Materials

Yarns: barbie wool (wool 85% Acrylic 15%) 45g per skein, thcikness -2.00mm

[Korean Brand Yarn] #3 Light worsted, Crochet Hook: 3.00mm

You need 84 grams of grey melange [no.57], 7 grams of black [no. 01]

to make one big doll. Safety eyes: 12mm

picaso cotton (Cotton 50% Acrylic 50%) 30g per skein, thcikness -1.00mm

[Korean Brand Yarn] #2 Fine, Crochet Hook: 2.00mm

You need 28 grams of charcoal gray [no.25], 5 grams of black [no.50]

to make one small doll. Safety eyes: 10mm

You will need a small amount of white and coral yarn for the tooth and cheek stitches. Tapestry needle, Scissors, fiberfill.

Crochet Abbreviations

MR - Make an adjustable ring

St - Stitch Ch - Chain

SI st - slip stitch Sc - Single crochet

Hdc - Half double crochet, Dc - Double crochet

Rnds - Rounds , Sk - skip, Tc - Triple[treble] crochet

inc - increase (2 sc in 1 st) dec - Decrease

BLO- Back loop only FLO-Front loop only

About this pattern

The yarn used to make this doll is made in Korea, so it may be difficult to purchase overseas. You can select yarn by referring to the composition and thickness of the yarn.

Finished size

About 10cm, 15cm -Applicable if the recommended yarn and needle are used. (Finished size may vary by individual)

This doll is crocheted from the bottom of the body and ends at the top of the head.

Body

Rnd 1: MR8 (8)

Rnd 2: (inc)*8 (16)

Rnd 3: (sc, inc) *8 (24)

Rnd 4: (sc3, inc)*6 (30)

Rnd 5: sc2, inc, (sc4, inc)*5, sc2 (36)

Rnd 6-10: sc36 (36)

Rnd 11: sc2, dec1,(sc4, dec1)*5, sc2 (30)

Rnd 12-14: sc30 (30)

Rnd 15: (sc3, dec1)*6 (24)

Rnd 16: sc1, dec1, (sc2, dec1)*5, sc1 (18)

Head

Rnd 17: sc18 (18)

Rnd 18: sc1, inc, (sc2, inc) *5, sc1 (24)

Rnd 19: (sc3, inc)*6 (30)

Rnd 20: sc2, inc1, (sc4, inc1)*5, sc2 (36)

Rnd 21: (sc5, inc1)*6 (42)

Rnd 22: sc3, inc1, (sc6, inc1)*5, sc3 (48)

Rnd 23: (sc7, inc1)*6 (54)

Rnd 24: sc4, inc1, (sc8, inc1)*5, sc4 (60)

Rnd 25-36: sc60 (60)

Stuff the body with fiberfill.

Now, insert the safety eyes, embroider the mouth and teeth, and proceed to the next round.







Eyes: between Rnd 28-29 [23rd sc, 34th sc]

Mouth: between Rnd 27-28 [27th sc, 31st sc]

between Rnd 26-27 [28th sc, 30th sc]

In the photo, the gap between the eyes is 13 stitches, but 10 stitches are correct.



Pass the needle in the following sequence: 1(out), 2(in), 3(out), 2(in), 4(out), and 3(in). After embroidering the mouth, finish by tying the thread inside the head.



Then, embroider the teeth using a single strand of white yarn. From inside the head, 1(out), 2(in), 3(out), and 1(in).

Rnd 37: sc4, dec1, (sc8, dec1)*5, sc4 (54)

Rnd 38: (sc7, dec1)*6 (48)

Rnd 39: sc3, dec1, (sc6, dec1)*5, sc3 (42)

Rnd 40: (sc5, dec1)*6 (36)

Rnd 41: sc2, dec1, (sc4, dec1)*5, sc2 (30)

Rnd 42: (sc3, dec1)*6 (24)

Rnd 43: (sc1, dec1)*8 (16)

Rnd 44: (dec)*8 (8) Cut the yarn.



Stuff the Head with fiberfill.



How to indent eyes

- 1. Put double threads on the needle (about 30cm)
- 2. Pass the needle in the following sequence:

 A(in)-1(out)-2(in)-A(out)-B(in)-3(out)-4(in)-B(out)
- 3. Pull threads to make eye indents and tie them tightly.
- 4. Using a needle, sew the last round hole closed by going through the **front loop only 4~5 stitches** and pull tightly to close the hole.
- 5. Use coral thread to embroider under the eyes.





Ears

Please make four pieces. A ear is completed by connecting the two pieces together.

Row 1: MR3, ch1, turn (3)

Row 2: inc1, sc1, inc1, ch1, turn (5)

Row 3: inc1, sc3, inc1, ch1, turn (7)

Row 4: inc1, sc5, inc1, ch1, turn (9)

Row 5: sc9, ch1, turn (9)

Row 6: inc1, sc7, inc1, ch1, turn (11)

Row 7: sc11, ch1, turn (11)

Row 8: inc1, sc9, inc1, ch1, turn (13)


Row 9-12: sc13, ch1, turn (13)

Row 13: sc13 (13)

Now, we will single crochet along the edges.

sc2 in the last st of the row 13 [A], sc11 (row12~row2),

(sc1, ch1, sc1) - in the Magic ring, sc11 (row2~row12), sc2 in the first st of the row 13. The first piece cuts the thread, but the second piece does not.









Now, place the two pieces with the wrong sides facing each other and single crochet them together along the edge. However, at the ch1 space, make (sc1, ch1, sc1).












Weave in the yarn tail as shown in the pictures to create a tidy shape.



Ear Placement and Sewing.















I think it's cute to add a stitch on the forehead.:)

Wings

Please make four pieces. A wing is completed by connecting two pieces together.

Row 1: Ch 6, starting from second ch from the hook, sc5, ch 1, turn. (5)

Row 2: Inc2, sc1, inc2, ch 1, turn. (9)

Row 3: Inc2, sc5, inc2, ch 1, turn. (13)

Row 4: Inc1, sc 11, inc1, ch 1, turn. (15)

Row 5-7: sc15, ch 1, turn. (15)

Row 8: sc15. (15)

Now, we will single crochet along the edges.

sc2 in the last st of the row 8, sc6 (row7~row2),







In row 1: skip 1, sc3, skip1,

sc6(row2~row7),

sc2 in the last sc.





Weave in the yarn tail as shown in the pictures to create a tidy shape.










Now, Place the two pieces with the wrong sides facing each other, and use black yarn to single crochet them together along the edge. Start at the middle single crochet (sc3 of row 1): sc10, ([ch3, slip 1, sc1], sc5)*3, (ch3, slip 1, sc1), sc9.

sc10



Sew the wings onto the body between rounds 7 and 13 of the body.



Baby bats are ready to fly
