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# Baby Ties

## SKILL LEVEL



INTERMEDIATE

## FINISHED SIZES

Blouse: Instructions given fit infants size 3 months (*small*); changes for 6 months (*medium*) and 12 months (*large*) are in [ ].

Skirt: Instructions given fit infants size 3 months (*small*); changes for 6 months (*medium*) and 12 months (*large*) are in [ ].

Rattle: Instructions given fit infants size 3 months (*small*); changes for 6 months (*medium*) and 12 months (*large*) are in [ ].

## FINISHED GARMENT

### MEASUREMENTS

Blouse chest: 18½ inches (*small*) [19½ inches (*medium*), 20½ inches (*large*)]

Skirt length: 7¼ inches (*small*) [8 inches (*medium*), 9 inches (*large*)]

Rattle: 5½ [6, 6] inches long

## MATERIALS

- Red Heart Soft Baby fine (sport) weight yarn (7 oz/575 yds/198g per skein):
  - 1 skein #7321 powder yellow
  - 10 yds each #7624 lime, #7737 powder pink and #7730 bright pink
- Sizes G/6/4mm and I/9/5.5mm crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Sewing needle
- 16½ [17½, 18½] inches white ½-inch-wide elastic
- 4 round 10mm wiggle eyes
- 1 snap
- Yellow sewing thread



## GAUGE

**Size G hook:** 18 sts = 5 inches; 7 pattern rows on Blouse = 2 inches

**Size I hook:** 19 sts = 7 inches; 5 pattern rows on Skirt = 2 inches



## PATTERN NOTE

Join with a slip stitch unless otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCH

**V-stitch (V-st):** (Dc, ch 2, dc) in next st or ch sp.

## INSTRUCTIONS BLOUSE

### BACK

**Row 1 (RS):** With size G hook and powder yellow, ch 35 [37, 39], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (34 [36, 38] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in **front lp** (see *Stitch Guide*) of next st, sc in **back lp** (see *Stitch Guide*) of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

Rep row 2 until piece measures 6 [7, 7½] inches from beg.

### ARMHOLE SHAPING

**Row 1:** Sl st in each of first 4 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front

lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 4 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last 3 sts unworked, turn. (28 [30, 32] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (26 [28, 30] sc)

**Note:** Row 3 establishes the pattern.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (24 [26, 28] sc)  
Rep row 3 until piece measures 2¾ [3, 3¼] inches from beg of Armhole Shaping.

### FIRST SHOULDER

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [2, 2] time(s), sc in front lp of next 1 [0, 1] st, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (5 [6, 7] sc)



**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in back lp of next 1 [0, 1] st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [2, 2] time(s), sc in last st. Fasten off.

## 2ND SHOULDER

**Row 1:** Sk next 14 sts on last row of Armhole Shaping, join powder yellow with sc in next st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [2, 2] time(s), sc in front lp of next 1 [0, 1] st, sc in both lps of next st, turn. (5 [6, 7] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in back lp of next 1 [0, 1] st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [2, 2] time(s), sc in last st. Fasten off.

## FRONT

**Row 1 (RS):** With size G hook and powder yellow, ch 35 [37, 39], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (34 [36, 38] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

Rep row 2 until piece measures 6 [7, 7½] inches from beg.

## ARMHOLE SHAPING

**Row 1:** Sl st in each of first 4 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 4 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last 3 sts unworked, turn. (28 [30, 32] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (26 [28, 30] sc)

**Row 3:** Work in pattern.

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (24 [26, 28] sc)

Rep row 3 until piece measures 5 rows less than Back.

## FIRST SHOULDER

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern across next 7 [8, 9] sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (8 [9, 10] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn. (7 [8, 9] sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (6 [7, 8] sc)

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (5 [6, 7] sc)

Work in pattern until piece measures same length as Back.

## 2ND SHOULDER

**Row 1:** Sk next 8 sts on last row of Armhole Shaping, join powder yellow with sc in next st, work in pattern across, turn. (8 [9, 10] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (7 [8, 9] sc)

**Row 3:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn. (6 [7, 8] sc)

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (5 [6, 7] sc)

Work in pattern until piece measures same length as Back

Sew shoulder seams.

## SLEEVE

**Make 2.**

**Row 1 (RS):** With size G hook and powder yellow, ch 44 [49, 49], **V-st** (see *Special Stitch*) in 6th ch from hook, [sk next 4 chs, V-st in next ch] 7 [8, 8] times, sk next 2 chs, dc in last ch, turn. (8 [9, 9] V-sts)

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), V-st in ch sp of each V-st across to last 5 chs, dc in next ch, turn.

**Row 3:** Sl st in each of first 5 sts and chs, ch 3, V-st in each of next 6 [7, 7] V-sts, dc in next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (6 [7, 7] V-sts)

**Row 4:** Ch 3, V-st in each V-st across to last st, dc in last st, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 3, dc in next V-st, V-st in each V-st across to last V-st, dc in last V-st, dc in last dc, turn. (4 [5, 5] V-sts)

**Row 6:** Ch 3, sk next st, dc in next V-st, V-st in each V-st across to last V-st, dc in last ch sp, dc in last st, turn. Fasten off. (2 [3, 3] V-sts)

Matching center of last row on Sleeves to shoulder seams, sew Sleeves in place. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

## NECK EDGING

**Rnd 1:** Working around neck opening, with size G hook and powder yellow,

join with sc in any st, evenly spacing sts, sc around, join in beg sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, (sc, ch 3, sc) in first st, sk in next st, [(sc, ch 3, sc) in next st, sk next st] around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

## FLOWER

With size G hook and powder pink, ch 4, join in beg ch to form ring, [sl st, ch 3, dc, ch 2, sl st] 5 times in ring. Fasten off.

With tapestry needle and bright pink, using **French knot** (see illustration), embroider center of Flower.



French Knot  
(2-wrap)

## LEAF

**Make 2.**

With size G hook and lime, ch 7, sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in each of next 2 chs, hdc in next ch, sc in last ch. Fasten off.

With tapestry needle, sew Flower with 1 Leaf on each side to center front of Blouse 1 inch below neck.

## SKIRT

### WAISTBAND

**Note:** Overlap ends of elastic ½ inch and sew tog forming a ring.

**Rnd 1:** With size G hook and powder yellow, ch 68 [72, 76], join in beg ch to form ring, ch 1, sc in each ch around, join in beg sc, **turn.** (68 [72, 76] sc)

**Rnds 2–7:** Ch 1, sc in each st around, join in beg sc, **turn.**

**Rnd 8:** Fold rnd 7 down to rnd 1, insert elastic circle inside fold, working through both thicknesses of rnds 1 and 7, ch 1, evenly sp 76 [80, 84] sc around, join in beg sc, **do not turn.** (76 [80, 84] sc)

### SKIRT

**Rnd 1 (RS):** With size I hook, ch 1, (sc, dc) in first st, sk next st, [(sc, dc) in next st, sk next st] around, **do not join.** (38 [40, 42] sc, 38 [40, 42] dc)

**Rnd 2:** (Sc, dc) in first sc, sk next st, [(sc, dc) in next st, sk next st] around, **do not join.**

Rep rnd 2 until piece measures  $7\frac{1}{4}$  [8, 9] inches from beg. Join in beg sc and fasten off at end of last rnd.

### TIE

**Row 1:** With size G hook and powder yellow, ch 9, V-st in 6th ch from hook, sk next 2 chs, dc in last ch, turn. (1 V-st)

**Row 2:** Ch 3, V-st in next V-st, dc in next ch, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, V-st in next V-st, dc in last st, turn.

Rep row 3 until pieces measures  $30\frac{1}{2}$  [33, 36] inches from beg. Fasten off at end of last row.

### EDGING

Working in ends of rows on 1 side of Tie, with size G hook and powder yellow, join with sc in end of first row, [ch 2, sc in end of next row] across. Fasten off.

Rep on other side of Tie.

Tack center of Tie to Waistband on 1 side of Skirt.

### WRIST RATTLE

#### SIDE

**Make 2.**

**Row 1:** With size G hook and powder yellow, ch 5, sc in 2nd ch

from hook and in each ch across, turn. (4 sc)

**Rows 2-4:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off at end of last row.

Hold Sides tog, matching sts, working through both thicknesses, with size G hook and powder yellow, join with sc in first st on last row, 2 sc in same st, sc in each of next 2 sts, 3 sc in last st, sk first row, sc in end of each of next 2 rows, working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1, 3 sc in first ch, sc in each of next 2 chs, 3 sc in last ch, insert 4 wiggle eyes into rattle, sk next row, sc in end of each of next 2 rows, join in beg sc. (20 sc)

### FIRST BAND

**Row 1:** Sl st in each of next 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, sc in each of next 3 sts, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (4 sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Rep row 2 until Band measures 2 [ $2\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $2\frac{1}{4}$ ] inches long. Fasten off.

### 2ND BAND

**Row 1:** Working on opposite side of Rattle, join with sc in 3rd st of 3-sc corner, sc in each of next 3 sts, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (4 sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Rep row 2 until Band measures 2 [ $2\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $2\frac{1}{4}$ ] inches long. Fasten off.

With sewing needle and thread, sew snap to end of each Band.



### FLOWER

With size G hook and powder pink, ch 4, join in beg ch to form ring, [sl st, ch 3, dc, ch 2, sl st] 5 times in ring. Fasten off.

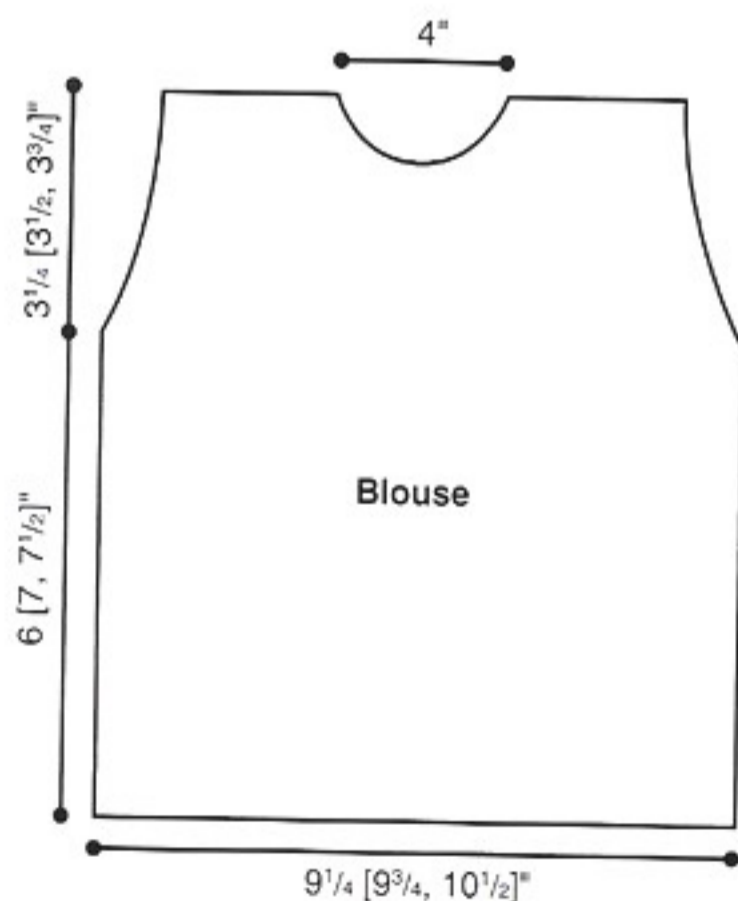
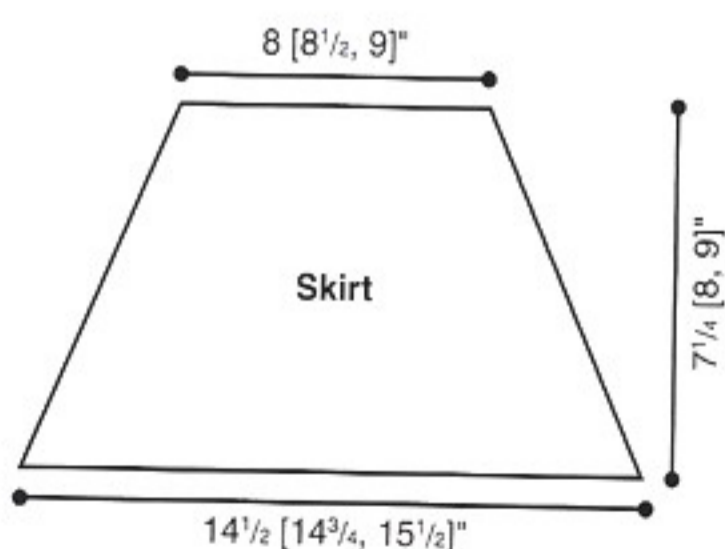
With tapestry needle and bright pink, using **French knot** (see illustration), embroider center of Flower.

### LEAF

**Make 2.**

With size G hook and lime, ch 7, sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in each of next 2 chs, hdc in next ch, sc in last ch. Fasten off.

With tapestry needle, sew Flower with 1 Leaf on each side to center front of Rattle. □□



# Baby Plaid

## SKILL LEVEL

## FINISHED SIZES

Sweater: Instructions given fit infants size 3 months (*small*); changes for 6 months (*medium*) and 12 months (*large*) are in [ ].

Skirt: Instructions given fit infants size 3 months (*small*); changes for 6 months (*medium*) and 12 months (*large*) are in [ ].

Purse: 4 inches across x 6 inches tall

## FINISHED GARMENT

### MEASUREMENTS

Sweater chest: 19 inches (*small*) [20 inches (*medium*), 21 inches (*large*)]

Skirt length: 7¼ inches (*small*) [8 inches (*medium*), 9 inches (*large*)]

## MATERIALS

- Red Heart Soft Baby fine (sport) weight yarn (7 oz/575 yds/198g per skein):



1 skein each #7624 lime and #7001 white

- Sizes F/5/3.75mm and G/6/4mm crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Sewing needle
- 16½ [17½, 18½] inches white ½-inch-wide elastic
- 3½-inch-diameter round piece of plastic canvas
- White sewing thread
- Stitch markers

## GAUGE

**Size G hook:** 18 sts = 5 inches; 19 pattern rows on Sweater = 5 inches; 11 pattern rows on Skirt = 6 inches

## PATTERN NOTE

Join with a slip stitch unless otherwise stated.



## INSTRUCTIONS SWEATER

### BACK

#### Ribbing

**Row 1 (RS):** With size F hook and lime, ch 6, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (5 sc)

**Rows 2–35 [2–37, 2–39]:** Working these rows in **back lps** (see *Stitch Guide*), ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off at end of last row.

### Body

**Row 1 (RS):** Working in ends of rows, with size G hook and white, join with sc in end of first row, sc in each row across, turn. (35 [37, 39] sc)

**Note:** Rows 2–5 establish pattern.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [**fptr** (see *Stitch Guide*) around post of corresponding st on row before last, sk next st on last row behind fptr, sc in next st] across, turn. (18 [19, 20] sc, 17 [18, 19] fptr)

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. (35 [37, 39] sc)

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in next st, fptr around corresponding st on row before last, sk next st on last row behind fptr] across to last 2 sts, sc in each of last 2 sts, turn. (19 [20, 21] sc, 16 [17, 18] fptr)

Rep rows 2–5 consecutively until piece measures 6 [7, 7½] inches from beg, ending with RS row.

### Armhole Shaping

**Row 1:** Sl st in each of first 3 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, sc in each st across, leaving last 2 sts unworked, turn. (31 [33, 35] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (29 [31, 33] sc)

**Row 3:** Work in pattern across, turn.

**Rows 4–7:** Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately. (25 [27, 29] sc at end of last row)

Work in pattern until armhole measures 2¾ [3, 3¼] inches from beg of shaping, ending with RS row.



## FIRST SHOULDER

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 6 [7, 8] sts, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (6 [7, 8] sc)

**Row 2:** Work in pattern across. Fasten off.

## 2ND SHOULDER

**Row 1:** Sk next 13 sts on last row of Armhole Shaping, join white with sc in next st, sc in each st across, turn.

**Row 2:** Work in pattern across. Fasten off.

## FRONT

### Ribbing

**Row 1 (RS):** With size F hook and lime, ch 6, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (5 sc)

**Rows 2–35 [2–37, 2–39]:** Working these rows in back lps, ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off at end of last row.

### Body

**Row 1 (RS):** Working in ends of rows, with size G hook and white, join with sc in end of first row, sc in each row across, turn. (35 [37, 39] sc)

**Note:** Rows 2–5 establish pattern.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, fptr around corresponding st on row before last, sk next st on last row behind fptr, [sc in next st, fptr around corresponding st on row before last, sk next st on last row behind fptr] twice, sc in next st, **changing color** (see *Stitch Guide*) to lime, sk next 3 sts on row before last, fptr around next st, changing to white, sk next st on last row behind fptr, sc in next st, changing to lime, working in front of last fptr, fptr around 2nd sk st on row before last, changing to white, sk next st on last row behind fptr, sc in next st, [fptr in corresponding st on row before last, sk next st on last row behind fptr, sc in next st] across, turn. (18 [19, 20] sc, 17 [18, 19] fptr)

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in each across, turn. (35 [37, 39] sc)

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts, [fptr around corresponding st on row before last, sk next st on last row behind fptr, sc in next st] twice, [sc in next st, changing to lime, fptr

around next fptr on row before last, changing to white, sk st on last row behind fptr] twice, sc in each of next 2 sts, [fptr around corresponding st on row before last, sk next st on last row behind fptr, sc in next st] across to last st, sc in last st, turn. (20 [21, 22] sc, 15 [16, 17] fptr)

Rep rows 2–5 consecutively until piece measures 6 [7, 7½] inches from beg, ending with RS row.

### Armhole Shaping

**Row 1:** Sl st in each of first 3 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, sc in each st across, leaving last 2 sts unworked, turn. (31 [33, 35] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (29 [31, 33] sc)

**Row 3:** Work in pattern across, turn.

**Rows 4–7:** Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately. (25 [27, 29] sc at end of last row)

Work in pattern until piece is 6 rows less than Back, ending on RS.

### First Shoulder

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 10 [11, 12] sts, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (10 [11, 12] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across, turn. (9 [10, 11] sts)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, leaving last st unworked, turn. (8 [9, 10] sts)

**Rows 4 & 5:** Rep rows 2 and 3. (6 [7, 8] sts at end of last row)

Work in pattern until Front is same length as Back. Fasten off at end of last row.

## 2ND SHOULDER

**Row 1:** Sk next 5 sts on last row of Armhole Shaping, join white with sc in next st, sc in each st across, turn. (10 [11, 12] sc)

Reversing shaping, work same as Front First Shoulder.

## SLEEVE

### Make 2.

#### Ribbing

**Row 1:** With size F hook and lime, ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (4 sc)

**Rows 2–27 [2–29, 2–31]:** Working these rows in back lps, ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off at end of last row.

### Body

**Row 1 (RS):** Working in ends of rows, with size G hook and white, join with sc in end of first row, sc in each row across, turn. (27 [29, 31] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Row 3:** Sl st in each of first 3 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [fptr around corresponding st on row before last, sk next st on last row behind fptr, sc in next st] across, leaving last 2 sts unworked, turn. (23 [25, 27] sts)

**Note:** Continue working in pattern as established in rows 2–5 of Back.

**Row 4:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, sc in each st across, leaving last st unworked, turn. (21 [23, 25] sc)

**Row 5:** Work in pattern across, turn.

**Rows 6–11:** Rep rows 4 and 5 alternately. (15 [17, 19] sts at end of last row)

**Rows 12 & 13:** Sl st in each of first 4 sts, work in pattern across, leaving last 3 sts unworked, turn. Fasten off at end of last row.

Sew Shoulder seams. Matching center of last row on Sleeves to shoulder seams, sew Sleeves in place. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

## COLLAR

**Rnd 1:** With size G hook and white, join with sc in any st at neck, evenly spacing sts, sc around, ending with even number of sts, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

**Row 2:** Now working in rows, with F hook and lime, join in any st, ch 4, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, sl st in same st on neck, sl st in next st, turn. (3 sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in back lp of each sc across, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in back lp of each st across, sl st in each of next 2 sts on neck, turn.

**Next rows:** Rep rows 3 and 4 alternately around neck edge, ending with row 3. Fasten off at end of last row.

Sew first and last rows tog.





## SKIRT

### WAISTBAND

**Note:** Overlap ends of elastic ½ inch and sew tog forming a ring.

**Rnd 1:** With size G hook and lime, ch 68 [72, 76], join in beg ch to form ring, ch 1, sc in each ch around, join in beg sc, turn. (68 [72, 76] sc)

**Rnds 2–7:** Ch 1, sc in each st around, join in beg sc, turn.

**Rnd 8:** Fold rnd 7 down to rnd 1, insert elastic circle inside fold, working through both thicknesses of rnds 1 and 7, ch 1, evenly sp 80 sc around, join in beg sc. Fasten off. (80 sc)

### FIRST STRIP SECTION

With size G hook and white, join in any st on last rnd of Waistband, \*ch 23 [25, 29], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, sl st in same st on Waistband, sl st in each of next 2 sts, rep from \* twice, ch 23 [25, 29], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, sl st in same st on Waistband. Fasten off. (4 Strips)

### NEXT STRIP SECTION

Sk next st on Waistband, with size G hook and lime, join in next st, \*ch 23 [25, 29], sc in 2nd ch from

hook and in each ch across, sl st in same st on Waistband, sl st in each of next 2 sts, rep from \* twice, ch 23 [25, 29], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, sl st in same st on Waistband. Fasten off. (4 Strips)

Alternating white and lime, rep Next Strip Section 8 times, for a total of 10 Strip Sections of 4 Strips each.

### MESH SECTION

**Note:** Pull Strips up and tuck into Waistband to keep out of way.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** With G hook and lime, join in first sk st on Waistband between Strip Sections, ch 5 (counts as first dc and ch-2 sp), [dc in next st between Strips, ch 2] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-5, turn. (40 dc, 40 ch sps)

**Rnds 2 & 3:** Ch 5, sk next ch sp, [dc in next st, ch 2] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-5, turn. At end of last rnd, fasten off.

**Rnd 4:** Join white in first st, ch 5, sk next ch sp, [dc in next st, ch 2] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-5, turn.

**Rnds 5 & 6:** Ch 5, sk next ch sp, [dc in next st, ch 2] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-5, turn. At end of last rnd, fasten off.

**Rnd 7:** Join lime in first st, ch 5, sk next ch sp, [dc in next st, ch 2] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-5, turn.

**Rnds 8–14:** Rep rnds 2–7 consecutively, ending with rnd 2.

At end of last rnd, drop lp from hook.

**Note:** Weave Strips through corresponding ch-2 sps.

**Rnd 15:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 sc in end of next Strip, [dc in next st, 2 sc in end of next Strip] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3, turn. (80 sc, 40 dc)

**Rnd 16:** Ch 1, sc in each st around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.



## PURSE

### BOTTOM

**Make 2.**

**Note:** Do not join or turn unless otherwise stated. Mark first st of each rnd.

**Rnd 1:** With G hook and lime, ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (6 sc)

**Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each st around. (12 sc)

**Rnd 3:** [Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st] around. (18 sc)

**Rnd 4:** [Sc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st] around. (24 sc)

**Rnd 5:** [Sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st] around. (30 sc)

**Rnd 6:** [Sc in each of next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st] around. (36 sc)

**Rnd 7:** [Sc in each of next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st] around. (42 sc)

**Rnd 8:** [Sc in each of next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st] around, join in beg sc. Fasten off. (48 sc)

### BASE

**Rnd 1 (WS):** Holding Bottom pieces WS tog with plastic canvas circle between, matching sts, working through both

thicknesses, with size G hook and lime, join with sc in any st, sc in each of next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st, [sc in each of next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st] around, join in beg sc, **turn**. (54 sc)

**Rnd 2:** Working this rnd in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

### FIRST STRIP SECTION

With size G hook and white, join in any st on last rnd of Base, [ch 17, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, sl st in each of next 3 sts] twice, ch 17; sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, sl st in next st on Base. Fasten off. (3 Strips)

### NEXT STRIP SECTION

Sk next st on Base, with size G hook and lime, join in next st, [ch 17, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, sl st in each of next 3 sts] twice, ch 17, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, sl st in next st on Base. Fasten off. (3 Strips)

Alternating white and lime, rep Next Strip Section 4 times, for a total of 6 Strip Sections of 3 Strips each.

### MESH SECTION

**Note:** Pull Strips up and tuck into Base to keep out of way.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** With G hook and white, join in first sk st on Base between Strip Sections, ch 5, [dc in next st between Strips, ch 2] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-5, **turn**. (18 dc, 18 ch sps)

**Rnds 2 & 3:** Ch 5, sk next ch sp, [dc in next st, ch 2] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-5, turn. At end of last rnd, fasten off.

**Rnd 4:** Join lime in first st, ch 5, sk next ch sp, [dc in next st, ch 2] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-5, turn.

**Rnds 5 & 6:** Ch 5, sk next ch sp, [dc in next st, ch 2] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-5, turn. At end of last rnd, fasten off.

**Rnd 7:** Join white in first st, ch 5, sk next ch sp, [dc in next st, ch 2] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-5, turn. Drop lp from hook.

**Note:** Weave Strips through corresponding ch-2 sps.

**Rnd 8 (WS):** Place lp back on hook, ch 3, 2 sc in end of next Strip, [dc in next st, 2 sc in end of next Strip]

around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3, turn. Fasten off. (36 sc, 18 dc)

**Rnd 9:** Join lime with sc in first st, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, [sc in next st ch 2, sk next 2 sts] around, join in beg sc.

**Rnd 10:** (Sl st, ch 1, sc, dc) in first ch sp, 2 tr in next st, (dc, sc) in next ch sp, [(sc, dc) in next ch sp, 2 tr in next st, (dc, sc) in next ch sp] around, join in beg sc. (18 tr, 18 sc, 18 dc)

**Rnd 11:** Ch 1, (sc, ch 2) in first st and in each st around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

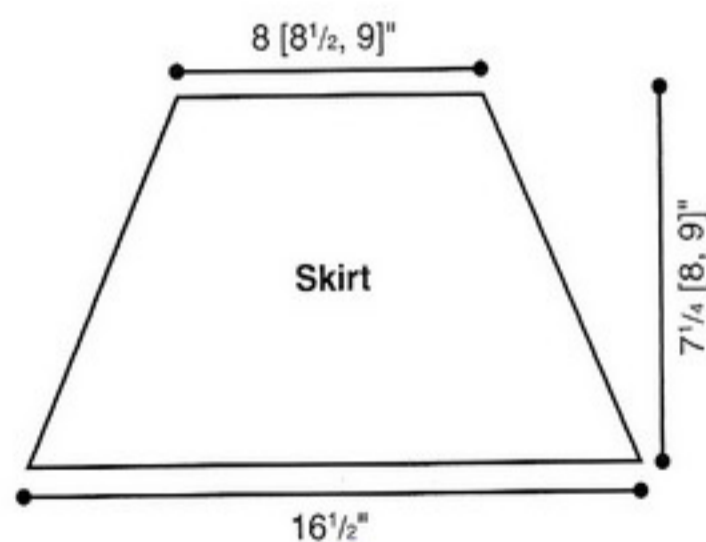
### DRAWSTRING

#### Make 2.

Cut a strand of lime 120 inches long. Fold strand in half, tie ends in knot. Slip knotted end around stationary object, twist opposite end 120 times, holding center of strands, let strands twist tog. Secure end.

Starting at 1 side, weave Drawstring through ch sps of rnd 9. With Purse open, tie ends of Drawstring into a knot close to purse. Trim ends.

Starting on opposite side of Purse, rep with other Drawstring. □□

Skirt: Instructions given fit infants size 3 months (*small*); changes for 6 months (*medium*) and 12 months (*large*) are in [ ].

Sock Edging:  $\frac{3}{4}$  inches wide

## FINISHED GARMENT

### MEASUREMENTS

Blouse chest: 18½ inches (*small*) [19½ inches (*medium*), 20½ inches (*large*)]

Skirt length: 7¼ inches (*small*) [8 inches (*medium*), 9 inches (*large*)]

## MATERIALS

- Red Heart Soft Baby fine (sport) weight yarn (7 oz/575 yds/198g per skein):
  - 1 skein each #7730 bright pink and #7001 white
- Sizes E/4/3.5mm and G/6/4mm crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Sewing needle
- 16½ [17½, 18½] inches white ½-inch-wide elastic
- Buttons:
  - 3/8-inch shank: 6 [6, 7] white heart-shaped
  - ½-inch shank: 2 white heart-shaped
- 22 [24, 24] white 6mm round pearl beads
- 2 snaps
- White sewing thread
- Pair white socks
- Stitch markers



## GAUGE

**Size G hook:** 18 sts = 5 inches; 7 pattern rows on Blouse = 2 inches; 15 pattern rows on Skirt = 4 inches

## PATTERN NOTE

Join with a slip stitch unless otherwise stated.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### BLOUSE

#### BACK

**Row 1 (RS):** With size G hook and white, ch 35 [37, 39], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (34 [36, 38] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in **front lp** (see *Stitch Guide*) of next st, sc in **back lp** (see *Stitch Guide*) of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

Rep row 2 until piece measures 6 [7, 7½] inches from beg.

#### ARMHOLE SHAPING

**Row 1:** Sl st in each of first 4 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 4 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last 3 sts unworked, turn. (28 [30, 32] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (26 [28, 30] sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (24 [26, 28] sc)  
Rep row 3 until piece measures 2¾ [3, 3½] inches from beg of Armhole Shaping.

#### FIRST SHOULDER

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [2, 2] times, sc in front lp of next 1 [0, 1] st, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (5 [6, 7] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in back lp of next 1 [0, 1] st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [2, 2] times, sc in both lps of last st. Fasten off.

#### 2ND SHOULDER

**Row 1:** Sk next 14 sts on last row of Armhole Shaping, join white with sc in next st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [2, 2] times, sc in front lp of next 1 [0, 1] st, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (5 [6, 7] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in back lp of next 1 [0, 1] st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [2, 2] times, sc in both lps of last st. Fasten off.

#### FRONT

##### Make 2.

**Row 1 (RS):** With size G hook and white, ch 17 [18, 19], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (16 [17, 18] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 1 [2, 1] st(s), sc in front lp of next 0 [1, 0] st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in back lp of next 0 [1, 0] st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately until piece measures 6 [7, 7½] inches from beg.

#### ARMHOLE SHAPING

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 5 [4, 5] sts, sc in front lp of next 1 [0, 1] st, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (13 [14, 15] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, sc in same st as last sl st, sc in back lp of next 0 [1, 0] st, [sc around front post of next st, sc around back post of next st with bpsc (see *Stitch Guide*)] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn. (12 [13, 14] sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 1 [2, 1] st(s), sc in front lp of next 0 [1, 0] st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Row 4:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as sl st, sc in back

lp of next 1 [0, 1] st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn. (11 [12, 13] sc)

**Note:** For pattern, work in front lp of st worked in back lp on row before, work in back lp of st worked in front lp on row before.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

Rep row 5 until piece measures 5 rows less than Back, ending at Front edge.

### SHOULDER

**Row 1:** Sl st in each of first 4 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn. (8 [9, 10] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (7 [8, 9] sc)

**Row 3:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn. (6 [7, 8] sc)

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. Fasten off. (5 [6, 7] sc)

### SLEEVE

#### Make 2.

**Row 1 (RS):** With size G hook and white, ch 27 [29, 31], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (26 [28, 30] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Row 3:** Sl st in each of first 4 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last 4 sts sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (20 [22, 24] sc)

**Row 4:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (18 [20, 22] sc)

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Rows 6 & 7:** Rep rows 4 and 5. (16 [18, 20] sc)

**Row 8:** Rep row 5.

**Rows 9-11:** Sl st in each of first 3 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last 3 sts, sc in both lps

of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. Fasten off at end of last row. (4 [6, 8] sc at end of last row)

Sew Shoulder seams. Matching center of last row on Sleeves to shoulder seams, sew Sleeves in place. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

### SLEEVE EDGING

**Rnd 1:** Working around 1 Sleeve opening, with size G hook and white, join with sc in any st, evenly spacing sts, sc around, join in beg sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st around, join in beg sc.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) in first st, sk in next st, [(sc, ch 2, sc) in next st, sk next st] around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

Rep on other Sleeve.

### BUTTON BAND

**Row 1:** With G hook and white, join with sc at top left front, evenly sp sc down to bottom left front, turn.

**Rows 2 & 3:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off at end of last row.

### BUTTONHOLE BAND

**Row 1:** With G hook and white, join with sc at bottom right front, evenly sp sc across to top right front, turn.

**Row 2:** Mark 4 [4, 5] sts for buttonhole placement, ch 1, [sc in each st across to next marked st, ch 1, sk marked st] 4 [4, 5] times, sc in each st across, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in each st and ch sp across. Fasten off.

With sewing needle and thread, sew 3/8-inch buttons to Button Band opposite buttonholes.

### COLLAR

**Row 1:** With size G hook and white, working across neck edge, join with sc in top end of row 2 of Buttonhole Band, evenly sp 41 sc across neck edge to row 2 of Button Band, turn. (42 sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in front lp of first st, sc in back lp of same st, sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of same st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 2 sts, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of same st] twice, turn. (46 sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in front lp of first st, sc in back lp of next st, [sc in front



lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in front lp of first st, sc in back lp of same st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in front lp of last st, sc in back lp of same st, turn. (48 sc)

**Row 5:** Rep row 3.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, **sc dec** (see *Stitch Guide*) in first 2 sts, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 2 sts, sc dec in last 2 sts. Fasten off. (46 sc)

### COLLAR EDGING

**Row 1:** With size G hook and white, join with sc in end of row 1 on Collar, sc in end of each of next 4 rows, 3 sc in end of next row, sc in each st across, 3 sc in end of next row on, sc in end of each of last 5 rows, **do not turn**. Fasten off. (62 sc)

**Row 2:** Join white with sc in first st, (ch 2, sc) in same st, [sk next st, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next st] across. Fasten off.

### EPAULET

**Make 2.**

With size G hook and white, ch 8. Fasten off.

Sew ends of 1 Epaulet to each shoulder seam.

### SKIRT

#### WAISTBAND

**Note:** Overlap ends of elastic  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch and sew tog forming a ring.

**Rnd 1:** With size G hook and bright pink, ch 68 [72, 76], join in beg ch to form ring, ch 1, sc in each ch around, join in beg sc, **turn**. (68 [72, 76] sc)

**Rnds 2–7:** Ch 1, sc in each st around, join in beg sc, **turn**.

**Rnd 8:** Fold rnd 7 down to rnd 1, insert elastic circle inside fold, working through both thicknesses of rnds 1 and 7, ch 1, evenly sp 70 [80, 80] sc around, join in beg sc. (70 [80, 80] sc)

#### PLEATS

**Rnd 1:** Working this rnd in back lps only, ch 1, sc in each st around, join in beg sc. (70 [80, 80] sc)

**Rnd 2:** Working this rnd in rem front lps of last rnd on Waistband, ch 1, sc in each st around, join in beg sc.



**Note:** Hold sts on last 2 rows tog, (there will be one st in front of the other), for each st, the front lp of st on the row in front is lp A, the back lp of the same st is lp B, the front lp of the st in back is lp C, the back lp of the same st in back is lp D.

When rnd is finished, all lps will have a st worked in them.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, [working through D lps, sc in each of next 5 lps, **turn**, working through C lps and B lps at the same time, sc in each of next 5 lps, **turn**, working through A lps, sc in each of next 10 lps, **turn**, working through C lps and B lps at the same time, sc in each of next 5 lps, **turn**, working through D lps, sc in each of next 5 lps] 7 [8, 8] times, join in beg sc. (210 [240, 240] sc)

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 1, sk next st, [sc in next st, ch 1, sk next st] around, join in beg sc. (105 [120, 120] sc, 105 [120, 120] ch sps)

**Rnd 5:** (Sl st, ch 1, sc) in first ch sp, ch 1, sk next st, [sc in next ch sp, ch 1, sk next st] around, join in beg sc.

Rep rnd 5 until piece measures  $7\frac{1}{4}$  [8, 9] inches from beg. Fasten off at end of last rnd.

#### SUSPENDER

**Make 2.**

**Rnd 1:** With size G hook and bright pink, ch 4, join in beg ch to form ring (buttonhole), ch 51 [57, 61], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each of next 49 [55, 59] chs, 6 sc in ring, working on opposite side of ch, sc in each ch across, 2 sc across end of Suspender, join in beg sc. (108 [120, 128] sc)

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) in first st, [sk next st, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next st] around, leaving last st unworked. Fasten off.

#### FINISHING

1. Sew snaps to Waistband horizontally centered on inside back of Skirt 4 [ $4\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ] inches apart and to end of Suspenders opposite buttonhole.
2. Sew  $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch buttons horizontally centered to outside front of Waistband 4 [ $4\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ] inches apart.



3. Snap Suspenders to back of skirt, pull other end of Suspenders to front through Epaulets and button.

### SOCK TRIM

#### TRIM

**Note:** Thread 11 [12, 12] beads onto bright pink. Push back until needed.

**Rnd 1:** With size E hook and bright pink, working through top edge of cuff on 1 sock, place slip knot on hook, insert hook through top edge of cuff, yo, pull through, complete as sc, ch 3, placing sts about  $\frac{1}{8}$  inch apart, [sc in top edge of cuff, ch 3] 21 [23, 23] times, join in beg sc. (22 [24, 24] sc, 22 [24, 24] ch sps)

**Rnd 2:** (Sl st, ch 1, sc) in first ch sp, ch 3, sc in next ch sp, ch 2, pull up 1 bead, ch 3, [sc in next ch sp, ch 3, sc in next ch sp, ch 2, pull up 1 bead, ch 3] around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

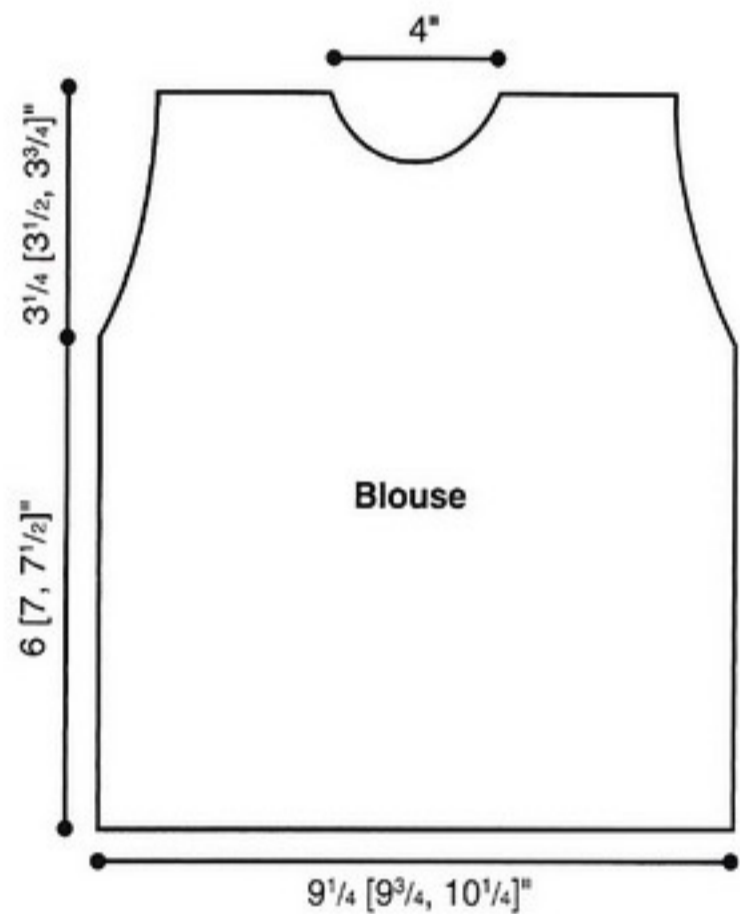
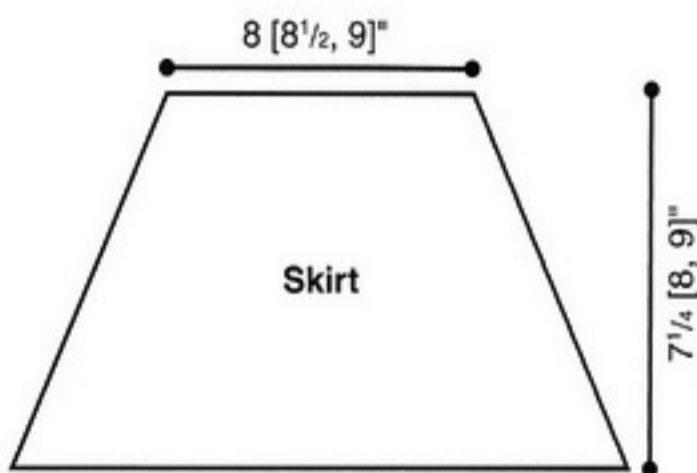

#### FLOWER

##### Make 2.

With size E hook and bright pink, ch 2, (sc, ch 2) 6 times in 2nd ch from hook, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

Sew  $1\frac{3}{8}$ -inch button to center of each Flower. Turn cuff down on Sock. Sew 1 Flower to outside edge of each cuff. □□

- Red Heart Soft Baby fine (sport) weight yarn (7 oz/575 yds/198g per skein for solids, 6 oz/430 yds/170g per skein for twinkles):
  - 1 skein each #8680 new mint twinkle and #7001 white
- Size G/6/4mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle



## GAUGE

18 sts on T-shirt = 5 inches; 7 pattern rows on T-shirt = 2 inches; 14 sts on Skirt = 3 inches; 4 pattern rows on Skirt = 2 inches

## PATTERN NOTE

Join with a slip stitch unless otherwise stated.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### BABY T-SHIRT DRESS

#### BACK

**Row 1 (RS):** With white, ch 35 [37, 39], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (34 [36, 38] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in **front lp** (see *Stitch Guide*) of next st, sc in **back lp** (see *Stitch Guide*) of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

Rep row 2 until piece measures 6 [7, 7½] inches from beg.



#### Armhole Shaping

**Row 1:** Sl st in each of first 4 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 4 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last 3 sts unworked, turn. (28 [30, 32] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (26 [28, 30] sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (24 [26, 28] sc)  
Rep row 3 until piece measures 2¾ [3, 3¼] inches from beg of Armhole Shaping.

#### First Shoulder

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [2, 2] time(s), sc in front lp of next 1 [0, 1] st, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (5 [6, 7] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in back lp of next 1 [0, 1] st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [2, 2] time(s), sc in both lps of last st. Fasten off.

#### 2nd Shoulder

**Row 1:** Sk next 14 sts on last row of Armhole Shaping, join white with sc in next st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [2, 2] time(s), sc in front lp of next 1 [0, 1] st, sc in both lps of last st, turn. (5 [6, 7] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in back lp of next 1 [0, 1] st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [2, 2] time(s), sc in both lps of last st. Fasten off.

### FRONT

**Row 1 (RS):** With size G hook and white, ch 35 [37, 39], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (34 [36, 38] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in back lp of next st, sc in front lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

Rep row 2 until piece measures 6 [7, 7½] inches from beg.

### Armhole Shaping

**Row 1 (RS):** Sl st in each of first 4 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 4 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last 3 sts unworked, turn. (28 [30, 32] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (26 [28, 30] sc)

**Note:** Row 3 establishes the pattern.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (24 [26, 28] sc)  
Rep row 3 until piece measures 5 rows less than Back.

### First Shoulder

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern across next 7 [8, 9] sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (8 [9, 10] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn. (7 [8, 9] sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (6 [7, 8] sc)

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (5 [6, 7] sc)  
Work in pattern until piece measures same length as Back.

### 2nd Shoulder

**Row 1:** Sk next 8 sts on last row of Armhole Shaping, join white with sc in next st, work in pattern across, turn. (8 [9, 10] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (7 [8, 9] sc)

**Row 3:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn. (6 [7, 8] sc)

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (5 [6, 7] sc)

Work in pattern until piece measures same length as Back. At end of last row, fasten off.

Sew shoulder seams.

### SLEEVE

#### Make 2.

**Row 1 (RS):** With white, ch 27 [29, 31], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (26 [28, 30] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Row 3:** Sl st in each of first 4 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last 4 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (20 [22, 24] sc)

**Row 4:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (18 [20, 22] sc)

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Rows 6 & 7:** Rep rows 4 and 5. (16 [18, 20] sc)

**Row 8:** Rep row 5.

**Rows 9–11:** Sl st in each of first 3 sts, ch 1, sc in last same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last 3 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. Fasten off at end of last row. (4 [6, 8] sc at end of last row)

Matching center of last row on Sleeves to shoulder seams, sew Sleeves in place. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

### SLEEVE EDGING

**Rnd 1:** Working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 around 1 Sleeve opening, join new mint twinkle in

first ch, (ch 3—counts as first dc, 2 dc, ch 3, sl st) in same ch, [sk next 2 chs, (3 dc, ch 3, sl st) in next ch] around to last 1 [3, 2] chs, sk last 1 [3, 2] chs, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

Rep on other Sleeve.

### NECK EDGING

**Rnd 1:** Working around neck opening, join white with sc in any st, evenly sp sc around, ending with a multiple of 3, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

**Rnd 2:** Join new mint twinkle in any st, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, sl st) in same st, sk next 2 sts, [(3 dc, ch 3, sl st) in next st, sk next 2 sts] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

### FLOWER

#### Make 4.

**Rnd 1:** With new mint twinkle, ch 2, 10 sc in 2nd ch from hook, join in beg sc. (10 sc)

**Rnd 2:** (Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, sl st) in first st, sk next st, [(3 dc, ch 3, sl st) in next st, sk next st] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

With white, using **French knot** (see illustration), embroider center of Flower.

Sew Flowers evenly spaced diagonally down Front.

(2-wrap)

### SKIRT

**Rnd 1:** Working in starting ch on opposite side of Front and Back, with size G hook and new mint twinkle, join in any ch, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, sl st) in same ch, sk next ch, [(3 dc, ch 3, sl st) in next ch, sk next ch] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3, **turn**. (34 [36, 38] 3-dc groups)

**Rnd 2:** (Sl st, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, sl st) in next ch-3 sp, (3 dc, ch 3, sl st) in each ch-3 sp around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3, **turn**.

Rep rnd 2 until Skirt measures 4 [4½, 5] inches long. Fasten off at end of last rnd.





### **TEDDY T-SHIRT DRESS**

#### **BACK**

**Row 1 (RS):** With white, ch 29, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (28 sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in **front lp** (see *Stitch Guide*) of next st, sc in **back lp** (see *Stitch Guide*) of next st (establishes pattern)] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

Rep row 2 until piece measures 1½ inches from beg.

#### **Armhole Shaping**

**Row 1:** Sl st in each of first 3 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 4 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last 2 sts unworked, turn. (24 sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1,

sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (22 sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (20 sc)

Rep row 3 until piece measures 2½ inches from beg of Armhole Shaping.

#### **First Shoulder**

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (3 sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in back lp of next st, sc in both lps of last st. Fasten off.

#### **2nd Shoulder**

**Row 1:** Sk next 14 sts on last row of Armhole Shaping, join white with sc in next st, sc in front lp of next st, sc in both lps of last st, turn. (3 sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in back lp of next st, sc in both lps of last st. Fasten off.

#### **FRONT**

**Row 1 (RS):** With white, ch 29, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (28 sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

Rep row 2 until piece measures 1½ inches from beg.

#### **Armhole Shaping**

**Row 1:** Sl st in each of first 3 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 4 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last 2 sts unworked, turn. (24 sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lps of next st] across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (22 sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (20 sc)

Rep row 3 until piece measures 5 rows less than Back.

#### **First Shoulder**

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern across next 6 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (6 sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn. (5 sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (4 sc)

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (3 sc)

Work in pattern until piece measures same length as Back.

## 2nd Shoulder

**Row 1:** Sk next 8 sts on last row of Armhole Shaping, join white with sc in next st, work in pattern across, turn. (6 sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (5 sc)

**Row 3:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn. (4 sc)

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (3 sc)

Work in pattern until piece measures same length as Back. At end of last for, fasten off.

Sew shoulder seams.

## SLEEVE

### Make 2.

**Row 1 (RS):** With white, ch 25, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (24 sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Row 3:** Sl st in each of first 3 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last 3 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (20 sc)

**Rows 4 & 5:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (18 sc, 16 sc)

**Rows 6 & 7:** Rep row 3. Fasten off at end of last row. (12 sc, 8 sc)

Matching center of last row on Sleeves to shoulder seams, sew Sleeves in place. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

## SLEEVE EDGING

**Rnd 1:** Working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 around 1 Sleeve opening, join new mint twinkle in first ch, (ch 3—counts as first dc, 2 dc, ch 3, sl st) in same ch, sk next 2 chs, [(3 dc, ch 3, sl st) in next ch, sk next 2 chs] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

Rep on other Sleeve.

## NECK EDGING

**Rnd 1:** Working around neck opening, join white with sc in any st, evenly sp sc around, ending with a multiple of 3, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

**Rnd 2:** Join new mint twinkle in any st, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, sl st) in same st, sk next 2 sts, [(3 dc, ch 3, sl st) in next st, sk next 2 sts] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

## FLOWER

### Make 3.

**Rnd 1:** With new mint twinkle, ch 2, 10 sc in 2nd ch from hook, join in beg sc. (10 sc)

**Rnd 2:** (Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, sl st) in first st, sk next st, [(3 dc, ch 3, sl st) in next st, sk next st] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

With white, using **French knot** (see illustration), embroider center of Flower.

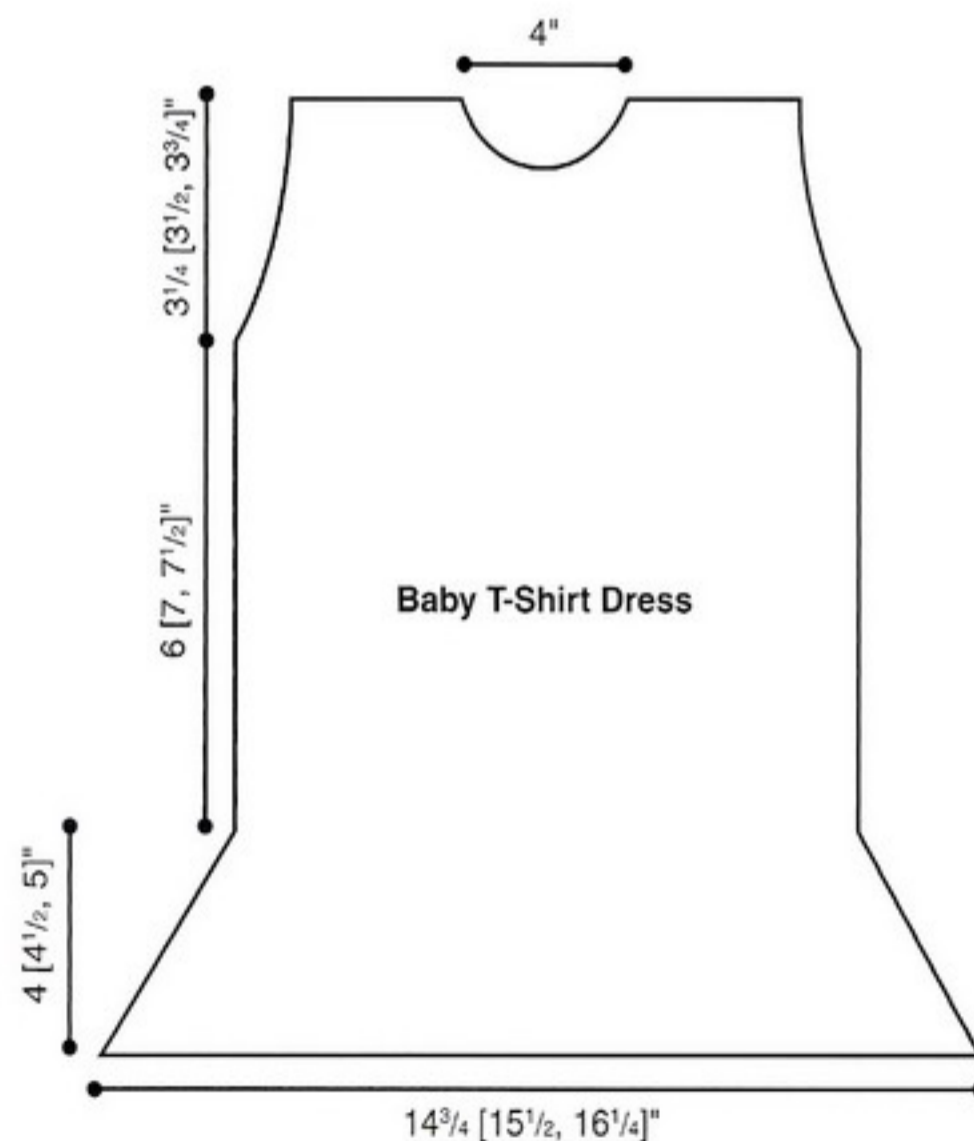
Sew Flowers evenly spaced diagonally down Front.

## SKIRT

**Rnd 1:** Working in starting ch on opposite side of Front and Back, with size G hook and new mint twinkle, join in any ch, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, sl st) in same ch, sk next ch, [(3 dc, ch 3, sl st) in next ch, sk next ch] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3, **turn**. (28 3-dc groups)

**Rnd 2:** (Sl st, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, sl st) in next ch-3 sp, (3 dc, ch 3, sl st) in each ch-3 sp around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3, **turn**.

Rep rnd 2 until Skirt measures 2 inches long. Fasten off at end of last rnd. □□

## MATERIALS

1 skein each #7588 lilac and #7001 white

5 yds #7321 powder yellow

- Sizes E/4/3.5mm, G/6/4mm and I/9/5.5mm crochet hooks or sizes needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Sewing needle
- 16½ [17½, 18½] inches white ½-inch-wide elastic
- White sewing thread

## GAUGE

**Size G hook:** 18 sts = 5 inches; 7 pattern rows on Shell = 2 inches

**Size I hook:** 3 sts on Bolero = 1 inch; 3 pattern rows on Bolero = 1 inch; 7 sc on Skirt = 3 inches; 9 sc rows on Skirt = 3 inches

## PATTERN NOTE

Join with a slip stitch unless otherwise stated.

## INSTRUCTIONS SHELL

### BACK

**Row 1 (RS):** With size G hook and white, ch 35 [37, 39], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (34 [36, 38] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in **front lp** (see *Stitch Guide*) of next st, sc in **back lp** (see *Stitch Guide*) of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

Rep row 2 until piece measures 6 [7, 7½] inches from beg.

### Armhole Shaping

**Row 1 (RS):** Sl st in each of first 4 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 4 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last 3 sts unworked, turn. (28 [30, 32] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (26 [28, 30] sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Rows 4–7:** Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately. (22 [24, 26] sc)

Rep row 3 until piece measures 2¾ [3, 3¼] inches from beg of shaping.

### First Shoulder

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [1, 2] time(s), sc in front lp of next 0 [1, 0] st, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (4 [5, 6] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in back of next 0 [1, 0] st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [1, 2] time(s), sc in both lps of last st. Fasten off.

### 2nd Shoulder

**Row 1:** Sk next 14 sts on last row of Armhole Shaping, join white with sc in next st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [1, 2] time(s), sc in front lp of next 0 [1, 0] st, sc in both lps of last st, turn. (4 [5, 6] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in back of next 0 [1, 0] st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 1 [1, 2] time(s), sc in both lps of last st. Fasten off.

### FRONT

**Row 1 (RS):** With size G hook and white, ch 35 [37, 39], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (34 [36, 38] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

Rep row 2 until pattern measures 6 [7, 7½] inches from beg.

### Armhole Shaping

**Row 1 (RS):** Sl st in each of first 4 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 4 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last 3 sts unworked, turn. (28 [30, 32] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (26 [28, 30] sc)

**Note:** Row 3 establishes the pattern.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Rows 4–7:** Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately. (22 [24, 26] sc)

Rep row 3 until piece measures 5 rows less than Back.

### First Shoulder

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] 2 [3, 3] times, sc in front lp of next 1 [0, 1] st, sc in both lps of next





**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (4 [5, 6] sc)  
Work in pattern until piece is same length as Back.

### 2nd Shoulder

**Row 1:** Sk next 8 sts on Armhole Shaping, join with sc in next st, work in pattern across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn. (7 [8, 9] sc)

Work same as First Shoulder reversing shaping.

Sew shoulder and side seams.

### NECK EDGING

**Rnd 1:** Working around neck edge, with size G hook and white, join in any st, evenly spacing sts, sc around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

**Rnd 2:** Join lilac in any st, ch 3, [sl st in next st, ch 3] around, join in beg sl st. Fasten off.

### ARMHOLE EDGING

**Rnd 1:** Working around 1 armhole, with size G hook and white, join in any st, evenly spacing sts, sc around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

**Rnd 2:** Join lilac in any st, ch 1, [sl st in next st, ch 1] around, join in beg sl st. Fasten off.

Rep on other armhole.

### PANSY

**Rnd 1:** With size E hook and powder yellow, ch 2, (sc, ch 3) 3 times in 2nd ch from hook, join in beg sc. Fasten off. (3 sc, 3 ch sps)

**Rnd 2:** For **petals**, join lilac with sc in any ch-3 sp, (dc, 2 tr, dc, sc) in same sp, (sc, dc, 2 tr, dc, sc) in each of next 2 ch sps, join in beg sc. (3 petals)

**Rnd 3:** Working behind petals, [ch 3, sl st between next 2 petals] twice, turn. (2 ch sps)

**Rnd 4:** [Ch 3, sl st between next 2 petals] twice, turn.

**Rnd 5:** [Working in next ch sps of last 2 rows at same time, (sc, 2, dc, 3 tr, 2 dc, sc) in next ch sp] twice. Fasten off.

Sew Pansy to Shoulder of Blouse.

### SKIRT

#### WAISTBAND & SKIRT

**Note:** Overlap ends of elastic 1/2 inch and sew tog forming a ring.

**Rnd 1:** With size G hook and lilac, ch



st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (7 [8, 9] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last st, sc in both

lps of last st, turn. (6 [7, 8] sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem st unworked, turn. (5 [6, 7] sc)

68 [72, 76], join in beg ch to form ring, ch 1, sc in each ch around, join in beg sc, **turn**. (68 [72, 76] sc)

**Rnds 2–7:** Ch 1, sc in each st around, join in beg sc, **turn**.

**Rnd 8:** Fold rnd 7 down to rnd 1, insert elastic circle inside fold, working through both thicknesses of rnds 1 and 7, ch 1, sc in each st around, join in beg sc, **turn**.

**Rnd 9 (RS):** With size I hook, evenly sp 72 [72, 80] sc around, join in beg sc, **turn**. (72 [72, 80] sc)

**Rnd 10:** Ch 1, sc in front lp of first st, sc in each of next 3 sts, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in each of next 3 sts] around, join in beg sc, **turn**.

**Rnds 11–13:** Ch 1, sc in each st around, join in beg sc, **turn**.

**Rnds 14–25 [14–29, 14–29]:** Rep rows 10–13 consecutively. Do not turn at end of last rnd.

**Rnd 26 [30, 30]:** Ch 3, [sl st in next st, ch 3] around, join in joining sl st of last rnd. Fasten off.

## RUFFLES

**Rnd 1:** With bottom of Skirt facing, working in rem front lps of rnd 9, with size I hook and lilac, join with sc in any lp, 7 tr in next lp, [sc in next lp, 7 tr in next st] around, join in beg sc. (9 [10, 10] sc, 9 [10, 10] 7-tr groups)

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3, [sl st in next st, ch 3] around, join in joining sl st of last rnd. Fasten off.

Rep Ruffle in rem front lps of rnds 14, 18 and 22 [14, 18, 22 and 26, 14, 18, 22 and 26].

## BOLERO

### BACK

**Row 1:** With size I hook and lilac, ch 29 [31, 33], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. (28 [30, 32] sc)

**Note:** Row 2 establishes the pattern.

**Rows 2 & 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Row 4:** Sl st in each of first 3 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last 3 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (24 [26, 28] sc)

**Row 5:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1,

sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem st unworked, turn. (22 [24, 26] sc)

**Row 6:** Rep row 2.

**Row 7:** Rep row 5. (20 [22, 24] sc)

**Rows 8–12 [8–13, 8–14]:** Rep row 2.

### First Shoulder

Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern for 2 [3, 4] sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. Fasten off. (4 [5, 6] sc)

### 2nd Shoulder

Sk next 12 sts on Back, join with sc in next st, work in pattern across to last st, sc in both lps of last st. Fasten off.

## FRONT

### Make 2.

**Row 1:** With size I hook and lilac, ch 29 [31, 33], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. (28 [30, 32] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [sc in front lp of next st, sc in back lp of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern for 10 [12, 13] sts, sc in both lps of next st, for tie, leave rem sts unworked, turn. (12 [14, 15] sc)

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern for next 8 [10, 11] sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (10 [12, 13] sc)

**Row 5:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in

pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both sts of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (8 [10, 11] sc)

**Row 6:** Work in pattern.

**Rows 7 & 8:** Rep rows 5 and 6. (6 [8, 9] sc)

**Row 9:** Ch 1, sc in first st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem st unworked, turn. (5 [7, 8] sts)

**Row 10:** Work in pattern.

**Rows 11 & 12 [11–14, 11–14]:** Rep rows 9 and 10 alternately. At end of last row, fasten off **medium size** only. (4 [5, 6] sc)

**Row 13 [15]:** For **small and large sizes** only, work in pattern. Fasten off. Sew shoulder seams.

## SLEEVE

### Make 2.

**Row 1:** With size I hook and lilac, ch 23 [25, 25], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (22 [24, 24] sc)

**Rows 2 & 3:** Work in pattern.

**Row 4:** Sl st in each of first 3 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last 3 sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (18 [20, 20] sc)

**Row 5:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last 2 sts sc in both lps of next st, leaving last st unworked, turn. (16 [18, 18] sc)

**Row 6:** Work in pattern.

**Row [7]:** For **medium size** only, rep row 5. [16 sc]



**Rows [7 & 8]:** For **large size** only, rep rows 5 and 6. [16 sc]

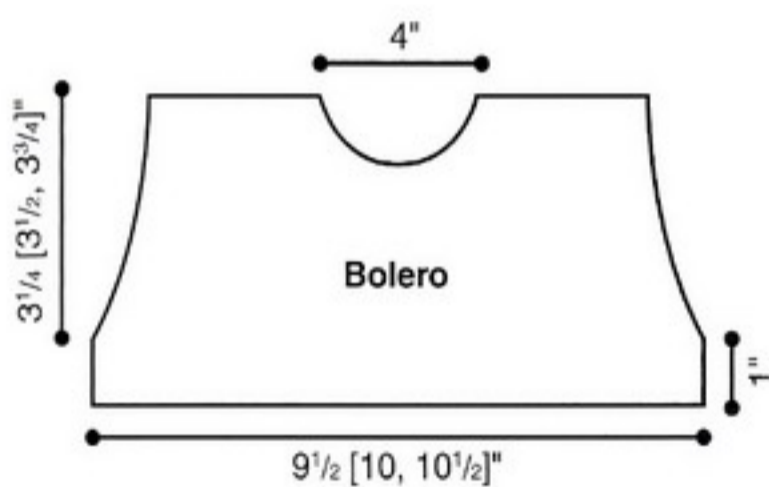
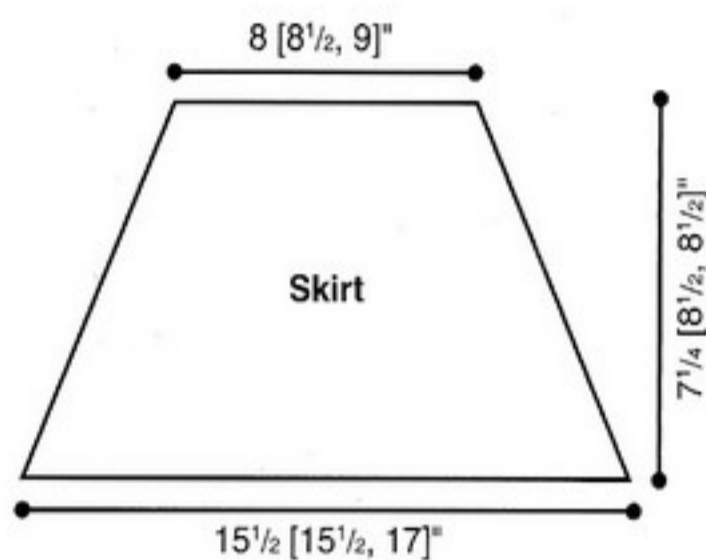
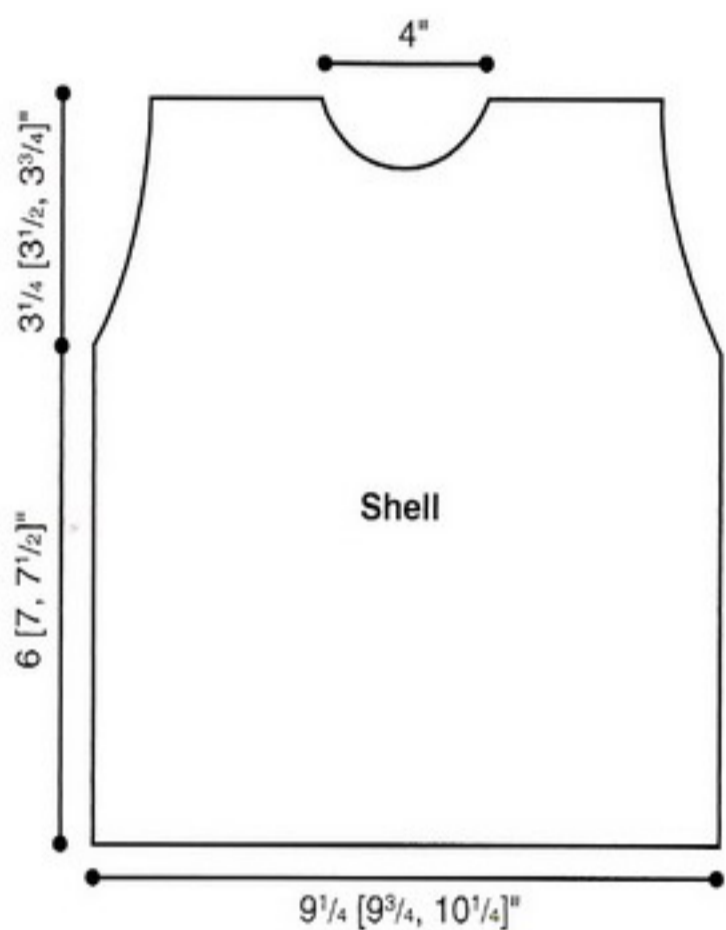
**Rows 7-9 [8-10, 9-11]:** Sl st in each of first 3 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, work in pattern across to last 3 sts, sc in both

lps of next st, leaving last 2 sts unworked, turn. Fasten off at end of last row.

Matching center of last row to shoulder seams, sew Sleeves in place. Sew Sleeve and side seams.

### EDGING

With size G hook and lilac, join in any st, sl st in each st and in end of each row around entire piece, join in beg sl st. Fasten off. □□

## FINISHED SIZES

Jumper: Instructions given fit infants size 3 months (*small*); changes for 6 months (*medium*) and 12 months (*large*) are in [ ].

Hat: Instructions given fit head circumference 13½ inches (*small*); changes for head circumference 15 inches (*medium*) and head circumference 16½ inches (*large*) are in [ ].

## FINISHED GARMENT MEASUREMENTS

Chest: 19 inches (*small*) [20 inches (*medium*), 21 inches (*large*)]

## MATERIALS

- ❑ Red Heart Soft Baby fine (sport) weight yarn (7 oz/575 yds/198g per skein):



- 1 skein #7822 sky blue
- 10 yds each #7001 white, #7624 lime, #7730 bright pink and #7588 lilac
- ❑ Size G/6/4mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- ❑ Tapestry needle
- ❑ Sewing needle
- ❑ 6 [6, 7] flower-shaped 14mm buttons
- ❑ Blue sewing thread
- ❑ Stitch markers

## GAUGE

13 sts on skirt = 3 inches; 14 pattern rows on skirt = 3 inches

## PATTERN NOTE

Join with a slip stitch unless otherwise stated.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### DRESS WITH BODICE

**Row 1:** Starting at **skirt**, with sky blue, ch 34 [40, 44], sc in 2nd ch from hook, [ch 1, sk next ch, sc in next ch] across, turn. (17 [20, 22] sc, 16 [19, 21] ch sps)



**Rows 2–130 [2–135, 2–140]:** Ch 1, sc in first st, [ch 1, sk next ch sp, sc in next st] across, turn. Do not turn at end of last row.

**Row 131 [136, 141]:** For **Bodice**, working in ends of rows, evenly sp 66 [70, 74] sc across, turn. (66 [70, 74] sc)

**Row 132 [137, 142]:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rep row 2 until entire piece measures 7½ [9, 10] inches in length.

### FIRST BACK

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 14 [15, 16] sts, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (14 [15, 16] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, sc in each st across, turn. (13 [14, 15] sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Rows 4–7:** Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately. (11 [12, 13] sc at end of last row)

Rep row 3 until Back measures 3¼ [3½, 3¾] inches from beg, ending at arm edge.

### Shoulder

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 4 [5, 6] sc, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (4 [5, 6] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

### FRONT

**Row 1:** Sk next 4 sts on Bodice, join sky blue with a sc in next st, sc in each of next 29 [31, 33] sts, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (30 [32, 34] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of next 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, sc in each st across, leaving last st unworked, turn. (28 [30, 32] sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Rows 4–7:** Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately. (24 [26, 28] sc at end of last row)

Rep row 3 until Front measures 7 rows less than Back.

### First Shoulder

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 7 [8, 9] sts, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (7 [8, 9] sc)

**Row 2:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, sc in each st across, turn. (6 [7, 8] sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, leaving last st unworked, turn. (5 [6, 7] sc)

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (4 [5, 6] sc)

**Rows 5–7:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off at end of last row.

### 2nd Shoulder

**Row 1:** Sk next 10 sts on last row of Front, join with sc in next st, sc in each st across, turn. (7 [8, 9] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, leaving last st unworked, turn. (6 [7, 8] sc)

**Row 3:** Sl st in each of first 2 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st, sc in each st across, turn. (5 [6, 7] sc)

**Row 4:** Rep row 2. (4 [5, 6] sc)

**Rows 5–7:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off at end of last row.

### 2ND BACK

**Row 1:** Sk next 4 sts on Bodice, join sky blue with sc in next st, sc in each st across, turn. (14 [15, 16] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, leaving last st unworked, turn. (13 [14, 15] sc)

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Rows 4–7:** Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately. (11 [12, 13] sc at end of last row)

Rep row 3 until Back measures 3¼ [3½, 3¾] inches from beg, ending at neck edge.

### Shoulder

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sl st in each of first 8 sts, ch 1, sc in same st as last sl st and in each st across, turn. (4 [5, 6] sc)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

Sew shoulder seams.

### RUFFLE

**Row 1:** With sky blue, ch 10, sc in 2nd ch from hook, [ch 1, sk next ch, sc in next ch] across, turn. (5 sc, 4 ch sps)

**Rows 2–260 [2–270, 2–280]:** Ch 1,

sc in first st, [ch 1, sk next ch sp, sc in next st] across, turn. Fasten off at end of last row.

Weave sky blue gathering strand through first ch-1 sps on 1 side of Ruffle, gather to 28 [29, 30] inches. Secure end.

Weave gathering strand through 2nd ch-1 sps on same side of Ruffle, gather to 28 [29, 30] inches. Secure end.

Sew gathered edge of Ruffle to bottom of skirt.

### BUTTON BAND

**Row 1:** Join sky blue with sc to top of right back, evenly sp sc across to bottom right back, turn.

**Rows 2 & 3:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off at end of last row.

### BUTTONHOLE BAND

**Row 1:** Join sky blue with sc to bottom of left back, evenly sp sc across to top left back, turn.

**Row 2:** Mark 6 [6, 7] sts for buttonhole placement, ch 1, [sc across to next marker, ch 1, sk marked st] 6 [6, 7] times, sc in each st across, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in each st and ch sp across. Fasten off.

With sewing needle and thread, sew buttons to Button Band opposite buttonholes.

### NECK EDGING

Working in sts across neck edge, join sky blue in end of last row on Buttonhole Band, sl st in end of each row and in each st across neck edge to last row on Button Band. Fasten off.

### ARMHOLE EDGING

Working around 1 armhole, join sky blue in any st at underarm, evenly sp sl st around, join in beg sl st. Fasten off.

Rep on other armhole.

With tapestry needle and lime, using **chain st** (see illustration), embroider 1 long stem with 2 short stems on each side of long stem, 3 times across center front of Bodice above Skirt (see photo on page 27).

### FLOWER

**Make 1 each bright pink, white and lilac.**

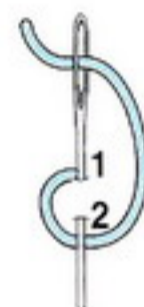
Ch 3, (dc, ch 2, sl st, {ch 2, dc, ch 2, sl st} 4 times) in 3rd ch from hook. Fasten off.

With white for bright pink Flower, lilac for white Flower and bright pink for lilac Flower, using **French knot**, (see illustration), embroider center of Flower.

Sew 1 Flower to top of each long embroidered stem.

### HAT

**Note:** Do not turn or join rnds unless otherwise stated. Mark first st of each rnd.

**Rnd 1:** With sky blue, ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (6 sc)

**Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each st around. (12 sc)

**Rnd 3:** [Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st] around. (18 sc)

**Rnd 4:** [Sc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st] around. (24 sc)

**Rnd 5:** [Sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st] around. (30 sc)

**Rnd 6:** [Sc in each of next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st] around. (36 sc)

**Rnd 7:** [Sc in each of next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st] around. (42 sc)

**Rnd 8:** [Sc in each of next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st] around. (48 sc)

**Rnd [9, 9]:** For **medium and large sizes** only, [sc in each of next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st] around. ([54, 54] sts)



**Rnd [10]:** For **large size** only, [sc in each of next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st] around. ([60 sc])

**Rnd 8 [10, 11]:** For **all sizes**, sc in each st around.

Rep last rnd until piece measures  $4\frac{3}{4}$  [ $5\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ] inches from beg. Join in beg sc at end of last rnd.

### BRIM

**Rnd 1:** Working this rnd in **back lps** (see *Stitch Guide*), ch 1, sc in each st around, **do not join**.

**Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each st around. (96 [108, 120] sc)

**Rnd 3:** Sc in each st around.

Rep rnd 3 until Brim is 1 inch long. Join in beg sc and fasten off at end of last rnd.

### FLOWER

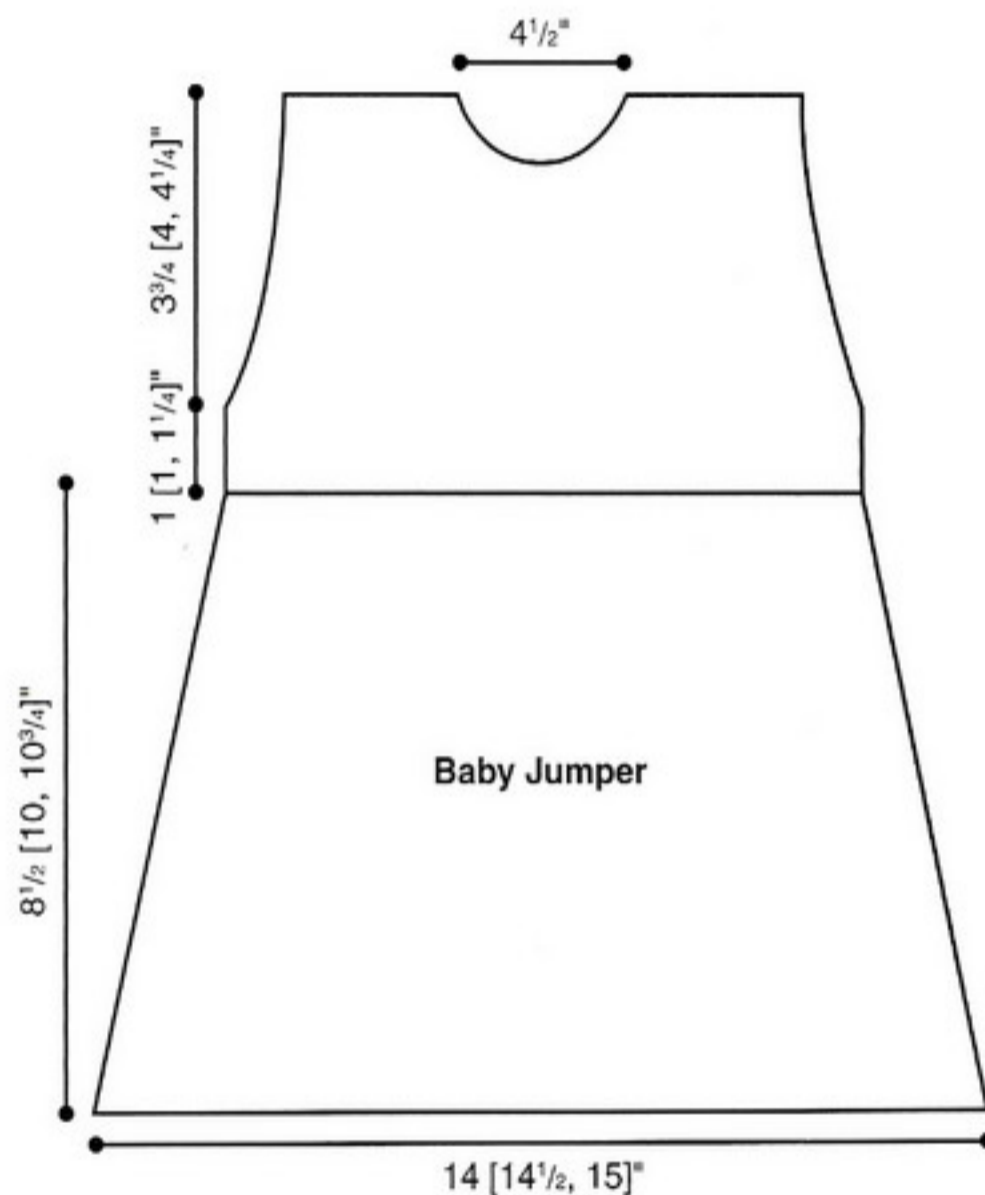
**Make 1 each bright pink, white and lilac.**

Ch 3, (dc, ch 2, sl st {ch 2, dc, ch 2, sl st} 4 times) in 3rd ch from hook. Fasten off.

With white for bright pink Flower, lilac for white Flower and bright pink for lilac Flower, using **French knot**, (see *illustration on page 28*), embroider center of Flower.

With tapestry needle and lime, using **chain st** (see *illustration on page 28*), embroider 1 long stem with 2 short stems on each side above Brim on Hat.

Sew 1 Flower to top of each stem. □□



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
