

Socquette, pretty fox,

Amigurumi crochet by Marina - PenseBonheur



What you need

- A 3 mm hook
- Wools of different colors adapted to your hook
- 9 mm safety eyes
- Black embroidery yarn
- Stuffing
- Embroidery needle

What I used

✧ Ricorumi by Rico Design
Caramel réf. 053 (3 x 25 g), Cream réf. 002 (1 x 25 g), Pink réf. 008 (1 x 25 g), Terracotta réf. 069 (~10 g), Reed réf. 074 (1 x 25 g)

Size

Socquette, the fox, crocheted with the described material measures approximately 38 cm.

Level

Intermediate

Recommandations

You can use the yarn of your choice by adjusting your hook size. Your fox may then have a different final size and you may have to adapt the eyes size.

Abbreviations

MC = magic circle
Ch = chain
st = stitch
sc = single crochet
slst = slip stitch
inc = increase
dec = decrease
hdc = half double crochet
DC = double crochet
(..) = repeat instructions
[..] = number of rounds to repeat

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Preliminary note

Unless otherwise stated, always crochet in spiral.

When changing colors, always do it in the final pull through of the last stitch which precedes the color change.

Technical point

> **3 sc together:** insert the hook, successively in the front loop of the 3 stitches that we want to decrease then yarn over loops. Finish the single crochet normally with a yarn over and pull through those front.

> **Spike stitch:** insert your hook in row below you would normally do : it's where you inserted your hook to make the sc of the previous row. Then, complete your stitch normally.

Socks – 3 mm (x 2)

In color 008 (pink)

Make a magic circle

Continue with colour 069 (terracotta)

Continue with color 008 (pink)

From this point we crochet in a row to form the heel of the foot:

| 7 sc (don't turn!) - <i>photo 1</i> | 7 sc |

Continue with colour 069 (terracotta) - *photo 2 and 3*

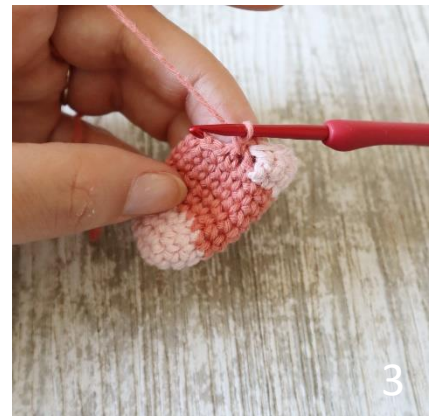
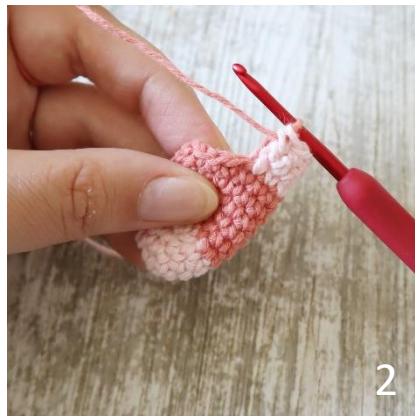

We are now at the starting point of the previous round, we start crocheting spiral - *photo 4*

Start stuffing and stuff as you go.

Break yarn and weave in the end - *photo 6*





Legs – 3 mm (x 2)

In colour 053 (caramel)

Join yarn in the back loop of the first stitch of round 17 of the sock and crochet: - *photo 1*

1-10. 14 sc [x 10 rounds] 14 sc

Stuf

Flatten and close with 7 sc in both layers (crochet 2 sc face to face together) - *photo 2 and 3*

Restart the rounds by continuing to crochet in rounds:

11. 1 ch, 7 sc in the 7 front loop and 7 sc in the
7 back loop to obtain 14 sc - *photo 4 and 5* 14 sc

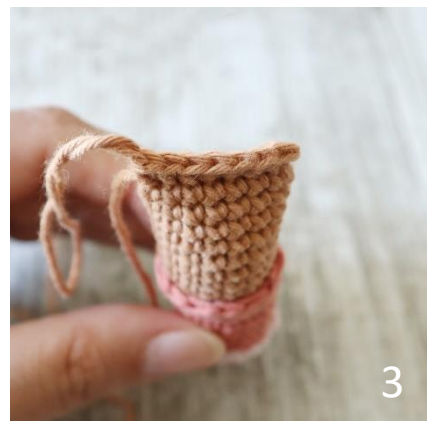
12-29 14 sc [x 18 rounds] 14 sc

Stuf

Make sure to shape the stuffing well so that this second leg part is well aligned with the first.

Flatten and close the first leg with 7 sc (crochet 2 sc face to face together) and break yarn.

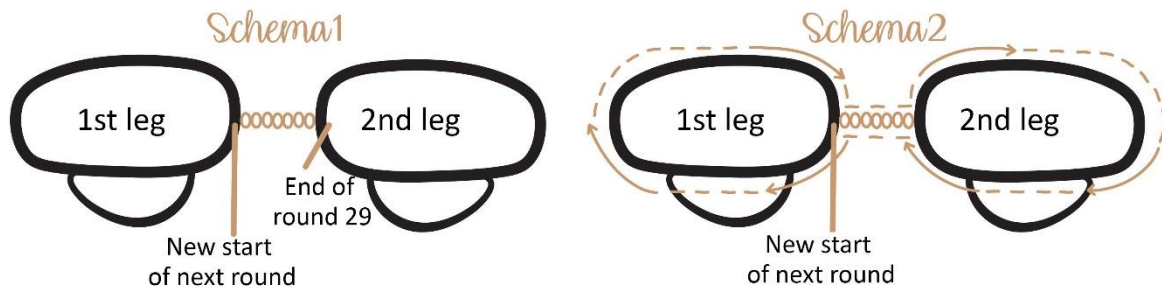
Crochet the second leg identically but do not cut the yarn - *photo 6*



Body – 3 mm

When the 2 legs are finished, place them side by side facing you (leg with the yarn on the right). Assemble the legs by making a ch 7 from the leg to your right that you attach to the leg to your left by 1 slst. This is the beginning of a new round – *photo 1 and 2 (schema 1)*

Crochet 7 sc in the 7 front loop of the leg and 7 sc in the 7 back loop of the same leg, then crochet 7 sc in the chain then crochet 7 sc in the 7 back loop of the other leg and 7 sc in the 7 front loop of the same leg. Finally, crochet again 7 sc in the starting chain = 42 sc (= round 1. of the body) – *photo 3 (schema 2)*

Fasten off and cut. Leave a long tail for sewing – *photo 4*



Arms – 3 mm (x 2)

In colour 002 (cream)

Make a magic circle

1.	6 sc in magic circle	6 sc
2.	6 inc	12 sc
3-4.	12 sc [x 2 rounds]	12 sc
5.	4 DC in the 1st stitch, 11 sc	15 sc
6.	1 sc, 3 sc together, 1 ch, 11 sc	14 sc
7.	14 sc	14 sc
8.	1 sc, 1 dec, 11 sc	13 sc
9.	13 sc	13 sc
10.	13 sc in the front loop	13 sc

Stuff hands only

Continue in colour 053 (caramel)

11.	13 sc in the back loop of the round 9 (do not crochet round 10)	13 sc
12.	1 dec, 11 sc	12 sc
13-30.	12 sc [x 18 rounds]	12 sc

Fasten off and cut. Leave a long tail for sewing.



Head – 3 mm

In colour 053 (caramel)

Make a magic circle

1.	8 sc in magic circle	8 sc
2.	1 inc x 8	16 sc
3.	(1 sc, 1 inc) x 8	24 sc
4.	(3 sc, 1 inc) x 6	30 sc
5.	(4 sc, 1 inc) x 6	36 sc
6.	(5 sc, 1 inc) x 6	42 sc
7.	(6 sc, 1 inc) x 6	48 sc
8.	(7 sc, 1 inc) x 6	54 sc
9.	(8 sc, 1 inc) x 6	60 sc
10-19.	60 sc [x 10 rounds]	60 sc
20.	29 sc, 1 inc, 4 hdc in the next stitch, 1 inc, 28 sc	65 sc

Insert the safety eyes between rounds 19 and 20 with 13 sc visible between the two eyes.- [photo 2](#)

Continue in cream color 002

Start stuffing and then stuff as you go.

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Continue in colour 053 (caramel)

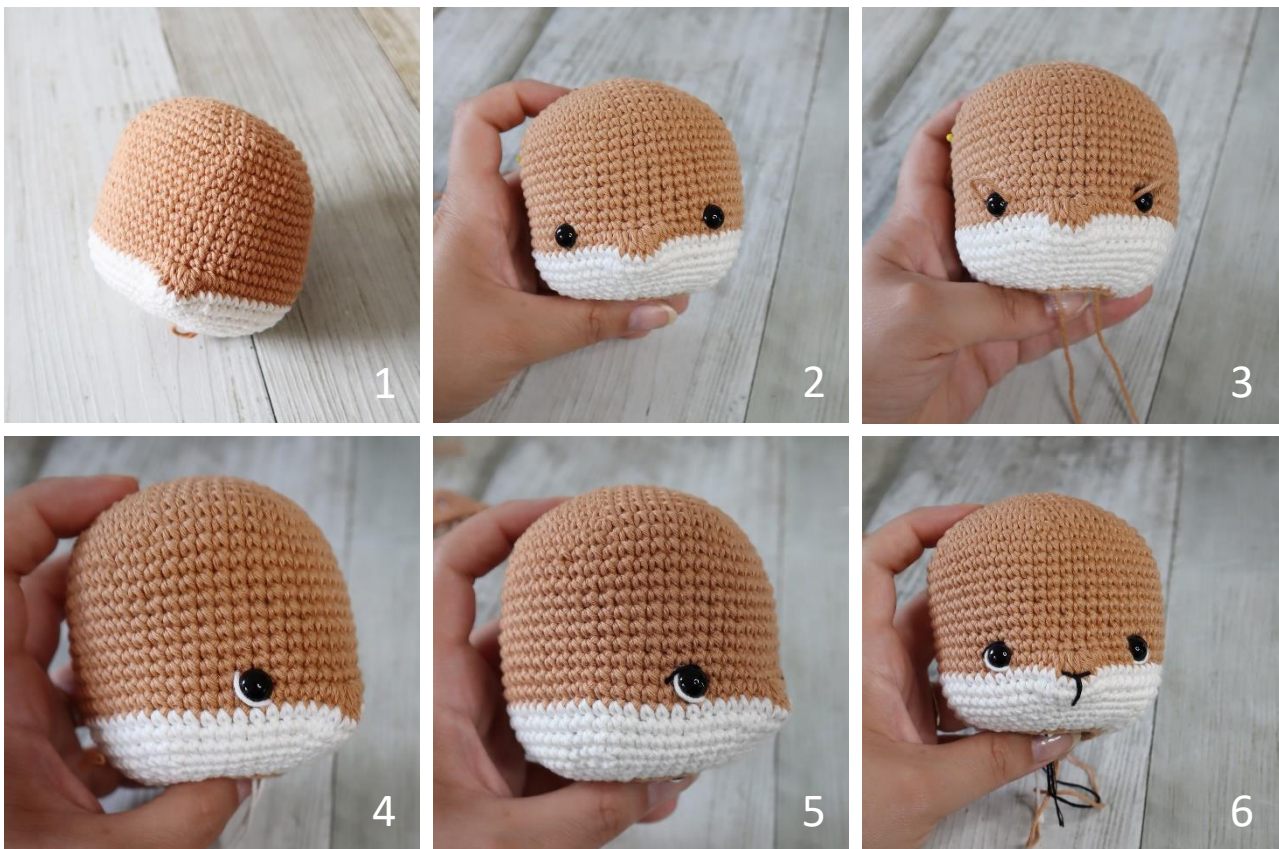
29.	(2 sc, 1 dec) x 6	18 sc
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Stop and break yarn - *photo 1*

Photo 3: Cut a long yarn into color 053 (caramel) then starting from the neck, pass the yarn on each side of the eyes. Then pull it and tie a knot in the neck. You get a slight indent at the eyes.

Photo 4 & 5: Embroider the eye contour with a 002 (cream) yarn on the outer side of each eye and with the black embroidery yarn above each eye.

Photo 6: With the black embroidery yarn, embroider the nose between rounds 20 and 21 centered between the eyes (below the 4 DC made in round 20).



Ears – 3 mm (x 2)

Outer part:

In colour 053 (caramel)

Make a magic circle

Fasten off and cut. Leave a long tail for sewing.

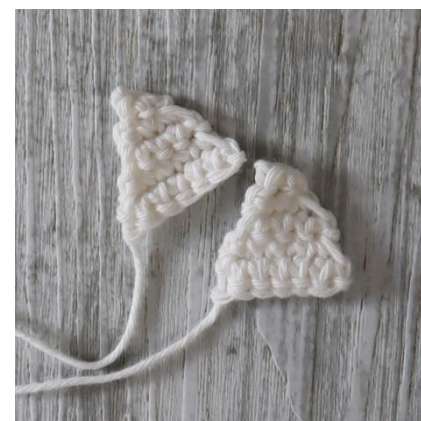
In colour 002 (cream)

Crochet in rows

| 2. | 1 inc + ch 1 to turn | 2 sc |
| 3. | 1 sc, 1 inc + ch 1 to turn | 3 sc |
| 4. | 2 sc, 1 inc + ch 1 to turn | 4 sc |
| 5. | 3 sc, 1 inc | 5 sc |
| 6. | 4 sc, 1 inc | 6 sc |

Fasten off and cut. Leave a long tail for sewing.

With the yarn color 002 (cream), sew the inner parts on the front of the external parts of the ears.



Backpack – 3 mm

In color 008 (pink)

Make a magic circle

- Stop and break yarn *photo 1*

Cord:

In color 002 (cream)

Cut 3 pieces of yarn of 30 cm, make a knot to assemble them, braid them and then pass them through the loops created in round 22 *photo 2 and 3*

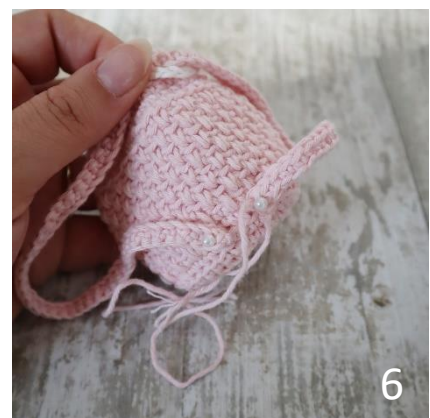
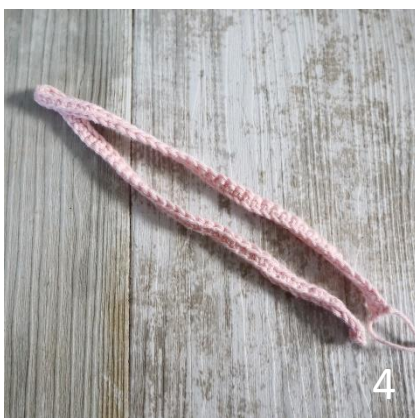
Handle:

In color 008 (pink)

Chain 80 + ch 1 to turn then make 80 sc *photo 4*

Break yarn and then pass the handle through the 2 loops on the back of the bag *photo 5*

Finish by sewing the 2 ends of the handle at the bottom of the back of the bag *photo 6*



Clothing – 3 mm

In color 075 (reed).

Make a chain of 32 ch and crochet in row:

1. 1 ch for turning, 5 sc, 3 ch, skip 1 st, 5 sc, 3 ch, skip 1 st, 8 sc,
3 ch, skip 1 st, 5 sc, 3 ch, skip 1 st, 5 sc 32 m

The 3 ch counts as 1 sc because we will then work in this space.

From the next row, crochet {1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc} always in the space of the 3 ch crochet in the previous row.

2. 1 ch to turn, 5 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc], 5 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc],
8 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc], 5 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc], 5 sc 40 m
3. 1 ch to turn, 6 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc], 7 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc],
10 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc], 7 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc], 6 sc 48 m
4. 1 ch to turn, 7 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc], 9 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc],
12 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc], 9 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc], 7 sc 56 m
5. 1 ch to turn, 8 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc], 11 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc],
14 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc], 11 sc, [1 sc, 3 ch, 1 sc], 8 sc 64 m
6. 1 ch to turn, 9 sc, 1 sc in the space of the 3 ch, 13 sc, 1 sc in the space of the 3 ch,
16 sc, 1 sc in the space of the 3 ch, 13 sc, 1 sc in the space of the 3 ch, 9 sc 72 sc

Photo 1: The following row will form the sleeves:

7. 1 ch to turn, 9 sc, 1 inc, skip 13 st, 1 inc, 16 sc, 1 inc, skip 13 st,
1 inc, 9 sc 42 sc
8. 1 ch, 11 sc, 1 inc, 18 sc, 1 inc, 11 sc 44 sc
9. 1 ch, 11 sc, 1 inc, 20 sc, 1 inc, 11 sc 46 sc
10. 1 ch, 11 sc, 1 inc, 22 sc, 1 inc, 11 sc 48 sc

Finish with a slst in the first st of the row to form a circle.

From the next row and the following rounds, crochet in rounds using DC :

Start each round with 2 ch and close each turn with 1 slst.

11. 2 ch (1 DC, 1 inc.DC) x 24, 1 slst 72 sc
- 12-17. 2 ch, 72 DC, 1 slst [x 6 rounds] 72 sc

>> Stop here if you want to get a dress – photo 2

You can add an extra row of DC if you find the dress too short.

>> Continue the instructions below if you want to get a romper.

The next row will form the first leg of the romper.

Crochet only in the first 36 stitches.

Use a marker ring to make it easier to locate yourself and know where to do the slst.

18. 2 ch, (dec.DC) x 18, 1 slst 18 sc
- 19-21. 18 sc [x 3 rounds] 18 sc

Stop and break yarn

To make the second leg, join a new yarn to the back of the romper and repeat rounds 18 to 21

– photo 3



Assembly

Photo 1 - Sew the ears on each side of the head between round 4 and 11

Photo 2 - Carefully sew the head on the body: the remaining 18 stitches from the head to the 18 stitches of the body. You can add some stuffing to the body during this step, especially in the neck

Photo 3 - Sew the arms on each side of the body between rounds 26 and 27, do not hesitate to adjust the placement of the arms by trying the clothing on your fox before



Hooray, you're done!

All you have to do is put on her clothing and backpack on your *Socquette* !
