

FREE PATTERN

Materials

- Chunky plush yarn (white) & 5,5mm hook
- Thick cotton yarn (black + another color) & 3,5 mm hook
- Thin cotton yarn (orange) & 2,5 mm hook
- Tapestry needle, filling, a piece of cardboard & a couple of sticks from your garden.



Notes

- The Snowman measures about 15cm with recommended yarn and hook size
 - Work in spirals, do not join rounds.
 - This pattern was designed by Boulette & Cie, it's a FREE pattern. It's prohibited to sell, distribute or copy any parts of this pattern without my consent. You're more than welcome to sell the finished product.
 - This is supposed to be a decoration, it's not suitable for children under 3 years old.

Body & Head

Chunky plush yarn (white) &
5,5mm hook

- 1) 6 sc in mr (6)
- 2) 6 inc (12)
- 3) (1 sc, 1 inc) x6 (18)
- 4) (2 sc 1 inc) x6 (24)
- 5) (3 sc, 1 inc) x6 (30)
- 6) BLO 30 sc (30)
- 7-12) 30 sc (6 rounds)

Cut a circle using cardboard or plastic and place it on the bottom so your snowman can stand without falling over.

- 13) (3 sc 1 dec) x6 (24) * start stuffing the body*
- 14) (2 sc, 1 dec) x6 (18)
- 15) (1 sc, 1 dec) x6 (12)
- 16) 12 sc (12)
- 17) 12 inc (24)
- 18-23) 24 sc all around (6 rounds)

Insert security eyes between rows 21 & 22, leave 3 sts between the eyes.

- 24) (2 sc, 1 dec)x6 (18) * start stuffing the head*
- 25) (1 sc, 1 dec) (12)
- 26) 6 dec (6)



Hat

With thick cotton yarn (black + another color) & 3,5 mm hook

1) 6 sc in mr (6)

2) 6 inc (12)

3) (1 sc, 1 inc) x6 (18)

4) (2 sc 1 inc) x6 (24)

5) BLO 24 sc

6-8) 24 sc (3 rounds)

Change to the second color, don't cut the yarn

9) 24 hdc

Change to black, fasten off second color

10) BLO 24 sc

11) FLO (3 sc, 1 inc) x6 (30)

12) 30 sc

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Sew hat on the head using the back loops from round 11.

The hat should be a little tilted to the side, not exactly in the middle of the head

ps: Scheepjes Cahlista is perfect for this part



Scarf

With thick cotton yarn (second color)
& 3,5mm hook

- 1) 71 ch
 - 2) Skip 1st chain, 70 sc (70)
 - 3) Ch1 & turn, 70 sc (70)
- Fasten off.

Cut a few pieces of yarn and attach them to the ends of the scarf: fold the piece of yarn in half, insert the hook through the scarf, hook under the yarn and pull your hook out the same st. You'll have a loop. Grab both ends of your piece of yarn and pass them inside the loop. Pull both ends to close the loop. Repeat until you have enough details and cut the yarn so they are all about 2cm long.



Final details

Using embroidery thread, add eyebrows and a smile to your snowman.

Add a little blush to the cheeks

Sew 3 little buttons on the body, leaving 2 rows between each button.

Insert one small stick on each side of the body to make the arms. I don't recommend using glue or any other material to permanently attach them; as sticks are fragile and might break, you should be able to remove & replace them easily.

Your little snowman is ready !



Carrot

With thin cotton yarn (orange)
& 2,5mm hook

- 1) 6 sc in MR
- 2) 6 sc (3 rnds) (6)
- 3) (1 sc, 1 dec)x2 (4)

Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for sewing. With a tapestry needle, pass the yarn through the front loops of the last 4 sts, pull it to close and insert the needle in the middle of these last 4 sts, pull out needle in the middle of the MR (1st round). Sew carrot to the face, 1 row below the eyes.
