



Crochet bat pattern

MATERIALS:

- 1. Stuffing materials (I use hollow fiber);
- 2. Scissors;
- 3. Crochet hook (I use 2mm size, size B to USA classification. If you crochet with other types of yarn, choose the size of crochet hook suitable for yarn's thickness);
- 4. Plastic eyes on the secure mount (10mm/0,39inches size) 2 pieces;
- 5. Needles for sewing (blunt end, metal or plastic) and for pinning details;
- 6. Yarn for embroidery nostrils, eyebrows and mouth. I use Yarn Art Iris (100% cotton; 151yards/138m; 0,70z/20g) color 935 black. You can use other yarn of suitable thickness or yarn for embroidery);
- 7. Yarns (Yarn Weight: A (24-26 stitches), 5 ply, Sport, Fine, 12 wpi). I use:
- Alize Cotton Gold Tweed (57% cotton + 40% acrylic + 3% polyester; 361 yards/330m; 3,530z/100g) color 616 purple (main yarn, for head, ears, body and wings). I use 35-50g (1,2-1,760z);
- Yarn Art Jeans (55% cotton + 45% acrylic; 175yards/160m; 1,760z/50g) color 36 pink (for nose) and 74 light pink (for ears);
- Alize Cotton Gold (55% cotton + 45% acrylic; 361yards/330m; 3,530z/100g) color 55 white (for eyes);
- Alize Softy (100% micropolyester; 126yards/115m; 1,760z/50g) color 185 light pink (for breast).

You can fantasize and choose other yarn's colors.

You can also use other types of yarn (similar in thickness and materials to the ones I used, or other types). If you use other materials, the size and appearance of the finished toy may differ from the photos in this pattern.



The following yarns can be used (they are similar in thickness to the ones I used):

- Gazzal Baby Cotton (60% cotton + 40% acrylic; 175yards/165m; 1,760z/50g);
- YarnArt Baby Cotton (60% cotton + 40% acrylic; 142,1yards/130m; 1,760z/50g);
- Kartopu Amigurumi Yarn (49% cotton + 51% acrylic; 175yards/165m; 1,76oz/50g);
- DROPS Safran Cotton Yarn (100% Cotton; 175yards/160m; 1,80z/50g);
- Knit Picks Comfy Sport (75% cotton + 25% acrylic; 136yards/124m; 1,76oz/50g).

<u>ABBREVIATIONS</u> (USA terminology):

RA - amigurumi ring / magic ring ch - chain sc - single crochet inc - increase (2sc in 1 stitch) dec - decrease (make sc from 2 stitches) dc - double crochet hdc - half double crochet P - picot (make chain 3 and then crochet sl in the first stitch of the chain) (...)*x - repeat x times sl - slip stitch BLO - back loop only FLO - front loop only (x) - total stitches in round / row x. - number of a round / row





Toy's size ~ 7,1inches/18cm using the materials described.

Work in the continuous spiral and turning rows.



<u>EYES</u>

Crochet with white yarn in the continuous spiral. <u>IMPORTANT</u>: the toy has symmetrical left and right parts (eyes, ears and wings). The left and right side of the toy, not left and right from our side (by generally accepted standards). For convenience and better understanding, photos are signed.

<u>Right eye</u>

1. 6sc in the RA (6) 2. (2inc, sc)*2 (10) (photo 1) 3. sc, 3inc, sc, 4inc, sc (17) (photo 2) 4. 2sc, 3inc, 5sc, inc, 2hdc in the 1 stitch, hdc, inc, 3sc (23) (photo 3) 5. 3sc, inc, 2sc, inc, sc, inc, 6sc, (2hdc in the 1 stitch)*2, hdc, 3sc, 2sl (28) + 3sl (photo 4)

<u>Left eye</u>

1. 6sc in the RA (6) 2. (2inc, sc)*2 (10) 3. sc, 3inc, sc, 4inc, sc (17) 4. 2sc, 3inc, 5sc, 2inc, hdc, 2hdc in the 1 stitch, 3sc (23) 5. 3sc, inc, 2sc, inc, sc, inc, 7sc, hdc, (2hdc in the 1 stitch)*2, 3sc, sl (28) + 3sl (photo 5)


Cut off the yarn from both details and leave tails 50cm/19,7inches for sewing (photo 6).

Note that hdc increases in the 5th rounds form small bumps on the ovals (see photo 6, 8, they are circled). They should be located on the inside of the eyes, "looking" at each other.

Insert plastic eyes into the white eyes between 3rd and 4th rounds as shown on the photos 7-8.


Don't cap plastic eyes.










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

<u>HEAD</u> Crochet with purple yarn in the continuous spiral, stuff when it's written in the pattern.

- 1. 6sc in the RA (6)
- 2. 6inc (12)
- 3. (sc, inc)*6 (18)
- 4. (2sc, inc)*6 (24)
- 5. (3sc, inc)*6 (30)
- 6. (4sc, inc)*6 (36)
- 7. 36sc (36)
- 8. (5sc, inc)*6 (42)
- 9-10. 42sc (42)
- 11. (6sc, inc)*6 (48)
- 12-13. 48sc (48)
- 14. (7sc, inc)*6 (54)
- 15.54sc (54)
- 16. (8sc, inc)*6 (60)
- 17.60sc (60)
- 18. (8sc, dec)*6 (54)
- 19. (7sc, dec)*6 (48)
- 20. (6sc, dec)*6 (42) (photo 9)

Take white eyes with plastic eyes inside. Insert the plastic eyes into the head between 15th and 16th rounds. The distance between the places of their insertion is 7sc (see the photos 10-11).

Fasten tightly inside the eyes with caps (photo 12).

White eyes should be located on the 8-17th rounds of the head (photos 11, 19).

The distance between the eyes in the middle part is sc, in the upper and lower parts - 2-3sc (photos 13-14).

- 21. (5sc, dec)*6 (36) 22. (4sc, dec)*6 (30)
- 22. (+30, 000) = 0 (50)
- Start filling the head (photo 15).
- 23. (3sc, dec)*6 (24)
- 24. (2sc, dec)*6 (18)
- 25. (sc, dec)*6 (12)
- Stuff tightly the head.
- Put the opening closed (photos 15-17).

Cut off the thread, leave tail 30cm/11,8inches for sewing (photo 18).







Sew the eyes in a circle on the 8-17th rounds (photos 19-20). I'm using the sewing method shown in the next video <u>https://youtu.be/RNEosnQ-YF0</u> (copy link and paste in the https input line).







Embroider the eyebrows with a thin black yarn on the head on the 6-9th rounds above the eyes (photos 21-24). The length of the eyebrows is 3,5sc diagonally.

Hide all yarn's tails inside the head.











<u>NOSE</u> Crochet with pink yarn in the continuous spiral, don't stuff.

1. make chain 5 (5) (photo 25)

2. from the 2nd stitch from the hook: inc, 2sc, 3sc in the 1 stitch (photo 26), on the other side of the chain: 2sc, inc (11) (photo 27) 3. 11sc (11) + 2sl (photo 28)


Cut off the yarn and leave tail 20cm/7,9inches for sewing.


Sew nose to the center of the head on the 17-18 rounds between the eyes (photos 29-30).

Embroider the nostrils on the nose with thin black yarn. The distance between the nostrils is 2sc (photo 31).

Embroider the mouth with thin black yarn from the middle of the nose down 3 rounds (photo 32).

Hide all yarn's tails inside the head (photo 33).







<u>EARS</u> Crochet 4 details: 2 with light pink yarn, 2 with purple yarn. Crochet in turning rows.

First, crochet 2 pink details, then 1 purple, assemble one ear, and only then crochet the second purple detail and assemble the second ear.

- 1. 4sc in the RA, ch (4)
- 2. turn crocheting and crochet: 3sc, inc, ch (5)
- 3. turn: inc, 3sc, inc, ch (7)
- 4. turn: inc, 5sc, inc, ch (9)
- 5. turn: 3sc in the 1 stitch, 7sc, inc, ch (12)
- 6. turn: inc, 10sc, inc, ch (14)
- 7. turn: inc, 12sc, inc, ch (16)
- 8. turn: inc, 14sc, inc (18)

Cut off the yarn from the pink detail and leave tail 30cm/11,8inches for sewing (photo 34).


Don't cut off the yarn from the purple detail. Put together details (1 purple and 1 pink) as shown on the photo 35.

Crochet them together with purple yarn (the direction of crocheting is shown on the photo 35) as shown on the photos 36-37 - for left ear, 38-39 - for right ear:

ch, 2sc, 2hdc, hdc + dc in the 1 stitch, dc, 2dc in the 1 stitch, dc (10).

Cut off the yarn and leave tail 30cm/11,8inches for sewing (photos 40-41).








Sew the outer edges of the ears with pink tail (photos 42-44). Hide all yarn's tails in the ears (except the purple tail, which was left after crocheting). Sew ears on the sides of the head on the 4-14 rounds with purple tail (photos 45-46). Distance from ears to eyes is 5sc.



<u>BODY</u> Crochet with purple yarn, from top to bottom. Crochet in the continuous spiral, stuff as you go.

1. 6sc in the RA (6) 2. 6inc (12) 3. (sc, inc)*6 (18) 4. (2sc, inc)*6 (24) 5. (3sc, inc)*6 (30) 6. (4sc, inc)*6 (36) 7.36sc (36) 8. (5sc, inc)*6 (42) 9-17 (9 rounds), 42sc (42) 18. (5sc. dec)*6 (36) 19-22 (4 rounds). 36sc (36) 23. (4sc. dec)*6 (30) 24-26 (3 rounds). 30sc (30) 27. (3sc, dec)*6 (24) 28-29, 24sc (24) 30. (2sc. dec)*6 (18) 31, 18sc (18) 32. (sc. dec)*6 (12) Put the opening closed. Cut off the thread and hide it in the body (photo 34).





<u>BREAST</u>

Crochet with fluffy pink yarn, in the continuous spiral, don't stuff.

1. 6sc in the RA (6)

(or make chain 3, crochet from the 2nd stitch from the hook: 2inc, on the other side of the chain: inc (6). This is the easer method to make RA with fluffy yarn)

- 2. 6inc (12)
- 3. (sc, inc)*6 (18)
- 4. (2sc, inc)*6 (24)
- 5. (3sc, inc)*6 (30)
- + 3sl (photo 35)

Cut off the thread, leave a tail 40-50cm / 15,8-19,7inches for sewing.

Sew breast to the body on the 6-17 rounds (photos 36-37).

Sew head to the body (photo 38). Hide all treads in the body.



<u>WINGS</u>


Crochet with purple yarn in the turning rows.


I recommend marking each crocheted row or using the row counter in wing crocheting.

RIGHT WING

Please note: if FLO / BLO is written at the beginning of the row, then crochet the whole row FLO / BLO.

- 1. make chain 27 (27)
- 2. from the 2nd stitch from the hook: 26sc, ch (26)
- 3. turn crocheting and crochet: 19sc, 7hdc, ch (26) (photo 39)
- 4. turn, skip 1 stitch, FLO: 25sc, ch (25)
- 5. turn, BLO: 18sc, 7hdc, ch (25) (photo 40)
- 6. turn, FLO: 25sc, ch (25)
- 7. turn, BLO: 18sc, 7hdc, ch (25) (photo 41)
- 8. turn, FLO: inc, 24sc, ch (26)
- 9. turn, BLO: 18sc, 7hdc, 2hdc in the 1 stitch, P (27, pico loops don't count) (photos 42-45)
- 10. turn, FLO: 8hdc, 18sc, inc, ch (28) (photos 46-47)
- 11. turn, BLO: 5sl, 7sc, 8hdc, 6dc, skip 1 stitch, dc, 2ch (27) (photo 48)
- 12. turn, skip 1 stitch, FLO: 6dc, 7hdc, 6sc, 7sl, ch (26)
- 13. turn, BLO: 7sl, 6sc, 7hdc, 4dc, skip 1 stitch, dc, 2ch (25) (photo 49)
- 14. turn, FLO: 2dc in the 1 stitch, 4dc, 7hdc, 5sc, 8sl, ch (26)
- 15. turn, BLO: 8sl, 5sc, 7hdc, 5dc, 2dc in the 1 stitch, <u>P</u> (27) (photo 50)
- 16. turn, FLO: 7dc, 7hdc, 5sc, 8sl, ch (27)
- 17. turn, skip 1 stitch, BLO: 7sl, 5sc, 7hdc, 5dc, skip 1 stitch, dc, 2ch (25) (photo 51)
- 18. turn, skip 1 stitch, FLO: 5dc, 7hdc, 5sc, 5sl, skip 1 stitch, sl, ch (23)
- 19. turn, skip 1 stitch, BLO: 6sl, 5sc, 5hdc, 6dc, 2ch (22) (photo 52)
- 20. turn, FLO: 2dc in the 1 stitch, 5dc, 5hdc, 5sc, 4sl, skip 1 stitch, sl, ch (22)
- 21. turn, skip 1 stitch, BLO: 6sl, 3sc, 5hdc, 6dc, 2dc in the 1 stitch, P (22) (photo 53)
- 22. turn, FLO: 8dc, 5hdc, 3sc, 4sl, skip 1 stitch, sl (21) (photo 54)
- Don't cut off the yarn and crochet as shown on the photo 55:
- 23. 3sc, <u>P</u>, 13sc (16).
- Cut off the yarn, leave the tail 40cm/15,7inches for sewing (photo 56).








<u>LEFT WING</u>

The pattern for the left wing is the same as for the right, only the alternation of rows crocheted BLO/FLO is different. For convenience, the left wing crocheting pattern is also given below.

- 1. make chain 27 (27)
- 2. from the 2nd stitch from the hook: 26sc, ch (26)
- 3. turn, 19sc, 7hdc, ch (26)
- 4. turn, skip 1 stitch, BLO: 25sc, ch (25)
- 5. turn, FLO: 18sc, 7hdc, ch (25)
- 6. turn, BLO: 25sc, ch (25)
- 7. turn, FLO: 18sc, 7hdc, ch (25)
- 8. turn, BLO: inc, 24sc, ch (26)
- 9. turn, FLO: 18sc, 7hdc, 2hdc in the 1 stitch, P (27)
- 10. turn, BLO: 8hdc, 18sc, inc, ch (28)
- 11. turn, FLO: 5sl, 7sc, 8hdc, 6dc, skip 1 stitch, dc, 2ch (27)
- 12. turn, skip 1 stitch, BLO: 6dc, 7hdc, 6sc, 7sl, ch (26)
- 13. turn, FLO: 7sl, 6sc, 7hdc, 4dc, skip 1 stitch, dc, 2ch (25)
- 14. turn, BLO: 2dc in the 1 stitch, 4dc, 7hdc, 5sc, 8sl, ch (26)
- 15. turn, FLO: 8sl, 5sc, 7hdc, 5dc, 2dc in the 1 stitch, <u>P</u> (27)
- 16. turn, BLO: 7dc, 7hdc, 5sc, 8sl, ch (27)
- 17. turn, skip 1 stitch, FLO: 7sl, 5sc, 7hdc, 5dc, skip 1 stitch, dc, 2ch (25)
- 18. turn, skip 1 stitch, BLO: 5dc, 7hdc, 5sc, 5sl, skip 1 stitch, sl, ch (23)
- 19. turn, skip 1 stitch, FLO: 6sl, 5sc, 5hdc, 6dc, 2ch (22)
- 20. turn, BLO: 2dc in the 1 stitch, 5dc, 5hdc, 5sc, 4sl, skip 1 stitch, sl, ch (22)
- 21. turn, skip 1 stitch, FLO: 6sl, 3sc, 5hdc, 6dc, 2dc in the 1 stitch, P (22)
- 22. turn: BLO: 8dc, 5hdc, 3sc, 4sl, skip 1 stitch, sl (21)
- Don't cut off the yarn and crochet:
- 23. 3sc, <u>P</u>, 13sc (16).

Cut off the yarn, leave the tail 40cm/15,7inches for sewing (photo 56).



Sew wings to the sides of the body on the 6-31 rounds. Distance to the breast is 9-10sc (photos 57-63). Make sure that the wings completely wrap around the bat and lie comfortably without kinks (photos 57-59). Hide all treads in the body.
