Abbreviations

SC - Single crochet INC - Increase DEC - Decrease ST - Stitch

Materials Needed

* Sport weight cotton yarn in any
two colours of your choice (i have used
pink as main colour and black for stripes)
* 2mm crochet hook (if you want to make
a smaller cat, use hook smaller than 2mm)
* 8mm flat back or safety eyes

* fiber fill for stuffing

* tapestry needle

* black embroidery thread and needle



Start with pink yarn,

R1: 6 sc in magic ring (6)

R2: inc in each stitch (12)

R3: [sc, inc] ×6 (18)

R4: [sc2, inc] ×6 (24)

R5: [sc3, inc] ×6 (30)

R6: [sc4, inc] ×6 (36)

R7: $[sc5, inc] \times 6$ (42)

R8-19: sc in each stitch (42)

R20: [sc5, dec] ×6 (36)

insert safety eyes between R10 and R11 with 7 stitches in between

R21: [sc4, dec] ×6 (30)

R22: [sc3, dec] ×6 (24)

R23: [sc2, dec] ×6 (18)

Stuff firmly with fiberfill and continue to stuff till the end

R24: [sc, dec] ×6 (12)

R25: dec ×6 (6)

Fasten off and close the ends

LEGS (MAKE 4)

Start with pink yarn,

Make 5 sc in magic ring

don't join and fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

EARS (MAKE 2)

Start with pink yarn,

R1: 4 sc in magic ring (4)

R2: [sc, inc] ×2 (6)

R3: [sc, inc] ×3 (9)

R4: [sc2, inc] ×3 (12)

fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

TAIL

Start with black yarn,

R1: 6 sc in magic ring (6)

R2: [sc2, inc] ×2 (8)

R3: sc in each stitch (8)

R4-5: [pink] sc in each st (8)

R6-7: [black] sc in each st (8)

R8-9: [pink] sc in each st (8)

R10-11: [black] sc in each st (8)

R12-13: [pink] sc in each st (8)

R14-15: [black] sc in each st (8)

R16-17: [pink] sc in each st (8)

sc through both the top layers to close.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

ASSEMBLING

- Sew the ears from R4 to R8.
- Attach the forelegs slantingly from R14 to R15.
- Attach the hind legs slanting inward from R20 to R21.
- Using 2 or 3 strands of embroidery thread, make an inverted 'v' shape for the mouth
- Sew the whiskers one stitch away from the eyes.
 - Using Tapestry needle and black yarn, make 3 long stripes from top of the head to R7 at the center.
 - Similarly make 2 more stripes at the sides, 2 stitches away from the center stripe.
- Add in 2 side stripes at R16 and another at R18 on both sides of the body.
- Sew 2 back stripes at R10 and another at R12 at the back of the body.
- Finally attach the tail slantingly from R18 to R19 at the back.
