

#### About this pattern


The doll is crocheted in continuous spirals without joining the rounds. You can use a scrap of contrasting yarn instead of the stitch marker.

About 18cm/7cm -Applicable if the recommended thread and needle are used. (Finished size may vary by individual)



## How to make eyeholes


- 1.Put a thread on the needle (about 30cm)
- 2.Pass the needle in the following sequence:

A(in)-B(out)-2(in)-1(out)-Repeat one more time.

- 3. Pull threads to make eyeholes and tie them tightly.
- 4. Put in the 9mm black safety eyes in the eyehole . It doesn't come off easily even without washer
- \* or you can use sew on eyes,

A-B-sew on eyes-2-1-sew on eyes-A-B-2-1










How to embroider Mouth: Pass the needle in the following sequence 1(in)-2(out)-3(in)-4(out)-4(ln)-5(out)-5(in)-1(out)
\*Divide the thread into strands and use only one line



## Legs

- 1) Blue, MR6 (6)
- 2) (inc)\*6 (12)
- 3) (sc, inc)\*6 (18)
- 4-5) sc18 (18)
- 6) (sc5, inc)\*3 (21)
- 7) sc21 (21)
- 8) Charcoal, (sc1, sc1-under the sc from the previous row)\*10, sc (21)
- 9) sc21 (21)
- \* When you finish the first leg, cut the yarn with 20cm yarn tail for sewing the hole between the legs later. When you finish the second leg, DO NOT fasten off or cut the yarn.







# **Body**

Charcoal, continue with 2nd leg make ch3,

1) sc21 (1st leg), sc3(ch3), sc21(2nd leg), sc3(ch3) (48)

Move the marker here and Pull out the yarn tail of the first leg.


