

# Pika the Electric Mouse



**Free  
Pattern**



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## Materials

Yarn: Super Bulky (6)

Hook: 8mm

Safety Eyes: 14mm

Tapestry Needle

Stuffing

Scissors

## Stitch Abbreviations

Sc = Single Crochet

Inc = Single Crochet Increase

Dec = Single Crochet Decrease

Hdc = Half Double Crochet

Hdc Inc = Half Double Crochet Increase

Hdc Dec = Half Double Crochet Decrease

Sl st = Slip Stitch

Ch = Chain

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## Head

In **Yellow**:

**1)** 8 Sc into Magic Ring (8)

**2)** Inc x 8 (16)

**3)** (Sc 1, Inc) x 8 (24)

**4-6)** Sc around (24)

**7)** (Sc 3, Inc) x 6 (30)

**8-9)** Sc around (30)

**10)** (Sc 3, Dec) x 6 (24)

**11)** (Sc 2, Dec) x 6 (18)

**12)** (Sc 1, Dec) x 6 (12)

Place safety eyes between R7+8, 5 stitches apart

**13)** Dec x 6 (6)

Tie off, leaving 6" tail. Use tapestry needle to sew the hole shut and secure end.



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## Body

In **Yellow**:



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Begin by holding the head upside down and face pointing away from you.

Note: You will be placing 6 sc into the bottom of the head (using Round 13 as a guide for stitch placement).

You will start the row at the back of the head.

- 1) 6 Sc into head (6)
- 2) Hdc Inc x 6 (12)
- 3) (Hdc 1, Hdc Inc) x 6 (18)
- 4) (Hdc 2, Hdc Inc) x 6 (24)
- 5) Hdc around (24)
- 6) (Hdc 3, Hdc Inc) x 6 (30)
- 7-8) Hdc around (30)
- 9) (Hdc 3, Hdc Dec) x 6 (24)
- 10) (Hdc 2, Hdc Dec) x 6 (18)



Do not tie off, continue to leg instructions.

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# Legs



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Add extra Hdc until you get to the centre of the back.

Lay the body flat to figure out how to place the legs (There will be 5 stitches designated for each leg, that will leave 8 stitches total unworked).

Using stitch markers, mark 5 stitches for each leg, with a 4 stitch gap in between on each side. Add extra Hdc to get to the first st marker, if needed.

## First Leg

Working the designated 5 stitches only:

- 1) Sc Inc x 5 (10)
- 2) (Sc 4, Inc) x 2 (12)
- 3) (Sc 2, Dec) x 3 (9)
- 4) (Sc 1, Dec) x 3 (6)

Fasten off and sew hole shut.

## Second Leg

Add Yellow yarn to Round 10 of body, leaving a 10" yarn tail. The second leg will be worked the same way as the first leg, but in the other set of 5 stitches. Use the 10" tail to sew the gap between the legs.



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## Arms (Make 2)

In **Yellow**:

**1)** 5 Hdc into Magic ring (5)

**2-4)** Hdc around (5)

**5)** Hdc 3, Hdc Dec (4)

Fasten off and leave a long tail to sew onto the body.

Sew onto R2 of the body, 4 stitches apart on the front.



## Ears (Make 2)

In **Black**:

**1)** 5 Sc into Magic ring (5)

**2)** Sc 4, Inc (6)

Change colour to **Yellow**:

**3)** Sl st, Sc 5 (6)

**4)** (Sc 2, Inc) x 2 (8)

**5)** Sc around (8)

**6)** Dec x 4 (4)

Fasten off and leave a long tail to sew onto the head.

Sew between R3+4 on either side of the head.



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## Cheeks (Make 2)

In **Red**:

1) 5 Sc into Magic ring (5) Sl st.

Fasten off and leave a long tail to sew onto the head.

Sew between R9+11 on each side of the head.



## Nose

In **Black**:

Sew yarn around centre stitch of R8+9, between the eyes. Secure ends inside the head.



## Tail

In **Yellow**:

Leave long tail at beginning to sew onto body.

1) Ch 6

2) Starting 2nd Ch from hook: Sc 5 (5) Ch 1 + turn

3) Sc 5 (5) Ch 1 + turn

4) Sc 2 (2) Ch 1 + turn

5) Sc 2, Ch 4 (6) turn

6) Starting 2nd chain from hook: Sc 5 (5) Ch 1 + turn

7) Sc 5 (5) Ch 1 + turn

8) Sc 5

Fasten off. Sew onto R7+8 of back, at a slight angle.



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
