

# Daisy Doll Crochet Pattern

## MATERIALS

Yarn: Yarn for crochet amigurumi dolls.	+ Black for sewing eyelids and eyebrows
I used YarnArt Jeans:	Hook: 2.0mm
+ Skin: 73	Safety eyes: 8mm
+ White: 62	Sewing needles
+ Yellow: 35	Fiberfill
+ Green: 69	3 buttons 8mm + 2 buttons 5mm
+ Light green: 11	Soft wires 1.5mm
+ Brown: 40	

## THE SIZE OF THE PRODUCT

Finished doll measure approximately 30cm if similar materials are used and depending on the crochet hook size you use and your crochet tension too.

## ABBREVIATIONS

R: round/row	hdc: haft double crochet stitch
MR: magic ring	dc: double crochet stitch
ch: chain stitch	dc-inc: double crochet increase
slst: slip stitch	B: bobble stitch (4 dc)
sc: single crochet stitch	inc-4: 4 single crochet stitches in a same stitch
inc (increase): single crochet increase	FLO: front loops only
dec (decrease): single crochet decrease	BLO: back loops only

**I/ ARMS (make 2)**

*Work in spiral rounds. Don't stuff.*

**Use skin color yarn**

**Left arm:**

R1: MR, 6 sc

R2: 6 inc (12)

R3-4: 12 sc

R5: 1B, 11 sc

R6: (4 sc, dec)\*2 (10)

R7: (3 sc, dec)\*2 (8)

R8: 8 sc

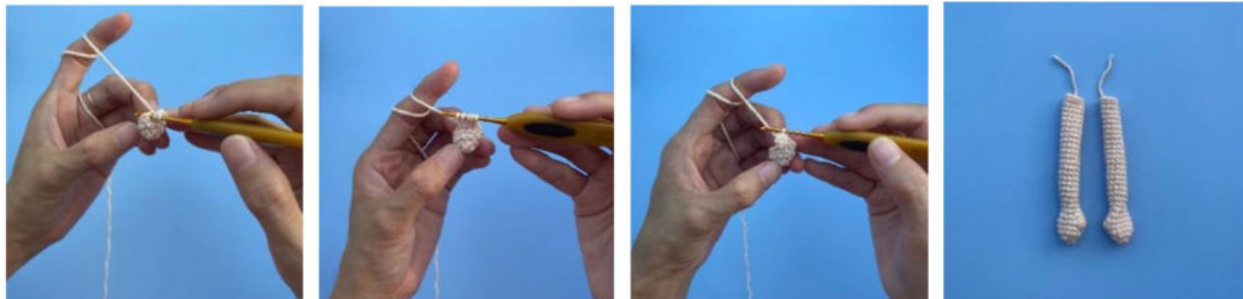
R9: (3 sc, inc)\*2 (10)

R10-28: 10 sc

Crochet 5 sc more (and 1 slst), the last stitch should be at the inside of the arm. Note the thumbs will be in front. Fasten off.

**Right arm:** Do same as the left arm until R28, slst. Fasten off.

**Note:** No need to stuff the arms, but when connect the arms to the body, stuff a bit at the shoulder to make it looks better.

**II/ LEGS (make 2)**

*Work in spiral rounds. Stuff as you go.*

**Left leg:**

**Start with skin color**

R1: Ch 6, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook: inc, 3 sc, inc-4, 3 sc, inc (14)

R2: 2 inc, 3 sc, 4 inc, 3 sc, 2 inc (22)

R3: (sc, inc)\*2, 3 sc, (sc, inc)\*2, (inc, sc)\*2, 3 sc, (inc, sc)\*2 (30)

R4-5: 30 sc

R6: 7 sc, (sc, dec)\*3, (dec, sc)\*3, 5 sc (24)

R7: 7 sc, 6 dec, 5 sc (18)

R8: 6 sc, 4 dec, 4 sc (14)

R9-24: 14 sc

R25: 7 sc, 4 hdc, 3 sc (14)

**Note:** To form the knee, 4 hdc must be at the center of the front.

R26: 3 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 3 sc (16)

R27: 16 sc

R28: (7 sc, inc)\*2 (18)

R29-36: 18 sc

### Change to white color

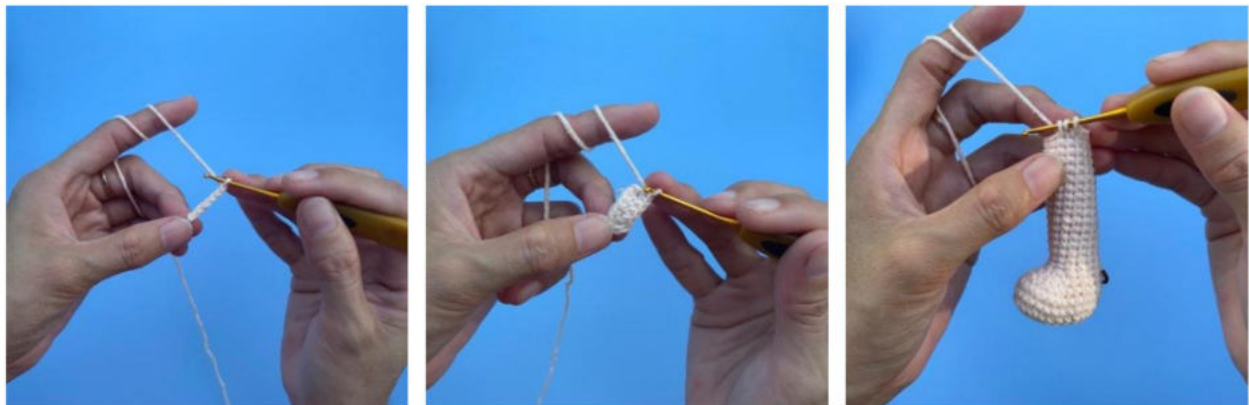
R37: BLO 18 sc

R38: 18 sc, slst.

Adjust how for the position of the last stitch is at the inside of the leg. Fasten off.

**Right leg:** Do same as the left leg but add more 10 sc (adjustable) to make the position of the last stitch is at the inside of the leg. Don't fasten off, continuing crochet to the body. Connect 2 legs with 3 chains.

**Ruffle of shorts:** Attach white yarn to R36, (ch 1, slst)\*18. Fasten off.





### III/ BODY

R1: 18 sc (left leg), 3 sc into 3 chains, 18 sc (right leg), 3 sc into 3 last chains (42)

R2: (6 sc, inc)\*6 (48)

R3-9: 48 sc. Leave white yarn to crochet ruffle of shorts.

**Ruffle of shorts:** 48 slst. Fasten off.

#### Change to skin color

R10: BLO 48 sc

R11: (6 sc, dec)\*6 (42)

R12: (5 sc, dec)\*6 (36)

R13-24: 36 sc

R25: 8 sc, 4sc (join with left arm), 14 sc, 4 sc (join with right arm), 6 sc (36)

R26: 8 sc, 6 sc (on left arm), 14 sc on the chest, 6 sc (on right arm), 6 sc (40)

**Note:** The position of the 2 thumbs should be in front and 2 arms should be even on the body.

R27: 40 sc

R28: (4 sc, dec, 4 sc)\*4 (36)

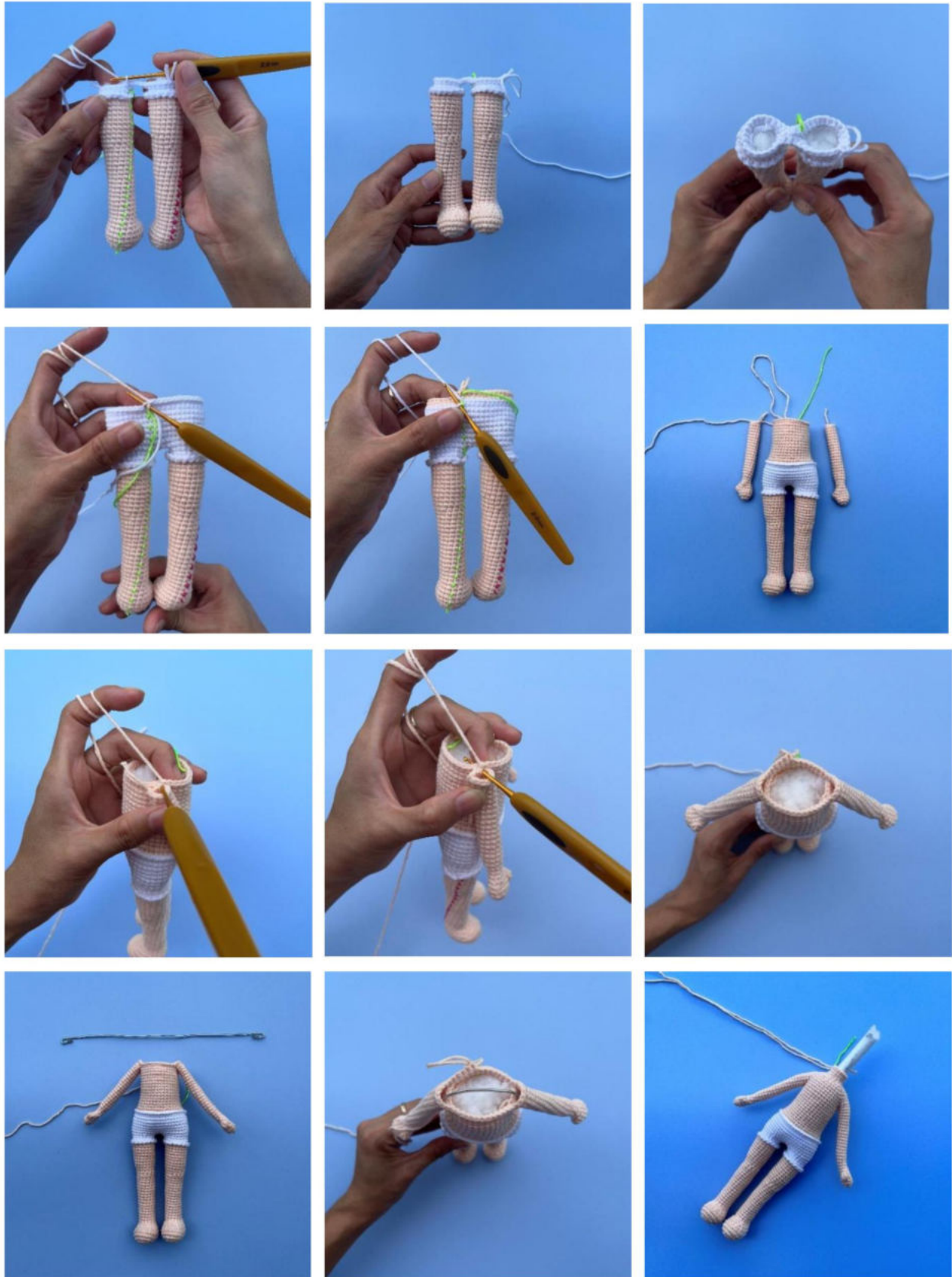
R29: (2 sc, dec, 2 sc)\*6 (30)

R30: (3sc, dec)\*6 (24)

R31: (sc, dec, sc)\*6 (18)

R32-35: 18 sc

Fasten off. Leave a long tail for sewing.



**IV/ EARS (make 2)***Work in rows.***Use skin color**

R1: MR, 3 sc, turn

R2: Ch 1, 3 inc (6)

Fasten off. Leave a long tail for sewing.

R1: MR, 8 sc

R2: 8 inc (16)

R3: (sc, inc)\*8 (24)

R4: (3 sc, inc)\*6 (30)

R5: 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc)\*5, 2 sc (36)

R6: (5 sc, inc)\*6 (42)

R7: 3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc)\*5, 3 sc (48)

R8: (7 sc, inc)\*6 (54)

R9: 4 sc, inc, (8 sc, inc)\*5, 4 sc (60)

R10: (9 sc, inc)\*6 (66)

R11-20: 66 sc

R21: 5 sc, inc, (10 sc, inc)\*5, 5 sc (72)

R22: (11 sc, inc)\*6 (78)

R23-24: 78 sc

R25: (11 sc, dec)\*6 (72)

R26: 5 sc, dec, (10 sc, dec)\*5, 5 dec (66)

R27: (9 sc, dec)\*6 (60)

R28: 4 sc, dec, (8 sc, dec)\*5, 4 dec (54)

R29: (7 sc, dec)\*6 (48)

R30: 3 sc, dec, (6 sc, dec)\*5, 3 sc (42)

R31: (5 sc, dec)\*6 (36)

R32: 18 dec. Fasten off.

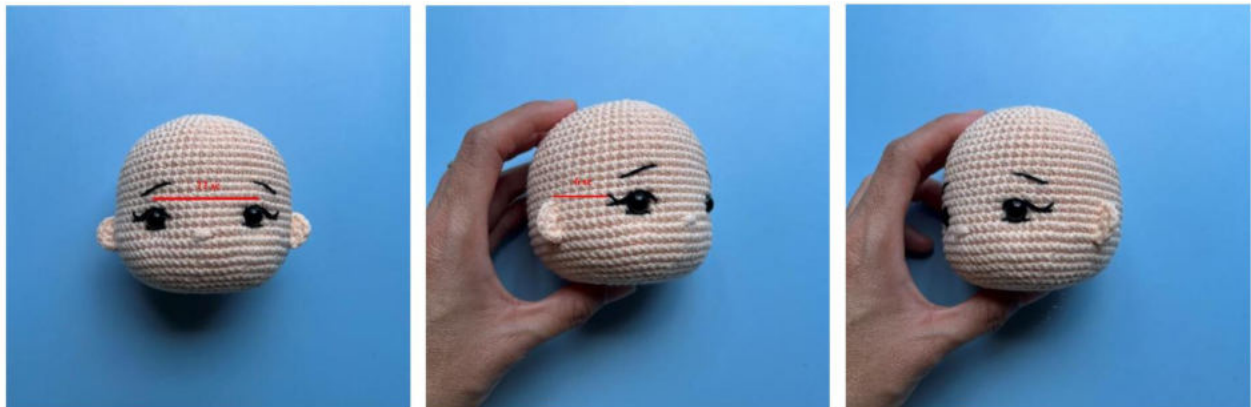
*Insert the eyes between R20 and R21, the distance is 12 stitches.*

*Make eyes indents on doll: [https://youtu.be/Ltj6pHI\\_trw](https://youtu.be/Ltj6pHI_trw)*

*Sew ears at the same level as the upper eyelid, 6 stitches from the outer lash line.*

*Embroider eyebrow with 1 stitch high, 4 stitches wide, 4 rows from the eye hole.*

*Embroider nose with 2 stitches wide, 2 rows from the eye hole.*



## VI/ HAIR

**Use yellow yarn**

**+ Hair loop around the head (32 strands: 16 long strands and 16 short strands are interlaced)**

Ch 64, slst to close the round. Ch 1, 64 sc, slst.

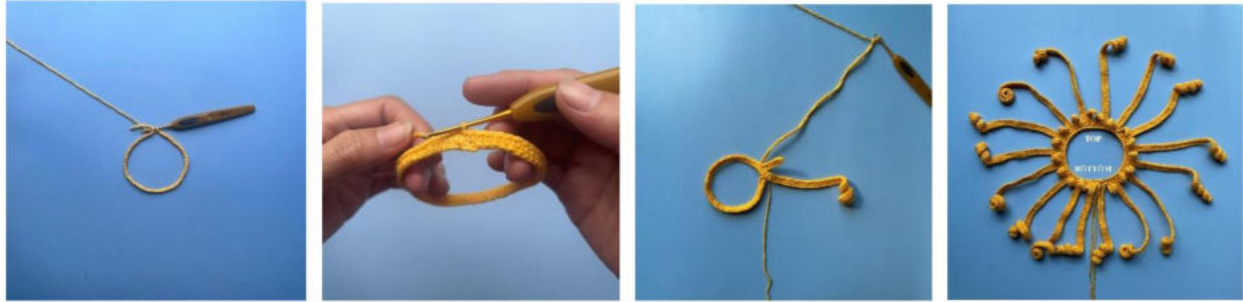
Don't fasten off, continue to crochet strands.

**Long strand:** Ch 60, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook: slst, sc, 57 hdc, 2 slst.

**Short strand:** Ch 10, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook: slst, sc, 7 hdc, 2 slst.



Crochet alternately one long strand and one short strands 8 times (long strand first, short strand later). Crochet the other half similar but symmetrical (crochet short first, long yarn later).



### + Bangs (8 strands)

Ch 7, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook:

**Strand 1:** Slst, ch 25, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook: slst, sc, 22 hdc, slst on the next stitch.

**Strand 2:** Slst, ch 35, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook: slst, sc, 32 hdc, slst on the next stitch.

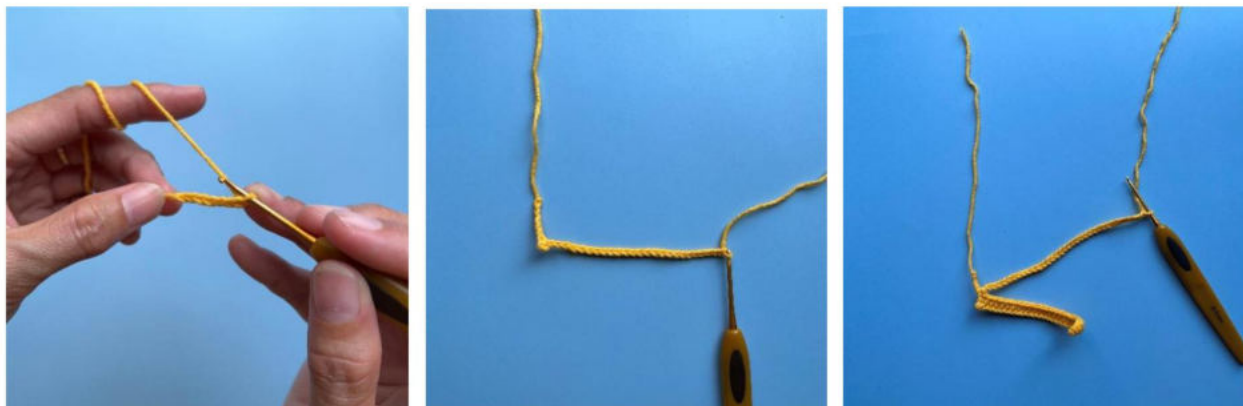
**Strand 3:** Slst, ch 25, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook: slst, sc, 22 hdc, slst on the next stitch.

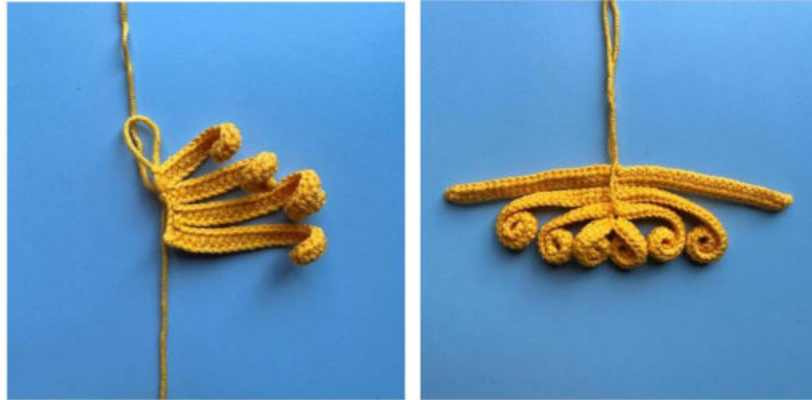
**Strand 4-5:** (Ch 20, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook: slst, sc, 17 hdc, slst)\*2.

**Strand 6:** Ch 25, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook: slst, sc, 2 hdc, slst on the next stitch.

**Strand 7:** Slst, ch 35, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook: slst, sc, 32 hdc, slst on the next stitch.

**Strand 8:** Slst, ch 25, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook: slst, sc, 22 hdc, slst on the next stitch. Fasten off. Leave a long tail for sewing.





### + Hair parting at the back of the head (24 strands)

Ch 25, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook: slst.

**Long strand:** Ch 60, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook: slst, sc, 57 hdc, 2 slst.

**Short strand:** Ch 12, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook: slst, sc, 9 hdc, 2 slst.

Crochet alternately one long strand and one short strands 6 times (long strand first, short strand later). Crochet the other half similar but symmetrical (crochet short first, long yarn later).



## VII/ HAIR TIE (make 2)

### Use green yarn

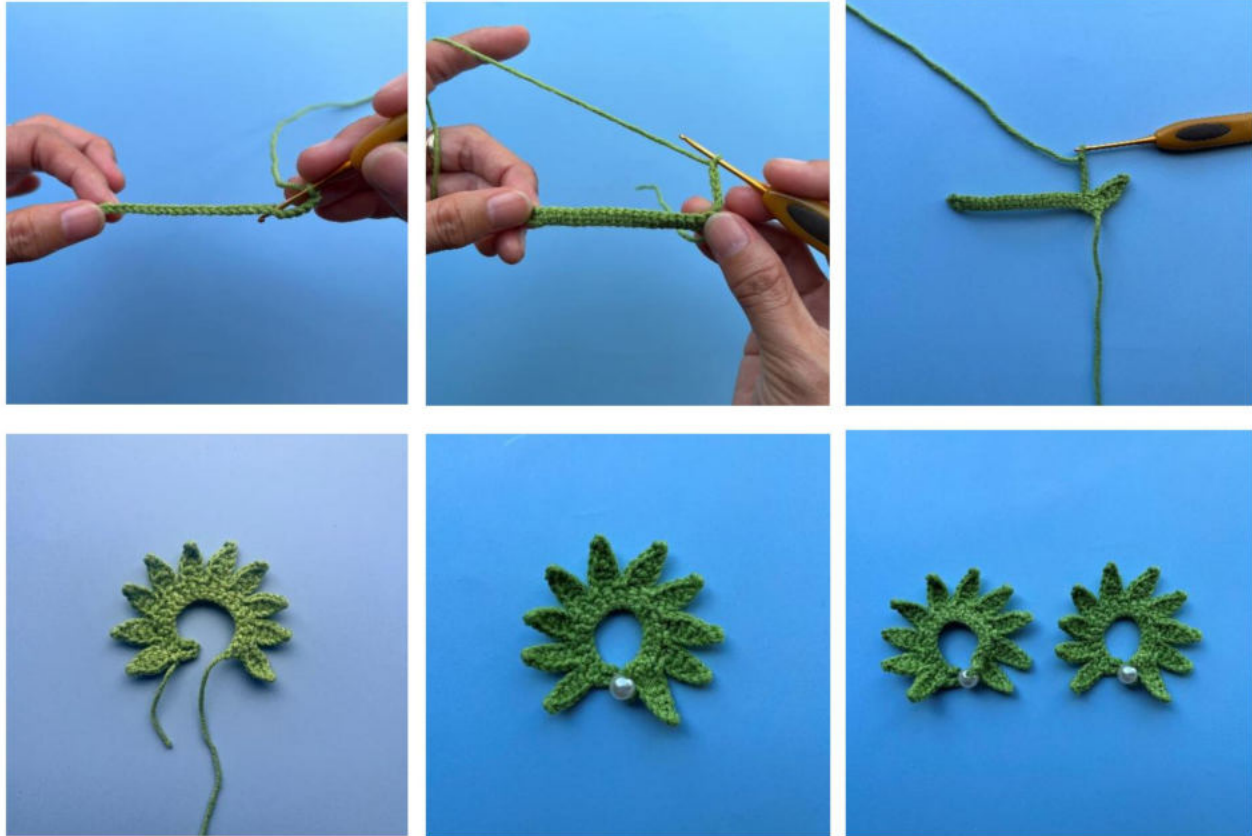
Leave a long tail to sew the buttons.

Ch 20 + ch 6 (make hole), start to crochet on the seventh chain from the hook:

R1: 20 sc, turn

R2: (Ch 6, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook: slst, sc, hdc, 2 dc, 2 slst)\*10.

Fasten off. Sew buttons.



### ASSEMBLY AND FINISH THE DOLL

Put hair loop on the head (4 rows from the top of the head and 4 rows from the nape). Divide the hair loop into 2 sections, each with 16 strands (8 long strands, 8 short strands) then use pins to fix 4 corners (top of head, nape and ears). Sew/glue these 4 corners.

Use pins to fix the parting line then sew the 2 ends (top of head and nape). Use double yarn to go through the 14 ends of the short strands (8 strands on the loop hair and 8 strands on the parting), tighten, fasten off. Use other double yarn to loop around the 14 long strands (8 strands on the loop hair and 8 strands on the parting) then tie the bun, fasten off. Do the same for the other side.

Sew/glue to fix the bangs.





## VIII/ DRESS

### + SKIRT

#### Start with light green yarn

Crochet the first round of the skirt then turn up to crochet the bodice, then go back to crochet the second round of the skirt until the end.

Ch 104, slst to close the round.

R1: Ch 2, 104 dc, slst.

R2: Ch 2, (6 dc, dc-inc, 6 dc)\*8, slst (112)

R3: Ch 2, (13 dc, dc-inc)\*8, slst (120)

R4: Ch 2, (7 dc, dc-inc, 7 dc)\*8, slst (128)

R5: Ch 2, (15 dc, dc-inc)\*8, slst (136)

R6: Ch 2, (8 dc, dc-inc, 8 dc)\*8, slst (144)

R7: Ch 2, (17 dc, dc-inc)\*8, slst (152)

R8: Ch 2, (9 dc, dc-inc, 9 dc)\*8, slst (160)

#### Change to green yarn

R9: Ch 1, (17 sc, inc)\*8, slst (168)

Fasten off. Crochet 1-2 rounds more depending on the desired dress length.

**+ BODICE**

Turn upside down, attach green yarn

R1: Ch 1, 104 sc, slst to close the round.

R2: Ch 1, (5-4-1, 6-3-2, sc, 1-4-5, 2-3-6)\*8 (8 pleated clusters, each set of 13 stitches collects into 5 stitches), slst (40).

**Hook formula:**

+ 5-4-1: insert the hook down to the 5th stitch, back to the 4th stitch and the 1st stitch.

+ 1-4-5: insert the hook down to the 1st stitch, go to the 4th stitch and the 5th stitch.

+ 6-3-2: insert the hook down to the 6th stitch, the 3rd stitch and the 2nd stitch.

+ 2-3-6: insert the hook down to the 2nd stitch, the 3rd stitch and the 6th stitch.

***Note:** The bodice has rows that **skip the first stitch (alternating)** and still ensure enough 40 stitches per row, this helps to make the back seam of the bodice more aligned. If you crochet into the base of the chain for all rows or skip the first stitch in all rows, the back seam of the bodice will slanted to one side.*

R3: Ch 1, BLO 40 hdc, turn.

R4: Ch 2, slst on the 40th stitch (FLO) of R3, (ch 2, slst on the next stitch)\*39, turn, slst on the **second stitch** (FLO) of R3.

R5: Ch 1, BLO 40 hdc, turn.

R6: Ch 2, slst on the 40th stitch (FLO) of R5, (ch 2, slst on the next stitch)\*39, turn, slst on the first stitch (BLO) of R5.

R7: Ch 1, BLO 40 hdc, turn.

R8: Ch 2, slst on the 40th stitch (FLO) of R7, (ch 2, slst on the next stitch)\*39, turn, slst on the **second stitch** (BLO) of R7.

R9: Ch 1, BLO 40 hdc, turn.

R10: Ch 2, slst on the 40th stitch (FLO) of R9, (ch 2, slst on the next stitch)\*39, turn, slst on the first stitch (BLO) of R9.

R11: Ch 1, BLO 40 hdc, turn.

R12: Ch 2, slst on the 40th stitch (FLO) of R11, (ch 2, slst on the next stitch)\*39, turn, slst on the **second stitch** (BLO) of R11.

R13: Ch 1, BLO 40 hdc, turn.

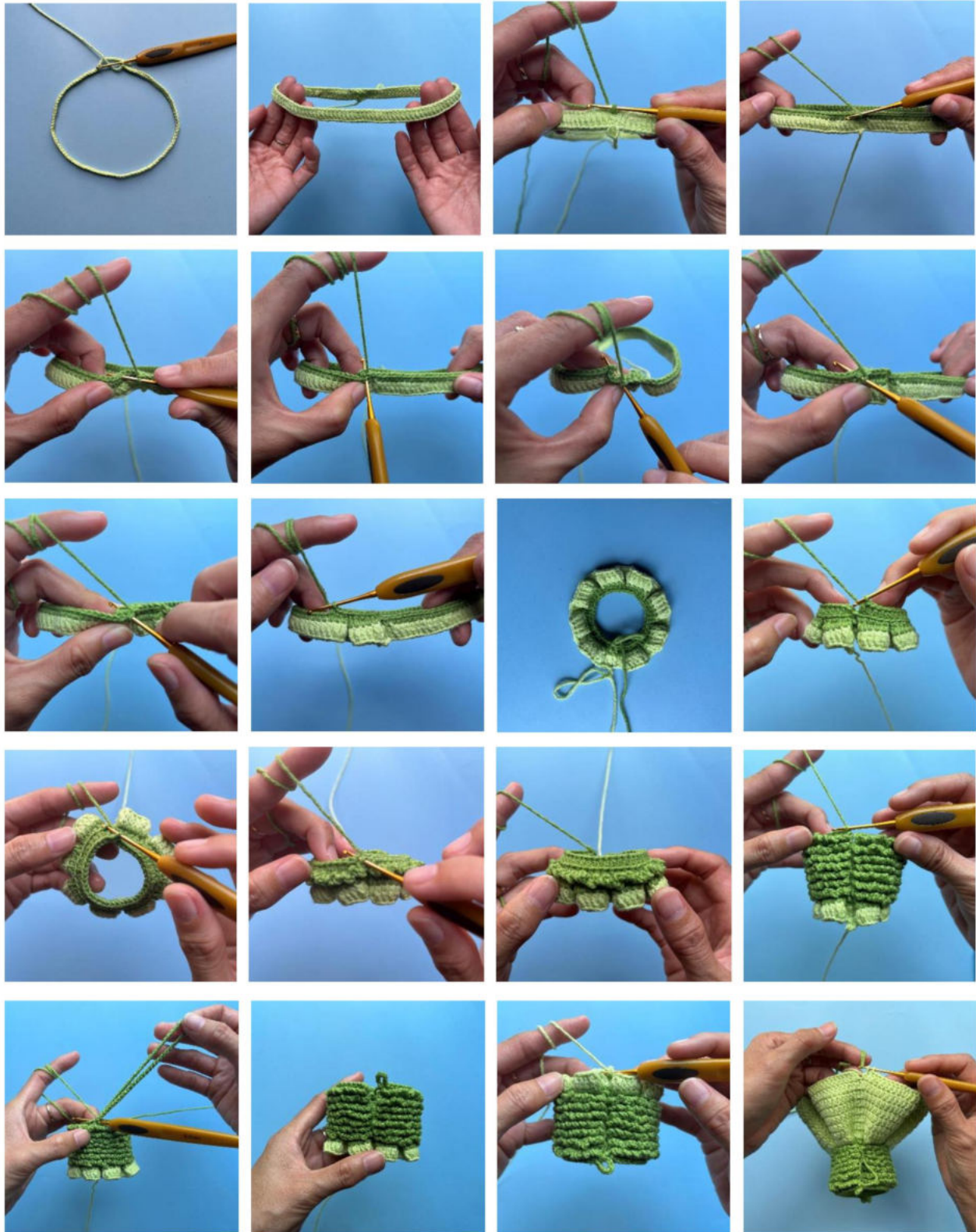
R14: Ch 2, slst on the 40th stitch (FLO) of R13, (ch 2, slst on the next stitch)\*39, turn, slst on the first stitch (BLO) of R13.

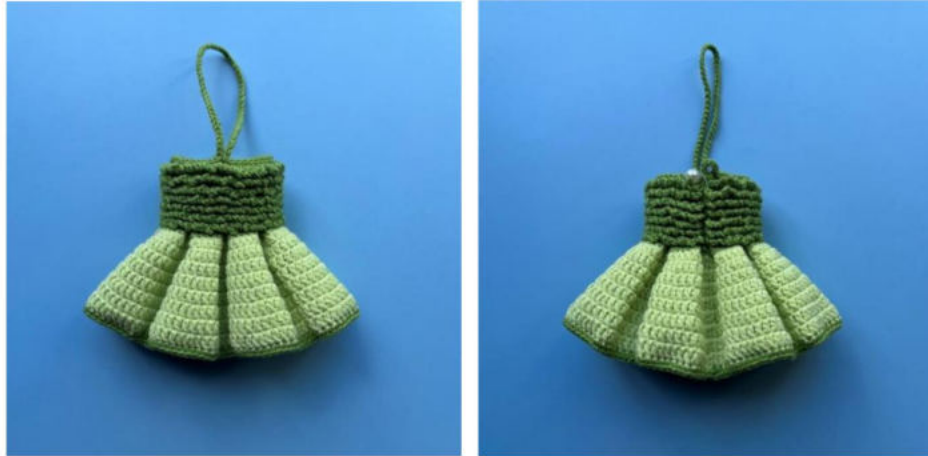
R15: Ch 1, BLO 40 sc, turn.

R16: Ch 2, slst on the 40th stitch (FLO) of R15, (ch 2, slst on the next stitch)\*39, turn, slst on the

first stitch of R15.

R17: 20 slst, ch 60, slst on the first stitch, 20slst + ch 6 (make hole), slst. Fasten off.





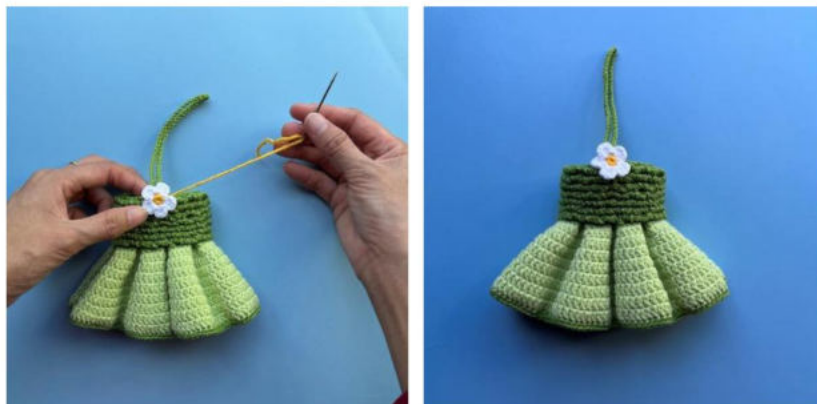
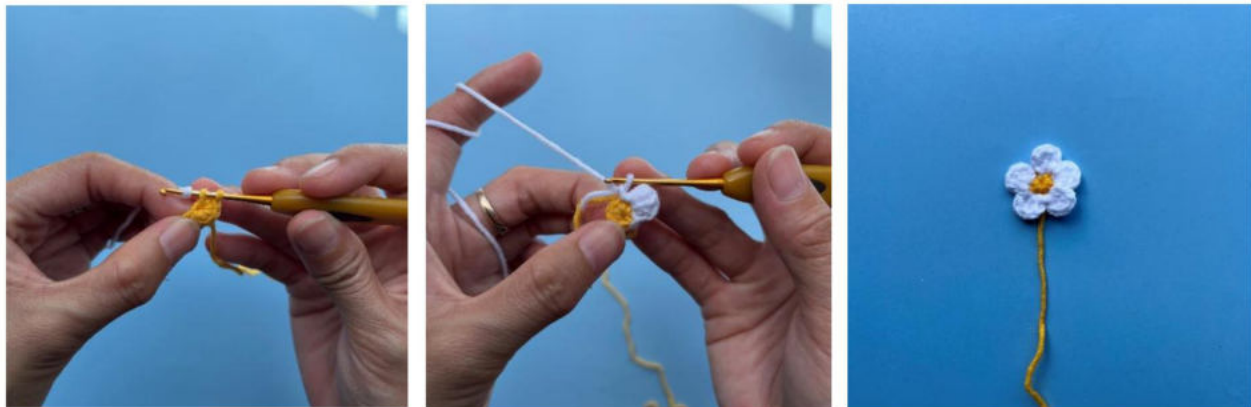
**+ DAISY FLOWER**

**Start with yellow yarn**

Ch 5, slst.

**Change to white yarn**

(Ch 2, 3 dc in a same stitch, 2 slst)\*5. Fasten off. Leave a long tail for sewing.





**IX/ SHOES (make 2)****Start with light green yarn**

R1: Ch 6, start to crochet on the second chain from the hook: inc, 3 sc, inc-4, 3 sc, inc (14)

R2: 2 inc, 3 sc, 4 inc, 3 sc, 2 inc (22)

R3: (sc, inc)\*2, 3 sc, (sc, inc)\*2, (inc, sc)\*2, 3 sc, (inc, sc)\*2 (30)

R4: (inc, 2 sc)\*2, 2 sc, hdc, (hdc-inc, 2 hdc)\*2, (2 hdc, hdc-inc)\*2, hdc, 2 sc, (2 sc, inc) (38)

Leave light green yarn to crochet welting: 38 slst. Fasten off.

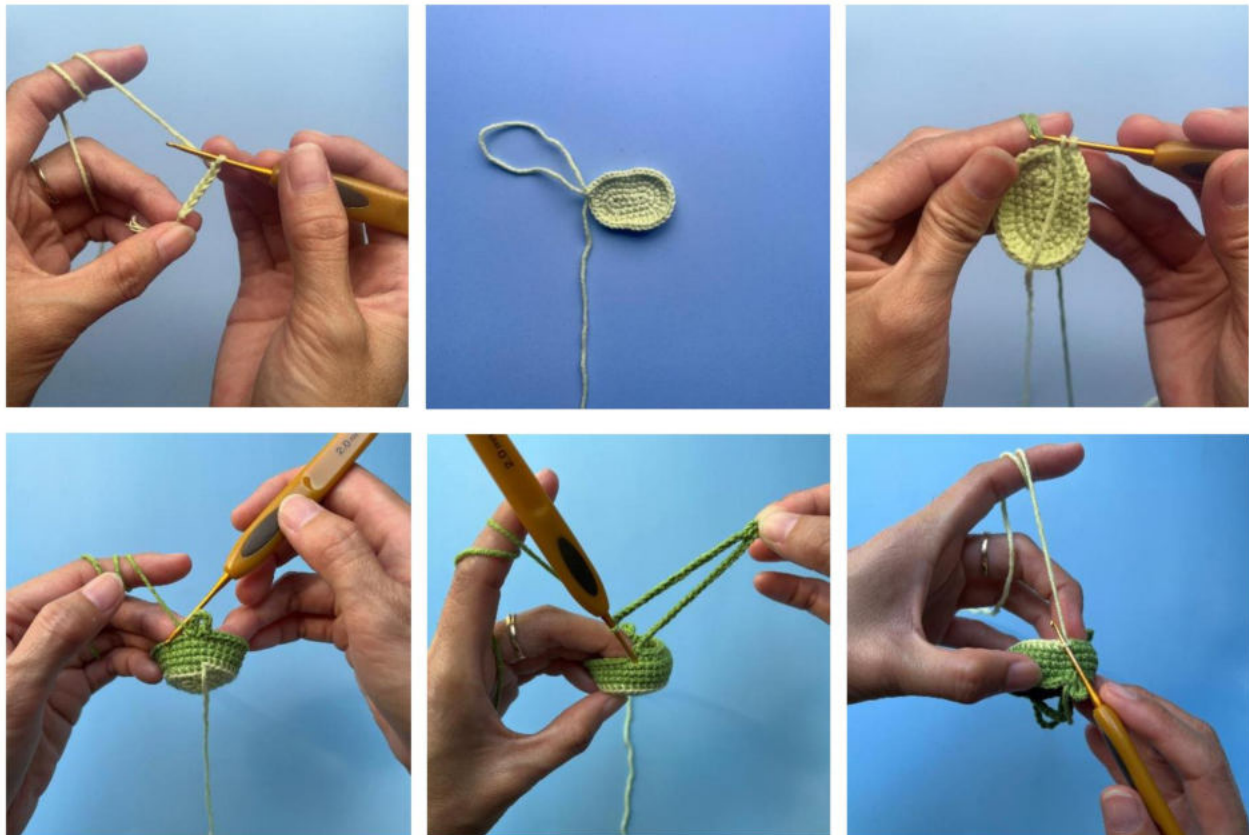
**Change to green yarn**

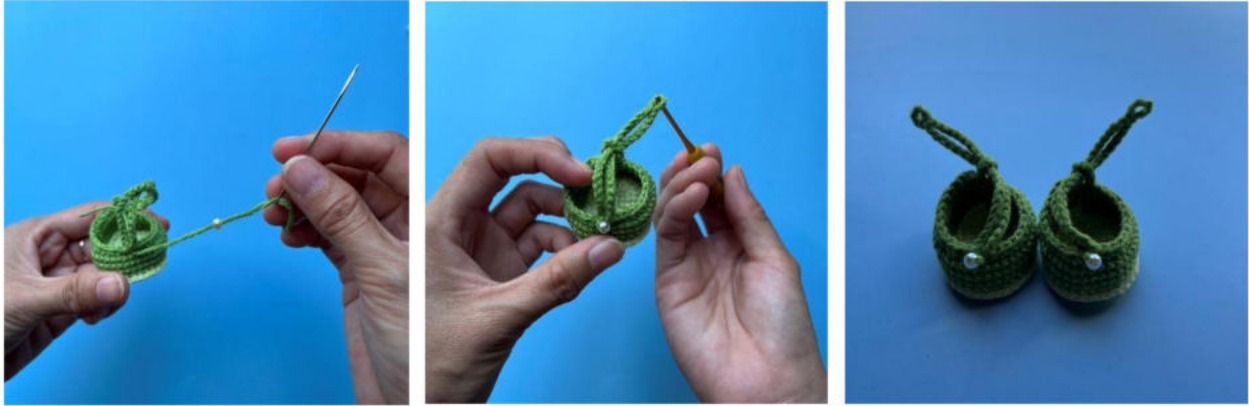
R5: BLO 38 sc

R6-8: 38 sc

R9: sc, ch 6 (make hole), slst on the first stitch, sc, (sc, dec)\*6, ch 20 + ch 4 (make hole), slst on the fifth chain from the hook, ch 20, slst on the first stitch, (dec, sc)\*6 (26), slst.

Fasten off. Sew buttons.



**X/ BEE****+ HEAD and BODY**

*Work in spiral rounds. Stuff as you go.*

**Start with yellow yarn**

R1: MR, 8 sc

R2: 8 inc (16)

R3: (sc, inc)\*8 (24)

R4: (3 sc, inc)\*6 (30)

R5-8: 30 sc

R9: (3 sc, dec)\*6 (24)

R10: (2 sc, dec)\*6 (18)

R11: (sc, dec)\*6 (12)

**Change to brown yarn**

R12: BLO 12 inc (24)

**Change to yellow yarn**

R13-15: 24 sc

**Change to brown yarn**

R16: (2 sc, dec)\*6 (18)

**Change to yellow yarn**

R17: 18 sc

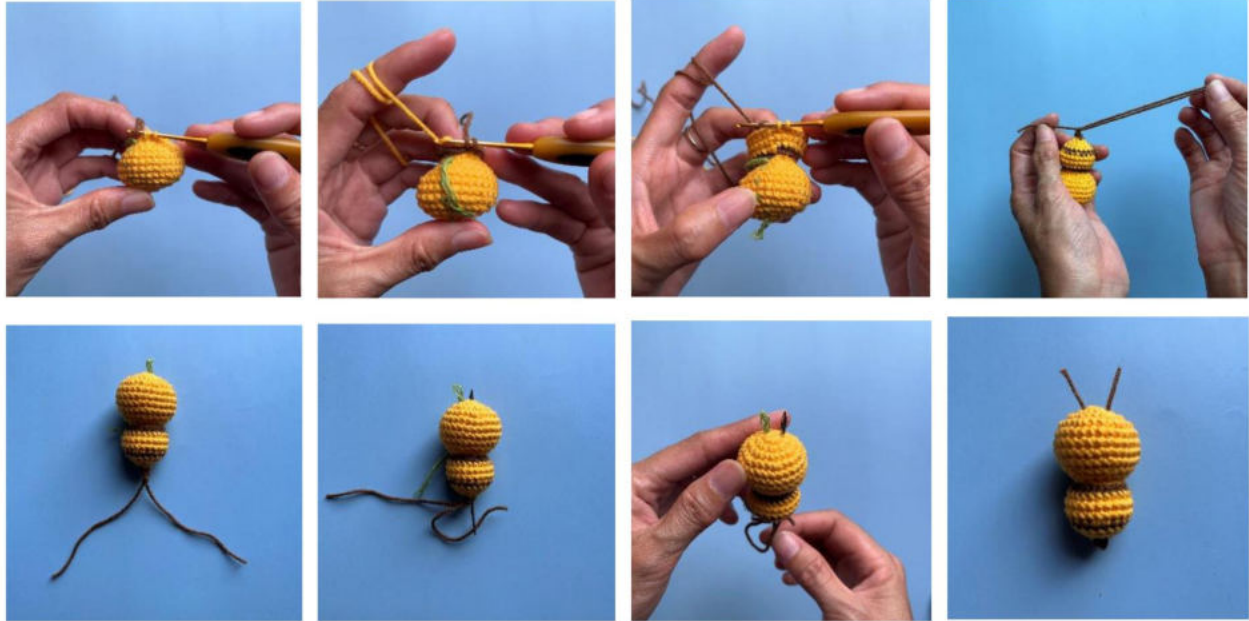
R18: (sc, dec)\*6 (12)

R19: 6 dec

**Change to brown yarn**

R20: 3 dec

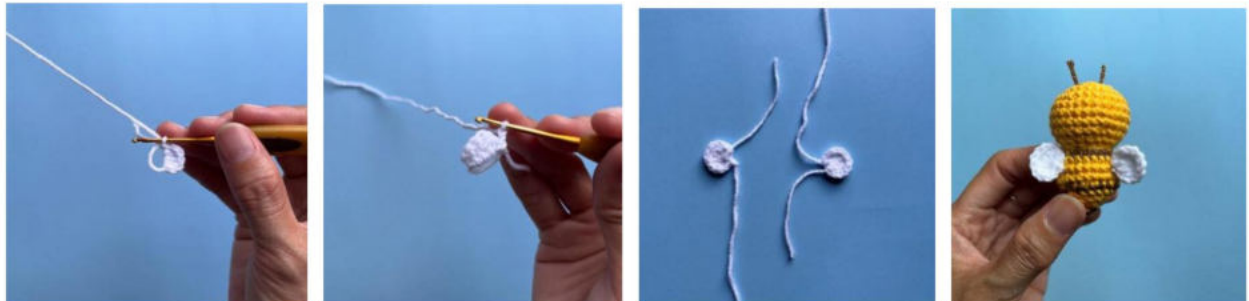
Fasten off. Leave 2 long pieces of brown yarn for the bee's antenaes.

**+ WINGS (make 2)****Use white yarn**

R1: MR, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 2, slst, turn.

R2: Ch 2, 3 inc, ch 2, slst.

Fasten off. Leave a long tail for sewing.

**+ BIB****Use light green**

Ch 20, start to crochet on the third chain from the hook: sc, (ch 2, sc on the next stitch)\*repeat to end. Fasten off. Leave a long tail for sewing.

Separate the black yarn to embroider the bee's eyes in between R5 and R6, the distance between the eyes is 4 stitches.

Separate the red yarn to embroider the bee's mouth in between R7 and R8, 2 stitches wide.
