

Garik the Pug



Materials

- 3,0 mm crochet hook (size D)
- Cotton yarn:
 - ► beige 50g / 160m (175 yards)
 - ► black 20g / 64m (70 yards)
 - ► small amount of white yarn

- Polyfill to stuff
- A pair of 16 mm (0.63 inches) brown safety eyes
- Tapestry needle
- Stitchmarker and pins (optional)

Yarn, finished size and gauge

This sample was made with YarnArt Jeans (half-cotton yarn): beige #07, black #28, white #01. **Finished size:** 7.87" (20 cm) in seated position, 9.84" (25 cm) tall.

Because this is a pattern for a stuffed animal, gauge is not really important. You can use any weight yarn, if you make sure that your hook is appropriately sized for your yarn, so that you get a nice, solid fabric. Using a different size hook and yarn weight will change the size of your finished project.

Make sure you crochet pretty tight all the way, to get no stretching holes between the stiches after you filled in a stuffing material.

Stitches and crochet techniques used

- Single crochet in rounds
- Magic adjustable ring
- Single crochet increasing and decreasing

HEAD

All parts are crocheted in continuous spirals, without joining the rounds. You can use a stitch marker to keep track of your rounds.

Fasten off, cut the yarn, leaving long tail for sewing.(image 1.3) If you use safety eyes, it is the best moment to place them. But firstly you should make 2 small circles. Use color C: Rnd1: 6 sc in the center of a magic adjustable ring; Rnd2: (inc) 6x, slst, fasten off and cut the yarn, leaving a tail for sewing. (image 1.4) Stick safety eyes in the center of the circles (image 1.5) and place them on the front side of a head (the wider side of oval) between 16 and 17 rnds, leave distance 15sc between eyes. Sew the edges of circles with **yarn C**. Stuff the head. (image 1.6)

EYELIDS (make 2). Start with color B

6 sc into the center of the magic adjustable 01 ring, pull tail to close ring





rnd		st
02	(inc) 6x	12
03	(sc, inc) 6x <i>(image 1.7)</i>	18
04	fold the circle in half (image 1.8) and sc across both sides of the circle in next 9 st (image 1.9). It'll be a bottom of an eyelid.	9

Fasten off, cut the yarn, leaving long tail for sewing.

Place the eyelids above eyes, slightly turning them to the sides, so the upper point of an eyelid is located on a 12 rnd of a head (image 1.10).

Sew them with tail we left from poit A to B. (image 1.11, 1.12) Do not sew the bottom of an eyelid.

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in end. (image 2.2)

Pin a muzzle to the head, turning top edges outwards, making the distance from $\bf A$ to $\bf E$ 3scs, and in the wider part of a cheeks 5scs (image 2.3). Place point $\bf A$ on a 15th rnd of a head, centering regarding to eyes, place points $\bf B$ and $\bf C$ on a 18th rnd of a head, retreated 3sc from the edges of eyes (image 2.4), point $\bf D$ - on a 28th rnd of a head. Do not stretch a muzzle, leaving some space inside for volume.

Sew the edges of a muzzle with yarn B (outside circle of the detail) following the way of points **B-D-C-A-B** (image 2.3, 2.5). When the sewing is almost done, stuff the muzzle with filling material (image 2.6) and finish sewing.

Sew the inside part of a face with color B, following the way of points **B-E-C** (image 2.3, 2.7).

Embroider a nose with color B. The size of a nose - 3sc in height, 4sc - the top side, 3sc - the bottom side. (image 2.12)

Fasten off, cut the yarn, leave long tail for sewing. (image 3.2)

Flat them and sew to 2-7 rnds of a head, slightly turned them to sides. (image 3.3, 3.4, 3.5)

03	(10sc, (inc, sc) 2x, inc) 2x	36
04	(11sc, (inc, 2sc) 2x, inc) 2x	42
05	(12sc, (inc, 3sc) 2x, inc) 2x	48
06	(13sc, (inc, 4sc) 2x, inc) 2x	54
07	(14sc, (inc, 5sc) 2x, inc) 2x (image 4.1)	60
08-12	sc in each st around	60
13	(8sc, sc2tog) 6x	54
14-17	sc in each st around	54

Fasten off, cut the yarn. Stuff with filling material. (image 4.2)

The body has an oval shape, where the wider sides are front and back sides of a body.

Sew the body to the head, placing the front side of a body centered regarding to a face side of a head, connecting last rnds of details. Add stuffing material, if needed. (image 4.3, 4.4)

ARMS (make 2)

Start with color A

rnd		st
01	ch5, sc in 2 nd ch from hook and remaining 2sc, 3sc in the last st, turn and continue on the other side of a chain 3sc, 3sc in next st	12
02	(3sc, 3inc) 2x	18
03-05	sc in each st around	18
06	(4sc, sc2tog)3x	15
07	(3sc, sc2tog)3x	12
08	(2sc, sc2tog)3x	9
Stuff the detail with filling material (image 5.1)		
09-22	sc in each st around	9

Fasten off, cut the yarn, leave long tail for sewing (image 5.2)

Make 2 palms in next way (use color B): Rnd1: 6 sc in the center of a magic adjustable ring; Rnd2: (inc) 6x, slst, fasten off and cut the yarn, leaving a tail for sewing.

Sew them to a flat side of hands (wider side of an oval) between 3 and 9 rnds of a hand. (image 5.3)

Embroider claws with color B (image 5.4)

Flat the base of hands and sew them to both sides of a body, between 25 and 26 rnds, guiding palms to the body. (image 5.5, 5.6)

Fasten off, cut the yarn, leave long tail for sewing (image 6.2) Make 2 foot pads. They are the same, as palms for hands: **Rnd1**: 6 sc in the center of a magic adjustable ring; Rnd2: (inc) 6x, slst,

fasten off and cut the yarn, leaving a tail for sewing. Sew them in the center of the feet (at 1st and 2nd rnds of a leg) (image 6.3)

Embroider claws with color B. Tighten them to make this part of foot flatter. (image 6.4, 6.5, 6.6)

Sew legs to both sides of a boby, making the base flat, between 1-5 rnds of a body. (image 6.7)

TAIL

Start with color A

rnd		st
01	6 sc into the center of the magic adjustable ring, pull tail to close ring	6
02	(inc) 6x	12
03	4sc, 4inc, 4sc	16
04	2sc2tog, 8sc, 2sc2tog	12
05	4sc, 4inc, 4sc	16
06	2sc2tog, 8sc, 2sc2tog	12

Fasten off, cut the yarn, leave long tail for sewing. Stuff it. Sew the tail between 6 and 11 rnds of a body. (image 7.1, 7.2)



The Pug is done. You can tie a ribbon around its neck to make it fancier;)
