## MATERIALS AND TOOLS

### 1. Yarn

- Alize Cotton Gold (55% cotton/45% acrylic, 100g/330m) of light beige (67), blue (279), mustard (02), red (56) and green (193) colors
- Alize Cotton Gold Tweed (55% cotton/45% acrylic, 100g/330m) of white (55) color
- Yarn Art Jeans (55% cotton/45% acrylic, 50g/160m) of white (62) and terracotta (85) colors

2. The hook Clover No 1.75 (1.75 mm) and 2 (2.00 mm) for the overall

3. Stuffing (hollofayber)

4. Eyes with stalks d=10 mm and black halfbeads d=5 mm for the frog

5. Glue

6. Wire d=2.5 mm

7. Adhesive plaster for wire insulation

8. Plastic buttons for decoration of the overall

9. Dry pastel of pink color

10. A thick needle for sewing of the details

11. Scissors

## ABBREVIATIONS

MR – magic ring

ch – chain

sl st - slip stitch

sc – single crochet

hdc – half double crochet

inc – increase (crochet two sc in 1 stitch)

dec – decrease (crochet two sc together)

bk lp – back loop

fr lp – front loop

(...) – the number in brackets indicates the number of stitches in a row

Crochet in a spiral without sl st. At the beginning of the row use a marker or thread of different color, which help mark the first loop of each new row.

The finished toy is 22 cm = 8,7”.

## HEAD

Crochet with the light beige (further main) color, stuff tightly in the course of crocheting.

1 rnd: 6 sc in MR

2 rnd: 6 inc (12)

3 rnd: (1 sc, inc)\*6 (18)

4 rnd: 1 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc)\*5, 1 sc (24)

5 rnd: (3 sc, inc)\*6 (30)

6 rnd: 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc)\*5, 2 sc (36)

7 rnd: (5 sc, inc)\*6 (42)

8 rnd: 3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc)\*5, 3 sc (48)

9 rnd: 48 sc

10 rnd: (7 sc, inc)\*6 (54)

11-14 rnd: 54 sc (4 rows)

15 rnd: 4 sc, inc, (8 sc, inc)\*5, 4 sc (60)

16 rnd: (9 sc, inc)\*6 (66)

17-21 rnd: 66 sc (5 rows)

If you want to insert the eyes with stalks, it's time to insert them. I recommend to insert the eyes between 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> rows, the space between them is 12 sc.

22 rnd: (9 sc, dec)\*6 (60)

23 rnd: 4 sc, dec, (8 sc, dec)\*5, 4 sc (54)

24 rnd: (7 sc, dec)\*6 (48)

25 rnd: 3 sc, dec, (6 sc, dec)\*5, 3 sc (42)

26 rnd: (5 sc, dec)\*6 (36)

27 rnd: 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec)\*5, 2 sc (30)

28 rnd: (3 sc, dec)\*6 (24)

29 rnd: 1 sc, dec, (2 sc, dec)\*5, 1 sc (18)

Cut the thread, fasten off, hide the end (photo 1, 2).

## BEAK

Crochet with the terracotta thread. Make chain 4 ch, insert the hook in the 2<sup>nd</sup> loop from the hook and crochet in a spiral:

1 rnd: inc, 1 sc, 4 sc in the last loop of the chain, further crochet on the other side of the chain 1 sc, inc (10)

2 rnd: inc, 3 sc, 2 inc, 3 sc, inc (14)

3 rnd: inc, 5 sc, 2 inc, 5 sc, inc (18)

4 rnd: 18 sc

Cut the thread, leaving a long end for sewing (photo 3).





## LEGS (2 details)

Crochet the foot with the terracotta thread, stuff tightly in the course of crocheting. Make chain 6 ch and start to crochet with the 2<sup>nd</sup> loop from the hook.

1 rnd: 4 sc, 3 sc in the last loop of the chain, further crochet on the other side of the chain 3 sc, inc (12)

2 rnd: inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 3 sc, 2 inc (18)

3-6 rnd: 18 sc (4 rows)

7 rnd: 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec)\*2, 2 sc (15)

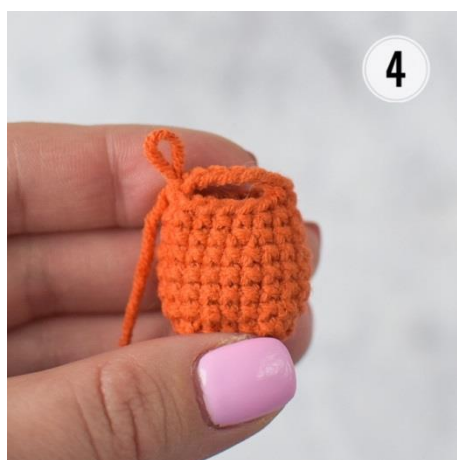
8 rnd: 15 sc

9 rnd: 1 sc, 5 ch (skip 5 sc and insert the hook in the 7<sup>th</sup> loop of the row, photo 4), 9 sc (15)

10 rnd: 1 sc, further crochet on the chain 2 sc, dec, 1 sc (photo 5), 2 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec (12)

11 rnd: 6 dec (6)

Stuff the detail, tighten the opening, cut the thread, fasten off (photo 6).

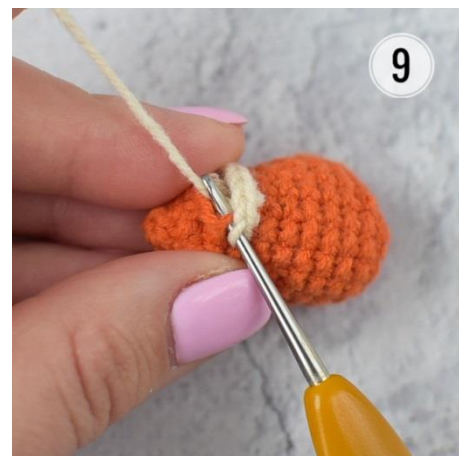
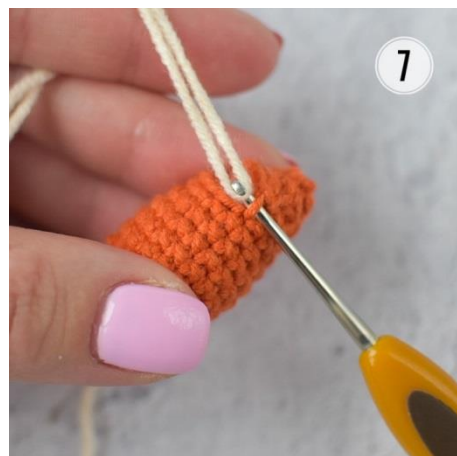


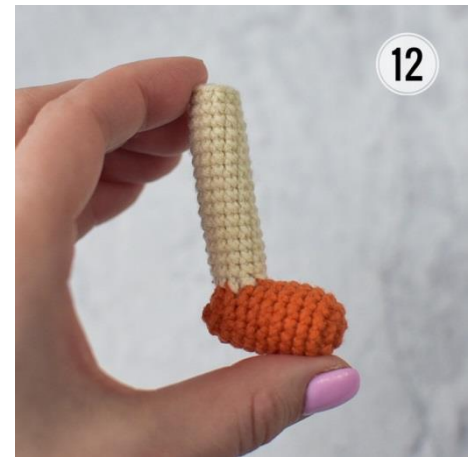
Attach the main thread to the loop between the heel and the foot and crochet the leg, stuff tightly in the course of crocheting.

1 rnd: 1 sc between the heel and the foot (photo 7), 5 sc on the foot in the fr lp (photo 8), 1 sc sc between the foot and the heel (photo 9), 5 sc on the chain of the 9<sup>th</sup> row (photo 10) (12)

2-16 rnd: 12 sc (15 rows, photo 12)

On the right leg (looking at the back of the head) crochet 2 additional sc, cut the thread. On the left leg crochet 8 additional sc, don't cut the thread.





## BODY

Make chain 12 ch from the 2<sup>nd</sup> (left) leg (photo 13) and insert the hook in the 1<sup>st</sup> loop of the last row of the 1<sup>st</sup> (right) leg after the «step» (photo 14).

1 rnd:

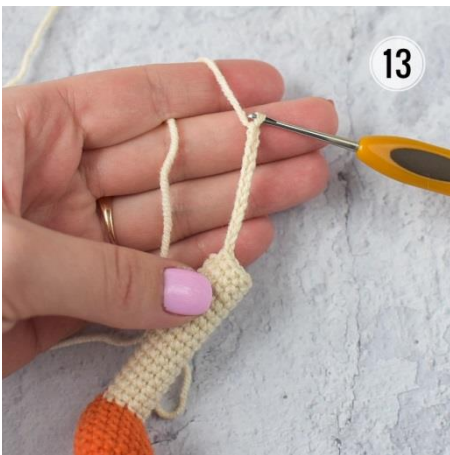
On the right leg: 7 sc, inc, 4 sc (photo 15)

On the chain: 3 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc (photo 16)

On the left leg: 7 sc, inc, 4 sc

On the other side of the chain: 3 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc

In total, in the 1<sup>st</sup> row of the body, there should be 54 sc (photo 17, 18). Put the marker.





2-12 rnd: 54 sc (11 rows)

Crochet additional 27 sc. Cut the main thread, change color to mustard, put the marker.

13-14 rnd: 54 sc (2 rows)

Change color to white tweed.

15 rnd: 54 sc

16 rnd: (7 sc, dec)\*6 (48)

Change color to mustard.

17-18 rnd: 48 sc (2 rows)

Change color to white.

19 rnd: 48 sc

20 rnd: 3 sc, dec, (6 sc, dec)\*5, 3 sc (42)

Change color to mustard.

21-22 rnd: 42 sc (2 rows)

Change color to white.

23 rnd: 42 sc

Attach the mustard thread to the last free loop of the 30<sup>th</sup> row, as it's shown at the photo 20 and crochet 24 sl st. Cut the thread, fasten off, hide the end (photo 21).

24 rnd: (5 sc, dec)\*6 (36)

Change color to mustard.

25-26 rnd: 36 sc (2 rows)

Change color to white.

27 rnd: 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec)\*5, 2 sc (30)

28 rnd: 30 sc

Cut the white thread, change color to mustard.

29 rnd: (3 sc, dec)\*6 (24)

30 rnd: 24 sc

Leave the mustard thread ahead, further crochet with the main thread.

31 rnd: 24 sc in the bk lp

32 rnd: 1 sc, dec, (2 sc, dec)\*5, 1 sc (18)

33-34 rnd: 18 sc (2 rows)

Cut the thread, leaving a long end for sewing (photo 19).





## WINGS (2 details)

Crochet with the main color, don't stuff.

1 rnd: 6 sc in MR

2 rnd: (1 sc, inc)\*3 (9)

3 rnd: 9 sc

4 rnd: 1 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc)\*2, 1 sc (12)

5 rnd: 12 sc

6 rnd: (3 sc, inc)\*3 (15)

7 rnd: 15 sc

8 rnd: 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc)\*2, 2 sc (18)

9-18 rnd: 18 sc (10 rows)

19 rnd: 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec)\*2, 2 sc (15)

20 rnd: 15 sc

21 rnd: (3 sc, dec)\*3 (12)

22 rnd: 12 sc

23 rnd: (1 sc, dec)\*4 (8)

Fold the detail in half and connect the edges by 4 sc.

Cut the thread, fasten off, hide the end (photo 22).

## SLEEVES

Make chain 24 ch with the mustard thread and close the ring by 1 sl st. Further crochet in a spiral.

1-2 rnd: 24 sc (2 rows)

Change color to white tweed.

3 rnd: 3 sc, dec, (6 sc, dec)\*2, 3 sc (21)

4 rnd: 21 sc

Change color to mustard.

5 rnd: (5 sc, dec)\*3 (18)

6 rnd: 18 sc

Change color to white.

7 rnd: 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec)\*2, 2 sc (15)

8 rnd: 15 sc

Cut the white thread, change color to mustard.

9 rnd: (3 sc, dec)\*3 (12)

Crochet additional 4 sc. Cut the thread, leaving a long end (photo 23). **Don't pull the thread!**



## ASSEMBLY AND DECORATIONS

Sew the beak between the 17<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> rows of the head, stuff the detail (photo 24). How to sew the beak carefully, look at the link [https://youtu.be/yQa7WZ3\\_TMs](https://youtu.be/yQa7WZ3_TMs).



If you haven't used the eyes with stalks, it's time to glue them. I use eyes with stalks, but glue them. I like it better this way, because the plug doesn't interfere with the design of the face in the future, and a thread "doesn't run" under the glued eye.

Firstly mark the points 1 and 2 between the 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> rows of the head (the space between points is 12 sc (photo 25)). Position the points so that the beak is centered between them. If necessary, increase or decrease the distance between the points.

Now take a thick knitting needle or something similar (I use knitting needle No5.5 (5.5 mm)) and start to gradually expand the crocheted fabric at these points (photo 26). How to do it, look on example at the link <https://youtu.be/dRs86ogCpX8>.

Now take glue and drip inside the resulting hole. Also, lubricate the inner surface of the eye with glue. Insert the eyes there and press on them, wait a couple of minutes (photo 27). How to do it, look on example at the link <https://youtu.be/Agh53qKB5fY>.



Start to design the face (photo 28). Embroider the whites of the eyes with a white thread (I used whole thread Yarn Art Jeans No62). Embroider the eyelids with the whole main thread. Embroider the brows with the brown thread (I use Alize Cotton Gold №690, 2 threads of 4). How to design the face, look at the link <https://youtu.be/y1hC32ZYekg>.

Make the crest with the main color. To do this, make chain 6 ch, insert the hook in the 2<sup>nd</sup> loop from the hook and crochet 5 sc, make chain 5 ch, insert the hook in the 2<sup>nd</sup> loop from the hook and crochet 4 sc. Cut the thread, leaving a long end for sewing. Sew the crest to the top of the head.

Tint the cheeks with dry pastel pf pink color. How to do it, look at the link <https://youtu.be/OKAZShan2LQ>.



Take a piece of wire about 20 cm long, fold it in such way that the cut points are approximately in the middle (photo 29). The folded length should be about 10 cm. Isolate it with adhesive plaster (photo 30).

Now place the frame in the body and the other end into the hole of the head. The frame must be evenly spaced, i.e. half should be on the body, half on the head (photo 31). Sew the head, stuff the neck in the course of sewing (photo 32, 33). How to sew the head carefully, look at the link <https://youtu.be/-EMfBqNQnz4>.







Now we need to connect the wings and sleeves. To do this, half the sleeve in half and insert the wing inside, further crochet 1 sc, grasping the sleeve's loops only. Further crochet 4 sc, grasping loops of the wing and sleeve together (photo 35). Crochet 1 sc, grasping the sleeve's loops only. Cut the thread, leaving a long end for sewing (photo 36). How to make this connection, look at the link <https://youtu.be/8ZuxII5REs4>.



Sew the wings between the 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> rows of the body (photo 37, 38). How to sew the wings carefully, look on example at the link <https://youtu.be/NxPpn2gnqxU>.





## OVERALL

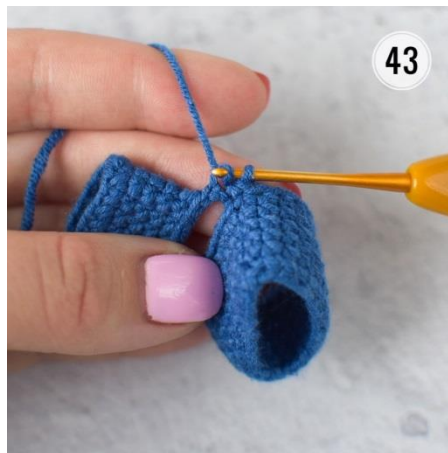
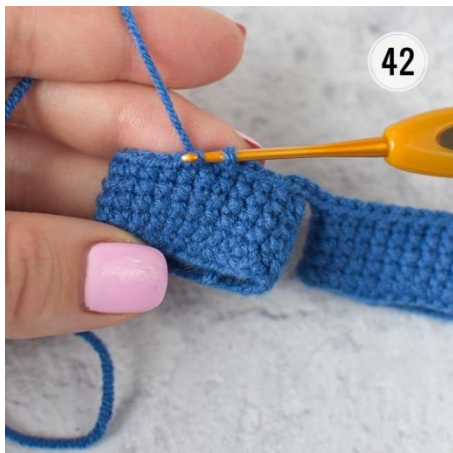
Crochet 2 pant legs with the blue thread and hook №2 (2.00 mm). Make chain 24 ch and close the ring by 1 sl st, further crochet in a spiral:

1-5 rnd: 24 sc (5 rows)

Cut the thread on the 1<sup>st</sup> pant leg only (photo 39).

Make chain 3 ch from the 2<sup>nd</sup> pant leg (photo 40) and insert the hook in the 1<sup>st</sup> loop of the last row of the 1<sup>st</sup> leg, as it's shown at the photo 41. Further crochet in a spiral:

1 rnd: 24 sc on the 1<sup>st</sup> pant leg (photo 42), 3 sc on the chain (photo 43), 24 sc on the 2<sup>nd</sup> pant leg, 3 sc on the other side of the chain (54) (photo 44)



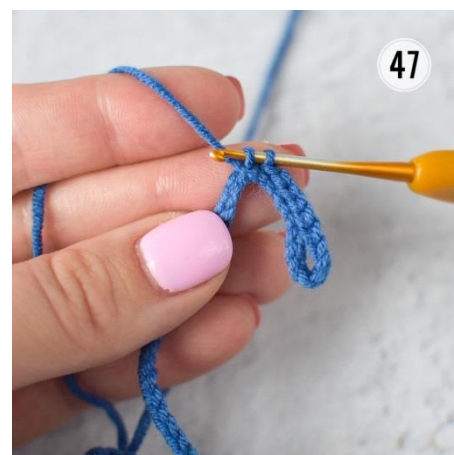
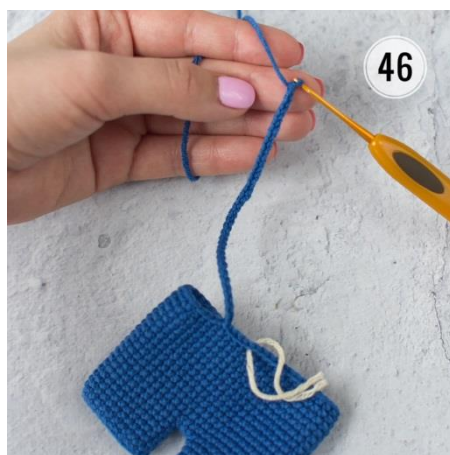
2-13 rnd: 54 sc (12 rows)

14 rnd: 8 sc, dec, (16 sc, dec)\*2, 8 sc (51) (photo 45)

Make straps in the next row. Crochet 5 csl st, make chain 37 ch (photo 46), insert the hook in the 8<sup>th</sup> loop from the hook and crochet 30 sl st on the chain (photo 47), further crochet sl st in the next loop of the row (photo 48). It'll be the 1<sup>st</sup> strap. Crochet 37 sl st, make chain 37 ch and crochet 30 sl st from the 8<sup>th</sup> loop from the hook, further crochet 1 sl st in the next loop of the row. End the row, crocheting 7 sc. Cut the end, fasten off, hide the end (photo 49).

Embroider seams and pockets with the mustard thread, as it's shown at the video <https://youtu.be/CU13qVE3-PY>.

Sew the buttons (photo 50).



## HAT

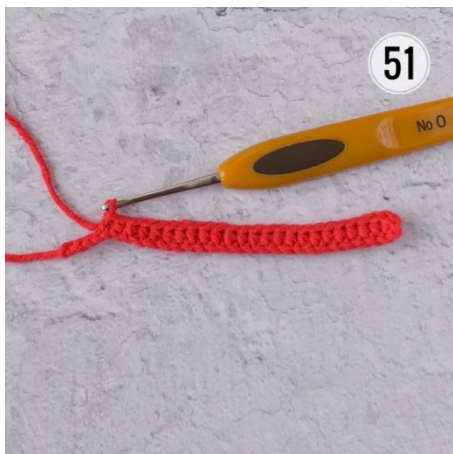
Crochet all rows for the back loops with the red thread in back-and-forth rows. Make chain 30 ch and insert the hook in the 2<sup>nd</sup> loop from the hook:

1 rnd: 22 hdc, 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn (leave 4 loops of the chain uncrocheted, photo 51)

2 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 23 hdc, turn (photo 52)

3 rnd: 2 ch, 24 hdc, further crochet in the uncrocheted loops of the chain 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn (leave 2 loops of the chain uncrocheted, photo 53)

How to crochet the 3<sup>rd</sup> row, look at the link <https://youtu.be/CRZpc6txh10>.





4 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 25 hdc, turn

5 rnd: 2 ch, 26 hdc, further crochet in the uncrocheted loops of the chain 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn

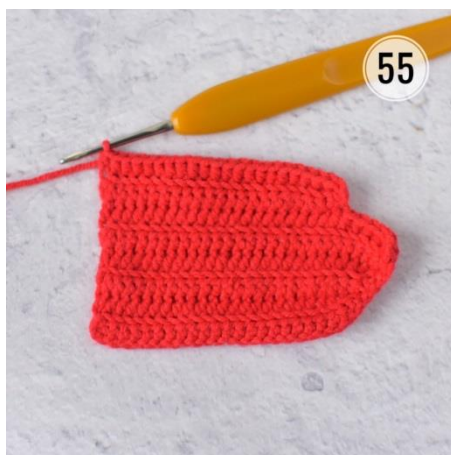
6 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 27 hdc, turn

7 rnd: 2 ch, 20 hdc, 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn (leave 6 loops of the chain uncrocheted, photo 54)

8 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 21 hdc, turn (photo 55)

9 rnd: 2 ch, 22 hdc, further crochet in the uncrocheted loops of the 6<sup>th</sup> row 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn (leave 4 loops of the 6<sup>th</sup> row uncrocheted, photo 56)

How to crochet the 9<sup>th</sup> row, look at the link <https://youtu.be/OK7wIVxhii8>.



10 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 23 hdc, turn

11 rnd: 2 ch, 24 hdc, further crochet in the uncrocheted loops of the 6<sup>th</sup> row 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn (leave 2 loops of the 6<sup>th</sup> row uncrocheted)

12 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 25 hdc, turn

13 rnd: 2 ch, 26 hdc, further crochet in the uncrocheted loops of the 6<sup>th</sup> row 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn

14 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 27 hdc, turn

15 rnd: 2 ch, 22 hdc, 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn (leave 4 loops of the 14<sup>th</sup> row uncrocheted)

16 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 23 hdc, turn

17 rnd: 2 ch, 24 hdc, further crochet in the uncrocheted loops of the 14<sup>th</sup> row 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn (leave 2 loops of the 14<sup>th</sup> row uncrocheted)

18 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 25 hdc, turn

19 rnd: 2 ch, 26 hdc, further crochet in the uncrocheted loops of the 14<sup>th</sup> row 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn

20 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 27 hdc, turn

21 rnd: 2 ch, 20 hdc, 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn (leave 6 loops of the 20<sup>th</sup> row uncrocheted)

22 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 21 hdc, turn

23 rnd: 2 ch, 22 hdc, further crochet in the uncrocheted loops of the 20<sup>th</sup> row 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn (leave 4 loops of the 20<sup>th</sup> row uncrocheted)

24 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 23 hdc, turn

25 rnd: 2 ch, 24 hdc, further crochet in the uncrocheted loops of the 20<sup>th</sup> row 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn (leave 2 loops of the 20<sup>th</sup> row uncrocheted)

26 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 25 hdc, turn

27 rnd: 2 ch, 26 hdc, further crochet in the uncrocheted loops of the 20<sup>th</sup> row 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn

28 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 27 hdc, turn

29 rnd: 2 ch, 22 hdc, 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn (leave 4 loops of the 28<sup>th</sup> row uncrocheted)

30 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 23 hdc, turn

31 rnd: 2 ch, 24 hdc, further crochet in the uncrocheted loops of the 28<sup>th</sup> row 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn (leave 2 loops of the 28<sup>th</sup> row uncrocheted)

32 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 25 hdc, turn

33 rnd: 2 ch, 26 hdc, further crochet in the uncrocheted loops of the 28<sup>th</sup> row 1 sc, 1 sl st, turn

34 rnd: 1 ch, 1 sc, 27 hdc

Fold the detail in half and connect the end by 1 row of sl st, insert the hook in the bk lp of the 34<sup>th</sup> row and loops of the base chain (photo 58). Connect the top of the hat, crocheting 3-4 sc. Cut the thread, fasten off, hide the end



## SCARF

Make chain 80 ch with the red thread and close the ring by 1 sl st.

1 rnd: 2 ch, 80 hdc, sl st to join in the end

2 rnd: 1 ch, 80 sc, sl st to join in the end

**When crocheting the 2<sup>nd</sup> row insert the hook in the bk lp of the 1<sup>st</sup> row and loops of the base chain.** How to crochet the 2<sup>nd</sup> row, look at the link <https://youtu.be/J2Faje0e8Gg> .



## FROG

### Body

Make chain 6 ch with the green thread and insert the hook in the 2<sup>nd</sup> loop from the hook.

1 rnd: 4 sc, 3 sc in the las loop of the chain, further crochet on the other side of the chain 3 sc, inc (12)

2 rnd: inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 3 sc, 2 inc (18)

3 rnd: 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, (1 sc, inc)\*3, 3 sc, (1 sc, inc)\*2 (24)

4-15 rnd: 24 sc (12 rows)

16 rnd: 1 sc, dec, (2 sc, dec)\*5, 1 sc (18)

17 rnd: (1 sc, dec)\*6 (12)

18 rnd: 6 dec (6)

Stuff the detail. Cut the thread, tighten the opening, hide the end in the detail (photo 61).



### Eyes (2 details)

Start to crochet with the white thread.

1 rnd: 6 sc in MR

2 rnd: 6 inc (12)

3 rnd: 12 sc

Cut the white thread, change color to green.

4 rnd: 12 sc

Attach the green thread to the 1<sup>st</sup> free front loop of the 4<sup>th</sup> rows (photo 63) and crochet 1 ch, (3 sc, inc)\*3, sl st to join in the end. Cut the thread, fasten off, hide the end.

Glue the black halfbeads (photo 64).

5 rnd: 12 sc in the bk lp

6 rnd: 12 sc

7 rnd: 6 dec (6)

Stuff the detail. Cut the thread, tighten the opening, hide the end (photo 62).



### *Arms (2 details)*

Make chain 11 ch with the green thread and insert the hook in the 2<sup>nd</sup> llop from the hook. Crochet 3 sl st (it'll be the 1<sup>st</sup> finger), make chain 4 ch and turn on the chain, crocheting 3 sl st it'll be the 2<sup>nd</sup> finger), make chain 4 ch again and turn on it, crocheting 3 sl st (it'll be the 3<sup>rd</sup> finger). Further crochet 7 sl st on the base chain. Cut the thread, leaving a long end for sewing.

How to crochet the fingers, look at the link <https://youtu.be/X-3V4aHTrZY>.

### *Legs (2 details)*

Make chain 15 ch with the green thread and insert the hook in the 2<sup>nd</sup> llop from the hook. Crochet 4 sl st (it'll be the 1<sup>st</sup> finger), make chain 5 ch and turn on the chain, crocheting 4 sl st it'll be the 2<sup>nd</sup> finger), make chain 5 ch again and turn on it, crocheting 4 sl st (it'll be the 3<sup>rd</sup> finger). Further crochet 10 sl st on the base chain. Cut the thread, leaving a long end for sewing.



### *Tongue*

Make chain 3 ch with the red thread, insert the hook in the 2<sup>nd</sup> loop from the hook and crochet 2 sc. Cut the thread, leaving a long end for sewing.

Sew the eyes on the sides of the body between the 14<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> rows, sew the arms between the 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> rows, sew the legs between the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> rows, sew the tongue between the 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> rows.



Our pretty Mr. Duck is ready!
