Crochet pattern «Flower bear»

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The required materials:

- 1. DK weight yarn YarnArt Jeans (71) brown
- 2. DK weight yarn YarnArt Jeans (29) light green
- 3. DK weight yarn YarnArt Jeans (35) yellow
- 4. DK weight yarn YarnArt Jeans (01) white
- 5. DK weight yarn YarnArt Jeans (03) milk
- 6. DK weight yarn YarnArt Jeans brown (40) or black (53) if you crochet the nose instead of the ready nose.
- 7. Safety eyes D=10 mm.
- 8. Safety nose D= 22mm*14mm.
- 9. Stuffing material (fiberfill/polyester)
- 10. 2.0 mm crochet hook
- 11. Thin cotton thread for the muzzle design
- 12. Tapestry needle
- 13. Scissors
- 14. Two small buttons
- 15. White felt under the eyes

Abbreviations (US):

MR - magic ring

Ch - chain

Sc - single crochet

Inc - increase (make 2 single crochet in 1 stitch)

Dec - decrease (make 2 single crochet together)

DC - double crochet

HDC - half double crochet

BLO/FLO - back/front loops only

SI st - slip stitch

(...) - The number of stitches in the round

Head:

Crochet with brown yarn:

Chain 10 and start crocheting in the second chain from hook:

- 1. inc, 7sc, 4sc in one stitch, continue crocheting on the other side of the chain foundation: 7sc, inc (22)
- 2. 2inc, 7sc, 4inc, 7sc, 2inc (30)
- 3. (1sc,inc)*2, 7sc, (1sc,inc)*4, 7sc, (1sc,inc)*2 (38)
- 4. (2sc,inc)*2, 7sc, (2sc,inc)*4, 7sc, (2sc,inc)*2 (46)
- 5. (3sc,inc)*2, 7sc, (3sc,inc)*4, 7sc, (3sc,inc)*2 (54)
- 6. 4sc, inc, (8sc,inc)*5, 4sc (60)
- 7. 60sc
- 8. (9sc,inc)*6 (66)
- 9-15. 66sc (7 rounds)
- 16. (9sc,dec)*6 (60)
- 17-19. 60sc (3 rounds)

If you use safety eyes then install them between rounds 19 and 20. The distance between rounds is 11-12 sc. Previously, glue the whites (made from felt) to the eyes.

- 20. 4sc, dec, (8sc, dec)*5, 4sc (54)
- 21-23. 54sc (3 rounds)
- 24. (7sc,dec)*6 (48)
- 25-28. 48sc (4 rounds)
- 29. 3sc, dec, (6sc, dec)*5, 3sc (42)

Start stuffing the part with fiberfill.

- 30. (5sc,dec)*6 (36)
- 31. (4sc,dec)*6 (30)
- 32. (3sc,dec)*6 (24)
- 33. (2sc,dec)*6 (18)
- 34. (1sc,dec)*6 (12)
- 35. 6 dec

Complete stuffing, tighten the hole, cut yarn, and hide the tail.



Designed by Rail

Muzzle:

Crochet with milk color yarn:

Chain 8 and start crocheting in the second chain from hook:

- 1. inc, 5sc, 4sc in one stitch and continue crocheting on the other side of the chain foundation: 5sc, inc (18)
- 2. 2inc, 5sc, 4np, 5sc, 2inc (26)
- 3. (1sc,inc)*2, 5sc, (1sc,inc)*4, 5sc, (1sc,inc)*2 (34)
- 4. (inc,2sc)*2, 5sc, (inc,2sc)*4, 5sc, (inc,2sc)*2 (42)

5-7. 42sc (3 rounds)

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

Sew the muzzle to the head between rounds 5 and 20.



Stuff with fiberfill as you sew.







Nose:

If you do not use a ready nose, then crochet it following the pattern below.

Crochet with black or brown yarn (to your taste):

Chain 5 and start crocheting in the second chain from hook:

- 1. inc, 2sc, 4sc in one stitch and continue crocheting on the other side of the chain foundation: 2sc,inc (12)
- 2. 1sc, inc, 2sc, (1sc,inc)*2, 3sc, inc (16)
- 3. 16sc

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Skip one row from the edge and sew in the center of the muzzle. Stuff the nose as you sew.

Ears:

Crochet with brown yarn:

- 1. 6sc into MR
- 2. 6inc (12)
- 3. (1sc,inc)*6 (18)
- 4. (2sc,inc)*6 (24)

5-6. 24sc

7. (2dec,8sc)*2 (20) + 1 sc (shift stitch)

Do not stuff the ears.

Flatten together and crochet 10 sc through both loops. Leave a long yarn tail for sewing. Crochet the second ear similarly.

Skip 6-7 rounds from the last round to the right and left. Sew the ears at an angle.





Arms:

Start crocheting with milk color yarn:

Stuff the arm up to round 25.

- 1. 6sc into MR
- 2. 6inc (12)
- 3. 2sc, 2inc, 4sc, 2inc, 2sc (16)
- 4-5, 16sc
- 6. 3sc, dec, 6sc, dec, 3sc (14)

Change to brown yarn:

- 7. 14 sl st
- 8. Crochet through back loops of rounds 7 and 6: 14sc
- 9-29. 14sc (21 rounds)
- 30. 13sc (decreases of the 6^{th} round must be on the sides do not complete 1sc).

Flatten together and crochet 7 sc through both loops across. Fasten off, cutyarn, and hide the tail inside. Crochet the second arm similarly. We will crochet the arms into the body later.







Legs, body:

Start crocheting with brown yarn:

- 1. 8sc into MR
- 2. 8inc (16)
- 3. (1sc,inc)*8 (24)
- 4. BLO: 24sc
- 5-7. 24sc (3 rounds)

Change to light green yarn:

- 8. 24 sl st
- 9. Crochet through back loops of rounds 8 and 7 at once: 24sc

10-13. 24sc (4 rounds)

Cut yarn on the first leg and secure it. Crochet the second leg similarly. DO NOT cut yarn on the second leg. Chain 6 and attach the first leg:

14. 24sc to the first leg, 6sc to the chain, 24sc to the second leg, 6sc on the other side of the chain. (60)

15. (9sc, inc)*6 (66)

16. (10sc, inc)*6 (72)

17-22. 72sc (6 rounds)

23. (10sc,dec)*6 (66)

24-25.66sc

26. (9sc,dec)*6 (60)

27.60sc

Change to brown yarn. Pull the light green yarn to the right side of the part (we will crochet the border of the pants with it):

28. BLO: 60sc

29. (8sc,dec)*6 (54)

30-33. 54sc (4 rounds)

34. (7sc,dec)*6 (48)

35-38. 48sc (4 rounds)

Stuff with fiberfill.

39. (6sc,dec)*6 (42)

40-42. 42sc (3 rounds)

43. (5sc,dec)*6 (36)

Adjust the marker to the middle of the backside.

44. 6sc, attach the left arm and crochet 7sc, 10sc, attach the right arm and crochet 7sc, 6sc (36)

45. (4sc,dec)*6 (30)

46-47, 30sc

Complete stuffing with fiberfill.

Leave a long yarn tail for sewing the head. Cut yarn.







Crochet around the pants:

Return to the front loops of round 27. Chain 46 and start crocheting in the 8th stitch from hook 39 sl st, continue crocheting 54 sc around the body, chain 46 and start crocheting in the 8th stitch from hook 39 sl st, continue crocheting to the end of the row (until you reach the first strap), closing into the circle. Cut yarn and hide the tail inside.





Sew 2 buttons:

Move three rows from the border of the pants downward. Sew the buttons. The distance between the buttons is about 14-15 sc.



Tail:

Crochet with brown yarn:

- 1. 6sc into MR
- 2. 6inc (12)
- 3. (1sc,inc)*6 (18)
- 4. 18sc
- 5. (1sc,dec)*6 (12)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Stuff with fiberfill. Skip 4 rows from the pants and sew the tail in the middle.



Assembly:

- 1. Embroider the eyebrows with thin cotton yarn.
- 2. Embroider the vertical line from the nose to the second to last row of the muzzle.



Cap:

Petals:

Crochet with white yarn:

Chain 59 and start crocheting in the second chain from hook:

- 2sc, chain 12, start crocheting in the second chain from hook, 11sc, 3sc to
 the chain, chain 12, start crocheting in the second chain from hook 11sc,
 continue crocheting 19 petals, crochet 3 sc at the end of the row and
 turn.
- 2. Chain 1, (2sc,5sc,5 HDC,5DC in one stitch (in the top of the petal), 5HDC, 5sc) * 19, 2sc, sl st.

Fasten off and cut yarn.











Crochet with yellow yarn:

Chain 60 and start crocheting in the third stitch from hook:

- 1. 58 DC, turn
- 2. Chain 2, 58 DC, turn
- 3. Chain 2, 15 DC, chain 8, skip 8 stitches, 12DC, chain 8, skip 8 stitches, 15 DC
- 4. Chain 2, attach the petals and crochet together.
- 5-11. Chain 2, 58 DC (7 rounds)



Fold in half (the petals on the wrong side) and crochet 29 sc through both loops. Fasten off and cut yarn.

Turn inside out.



Crochet the tie:

With yellow yarn:

Chain 100-130, cut yarn, and secure it.

Pull the tie along the bottom of the cap in a zigzag.
