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Materials

- **Plush yarn:**
 - the main body color - white for legs/horn
 - the secondary color - brown (for the legs, horn), pink (for the snout), contrasting color (for the hair)
- 14/16 mm safety eyes
- 4 mm crochet hook
- a yarn needle
- scissors
- polyfil
- st marker
- acrylic yarn for the face/eye details

Abbreviations

MR - Magic Ring
ch - Chain
st - Stitch
sl st - Slip stitch
sc - Single crochet
dec - Decrease
inc - Increase (2 sc in one st)
BLO - Back loop only
hdc - Half double crochet
**BBL- Bobble stitch (4 double
crochet bbl st)**

cc- Color change
**(...) - repeat the
instructions in
parentheses**
**x... - repeat the
instructions the number of
times shown**
FO - fasten off

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- Himalaya dolphin baby
- Hook: 4 mm
- Safety eyes: 14 mm



- Sweet snuggles lite
- Chenille home slim
- Hook: 5mm
- Eyes: 18mm



- Alize Velluto
- Hook: 6 mm
- Safety eyes: 18 mm



- Premier Parfait XL
- Hook: 10 mm
- Eyes: 30 mm

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Ears (2)

Start with the white (or other contrasting color)

R1: ch 2, in the 2nd ch from the hook: 6 sc, ch 1, turn

R2: (sc, inc) x3 (9), ch 1, turn

R3: 9 sc

Make 6 sc along the bottom of the ear, ch 1, turn

fold in half and crochet 3 sc through both sides (watch video tutorial)

*No need to leave a long tail, cut the yarn, FO

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Body

Start with the white

R1: 8 sc in a MR

R2: 8 inc (16)

R3: (sc, inc)x8 (24)

[In R4 you will be color changing. The black text - white yarn, the red text - brown yarn]

R4: inc, sc, inc, 2 sc, BBL, 3 sc, BBL, 2 inc, sc, BBL, 3 sc, BBL, 3 sc, inc, sc, inc, *TAIL (30)

R5-R7: 30 sc around (3 rows)

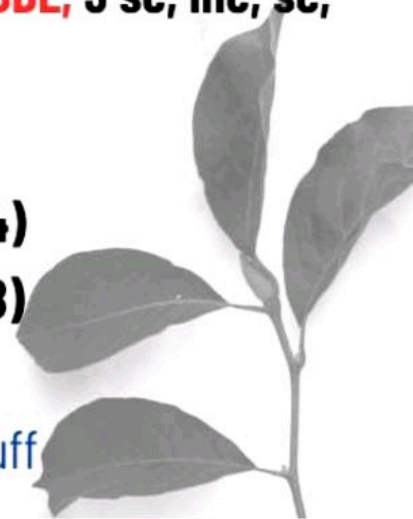
R8: (dec, sc)x2, 5 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 5 sc, (sc, dec)x2 (24)

R9: (dec, sc)x2, 2 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 2 sc, dec, sc, dec (18)

R10: 18 sc around (18)

R11: 2 dec, 2 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, sc, 2 dec (12) *starting to stuff

***TAIL: ch 6, from the 2nd ch from the hook: 5 sl st, sl st on to the body in the same inc**



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Head



R12: 12 inc (24)

R13: (3 sc, inc)x6 (30)

R14: (4 sc, inc)x6 (36)

In R15-18 you will be color changing. The black text - white yarn, the red text - brown yarn. (HDCs should be in the middle of the snout, adjust if necessary. Make the HDCs very tight so that there are no holes)

R15: 17 sc, 6 hdc, 13 sc (36)

R16: 17 sc, 6 hdc, sc, 12 sc (36)

R17: 17 sc, (sc, dec)x2, sc, 12 sc (34)

R18: 17 sc, [BLO 5 sc], 12 sc (34) (watch video tutorial)

R19: (6 sc, dec)x4, 2 sc (30)

R20: 30 sc around (30)

[R15-R18

in the video tutorial]



* If necessary, offset the stitch at the beginning of the row to ensure symmetrical placement of the ears and horns.

***eyes- between round 18 and 19, 5 visible stitches apart**

Head

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R21: 8 sc, 3 sc tog with ear, 13 sc, 3 sc tog with ear, 3 sc (30)

R22: (3 sc, dec)x6 (24)

R23: (dec, 2 sc)x2, dec, sc, **BBL, dec, 2 sc, dec, **BBL**, sc, dec, 2 sc (18)**

*Begining to stuff

R24: (sc, dec)x6 (12)

R25: 6 dec

*cut the yarn, close the hole



1. Next we'll shape the face.

I show you how to shape the face in my video tutorial

2. Add a tassel to the tip of the tail.

3. Add hair (optional).

4. Embroider the spots with a contrasting color.
