24
4. (2 sc, inc) \*8 /32
5. (3 sc, inc) \*8 /40
6. (4 sc, inc) \*8 /48
7. (5 sc, inc) \*8 /56
8. (6 sc, inc) \*8 /64
9. (7 sc, inc) \*8 /72
10. (8 sc, inc) \*8 /80



**!!! NOTE. Try on the wig on the head. If it's too big, don't crochet the last rounds with increases, but crochet all rounds to the end (without increases). Pay attention to how the base is sewn on, as many people place it incorrectly on the head.**

11-21. 80 sc (11 rounds) **Photo 50.**

Fasten off, and cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## STRANDS.

**Crochet the strands according to one description. Crochet each strand separately.**

**As a result, we should get - 30 strands.**

**!!! TIP. Insert the hook downward. Photo 51.**

Begin crocheting with yarn No. 83 (orange)





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1. FLO of round 21, from the loop where you finished crocheting, work along 15 loops to the left:

- Attach yarn to the first loop.
- ch55.
- Fasten off, cut the yarn and weave in ends. **Photo 52.**

2. FLO of round 21, from the loop where you finished crocheting, skip 10 loops to the right and work along 15 loops to the right:

- Attach yarn to the first loop.
- ch55.
- Fasten off, cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Attach the yarn to the last loop. Repeat 15 times – 15 strands.

- Notice how the wig is sewn on, completely covering the entire back of the head and placing close to the ears on both sides.

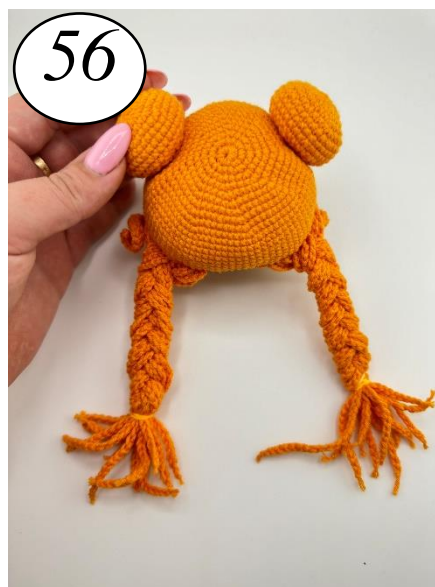

8. 6 hdc, turn, ch1
9. 6 hdc, turn, ch1 **Photo 60-62.**



**!!! NOTE. Work in a spiral.**

10. to prevent gaps in the heel crochet as follows: insert a hook in the middle between rows 8 and 9 - 1 sc, 6 sc, insert a hook in the middle between rows 8 and 9 - 1 sc, 6 sc /14

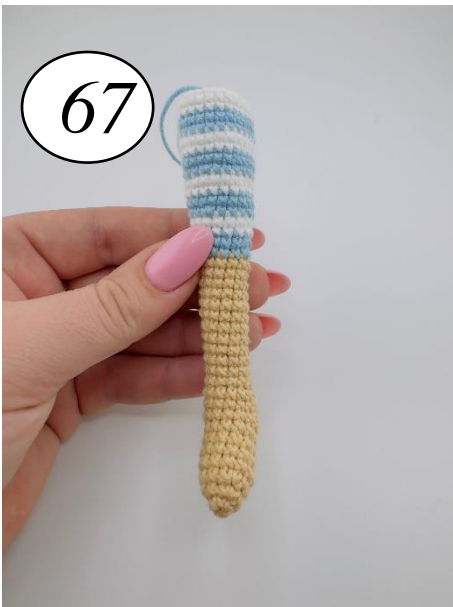

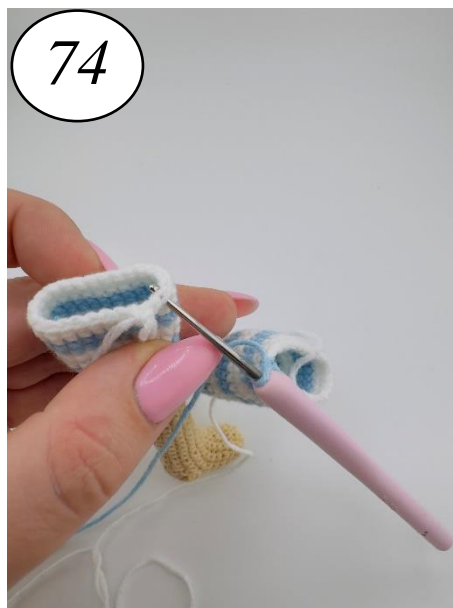

Cut the yarn No. 36 (pink).



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Join yarn in color No. 29 (pistachio green).

17. FLO: (7 sc, inc) \*6 /54

18. (8 sc, inc) \*6 /60

19. (9 sc, inc) \*6 /66

20. (10 sc, inc) \*6 /72

21. (11 sc, inc) \*6 /78

- Count 15 stitches from the first stitch to the right.

Join yarn in color No. 62 (white).

61-80. 15 sc (20 rounds) **Photo 105.**

**Next, stuff the swim ring completely. Connect both edges and sew up with thread. Photo 106.**

Fasten off, cut the yarn and weave in ends.
