

“Baby mobile: safari toys”

*Giraffe, elephant, lion,
Monkey, moon and clouds by RNata*



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The pattern is written in English using US crochet terminology. Instructions are easy to follow if you are familiar with basic crochet techniques.

Materials:

- 2.5 mm and 3,5 mm hook
- Cotton yarn

I used Schachenmayr Catania “Original”

- Light blue (173), white (106), mustard (249), brown (157), light brown (437),
- beige (263), grey (172)

DMC Natura “midium” in yellow (04).

- Black embroidery thread
- Safety eyes 6.00 mm
- Stuffing
- Yarn needle
- Stitch marker

I used the black thread

The toys are approximately 4-16 cm tall.

It may vary though depending on the kind of yarn and hook size used.

You can also use any color of yarn.

Feel free to add accessories to your very own safari toys.

Abbreviations:

- ch – chain
- sc – single crochet
- st/sts - stitch/stitches
- hdc – half double crochet
- dc – double crochet
- dec – decrease
- slst - slip stitch
- BLO – use the back loop only
- FLO – use the front loop only



BODY (big, make 2)

Use light blue (173) yarn.

Rnd 1: 8 sc in magic ring [8]

Rnd 2: (inc) x8 [16]

Rnd 3: (inc, sc) x8 [24]

Rnd 4-7: sc around [24], **4 rounds**

Rnd 8: use only front loops (FLO): 6 inc, 18 sc [30]

Rnd 9: FLO: (sc, inc) x6, 18 sc [36]

Rnd 10-16: sc around [36], **7 rounds**

Rnd 17: 4 sc, 8 dec, 16 sc [28]

Rnd 18: 5 sc, FLO: 6 inc, 17 sc, (fig 1) [34]



Rnd 19-23: sc around [34], **5 rounds**

Rnd 24: 6 sc, 6 dec, 16 sc [28]

Rnd 25: 5 sc, 4 dec, 15 sc [24]

Rnd 26: 4 sc, FLO: 6 sc, 14 sc [24]

Rnd 27-28: sc around [24], **2 rounds**

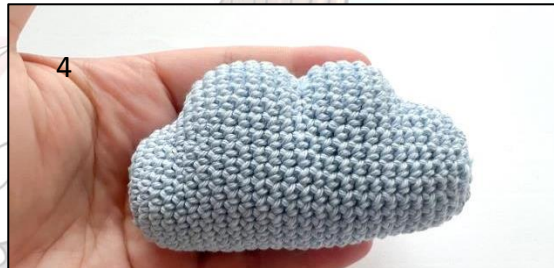
Rnd 29: (dec, 2 sc) x6 [18]

Rnd 30: (dec, sc) x6 [12]

Stuff the cloud firmly (fig 4).

Close the opening.

How to close the end of the round: with a darning needle, insert the remaining yarn through all the front loops of the stitches on the last round (fig 2). Pull all together at once and sew to hide the yarn inside the part you are working on (fig 3).



BODY (small, make 2)

Use white (106) yarn.

Rnd 1: 8 sc in magic ring [8]

Rnd 2: (inc) x8 [16]

Rnd 3-5: sc around [16], **3 rounds**

Rnd 6: FLO: (3 sc in next stitch) x3, 13 sc, (fig 5) [22]



Rnd 7: (sc, 2 inc) x3, 13 sc [28]

Rnd 8-11: sc around [28], **4 rounds**

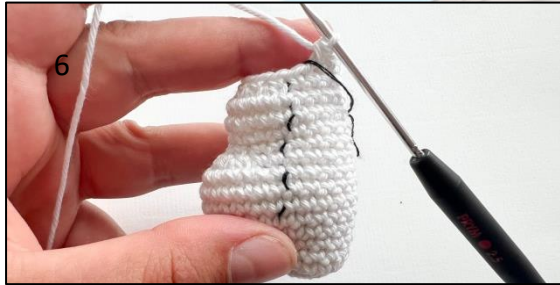
Rnd 12: 2 sc, 6 dec, 14 sc [22]

Rnd 13: 2 sc, 3 dec, 14 sc [19]

Rnd 14: FLO: (sc, inc) x3, 13 sc [22]

Rnd 15-16: sc around [22], **2 rounds**

Rnd 17: 6 dec, 9 sc, put your stitch marker here. It will be a new beginning (fig 6).



Rnd 18: 4 dec, 8 sc [12]

Rnd 19: FLO: 4 sc, 8 sc [12]

Rnd 20: sc around [12]

Stuff the cloud firmly (fig 7).

Fasten off.



BODY

Use DMC Natura yellow (04) yarn and 3,5 mm hook (fig 1).



Rnd 1: 8 sc in magic ring [8]

Rnd 2: (inc) x8 [16]

Rnd 3: (sc, inc) x8 [24]

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x8 [32]

Rnd 5: 3 sc, inc, (sc, inc) x2, (3 sc, inc) x3, (sc, inc) x2, (3 sc, inc) x2, (fig 2) [42]



Rnd 6: 4 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc) x2, (4 sc, inc) x3, (2 sc, inc) x2, (4 sc, inc) x2 [52]

Rnd 7: 5 sc, inc, (sc, inc) x4, (5 sc, inc) x3, (sc, inc) x4, (5 sc, inc) x2 [66]

Rnd 8: 6 sc, inc, 3 sc, (inc, sc) x2, inc, 3 sc, (inc, 6 sc) x3, inc, 3 sc, (inc, sc) x2, inc, 3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc) x2, (fig 3) [80]

Rnd 9: 7 sc, inc, 5 sc, (inc, sc) x2, inc, 5 sc, (inc, 7 sc) x3, inc, 5 sc, (inc, sc) x2, inc, 5 sc, inc, (7 sc, inc) x2 [94]



Rnd 10: 8 sc, inc, 7 sc, (inc, sc) x2, inc, 7 sc, (inc, 8 sc) x3, inc, 7 sc, (inc, sc) x2, inc, 7 sc, inc, (8 sc, inc) x2 [108]

Rnd 11: 9 sc, (inc, 11 sc) x2, (inc, 9 sc) x3, (inc, 11 sc) x2, (inc, 9 sc) x2, inc [116]

Rnd 12-13: sc around, (fig 4) [116], **2 rounds**



Crochet 23 sc more after finished the last round to bring the yarn in the corner (fig 5). Now we are going to close the moon. Insert your hook in second stitch from your hook and the stitch on the hook (fig 6), make a slst (fig 7). Insert your hook in next two stitches and crochet slst. Close the body with slst (fig 8-10).

- make a slst loosely and stuff it during the closing.

HEAD

Use yellow (280) yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (inc) x6 [12]

Rnd 3: (inc, sc) x6 [18]

Rnd 4: sc around [18]

Rnd 5: 4 sc, (inc, sc) x2, inc, 9 sc [21]

Rnd 6: sc around [21]

Rnd 7: 5 sc, (inc, 2 sc) x2, inc, 9 sc [24]

Rnd 8-9: sc around [24], **2 rounds**

Stuff the head firmly.

Fasten off.

LEGS (make 2 pieces)

Use yellow (280) yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (inc) x6 [12]

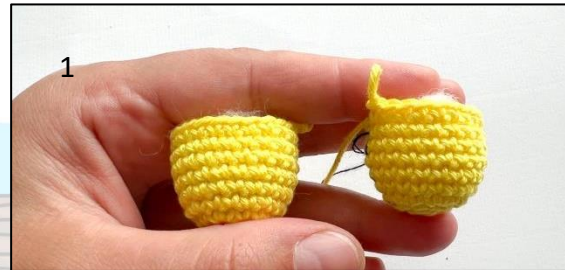
Rnd 3: (inc, sc) x6 [18]

Rnd 4: (5 sc, inc) x3 [21]

Rnd 5-9: sc around [21], **5 rounds**

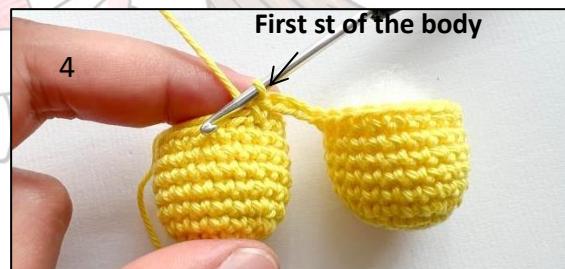
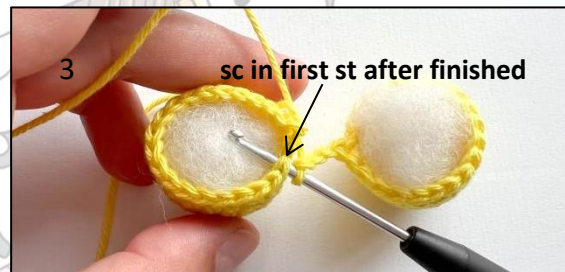
Don't cut the yarn of the second leg.

Now we are going to connect two legs together.



BODY

Ch 3 (fig 2), insert your hook in next stitch of the first leg after finished (fig 3), sc in this stitch (fig 4). It will be a first stitch of the body, Put your stitch marker here.



Rnd 1: 21 sc around the first leg, sc in next 3 chain st, 21 sc around the second leg, sc in next 3 chain st, (fig 5, 6) [48]



Rnd 2-9: sc around [48], **8 rounds**

Rnd 9: 7 sc, (dec, 2 sc) x2, dec, 31 sc [45]

Rnd 10: sc around [45]

Rnd 11: 6 sc, (dec, 2 sc) x2, dec, 29 sc [42]

Rnd 12: sc around, (fig 7) [42]



Rnd 13: sc, (dec, 2 sc) x4, dec, 23 sc [37]

Rnd 14: 36 sc, put your stitch marker here. It will be a new beginning (fig 8).



Rnd 15: (dec, 2 sc) x4, dec, 19 sc [32]

Rnd 16: sc around [32]

Rnd 17: 2 sc, (dec, 2 sc) x3, dec, 14 sc, dec [27]

Rnd 18: sc around [27]

Rnd 19: sc, (dec, 2 sc) x3, dec, 9 sc, dec, sc, (fig 9) [22]

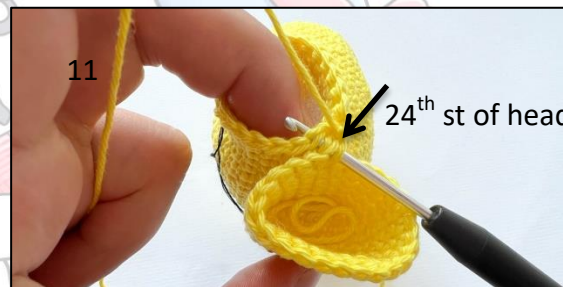


Rnd 20-22: sc around [22], **3 rounds**

Stuff the body firmly.

Now, we are going to attach the head to the body (fig 10).

Rnd 23: 14 sc, attach the head: insert your hook in last 24th st after finished and next stitch of the body (fig 11), 4 sc (together across stitch of the head and body (fig 12)), 4 sc around the body [22]





Rnd 23: 14 sc, 20 sc around the head, 4 sc, (fig 13, 14) [38]

Rnd 24-25: sc around [38], **2 rounds**

Rnd 26: 13 sc, dec, 18 sc, dec, 3 sc [36]

Attach the safety eyes between rounds 23 and 24 with 9 st between.

Skip 19 sts from the beginning, attach the first eye, then skip 9 sts and attach the second eye (fig 15, 16).



Rnd 27-29: sc around [36], **3 rounds**

Rnd 30: (dec, 4 sc) x6 [30]

Rnd 31: (dec, 3 sc) x6 [24]

Start to stuff the head.

Rnd 32: (dec, 2 sc) x6 [18]

Rnd 33: (dec, sc) x6 [12]

Stuff the head firmly.

Close the opening in the same way as the clouds.



EARS (make 2)

Use yellow (280) yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (sc, inc) x3 [9]

Rnd 3: (2 sc, inc) x3 [12]

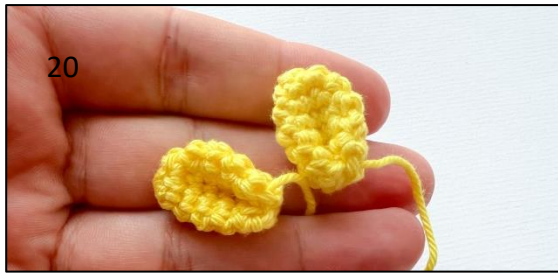
Rnd 4-6: sc around [12], **3 rounds**

Don't stuff the ears.

Cut the yarn, leave a tail for sewing

Fold ear in half and sew two sides together (fig 18-20).





HORNS (make 2)

Use light brown (437) yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (sc, inc) x3 [9]

Rnd 3-4: sc around [9], **2 rounds**

Rnd 5: (dec, sc) x3 [6]

Rnd 6: sc around [6],

Stuff the horns lightly.

Cut the yarn, leave a tail for sewing.



SPOTS (make 6)

Use light brown (437) yarn.

Rnd 1: 7 sc in magic ring [7]

Fasten off.

Leave a tail for sewing.

MANE

Use light brown (437) yarn.

Ch 18. Make sure that your chains are not twisted.

Row 1: start in second chain from the hook: slst in next 2 back ridge loops (fig 22).

Ch 3 (fig 23), start in second chain from hook, slst in next 2 back ridge loops, slst in

next back ridge loop of chains (fig 24, 25). Repeat it 14 times.

Cut the yarn, leave a tail for sewing.

TAIL

Use yellow (280) yarn.

Ch 15. Make sure that your chains are not twisted.

Row 1: start in second chain from the hook: slst in each back ridge loops.

Cut the yarn, leave a tail for sewing.
Cut 8 cm long 10 pieces of light brown yarn.
Fold them in half, lay the pieces around the
end of the tail and secure them with thread
(fig 26-28).



ASSEMBLING:

sew the ears and horns on the top of the
head (fig 29-32).



Sew the tail on the back of the body (fig 33).
Place the mane from the top of the head to
the beginning of the body as shown on the
photos 34 and 35. Sew it using the chain
loops (fig 36).





Sew the spots to the body using the back ridge loops (fig 37).

At last, embroider the nose one stitch long (fig 38).



BODY

Use mustard (249) yarn. You should need 40 gram.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (inc) x6 [12]

Rnd 3: (inc, sc) x6 [18]

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x6 [24]

Rnd 5: (inc, 3 sc) x6 [30]

Rnd 6: 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x5, inc, 2 sc [36]

Rnd 7: 4 sc, (inc, 5 sc) x5, inc, sc [42]

Rnd 8-14: sc around [42], **7 rounds**

Rnd 15: (dec, 5 sc) x3, dec, 19 sc [38]

Rnd 16-17: sc around [38], **2 rounds**

Rnd 18: (dec, 4 sc) x3, dec, 18 sc [34]

Rnd 19-20: sc around [34], **2 rounds**

Rnd 21: (dec, 3 sc) x3, dec, 17 sc [30]

Rnd 22-23: sc around [30], **2 rounds**

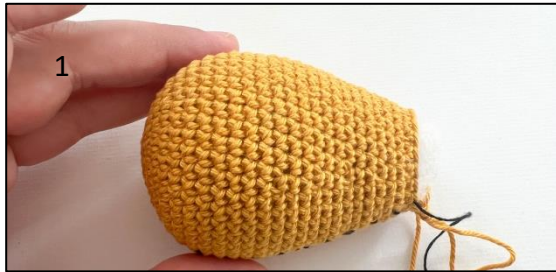
Rnd 24: (dec, 2 sc) x3, dec, 16 sc [26]

Rnd 25-26: sc around [26], **2 rounds**

Rnd 27: (dec, sc) x3, dec, 15 sc [22]

Rnd 28-29: sc around, (fig 1, 2) [22]

Stuff the body firmly.



Now we are going to crochet the first leg.

LEGS

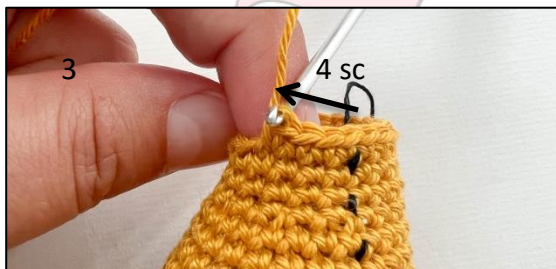
Use mustard (249) yarn.

Crochet 4 sc (fig 3), skip next 11 st and turn your crocheting on the other side (fig 4), insert your hook in next st, 7 sc, (fig 5) [11]

Rnd 1-11: sc around [11], 11 rounds

Stuff the leg firmly.

Fasten off (fig 6).



Second leg: insert your hook across the first stitches from the first leg (fig 8), pull the yarn through (fig 9), ch 1, sc in this stitch (count this st as the first st of the new round) (fig 10), sc in next 10 st.

Rnd 1-11: sc around [11], 11 rounds

Stuff the leg firmly.

Fasten off (fig 11).





HEAD

Use mustard (249) yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (inc) x6 [12]

Rnd 3: (inc, sc) x6 [18]

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x6 [24]

Rnd 5: (inc, 3 sc) x6 [30]

Rnd 6: sc around [30]

Rnd 7: 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x5, inc, 2 sc [36]

Rnd 8: sc around [36]

Rnd 9: 4 sc, (inc, 5 sc) x5, inc, sc [42]

Rnd 10-17: sc around [42], **8 rounds**

Attach the safety eyes between rounds 12 and 13 with 8 st between (fig 12).



Rnd 18: (dec, 4 sc) x7 [35]

Rnd 19: (dec, 3 sc) x7 [28]

Rnd 20: (dec, 2 sc) x7 [21]

Rnd 21: (dec, sc) x7 [14]

Stuff the head firmly.

Rnd 22: (dec) x7 [7]

Fasten off (fig 13, 14).

Leave a tail for sewing.



BACK LEGS (make 2)

Use mustard (249) yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (inc) x6 [12]

Rnd 3-4: sc around [12], **2 rounds**

Rnd 5: 3 sc, 3 dec, 3 sc [9]

Stuff the beginning of the leg firmly.

Rnd 6-9: sc around [9], **4 rounds**

Rnd 10: (2 sc, inc) x3 [12]

Rnd 11: 6 sc, 3 inc, 3 sc [15]

Rnd 12: 2 dec, 3 sc, (inc, sc) x2, inc, 3 sc [16]

Rnd 13: dec, 4 sc, (inc, 2 sc) x2, inc, 3 sc [18]

Rnd 14-18: sc around [18], **5 rounds**

Rnd 19: (dec, sc) x6 [12]

Don't stuff the rest of leg.

Fasten off.

Leave a tail for sewing (fig 15, 16).



TAIL

Use mustard (249) yarn.

Ch 23. Make sure that your chains are not twisted.

Row 1: start in second chain from the hook: slst in each back ridge loops.

Cut the yarn, leave a tail for sewing.

Cut 8 cm long 10 pieces of brown yarn (fig 17). Fold them in half, lay the pieces around the end of the tail and secure them with thread (fig 18, 19).



MANE

Use brown (157) yarn.

Ch 43. Make sure that your chains are not twisted.

Row 1: start in second chain from the hook: slst in next 2 back ridge loops.

Ch 3, start in second chain from hook, slst in next 2 back ridge loops, slst in next back ridge loop of chains (fig 20). Repeat it 42 times (fig 21).

Cut the yarn, leave a tail for sewing.

Use the needle, sew the two sides together (fig 22, 23).





EARS (make 2)

Use mustard (249) yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (sc, inc) x3 [9]

Rnd 3: sc around [9]

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x3 [12]

Don't stuff the ears.

Cut the yarn, leave a tail for sewing.

Use the needle, add a little black on the top of the ear (fig 24, 25).



NOSE (make 2)

Use white (106) yarn.

Rnd 1: 5 sc in magic ring [5]

Rnd 2: (inc) x5 [10]

Invisible fasten off (fig 26, 27).

Leave a tail for sewing.



FACE

Use brown (157) yarn.

Ch 3. Make sure that your chains are not twisted.

Row 1: start in second chain from hook: 2 sc, turn [2]

Row 2-3: 2 sc, turn [2], **2 rows**

Row 4: inc, sc, turn [3]

Row 5-7: 3 sc, turn [3], **3 rows**

Row 8: inc, 2 sc, turn [4]

Row 9-11: 4 sc, turn [4], **3 rows**

Row 12: inc, 3 sc [5]

Row 13-16: 5 sc [5], **4 rows**

Cut the yarn, leave a tail for sewing (fig 28).

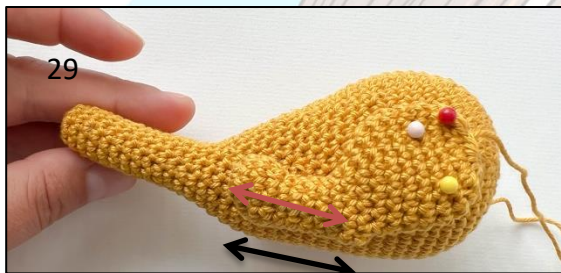


Sew the tail on the back of the body (fig 33, 34).



ASSEMBLING:

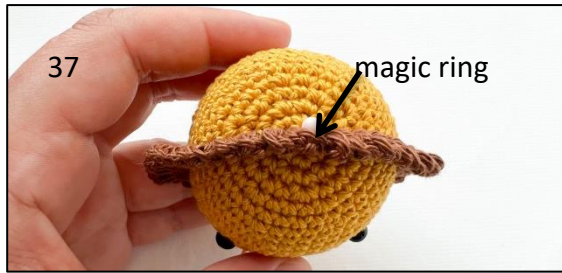
Place and sew the back legs to the body in diagonal as show on photos 29-32.



Use the black thread, embroider the three claws on each leg (fig 35, 36).



Place the mane so that the top will be on magic ring, 6 stitches from the eye and 2 stitches on front from the closing the head (fig 37, 38, 39). You should sew the mane to head using the chain loops (fig 40).



Place the face to the head on the top from mane and below the eyes. You should sew the face in the begin and end (fig 41, 42).



Sew the ears to the head on front from the mane (fig 43).



Sew the nose to the head using the back ridge loops (fig 44, 45).



Use the black thread, embroider the eyebrows.

At last, sew the head to the body. You should start to sew the head from round 17 to until finished point (fig 48, 49) and back to round 17 (fig 50).



FACE

Use beige (263) yarn.

Ch 7. Make sure that your chains are not twisted.

Rnd 1: start in second chain from the hook: inc in this stitch, 4 sc, 3 sc in last chain stitch.

Continue on the other side of the foundation chains, 5 sc [14]

Rnd 2: 2 inc, 4 sc, 3 inc, 4 sc, inc [20]

Rnd 3: (3 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc) x2 [24]

Rnd 4: sc around [24]

Rnd 5: 4 sc, skip next st, 6 dc in next stitch (fig 1), skip next st, 2 sc, skip next st, 6 dc in next st (fig 2), skip next st, 12 sc
Invisible fasten off (fig 3, 4).

Attach the safety eyes in 6 dc space as show on photo 5.

Stuff the face firmly.



HEAD

Use light brown (437) yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (inc) x6 [12]

Rnd 3: (inc, sc) x6 [18]

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x6 [24]

Rnd 5: (inc, 3 sc) x6 [30]

Rnd 6: sc around [30]

Rnd 7: 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x5, inc, 2 sc [36]

Rnd 8-9: sc around [36], **2 rounds**

Rnd 10: 4 sc, (inc, 5 sc) x5, inc, sc [42]

Rnd 11-15: sc around [42], **5 rounds**

Rnd 16: 8 sc, 6 inc, 15 sc, 6 inc, 7 sc [54]

Rnd 17: sc around [54]

Rnd 18: 8 sc, 6 dec, 15 sc, 6 dec, 7 sc [42]

Rnd 19: (dec, 4 sc) x7 [35]

Rnd 20: (dec, 3 sc) x7 [28]

Rnd 21: (dec, 2 sc) x7 [21]

Stuff the head firmly. Invisible fasten off.

Attach the face with eyes between round 12 and 13 with 6 st between (fig 6).

Skip the 18 st from the beginning, attach the first eyes, skip next 6 st and attach the second eye (fig 7, 8).



BODY

Use light brown (437) yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (inc) x6 [12]

Rnd 3: (inc, sc) x6 [18]

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x6 [24]

Rnd 5: (inc, 3 sc) x6 [30]

Rnd 6: 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x5, inc, 2 sc [36]

Rnd 7: 4 sc, (inc, 5 sc) x5, inc, sc [42]

Rnd 8-14: sc round [42], 7 rounds

Rnd 15: (dec, 5 sc) x3, dec, 19 sc [38]

Rnd 16: sc around [38]

Rnd 17: (dec, 4 sc) x3, dec, 18 sc [34]

Rnd 18: sc around [34]

Rnd 19: (dec, 3 sc) x3, dec, 17 sc [30]

Rnd 20: sc around [30]

Rnd 21: (dec, 2 sc) x3, dec, 16 sc [26]

Rnd 22: sc around [26]

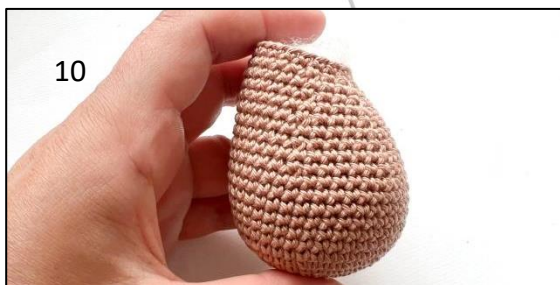
Rnd 23: (dec, sc) x3, dec, 7 sc, dec, 6 sc [21]

Rnd 24: sc around [21]

Stuff the body firmly.

Cut the yarn, leave a tail for sewing.

Invisible fasten off (fig 9, 10).



Bring the tail of yarn in the 4th stitch of the body (fig 10a).



EARS (make 2)

Use light brown (437) yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (inc) x6 [12]

Rnd 3: sc around [12]

Invisible fasten off.

Leave a tail for sewing (fig 11).



TAIL

Use light brown (437) yarn.

Ch 12. Make sure that your chains are not twisted.

Row 1: start in second chain from the hook: slst in each back ridge loops.

Cut the yarn, leave a tail for sewing (fig 12).



ARMS (make 2)

Use light brown (437) yarn.

Rnd 1: 5 sc in magic ring [5]

Rnd 2: (inc) x5 [10]

Rnd 3-4: sc around [10], **2 rounds**

Rnd 5: dec, 8 sc [9]

Rnd 6: dec, 7 sc [8]

Rnd 7-22: sc around [8], **16 rounds**

Don't stuff the arms.

Crochet 1 sc more after finished the round to bring the tail of yarn in the corner.

Leave a tail for sewing (fig 13).



BACK LEGS (make 2)

Use light brown (437) yarn.

Rnd 1: 5 sc in magic ring [5]

Rnd 2: (inc) x5 [10]

Rnd 3-4: sc around [10], **2 rounds**

Rnd 5: dec, 8 sc [9]

Rnd 6: dec, 7 sc [8]

Rnd 7-18: sc around [8], **12 rounds**

Don't stuff the legs.

Crochet 1 sc more after finished the round to bring the tail of yarn in the corner.

Leave a tail for sewing (fig 13).

ASSEMBLING:

Sew the face to the head using the back ridge loops (fig 14).

Sew the head to the body. You should start to sew the body and head from the middle using the remaining tail of the body (fig 15-17).

Place and sew the arms to the body in diagonal as shown on photo 18 and 19.



Sew the legs to the body (fig 20, 21). You should sew them in the one line with arms.



Sew the tail on the back of the body.
Sew the ears to the head between rounds 6 and 9 (fig 22, 23).
Put the small cloud front of the belly and sew all arms (fig 24-26).



BOW

Ch 20. Join with slst in first chain st.

Rnd 1- 5: ch 1, 20 sc, slst in first st [20], **5 rounds**

Cut the yarn leaving the tail of yarn.

Wrap the tail around the bow few times (fig 27).

Lace: ch 40.

Use the needle, pull the lace through the threads (fig 28, 29).

Wrap the bow around the neck of monkey.

TRUNK and HEAD

Use grey (172) yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (inc) x6 [12]

Rnd 3-9: sc around [12], **7 rounds**

Rnd 10: (3 sc, inc) x3 [15]

Rnd 11: sc around [15]

Rnd 12: (4 sc, inc) x3 [18]

Rnd 13: sc around [18]

Rnd 14: (5 sc, inc) x3 [21]

Rnd 15: sc around [21]

Stuff the trunk firmly.

Rnd 16: (sc, inc) x5, 11 sc [26]

Rnd 17: (2 sc, inc) x5, 11 sc [31]

Rnd 18: (3 sc, inc) x5, 11 sc [36]

Rnd 19: (4 sc, inc) x5, 11 [41]

Rnd 20: (5 sc, inc) x2, 6 sc, (5 sc, inc) x2, 11 sc [45]

Rnd 21-29: sc around [45], **9 rounds**

Attach the safety eyes between rounds 21 and 22 with 22 st between.

Skip 8 st from the beginning, attach the first eye, then skip next 22 st and attach the second eye (fig 1, 2).



Rnd 30: (dec, 13 sc) x3 [42]

Rnd 31: sc around [42]

Rnd 32: (dec, 5 sc) x6 [36]

Rnd 33: (dec, 4 sc) x6 [30]

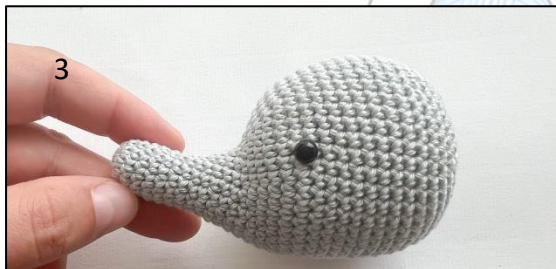
Rnd 34: (dec, 3 sc) x6 [24]

Rnd 35: (dec, 2 sc) x6 [18]

Rnd 36: (dec, sc) x6 [12]

Stuff the head firmly (fig 3, 4).

Close the opening.



EARS (make 2)

Use grey (172) yarn.

Make 2 pieces:

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (inc) x6 [12]

Rnd 3: (3 sc, inc) x3 [15]

Don't cut the yarn of the second piece.

Now we are going to connect two pieces together.

Insert your hook in next st after finished off (fig 5) and make a single crochet (fig 6). It will be a first stitch of new round. Put your stitch marker here.



Rnd 4: two pieces together: 15 sc around the first piece, 15 sc around the second piece, (fig 7) [30]

Rnd 5-7: sc around [30], **3 rounds**

Rnd 8: (dec, 4 sc) x5 [25]

Rnd 9: sc around [25]

Rnd 10: (dec, 3 sc) x5 [20]

Rnd 11: sc around [20]

Rnd 12: (dec, 2 sc) x5 [15]

Crochet 4 sc more after finished the round 12 to bring the yarn in the corner.

Cut the yarn, leave a tail for sewing (fig 8).

Don't stuff the ears.



LEGS (make 4) and BODY

Use grey (172) yarn.

Make 4 legs:

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (inc) x6 [12]

Rnd 3: (inc, sc) x6 [18]

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x6 [24]

Rnd 5-6: sc around [24], **2 rounds**

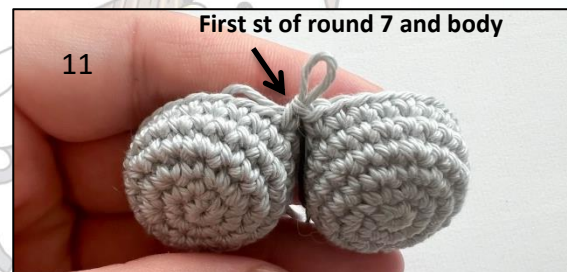
Don't cut the yarn of the 4th leg. We are going to connect 4 legs together (fig 9).

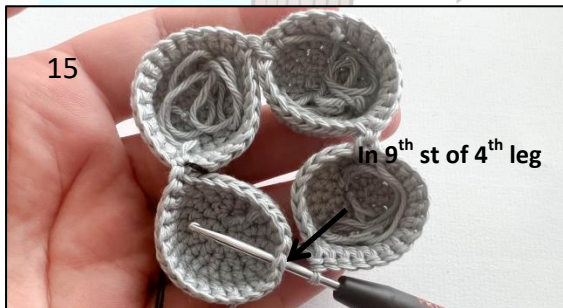


Rnd 7: attach the first leg: insert your hook in next st after finished off (fig 10) and crochet a sc (fig 11) (*It will be the first stitch of round 7 and body. Place your stitch marker here*), SC in next 15 st (fig 12), attach the second leg: insert your hook in next st after finished off, 16 sc around (fig 13), attach the third leg: insert your hook in next st after finished off, 16 sc around (fig 14), to connect 3rd and 4th legs, skip 8 st from finished off the 4th leg, insert your hook in next stitch and crochet 16 sc, (fig 5) [64]

Rnd 8-9: sc around [64], 2 rounds

Rnd 10: (dec, 6 sc) x8 [56]

Rnd 11-15: sc around [56], 5 rounds

Rnd 16: (dec, 5 sc) x8, (fig 16) [48]

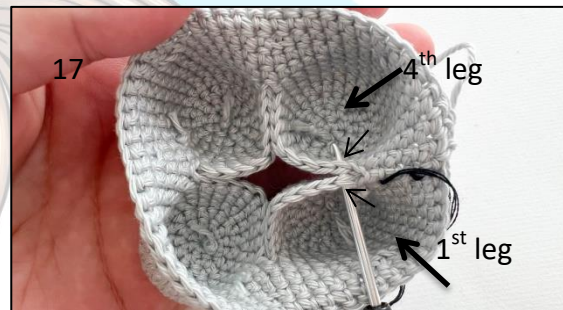


Now we are going to close the hole between legs (fig 16). Insert your hook in first stitches of 4th and 1st legs (we left them on round 7) and pick up the yarn and pull it through (fig 17, 18), again, insert the hook in next two stitches and make a slst. Repeat

it 2 times more. Then insert the hook in 4th stitches of second and third legs and make a slst (fig 19). Crochet a slst in next 3 sts. Fasten off (fig 20).

Close the legs in the same way on vertical (fig 21-23).

Continue to crochet the body:

Stuff the legs and body.

Rnd 17-19: sc around [48], **3 rounds**

Rnd 20: (dec, 4 sc) x8 [40]

Rnd 21: sc around [40]

Rnd 22: 5 sc, (dec, 3 sc) x2, dec, 8 sc, (dec, 3 sc) x2, dec, 3 sc [34]

Rnd 23: 5 sc, (dec, 2 sc) x2, dec, 7 sc, (dec, 2 sc) x2, dec, 2 sc [28]

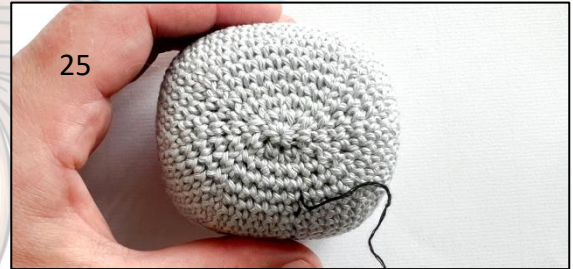
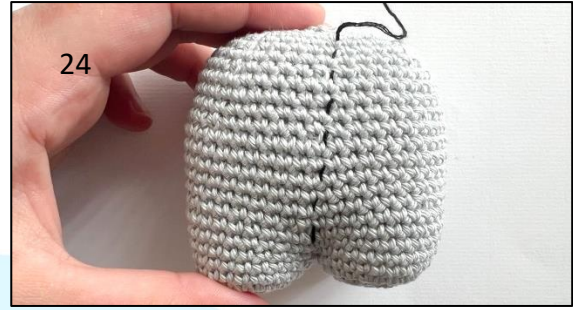
Stuff the body firmly.

Rnd 24: 5 sc, (dec, sc) x2, dec, 6 sc, (dec, sc) x2, dec, sc [22]

Rnd 25: (5 sc, 3 dec) x2 [16]

Rnd 26: (dec) x8 [8]

Invisible fasten off (fig 24-26).



TAIL

Use grey yarn.

Ch 18. Make sure that your chains are not twisted.

Row 1: start in second chain from the hook: slst in each back ridge loops.

Cut the yarn, leave a tail for sewing.

HAIR

Use grey yarn.

Ch 5. Start in second chain from the hook: slst in each back ridge loops [4].

Ch 6. Start in second chain from hook: slst in each back ridge loops (fig 27) [5].



ASSEMBLING:

Sew the ears to the head below the eyes as show on photos 28 and 29.



Sew the hair on the top of the head (fig 30).

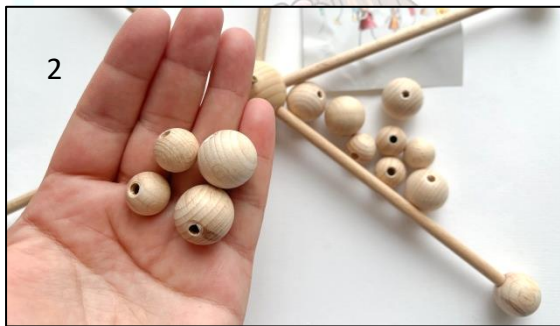


Sew the tail on the back of the body.
At last, sew the head to the body. You should start to sew the head from the front side of the middle (fig 31-35).





I used the baby mobile in 6 pieces, wood beads, thread and glue.



I secured the toys and clouds with few knots and hid the tails inside of the body.
