



MINI RUBBER DUCK

FREE PATTERN



hook & yarn

+/- 6.5cm tall

Materials & Tools

- 2mm yellow yarn
- 2mm orange yarn
- 4mm button eyes
- Fiberfill for stuffing
- 2mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needles & scissors

Abbreviations

- ch chain stitch
- st stitch
- sc single crochet
- inc increase (2 sc in one st)
- dec decrease (2 sc together)



Body

use yellow yarn

- Row 1: make 6 ch [6]
Row 2: on second chain from hook,
4 sc, inc, working around,
4 sc, inc [12]
Row 3: inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 3 sc, 2 inc [18]
Row 4: 6 sc, 5 inc, 6 sc, inc [24]
Row 5-6: sc in all st [24]
Row 7: 4 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc) x4, 6 sc, inc [30]
Row 8-9: sc in all st [30]
Row 10: 8 sc, dec, (2 sc, dec) x3, 8 sc [26]

Fasten off & leave tail for sewing



Head

use yellow yarn

- Row 1: Skip 8 st, make 12 sc [12]
Row 2: sc in all st [12]
Row 3: (sc, inc) x6 [18]
Row 4: (2 sc, inc) x6 [24]
Row 5: (3 sc, inc) x6 [30]
Row 6: (4 sc, inc) x6 [36]
stuff body with fiberfill and sew the opening with the tail
Row 7-9: sc in all st [36]
Row 10: (4 sc, dec) x6 [30]
Row 11: sc in all st [30]
Row 12: (3 sc, dec) x6 [24]
Row 13: sc in all st [24]
Row 14: (2 sc, dec) x6 [18]
Row 15: (sc, dec) x6 [12]
stuff head with fiberfill
Row 16: dec x6 [6]

Fasten off

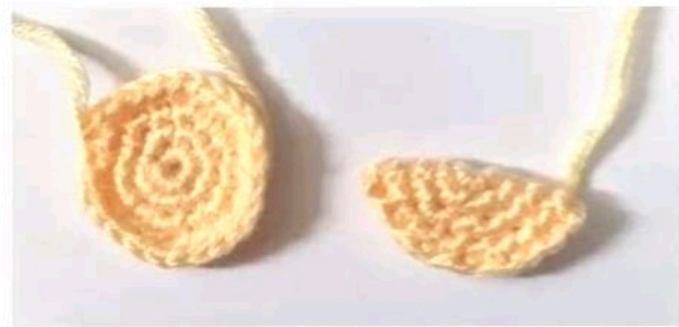


Wings (make 2)

use yellow yarn

- Row 1: magic circle [6]
- Row 2: inc x6 [12]
- Row 3: (sc, inc) x6 [18]
- Row 4: (2 sc, inc) x6 [24]

Fasten off & fold into two then sew with the tail



Beak

use orange yarn

- Row 1: make 6 ch [6]
- Row 2: on second chain from hook, 5 sc, working around, 5 sc [10]
- Row 3-5: sc in all st [10]
- Row 6: 5 sc [5]

Fasten off & leave tail for sewing



Assembly

- a. Sew wings on both sides of the body
- b. Sew beak at the front of the face and insert button eyes
