Crocheting description Assembly and design

Mr. Pumpkin

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MONSTER

Hello, my dear friends!

I'm very glad to greet you on the pages of my a crochet pattern.

Thank you for your confidence and purchase of this pattern.

You'll receive a step by step instruction for crocheting Mr. Pumpkin.

I tried to make everything as clear as possible for you, but if you have questions, you're welcome – I'll answer them for sure.

Well, let's started!

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IMPORTANT!!!

I want to remind you, that this pattern is my personal working-out. And any distribution (publication, sale, forwarding, translation into foreign languages) is prohibited.

This description doesn't contain crochet lessons. Initial skills are required.

The size of the finished toy is about 6.3 inches, provided that you use the yarn specified below.

PUMPKIN

Necessary materials:

- Yarnart Jeans yarn 50g/174yds (55% cotton, 45% pac): mustard № 84, brown № 71, green (khaki) № 82
- Yarnart Jeans Crazy yarn 50g/174yds (55% cotton, 45% pac): № 7203
- Black threads 25g/163yds, cotton 100% (for the design of the muzzle and fixing the legs and handles).
 Threads for fixing the legs and handles need to be selected in the color of the yarn.
- Two buttons: 1) dark green, diameter 0,71 inches, plastic; 2) brown, diameter 0,55 inches, wooden
- Wooden bead, diameter approximately 0.39 inches
- Hook that fits the size (I have 2.0 mm)
- Fiberfill
- A needle with a large ear for sewing details, a long needle for thread fastening, a sewing needle for making faces, pins, scissors.

Abbreviation:

AR – Amigurumi Ring

ch – chain

sc – single crochet

dc – double crochet

tr - treble crochet

sl st - slip stitch

hdc - half double crochet

inc – increase

dec – decrease

* - the number after * is the number of times this combination to be repeated in a given row

(...) – the number in brackets is the number of loops in a given row

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Crocheting description

HEAD

Dial 23 ch

Crochet behind the back wall of the loop. At the end of each row, do 1 ch and a u-turn.

2 sl st, 2 sc, 14 hdc, 2 sc, 2 sl st; 1 ch, expand the crochet

In total, you need to crochet 46 rows. Cut the thread, leaving a long tail.

Fold the part in half and sew it with the same thread and needle.

Fasten the thread.

Next, you need to tighten the head of the pumpkin on both sides.

To do this, insert a needle with the same thread between the rows along the edge of the detail (pave the basting seam).

Carefully tighten, leaving a hole about 0.4-0.6 inches in diameter. This will be the top of your head.

Secure the thread













Adding the filler.

On the other hand we do the same (using a new thread, having previously secured it).

The hole can be made the same or smaller diameter. Here we are going to sew the body.

Hide the thread and cut it off

If necessary, add more filler, giving the head the desired shape.















TAIL

With the help of a hook and a new thread of additional color (I have green), we tie the in a circle sc:



2 - dec repeat 11 times (11)

3-4 - 11 sc

Add a filler at this stage. Next, we do not fill the part.

5 - 1 sc, 2 dec, 6 sc (9)

6 - 1 sc, 2 dec, 4 sc (7)

7-8 - 7 sc

9 - (1 sc, dec) *2, 1 sc (5)

Tighten the hole by the front hinges. Hide and cut the thread.

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BODY

From 1 to 14 rows, you can knit with one additional color or alternate shades as you like.

I will write how I did it.

Crochet with a thread of additional color (brown):

1 - 6 sc in to magic ring

2 - inc repeat 6 times (12)

3 - (1 sc, inc) *6 (18)

4 - 1 sc, inc; (2 sc, inc) *5; 1 sc (24)

5 - (3 sc, inc) *6 (30)

6 - 2 sc, inc; (4 sc, inc) *5; 2 sc (36)

7 - (5 sc, inc) *6 (42)

8 - 3 sc, inc; (6 sc, inc) *5; 3 sc (48)

Changing the thread to an additional color (browngreen):

9-10 - 48 sc

11 - (7 sc, inc) *6 (54)

12-13 - 54 sc

Changing the thread to an additional color (mustard):

14 - 4 sc, inc; (8 sc, inc) *5; 4 sc (60)



Changing the thread to the main color (graphite):

15-17 - 60 sc

18 - 4 sc, dec; (8 sc, dec) *5; 4 sc (54)

19 - 15 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 2 sc, dec, 1 sc,

dec, 4 sc, dec, 15 sc (48)

20 - 48 sc

21 - 3 sc, dec; (6 sc, dec) *5; 3 sc (42)

22 - 42 sc

23 - (5 sc, dec) *6 (36)

24 - 36 sc

25 - 2 sc, dec; (4 sc, dec) *5; 2 sc (30)

26 - 30 sc

Fasten the thread, cut off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Adding the filler.

LEGS

Crochet with an additional color thread (sectional yarn):

1 - 6 sc in to magic ring

2 - inc repeat 6 times (12)

3 - (1 sc, inc) *6 (18)

4-5 - 18 sc

6 - 5 sc, 4 dec, 5 sc (14)

7 - 3 sc, 4 dec, 3 sc (10)

8 - 10 sc

Gradually add the filler.

9 - (4 sc, inc) *2 (12)

10 - 2 inc, 8 sc, 2 inc (16)

11 - 16 sc



Changing the thread to an additional color (mustard):

12 - 16 sc

Changing the thread to the main color (graphite):

13 - 1 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec) *2, 1 sc (13)

14 - 13 sc

15 - 1 sc, dec, 7 sc, dec, 1 sc (11)

16 - 11 sc

Fill the part with filler.

Carefully tighten the hole by the front loops using a needle and the same thread.

Secure, hide, and cut the thread.





ARMS

Crochet with a thread of additional color (I have brown):

1 - 6 sc in to magic ring

2 - inc repeat 6 times (12)

3 - (2 sc, inc) *4 (16)

4 - 16 sc

Crochet with an additional color thread (sectional yarn):

5 - dec, 12 sc, dec (14)

Changing the thread to the main color (graphite):

6 - dec, 10 sc, dec (12)

Gradually add the filler.

7 - dec, 8 sc, dec (10)

8 - dec, 6 sc, dec (8)

9 - 8 sc

10 - (3 sc, inc) *2 (10)

11 - (4 sc, inc) *2 (12)

12-14 - 12 sc

Fill the part with filler.

Carefully tighten the hole by the front loops using a needle and the same thread.

Secure, hide, and cut the thread.





SHEET

Dial 11 ch

Crochet 9 sc, starting with the second loop from the hook. Then 3 sc in the last loop.

1 hdc, 2 dc, 2 tr, 2 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc, 1 sc и 2 hdc in one loop





And on the other side:

1 hdc и 1 sc in one loop

1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 2 tr, 2 dc, 1 hdc

1 sl st

Next we will crochet according to the scheme:

5 ch and through 2 loops we do 1 sl st

5 ch and through 1 loop 1 sl st

4 ch and through 1 loop 1 sl st

3 ch and through 1 loop 1 sl st

2 sl st

3 dc in one loop



3 sl st

3 ch and through 1 loop 1 sl st

4 ch and through 1 loop 1 sl st

5 ch and through 1 loop 1 sl st

5 ch and through 2 loops 1 sl st













At the end - 1 sl st (in the loop of the previous row, where crocheted sl st and scored the first 5 ch)

Then we dial about 30 ch

The length of your rope (from the leaf to the knot) should be equal to the circumference of the neck of the pumpkin.

Put on a bead, tie a knot and cut off the excess.

SPIRALS

I used three colors of yarn - brown, green, and graphite.

• Short (make 2):

Dial 27 ch

And with the second loop from the hook, we crochet 3 sc in each loop to the end of the chain.

Straightening the spiral.

• Long (make 1):

Dial 37 ch

And with the second loop from the hook, we crochet 3 sc in each loop to the end of the chain.

Straightening the spiral.





Assembly and design

- Attach the head to the body with pins so that the protruding part of it is in front.
- Sew. When a small hole is left, add the filler.
- Secure the thread, hide it, and cut it off.











- Next, we will attach the legs (see page 16).
- First, you need to plan where they will be located.
- Attach them with pins, bend and plant the pumpkin. It is important that the bottom of the body is on a level withthe legs.
- Then we take a thin cotton, fold the thread in half.
- Enter the needle on the back in the middle at the level of the legs (leaving the tail about 3.9 inches) and output it at the place of attachment of the left leg.
- Next, grab the loop from the inside of the leg (between 3 and 4 rows) and re-enter the same hole.
- The needle should come out at the attachment point of the right leg.
- Again, we grab the right leg from the inside and again insert the needle into the same hole.
- We repeat the same thing one more time.
- After this, the needle should come out on the back in the place where the tail was left.
- Gently tighten the threads. Tie two knots and with a needle hide the ends of the threads inside the body.





















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The handles are attached on the same principle.

Only the needle is inserted into them between 2 and 3 rows.





















Now you need to sew the buttons to the place where the eyes will be located. I used the same yarn.

We embroider the smile, seam and eyebrows with a thin cotton thread.



















If desired, you can also embroider the navel with a contrasting color thread.

Curls are sewn on the side of the tail. I placed the longest spiral in the middle.

And the final touch - put on a leaf, fasten with a bead and one of the loops.















HAPPINESS

That's it, Your Mr. Pumpkin is ready! :)
