Amigurumi pattern crochet "Diana doll"



Thank you for purchasing pattern. I'm sure you will succeed.



This pattern does not contain crochet lessons and is designed for those who have basic crochet skills. Difficulty: medium.

Recommendations:

Knit tightly so that there are no holes.

All details are knitted in a spiral, except as specified.

The size of the finished toy when using the specified materials is about 24cm (9.4 inch)

Symbols:

mr - magic ring

ch - chain stitch

inc - increase

sc - single crochet

dec - decrease

sl st - slip stitch

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

tc - triple crochet

(...) - the number in brackets means the number of stitches in the row

(...)*x - repeat x times the specified number in brackets



Materials:

- Yarn:
- Alize Cotton Gold 100g (3.5 oz.) /330m (12992 inch), color 401 (body) for body.
- Alize Cotton Gold 100g (3.5 oz.) /330m (12992 inch), color 446 (pink beige) for shoes.
- Alize Cotton Gold 100g (3.5 oz.) /330m (12992 inch), color 62 (milk) for panties and bodice.
- YarnArt Baby cotton 50g (1.8 oz.) /165m (6496 inch), color 402 (creamy) for hair.
- YarnArt Baby cotton 50g (1.8 oz.) /165m (6496 inch), color 410 (pink) for dress.
- YarnArt Baby cotton 50g (1.8 oz.) /165m (6496 inch), color 404 (honey) for dress.
- YarnArt Baby cotton 50g (1.8 oz.) /165m (6496 inch), color 407 (brown) for apron-basque.
 - Steel hook № 1,75 (mm) (№ 4 for US)
 - Polyester fiberfill
 - Safety eyes for toys 10mm (0.4 inch).
 - Thick sewing needle, pins, scissors, knitting marker. Black, white and brown threads for the design of the face.
 - Blush or dry pastel for tinting.
 - Braided wire with a diameter of 6 mm (0.24 inch) 11 cm (4.3 inch).

Wire diameter 1.5 mm (0.06 inch) - 25cm (9.8 inch).

- Plastic cutting boards (for the sole).
- Adhesive plaster.
- Lace.
- Buttons.



Hands:

Knit 2 pieces with body color thread.

Fill only the palm tightly, then you do not need to fill it.

1 row: 6sc in mr (6)

2 row: 6inc (12)

3-4 rows: 12sc (2 rows)

5 row: bobble stitch (dc3tog cluster in one loop), 11sc (12)

6 row: (dec, 4sc) * 2 (10) 7 row: (dec, 3sc) * 2 (8)

8 row: 8sc

9 row: (inc, 3sc) * 2 (10) 10-25 rows: 10sc (16 rows)

Cut yarn and fasten off.



Legs + torso:

Right leg.

Start knitting in pink-beige.

Fill the legs and torso tightly during knitting.


1 row: Cast on a chain of 7ch, from the 2nd loop from the hook: 5sc, 3sc in one loop, on the other side of the chain - 4sc, inc (14)

2 row: inc, 4sc, 3inc, 4sc, 2inc (20)

3 row: 1sc, inc, 4sc, (1sc, inc) * 3, 4sc, (1sc, inc) * 2 (26)

4 row: 2sc, inc, 4sc, (2sc, inc) * 3, 4sc, (2sc, inc) * 2 (32)

Prepare the insoles. I use soft plastic cutting boards. Circle the part, cut it out. Make 2 details.



5 row: back loop only: 32sc (32)

6-8 rows: 32sc (3 rows) - the marker should be in the center of the heel.

9 row: 10sc, 6dec, 10sc (26)

Insert the insole.

10 row: 7sc, 6dec, 7sc (20)

11 row: 7sc, 3dec, 7sc (17)

12 row: 3sc, dec (side), 7sc, dec (side), 3sc (15)

13 row: 15sc

Change to thread body color. Do not cut the pink-beige thread, but bring it out and leave it before work.

14 row: back loop only: 15 sc (15)

15-16 rows: 15 sc (2 rows) 17 row: (4sc, inc) * 3 (18)



At this stage, it is more convenient to tie the boots. With the pink-beige thread left outside, knit 1 row 15sc for the front loops of the 13th row. Finish knitting sl st, fasten the thread, cut. Hide the end of the thread inside the part.

When knitting, hold the leg as in the photo.





Attach the pink-beige thread to the front half loops of the 4th row: 32 sl st. Fasten the thread, cut. Hide the end of the thread inside the part.

When knitting, hold the leg as in the photo.





18-22 rows: 18sc (5 rows)

23 row: (inc, 5sc) * 3 (21)

24-29 rows: 21sc (6 rows)

In the next row, the decreases should be located as indicated in brackets. If necessary, knit bias stitches or do not knit a few sc in the 29th row.

30 row: 3sc, dec (back in the middle), 4sc, dec (side), 8sc,

dec (side) (18)

31 row: 12sc, 3inc, 3sc (21) - increase strictly in the

middle.

32 row: 21sc


33 row: 15sc, dec (front middle), 4sc (20)

34 row: 20sc

35 row: (inc, 9sc) * 2 (22) - increase on the sides of the

leg

36-41 rows: 22sc (6 rows)



Change the thread to milk thread. Cut the body color

thread.

42 row: 22sc

43 row: back loop only: 22 sc Knit an additional sc (I have

7sc) so that the marker is on the side (see photo). Fasten

the thread on the right leg and cut it off.





Attach the milk thread to the front half loops of the 42nd row: (3ch, sl-st) * 22. When knitting, keep the part as in the photo.

Fasten the thread, cut. Hide the end of the thread inside the part.



Tie the left leg in the same way as the right one, but do not cut the thread, but continue knitting. Place a marker.

44 row: 11sc along the left leg, dial a chain of 3ch and attach it to the right leg.

Knit 22sc on the right leg, 3sc on a chain of ch loops, 11sc on the left leg (50)



45-50 rows: 50 sc (6 rows)

51 row: 4sc, dec, (8sc, dec) * 4, 4sc (45)

52 row: 45sc

53 row: 35sc - the row is incomplete (you may have a different number of loops). Move the marker. It is located in the middle back. Change the thread to body. Cut off the milk thread.

54 row: back loop only: 10sc, dec, 21sc, dec, 10sc (43) - decreases on the sides

55 row: dec, 41sc (42) - decrease in the back in the middle

56-61 rows: 42sc (6 rows)

Knit an additional sc (I have 1sc) so that the marker is in the back in the middle (see photo).

Change the thread to milk thread. Cut the body color thread.

62-65 rows: 42sc (4 rows)

Knit an additional sc (I have 1sc) so that the marker is in the back in the middle (see photo).

Change thread to body color. Cut off the

milk thread.

66 row: back loop only: 42sc



In the next row, knit handles. Make sure that they are located symmetrically on the sides of the body. The fingers are looking at you.

67 row: 8sc, knit 5sc, capturing the loops of the inside of the handle and torso, 16sc, 5sc, capturing the loops of the inside of the handle and torso, 8sc (42)

68 row: 8sc, knit 5sc on the outside of the handle, 16sc, 5sc on the outside of the handle, 8sc (42)



Prepare a wire with a diameter of 1.5 mm (0.06 inch) and a length of 25cm (9.8 inch). Fold the edges as shown in the photo. Try on the frame in the handles (your length may vary). Isolate the frame, as in the photo, with adhesive plaster. Insert into handles. Add filler to the handles.



69 row: (5sc, dec) * 6 (36)

70 row: 2sc, dec, (4sc, dec) * 5, 2sc (30)

71 row: (3sc, dec) * 6 (24)

72 row: (2sc, dec) * 6 (18)

73 row: (4sc, dec) * 3 (15)

74-77 rows: 15sc (4 rows)

Finish knitting sl st, cut the thread, fasten, leaving a long end for sewing.



Head:

Knit with body color thread. Stuff tightly while knitting.

1 row: 6sc in mr (6)

2 row: 6inc (12)

3 row: (1sc, inc) * 6 (18)

4 row: 1sc, inc, (2sc, inc) * 5, 1sc (24)

5 row: (3sc, inc) * 6 (30)

6 row: 2sc, inc, (4sc, inc) * 5, 2sc (36)


7 row: (5sc, inc) * 6 (42)

8 row: 3sc, inc, (6sc, inc) * 5, 3sc (48)

9 row: (7sc, inc) * 6 (54)

10 row: 4sc, inc, (8sc, inc) * 5, 4sc (60)

11-19 rows: 60sc (9 rows)





20 row: 24sc, 1ch, 1 stitch skip, 10sc, 1ch, 1 stitch skip, 24sc (60)

21 row: 60sc

22 row: 15sc, (1sc, inc) * 5, 10sc, (inc, 1sc) * 5, 15sc (70)

23-24 rows: 70sc (2 rows)

Insert the eyes into the holes and secure with a plug from the wrong side.

25 row: 15sc, (1sc, dec) * 5, 10sc, (dec, 1sc) * 5, 15sc (60)

26 row: 4sc, dec, (8sc, dec) * 5, 4sc (54)

27 row: (7sc, dec) * 6 (48)

28 row: 3sc, dec, (6sc, dec) * 5, 3sc (42)

29 row: (5sc, dec) * 6 (36)

30 row: 2sc, dec, (4sc, dec) * 5, 2sc (30)

31 row: (3sc, dec) * 6 (24)

32 row: 1sc, dec, (2sc, dec) * 5, 1sc (18)

33 row: (3sc, dec) * 3, 2sc, sl st (15)

Fasten and cut the thread, hide the end inside the part.

Ears:

Knit two details with body color thread. Leave the long end of the thread, it will be used to sew the ears to the head.

1 row: 5sc in mr (5)

Cut the thread, leaving a long end for sewing.



Face tightening:

Make tightenings, focusing on the photo. Take a long strong thread. In this case, I used the same thread with which I knitted the doll. Insert the needle as close to the eyes as possible.

Points 5 and 6 are located in the last row of the head, in the front in the middle. Insert the needle at point 5 and bring it out at point 1. Then insert the needle at point 2 and bring it out at point 6. Now tighten the second eye. Insert the needle at point 5 and withdraw at point 3. Then enter at point 4 and withdraw at point 6. Pull the ends very gently, trying to pull the eyes evenly and not too much. Tie a knot and hide inside the piece.



Embroider the nose.

Mark 2 points with pins, they are located between the 22nd and 23rd rows of the head, the distance between the points is 3 sc. Make two stitches with body color thread from one pin to the other.

Using a needle, wrap these stitches with the same thread.







Sew on the ears.

Mark 2 points with pins: the upper edge is between the 19th and 20th rows of the head, the lower one is between the 21st and 22nd rows. From the edge of the eye 8sc. Sew the ears to the head.







With white thread, make stitches from the outside of the eyes.

Embroider eyelashes above the eyes with black thread. Embroider eyebrows with brown thread. Pull the ends of the white, black and brown threads into the hole in the head.

After everything is embroidered, tie the ends of the threads into a knot and hide inside the head.

Lightly blush cheeks and nose using blush or dry pastels. Brown shadows or dry pastels tone the eyebrows.



Hair:

Knit with creamy thread.

1 row: 6sc in mr (6)

2 row: back loop only: 6inc (12)

3 row: (1sc, inc) * 6 (18)

4 row: back loop only: (2sc, inc) * 6 (24)

5 row: (3sc, inc) * 6 (30)

6 row: back loop only: (4sc, inc) * 6 (36)

7 row: (5sc, inc) * 6 (42)

8 row: back loop only: (6sc, inc) * 6 (48)

9 row: (7sc, inc) * 6 (54)

10 row: curls - (60ch, from the second loop from the hook, knit along the chain 59 sl st, skip one

loop, sc) * 27

With the help of two sl st, go to the next row. Knit for the front half loops of the 7th row: (60 ch, from the second loop from the hook, knit along the chain 59sl st, skip one loop, sc) * 20





With the help of two sl st, go to the next row. Knit for the front half-loops of the 5th row: (60ch, from the second loop from the hook, knit along the chain 59sl st, skip one loop, sc) * 14

With the help of two sl st, go to the next row. Knit for the front half-loops of the 3rd row: (60ch, from the second loop from the hook, knit along the chain 59sl st, skip one loop, sc) * 8

With the help of two sl st, go to the next row. Knit for the front half loops of the 1st row: (60 ch, from the second loop from the hook, knit along the chain 59sl st, skip one loop, sc) * 3

Fasten and cut the thread, hide the end.

Take a wire 11 cm long, isolate the ends with adhesive plaster. Insert the wire into the doll's body first. Add filler to the neck. The neck should be stuffed tightly. Put head on neck, secure with pins. Sew firmly around the circle.



Try on the wig on head. In front, leave 6 strands of the bottom row for bangs. Secure the remaining curls of the bottom row with pins. Twist two strands of bangs between each other and lay first to one ear - 4 strands, 2 strands to the other. Sew curls to the head. Next, close the gaps between the curls with a few curls of the next row at the back. Sew curls to the head.



Dress:

Start with pink thread.

The top of the dress is knitted in turning rows of sc.

Since the density of knitting is different for everyone, you may need a larger or smaller hook.

Dial a chain of 30ch + 1ch lifting.

1 row: starting from the 2nd loop from the hook: 4sc, inc from 3 sc, 5sc, inc from 3 sc, 8sc, inc from 3 sc, 5sc, inc from 3 sc, 4sc (38)

2 row: 1ch lift, 5sc, inc from 3 sc, 7sc, inc from 3 sc, 10sc, inc from 3 sc, 7sc, inc from 3 sc, 5sc (46)

3 row: 1ch lift, 6sc, inc from 3 sc, 9sc, inc from 3 sc, 12sc, inc from 3 sc, 9sc, inc from 3 sc, 6sc (52)

4 row: 1ch lifting, 7sc, inc from 3 sc, 11sc, inc from 3 sc, 14sc, inc from 3 sc, 11sc, inc from 3 sc, 7sc (60)

5 row: 1ch lifting, 9sc, 6ch, skip 13sc of the previous row (see photo), 18sc, 6ch, skip 13sc of the previous row, 9sc (48)

6-14 rows: 1ch lift, 48sc (9 rows)





Change the thread to honey. Cut off the pink thread. Next, knit dc.

15 row: front loop only: 2ch lifting, (3dc in one loop) * 48 (144)

16-17 rows: 2ch lifting, 144 dc (2 rows) Connect knitting in a circle with sl-st, then knit in

circular rows, each row start with 2 ch lifting and end with sl-st.

18-20 rows: 144 dc (3 rows)

Fasten the thread, cut it off, hide the end of the thread

Sleeves

Attach the thread as shown in the photo.

1 row: 3sc on the bottom of the sleeve,

13sc on the top of the sleeve,

3sc on the bottom of the sleeve (19)

Next, knit in a spiral.

2-3 rows: 19sc (2 rows)

4 row: 3sc, dec, 4sc, dec, 3sc, dec, 3sc (16)

Fasten the thread, cut off, hide the end of the thread.

Knit the second sleeve in the same way.







Tie the side edges and neck of the sc. Make 3 buttonholes from 6ch (you may have a different number of ch) along one edge of the dress. Fasten the thread, cut off, hide the end of the thread. Sew 3 buttons on the back. The front can be decorated with a decorative element or buttons.

If desired, you can sew lace on the bottom of the dress.



Basque Apron:

Knit with brown yarn. Dial a chain of 52ch + 1ch lifting.

1 row: from the 2nd loop from the hook we knit

along the chain 52sc (52) - turn

2 row: 52sl-st - turn

3 row: 2ch lifts, insert the hook as shown in the

photo: (2dc in one loop) (104)

Fasten the thread, cut off, hide the end of the thread.

Attach the brown thread to the beginning of the 3rd row (see photo).

4 row: 2ch lifting, (dc, inc from dc) * 52 (156)

Fasten the thread, cut off, hide the end of the thread.





Shuttlecocks:

Tie two pieces with a brown thread. Dial a chain of 30ch + 1ch lifting.

1 row: from the 2nd loop from the hook we knit along the chain $30sc\ (30)$ - turn

2 row: 30 sl st - turn




3 row: 1 ch lifting, insert the hook as shown in the photo: 4sc, hdc, (2dc in one loop) * 5, (2tc in one loop) * 10, (2dc in one loop) * 5, hdc, 4sc.

Fasten the thread, cut, leaving a long end for sewing.



Mark on the main part on top of the place for sewing the frills. I have this 5th, 21st, 31st and 48th loop from the edge. Sew the frills to the main part - see photo.



For ties, attach a brown thread, as shown in the photo. Dial 50ch. Fasten the thread and cut. Repeat the same on the other side.





Put on a dress and a basque apron. Decorate your hairstyle with bows.

Your Diana is ready!
