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Hello, my dear friends!

You've bought this pattern and it means that you are ready to dive into the magic world of amigurumi. To create your own miracle you only need to find the cosiest place in your flat, take a cup of aroma coffee or tea, magic balls of yarn and the most wonderful mood. I'm sure you'll have something unique.

THE PATTERN INCLUDES A FULL DESCRIPTION OF HOW TO CROCHET THE TOY , ASSEMBLE PARTS TOGETHER , DESIGN AND HOW TO MAKE ITS CLOTHES WHICH IS ACCOMPANIED BY HIGH QUALITY PHOTOS OF THE PROCESS

ABBREVIATIONS:

MR- magic ring

Ch – chain

Hdc - half double crochet

Sc – single crochet

Dc – double crochet

Tr - treble crochet

St – stitch

Inc – increase (2 sc or 2 dc in one st)

Dec – invisible decrease (crochet next
2 st together)

BLO - back loops only

[n] Inc/Dec – increase/decrease [n]
times in a row

Sl st – slip stitch

Number in () at the end of the Row
indicates number of st in that Row

The yarn mentioned here is just recommendation.

You can use any other yarn you want.

In this case the size and quality of the finished toy will change.



MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES:

- 1. Yarn for body - Himalaya Dolphin Baby, plush, grey color, 1 skein.*
- 2. Little bit of yarn Drops Lima of pink color for the ears and a nose.*
- 3. Yarn for clothes – wool Drops Lima, yellow color;*
- 4. Hook size 3mm*
- 5. Fiber filling;*
- 6. Two black plastic beads for the eyes, diameter 5 mm;*
- 7. Buttons for clothes decoration;*
- 8. Brush and blush.*

HEAD

Work with main color yarn.

R1: 6 sc in MR

R2: 6 inc (12)

R3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)

R4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)

R5: (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)

R6: 30 sc

R7: (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)

R8: (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)

R9-13 (5 rounds): 42 sc

R14: (5 sc, dec) x 6 (36)

R15: (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30)

R16: (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)

R17: (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18)

Stuff with fiber. Cut the yarn, hide yarn tail inside the detail



MUZZLE

Crochet with main color yarn.

R1: 6 sc in MR

R2: 6 inc (12)

R3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)

R4: 18 sc

Cut the yarn leaving a long tail
for sewing



EARS

The ears consist of two parts: external and internal. Crochet external part with plush yarn of main color. Crochet internal part with wool yarn Drops Lima pink color. Use hook size 3 mm for both parts and same pattern:

Make a chain of 12, sc into the 2nd chain from the hook, hdc, dc, 5 tr, dc hdc, (sc, ch 3, sc) into the last chain. Turn and continue to crochet on the other side of beginning chain: hdc, dc, 5 tr, dc, hdc, sc, sl st in the end. Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly.

Crochet 2 details.



LEGS + BODY

Crochet with main color yarn.

Start to crochet first leg:

R1: 6 sc in MR

R2: 6 inc (12)

R3-5: 12 sc

R6: (3 sc, inc) x 3 (15)

R7-16 (10 rounds): 15 sc



R17: Stuff to the top. Cut the yarn.
Crochet the second leg the same way.
Don't cut the yarn and make a chain of 3. Join the second leg: crochet 15 sc on the 1st leg, then 3 sc on the chain, 15 sc on the 2nd leg and 3 sc on the other side of the chain. You should get in total: $15+3+15+3=36$ sc



R18-27 (10 rounds): 36 sc

R28: (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30)

R29-30: 30 sc

R31: (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)

R32-33: 24 sc

R34: (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18)

R35-36: 18 sc

Stuff the toy tight. Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly.



ARMS

Work with main color yarn.

Make 2 details.

R1: 5 sc in MR

R2: 5 inc (10)

R3-20 (18 rounds): 10 sc

Stuff to R15. Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.

ASSEMBLY

IMPORTANT: If it is hard for you to sew the details with plush yarn, you can do it with cotton yarn. Just make sure to take the yarn in the tone of the toy.

Sew the head to the body previously securing it with pins around.

When there is a small hole left, stuff the area with fiber between the head and the body. Then sew details to the end.



Next we will sew the muzzle in the center of the bottom of the head. Also secure it with pins around before sewing.

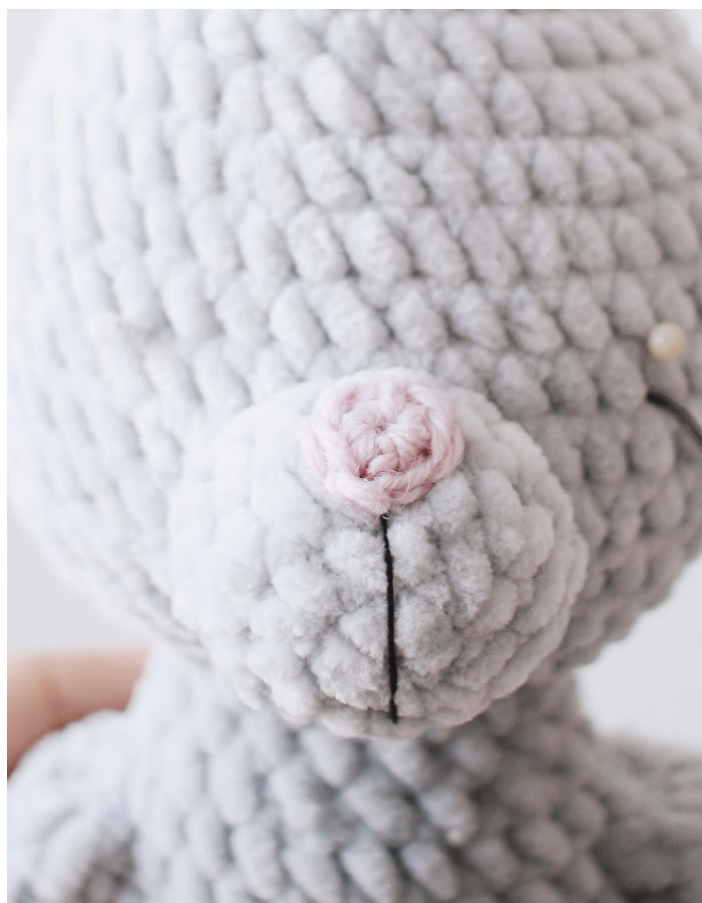
Don't forget to stuff the muzzle with the fiber before sewing details completely.



Then sew the arms on the sides of the body.



Take a pink yarn and crochet a nose:
6 sc in MR
and sew the nose on top of the
muzzle right in the center.
Embroider strip with black sewing
thread perpendicular to the nose, as
shown on the picture.



The eyes are sewn between R9-10.
The distance between them is around
7-8 stitches.

Now we need to sew two details of
ears together as shown on the picture.
Next sew the ears. Choose the place
for them with the pins.





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SARAFAN

Crochet with yarn Drops Lima, hook size 3 mm.

Make a chain of 54, join with first ch with sl st, making a ring this way. Continue to crochet in rounds:

R1-4: ch 3, 54 dc, sl st in the end (54)

R5: ch 3, 54 dc inc, sl st in the end (108)

R6-11: ch 3, 108 dc, sl st in the end (108)

R12: ch 1, 108 sc, sl st in the end.

Cut the yarn, hide yarn tail.



Straps:

For one strap: define the place of attaching the yarn, make a chain of 15, join on the opposite side of the sarafan with slip stitch and continue to crochet on that chain:

Sc inc, hdc inc, 11 dc inc, hdc inc, sc inc.

Decorate the sarafan with buttons.





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BOW

Crochet in MR: ch 4, 6 tr, ch 4, sl st in the ring, ch 4, 6 tr, ch 4, sl st in the ring. Pull off the ring. Wrap it with yarn around several times in the center. Sew the bow to our bunny's head.





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
