Abbreviations (US):

MR - magic ring

Ch - chain

Sc - single crochet

Inc - increase (make 2 single crochet in 1 stitch)

Dec - decrease (make 2 single crochet together)

DC - double crochet

HDC - half double crochet

BLO/FLO - back/front loops only

SI st - slip stitch

(...) - The number of stitches in the round Bobble st - 5 DC together cluster stitch

The required materials:

- 1. Plush yarn Wolans Bunny Baby brown (No. 41) 1 skein
- 2. Plush yarn Wolans Bunny Baby red (No. 08) a little bit for a bow
- 3. Plush yarn Wolans Bunny Baby milk (No. 02) a little bit for a muzzle
- 4. DK weight yarn YarnArt jeans light pink (No. 74) a little bit for cheeks
- 5. 3.75 mm crochet hook
- 6. 2.0 mm crochet hook
- 7. Safety eyes D=12 mm
- 8. Safety nose 18*13mm
- 9. Stuffing material (fiberfill/polyester)
- 10. Thin black thread for eyebrows (I used YarnArt Canarias)
- 11. Scissors
- 12. Tapestry needle

Arms:

Stuff the palm only (up to round 6)

With brown yarn:

- 1. 6sc into MR
- 2. (inc)*6 (12)
- 3-5. 12sc (3 rounds)
- 6. (dec,4sc)*2 (10)
- 7-13. 10sc (7 rounds)
- 14. (dec,3sc)*2 (8)
- 15. Flatten together and crochet 4 sc through both loops across.

Fasten off and break yarn. We will crochet the arms into the body later. Crochet the second arm similarly.



Legs-body-head:

With brown yarn:

- 1. 8sc into MR
- 2. (inc)*8 (16)
- 3. BLO: 16sc
- 4-7. 16sc (4 rounds)

Fasten off and break yarn. Crochet the second leg similarly BUT DO NOT cut yarn. Chain 5 and join to the first leg. Continue crocheting to the first leg:

8. 16sc, 5sc to the chain, 16sc to the second leg, 5sc to the chain (42)





In the next round, increase above the chains.

9. 16sc, (inc)*5, 21sc (47)

10-12. 47sc (3 rounds)

13. 44sc, Bobble st (tog5DC cluster), 2sc (47)

A Bobble stitch is a tail. It must be in the middle of the backside. Crochet shift stitches if needed.



14. 47sc

Video: Crochet the tail

Start stuffing the body.

In the next round, crochet the decrease above increases, which we crocheted in round 9.

15. 16sc, (dec)*5, 21sc (42)

16. (5sc,dec)*6 (36)

17. 36sc

18. (4sc,dec)*6 (30)

19. 30sc

20. (3sc,dec)*6 (24)

21-22, 24sc

Adjust the marker to the middle of the backside. In the next round, crochet the arms into the body.

23. 4sc, 4sc with the left arm together, 8sc, 4sc with the right arm together, 4sc (24)

Complete stuffing the part with fiberfill.



Continue crocheting the head (start counting from the first round for your convenience)

1. FLO: (inc)*24 (48)

2. (7sc,inc)*6 (54)

3-10. 54sc (8 rounds)

Install the eyes between rounds 6 and 7. The distance between them is 10 sc.

11. (7sc,dec)*6 (48)

12. (6sc,dec)*6 (42)

13. (5sc,dec)*6 (36)

14. (4sc,dec)*6 (30)

15. (3sc,dec)*6 (24)

Stuff the head gently because we will sculpt the muzzle later.

16. (2sc,dec)*6 (18)

17. (1sc,dec)*6 (12)

18. (dec)*6 (6)

Fasten off, break yarn, tighten the hole and hide the tail inside the head.



Ears (make 2):

DO NOT stuff.

With brown yarn:

- 1. 6sc into MR
- 2. (inc)*6 (12)
- 3. (1sc,inc)*6 (18)
- 4-5. 18sc
- 6. Flatten the ear together and crochet 9 sc through both loops across.

Fasten off and break yarn, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

Crochet the second ear similarly.



Muzzle:

With milk color yarn:

- 1. 6sc into MR
- 2. (inc)*6 (12)
- 3. (1sc,inc)*6 (18)
- 4. 18sc

Fasten off and break yarn, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing. (I cut yarn and sew the muzzle to the head with cotton thread matching the color).

Install the nose between rounds 3 and 4.





Cheeks (make 2):

With light pink yarn (a 2.0 mm crochet hook):

- 1. 6sc into MR
- 2. (inc)*6 (12)

Fasten off and break yarn, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing. Crochet the second cheeks similarly.



Bow:


With red yarn:

Chain 6 and start crocheting in the second chain from hook:

1. 5sc

2-18. chain 1,5sc, turn

Fold the short sides together and join them with sl st together. Fasten off and break yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing. Turn the part inside out and shape the middle with the yarn tail (wrap around it 5-6 times). Fasten off.



Assembly:

1. Sculpt the muzzle (watch a video and photo)





2. Place the muzzle between the last row of the body and 6^{th} row of the head and sew it. Stuff the muzzle with fiberfill gently as you sew.



3. Place the ears on the sides of the head between rows 6 and 15. Sew them in a semicircle.



4. Sew the cheeks.



5. Embroider the eyebrows and a vertical stitch across the muzzle with black thin thread.



6. Sew a bow in the mizzle to the second to last row of the body.



Your cute bear is finished!
