Hello My Dear Friends,

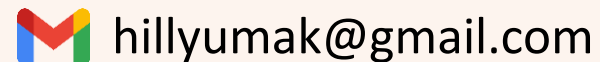
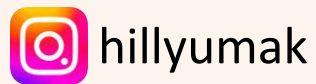

# Materials

# Abbreviations

MR: Magic Ring

sc: Single crochet stitch

inc: Single crochet increase

dec: Single crochet decrease

dc: Double crochet

hdc: Half double crochet stitch

ch: Chain stitch

tog: Together

st: Stitch

sts: Stitches

slst: slip stitch

BLO: Back loops only

FLO: Front loops only



Needle Nose Pliers

Hook

Needle

Fiber

Scissor

Safety Eyes

Silicon

Rayon Lace Yarn

\*Silicon is for glueing the hair.

\*The size of the hook is 0.55.

\*The size of safety eye is 2.5 mm.

\*Soft pastels can be used for makeup.

\*4 pyl rayon lace yarn ( I use brand 'Leylak').

Yarn codes: Dust Rose:2929, White, Hair Colour:73, Skin Colour: 1108, Blue:8146

## Arms (make two)

*Start crocheting with skin color yarn.*

***Note:** Push the ring outward to make the right side out by the hook or scissors.*

**Round 1:** 5sc in MR

**Round 2:** 5inc (10)

**Round 3-4 (2 Rounds):** 10sc

**Round 5:** 3-dc bobble st, 9sc

**Round 6:** (3sc, dec)x2 (8)

**Round 7-24 (18 Rounds):** 8sc

***Note:** Please stuff the arms with fiberfill loosely. Do not use too much fiber.*



## Legs (make two)

*Start crocheting with white color yarn.*

**Round 1:** 6ch, (Start from 2nd chain), 4sc, [4sc in one stitch], 3sc, inc (13)

**Round 2:** inc, 3sc, 4inc, 3sc, 2inc (20)

**Round 3:** inc, 6sc (inc-sc)x3, 5sc, 2inc (26)

**Round 4:** BLO, 26sc

**Round 5:** 26sc

**Round 6:** 6sc(dec-sc)x5, 5sc (21)

**Round 7:** dec, 3sc, 5dec, 4sc, dec (14)

**Round 8:** 5sc, 2dec, 5sc (12)

**Round 9-12 (4 Rounds):** 12sc

*Change to skin color yarn*

**Round 13:** BLO, 12sc

**Round 14:** 11sc, inc (13)

**Round 15:** 12sc, inc (14)

**Round 16-35 (20 Rounds):** 14sc

**Note:** (Round 13): FLO, ch1, (1sc, chain 2)x12, slst to the first st and fasten off.



## Body

*Continue with skin color yarn*

**Round 1:** 4 chains, 14sc (around the first leg), 4sc (along 4ch), 14sc (around the second leg), 4sc on chains (36 sc)

**Round 2-7(6 Rounds):** 36sc

**Round 8:** (4sc, 1dec)x6 (30)

**Round 9-17 (9 Rounds):** 30sc

**Round 18:** (3sc, 1dec)x6 (24sc)

**Round 19:** 24sc

*Proceed to join the arms. Adjust the marker to be located on the back (see pic 1)*

**Round 20:** Crochet 7sc from the body, and join the arm with 3sc. Crochet 9sc from the body, combine the arm with 3sc, and crochet 2sc from the body. (24)

**Round 21:** 7sc on the body, 5sc (arm), 9sc on the body, 5sc (arm), 2sc on the body (28)

**Round 22:** (5sc, 1dec)x4 (24)

**Round 23:** (2sc, 1dec)x6 (18)

**Round 24:** (1sc, 1dec)x6 (12)

**Round 25:** (4sc, 1dec)x2 (10)

**Round 26-32 (7 Rounds):** 10sc

**Round 33:** 5dec, fasten off.

*Note: You can use silicone or wire to stabilize the neck.*



# Head

*Continue with the skin colour yarn*

**Round 1:** 6sc in MR

**Round 2:** 6inc (12)

**Round 3:** (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

**Round 4:** (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)

**Round 5:** (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30)

**Round 6:** (4sc, 1inc)x6 (36)

**Round 7:** (5sc, 1inc)x6 (42)

**Round 8:** (6sc, 1inc)x6 (48)

**Round 9:** (7sc, 1inc)x6 (54)

**Round 10-22 (13 Rounds):** 54sc

**Note:** Insert the safety eyes between rounds 17 and 18. The number of stitches between two eyes should be 7 after placing the eyes (9 stitches before placing the eyes).

**Round 23:** (7sc, 1dec)x6 (48)

**Round 24:** 3sc, dec, (6sc, dec)x5, 3sc (42)

**Round 25:** (5sc, 1dec)x6 (36)

**Round 26:** 2sc, dec, (4sc, dec)x5, 2sc (30)

**Round 27:** (3sc, 1dec)x6 (24)

**Round 28:** 1sc, dec, (2sc, dec)x5, 1sc (18)

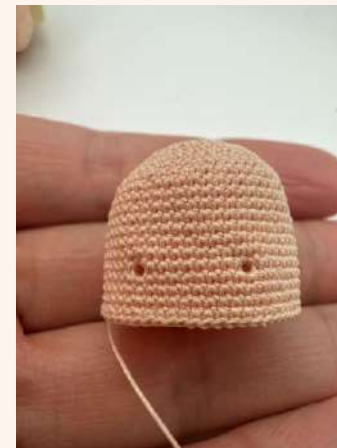
**Round 29:** (1sc, 1dec)x6 (12)

**Round 30-33(4 Rounds):** 12sc

**Round 34:** 6dec, fasten off.

**Note:** Please, push the neck inward using scissors or tweezers. After that, place the head on the neck.

**Note:** I didn't sew the head to body in order to take the dress out. If you want to sew it, do not forget to sew the head after putting the dress on because it is not possible when the head is sewn.



## Dress

*Start with white colour yarn*

**Round 1:** Chain 33,( Start from 2. chain), 32sc, 1ch, turn

**Round 2:** 6sc, 5ch, skip 5, 10sc, 5ch, skip 5, 6sc, 1ch, turn (32)

**Round 3:** 5sc, inc, 5sc, inc, 8sc, inc, 5sc, inc, 5sc, 1ch, turn (36)

**Round 4-12 (9 Rounds):** 36sc

**Round 13:** BLO (36incdc), slst, 2ch (72dc)

**Round 14-17 (4 Rounds):** 72dc

**Round 18:** *BLO (incdc, chain 2)x72, slst to the first st and fasten off.*

## Scarf

*Start with white colour yarn*

Chain 118,( Start from 2. chain), 117dc, fasten off.





## Jacket

**Start with the dusty rose color**

**Round 1:** Chain 25,( Start from 2. chain), 3hdc, inc3, 4hdc, inc3, 6hdc, inc3, 4hdc, inc3, 3hdc (32)

**Round 2:** 4hdc, inc3, 6hdc, inc3, 8hdc, inc3, 6hdc, inc3, 4hdc (40)

**Round 3:** 5hdc, inc, 8hdc, inc, 10hdc, inc, 8hdc, inc, 5hdc (44)

**Round 4:** 7hdc, 5ch, skip 8, 14hdc, 5ch, skip 8, 7hdc (38)

**Round 5:** 6hdc,inc, 5hdc (in 5 chains), inc, 12hdc, inc, 5hdc (in 5 chains), inc, 6hdc, 2ch, turn (42)

**Round 6:** (6hdc, inc)x6, 2ch, turn (48)

**Round 7:** 48hdc, 2ch, turn

**Round 8:** (7hdc, inc)x6, 2ch, turn (54)

**Round 9:** 54hdc, 2ch, turn

**Round 10:** *BLO (incdc, chain 2)x54, slst to the first st and fasten off.*

## Jacket's Sleeves

**Round 1:** Attach the yarn to the sleeves. 5hdc upside, 8hdc downside, fasten up with 1 chain. Continue crocheting 13hdc spirals through 7 rows



## Hair Cap

Start with mustard colour yarn

**Round 1:** 7 sc MR

**Round 2:** (inc)x7 14sc

**Round 3:** (1sc,inc)x7 (21)

**Round 4:** (2sc,inc)x7 (28)

*Please continue from the 4th row without cutting the yarn.*

## Hair Strands

**Strand 1-6:** Chain 26, starting from the third chain from your hook, 24hdc, slst in the next st on the cap.

**Strand 7-28:** Chain 55, starting from the third chain from your hook, 53hdc, slst in the next st on the cap (22 Strands).

*Note: Glue the hair from the back side. First, glue the cap on the top of the head in order to fix it. Then, glue the strands.*

*You can also sew the hair to the head. It is all at your preference.*



# Hat

*Start with dust rose colour yarn*

**Round 1:** 7sc in MR

**Round 2:** 7inc (14)

**Round 3:** (1sc, 1inc)x7 (21)

**Round 4:** (2sc, 1inc)x7 (28)

**Round 5:** (3sc, 1inc)x7 (35)

**Round 6:** (4sc, 1inc)x7 (42)

**Round 7:** (5sc, 1inc)x7 (49)

**Round 8:** (6sc, 1inc)x7 (56)

**Round 9-11 (3 Rounds):** 56sc

**Round 12:** (6sc, 1dec)x7 (49), fasten off.



## Shoes

*Start with dusty rose colour yarn*

**Round 1:** 6ch, (Start from 2nd chain), 4sc, [4sc in one stitch], 3sc, inc (13)

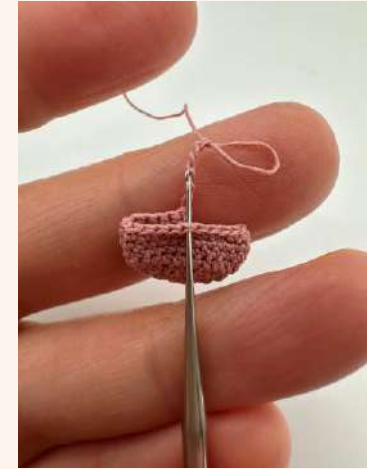
**Round 2:** inchdc, 3hdc, 4inchdc, 3hdc, 2inchdc (20)

**Round 3:** inchdc, 6hdc (inc-hdc)x3, 5hdc, 2inchdc (26)

**Round 4-5 (2 Rounds):** 26sc

**Round 6:** 7sc, (dec, sc)x4, 7sc (22)

**Round 7:** 5sc, 7 chain, skip 10, 7sc, fasten off.
