## PATTERN Christmas Baubles Set 3





## Materials

- 2.0 mm crochet hook (size B)
- Cotton yarn:
  - ▶ white 30g / 96m (90 yards)
  - ▶ light blue 20g / 64m (60 yards)
  - ▶ dark blue 20g / 64m (60 yards)
  - ▶ beige 10g / 32m (30 yards)
  - small amount of black and pink

- Polyfill to stuff
- 4 pairs of 8 mm (0.31 inches) safety eyes
- Tapestry needle
- Stitchmarkers and pins (optional)

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### Yarn, finished size and gauge

This samples was made with YarnArt Jeans (half-cotton yarn): white #62, blue #75, dark blue #68, beige #73. **Finished size:** 8,5 cm (3.3") tall with hat

Because this is a pattern for a stuffed toy, gauge is not really important. You can use any weight yarn, if you make sure that your hook is appropriately sized for your yarn, so that you get a nice, solid fabric. Using a different size hook and yarn weight will change the size of your finished project.

Make sure you crochet pretty tight all the way, to get no stretching holes between the stiches after you filled in a stuffing material.

### Stitches and crochet techniques used

- Single crochet, half double crochet, double crochet, treble crochet in rounds
- Magic adjustable ring
- Increasing and decreasing

### HOW TO MAKE A POMPOM

### ABBREVIATIONS

- A white color
- B dark blue color
- **C** light blue color
- **D** beige color

Take white yarn, densely reel up the yarn around a fork (*image 0.1*), cut the end. Take a small piece of yarn and tie a knot in the center of a bundle (*image 0.2, 0.3*). Cut the edges of yarn from the both sides.(*image 0.4*) The pompom is ready. Fluff it. (*image 0.5*)





Put the wig on a head. The distance between eyes and a wig should be 4sc up and 5sc to the sides. (image 1.10)

Sew the wig to the head, making a sew along the 13<sup>th</sup> rnd of a wig. Leave the curls unsewn. (image 1.11, 1.12)





Place the bun on a top of a head. The distance between curls and a bun - 6 rnds. (image 1.14) Then sew it. When the sewing is almost done, stuff the bun with filling material and then finish sewing. (image 1.15)

Take a piece of color D yarn and embroider a nose between 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> rnds of head, centering it regarding to the eyes (make 4-5 loops of yarn). With the color A yarn embroider the eyebrows, placing them between 13<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> rnds of a head (over the eyes). The length of an eyebrow - 3sc. (image 1.16)

### BOW

This detail is made in back and forth rows. The turning ch1 at the end of each row does not count as a st.

#### Start with color B

Do not cut the yarn. Continue crocheting around the perimeter of finished detail. Start from the point where you finished and continue moving to the left side of a detail (image 1.17, 1.18):

#### (\*sc, ch3, sc\* in one st) 3x, 6sc, (\*sc, ch3, sc\* in one st) 3x, 6sc

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn end.

With the same yarn make ch50. Fasten off, weave in the yarn ends. (image 1.19)







Sew the wig to the head, making a sew along the 13<sup>th</sup> rnd of a wig. (image 2.12, 2.13)







Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Using tapestry needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close. Weave in the yarn end.

Sew the eye spot around the perimeter. With the black yarn embroider the nose between 11 and 12 rnds of a head, centering it regarding to the eyes. The width of a nose - 3 sc. Embroider the line from the bottom of a nose for 2sc down. (image 4.9, 4.10).


