# LEMON THE GOLDEN CAT

Yellow & White Color



# **SKILL LEVEL:**

Rnd: round

Ch: chain stitch slst: slip stitch

sc: single crochet stitch st, sts: stitch, stitches

dec: single crochet 2 stitches in front loops together

inc: single crochet 2 stitches in same sc

hdc: half double crochet stitch

dc: double crochet stitch

inc-tr: tripble crochet increase

BLO: crochet through back loops only

<...>: join the < c o I o r > yarn

( ....) x .... : repeat instructions in braces ....times

NOTE:

when changing color and join yarn:

- Work in the previous color yarn until two loops of the last stitch remain on the hook.
- Use the new color yarn to complete the stitch, continue working with the new color yarn.

Do not cut color yarn that will be needed later on.

I use black thread or smaller black yarn for embroidering.

It's highly recommended that you read through the pattern completely before beginning to crochet.

# **MATERIALS**

# Worsted yarn

Yellow yarn
White yarn



Crochet Hook 2.5mm

Stuffing Fiberfill

Safety Eyes black 10mm x 2

SIZE: 17 cm (6.8 inches)
(If using fingering weight yarn on a 2.5mm crochet hook)



## **HEAD**

#### Begin with yellow yarn:

Rnd 1: 9 Chain, 1 sc on the 2nd chain from the hook, 6 sc, 3 sc in the last st, 6 sc on the other side of the chain, 1 inc in the last st [18]

Rnd 2: 1 inc, 6 sc, 3 inc, 6 sc, 2 inc [24]

Rnd 3: 1 sc, 1 inc, 7 sc, 1 inc, (1 sc, 1 inc) x 2, 6 sc,

(1 sc, 1 inc) x 2 [30]

Rnd 4: 2 sc, 1 inc, 8 sc, 1 inc, (2 sc, 1 inc) x 2, 6 sc,

(2 sc, 1 inc) x 2 [36]

Rnd 5: (5 sc, 1 inc) x 6 [42]

Rnd 6: (6 sc, 1 inc) x 6 [48]

Rnd 7: <yellow> 9 sc, <white> 1 sc, <yellow> 38 sc [48]

Rnd 8: <yellow> 8 sc, <white> 3 sc, <yellow> 37 sc [48]

Rnd 9: <yellow> 8 sc, <white> 4 sc, <yellow> 36 sc [48]

Rnd 10: <yellow> 8 sc, <white> 4 sc, <yellow> 36 sc [48]

Rnd 11: <yellow> (2 sc, 1 inc) x 2, 2 sc, <white> 1 inc,

2 sc, 1 inc, <yellow> (2 sc, 1 inc) x 12 [64]

Rnd 12: <yellow> 10 sc, <white> 7 sc, <yellow> 47 sc [64]

Rnd 13: <yellow> 7 sc, <white> 13 sc, <yellow> 44 sc [64]

Rnd 14: <yellow> 6 sc, <white> 15 sc, <yellow> 43 sc [64]

Rnd 15: <yellow> 5 sc, <white> 17 sc, <yellow> 42 sc [64]

Rnd 16: <yellow> 5 sc, <white> 17 sc, <yellow> 42 sc [64]

Rnd 17: <yellow> 5 sc, <white> 17 sc, <yellow> 42 sc [64]

Rnd 18: <yellow> 5 sc, <white> 1 sc, 1 dec, 6 sc, 1 dec, 6 sc,

<yellow> 1 dec, (6 sc, 1 dec) x 5 [56]

Insert the safety eyes between rounds 11 and 12,

with an interspace of 8 stitches.

Rnd 19: <yellow> 5 sc, <white> 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec, 5 sc,

<yellow> 1 dec, (5 sc, 1 dec) x 5 [48]

Rnd 20: <yellow> 4 sc, 1 dec, <white> 4 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc,

<yellow> 1 dec, (4 sc, 1 dec) x 5 [40]

Rnd 21: BLO [<yellow> 3 sc, 1 dec, <white> (3 sc, 1 dec) x 2,

<yellow> (3 sc, 1 dec) x 5] [32]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Fill the head with stuffing material.





















# **SNOUT**

Begin with white yarn:

Rnd 1: 5 Chain, 1 inc on the 2nd chain FROM THE HOOK,

2 sc on the chain, (1 inc + 1 inc-hdc on last st),

2 sc on the other side of the chain, 1 inc-hdc in the

last st [12]


Rnd 2: 1 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc, 1 inc-hdc, 1 sc, 2 slst,

1 sc, 1 inc-hdc [16]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Embroider snout same picture with black thread.

Sew the snout to the head between Rnd 13 and 16.















# **EARS**

Begin with yellow yarn:

Rnd 1: 4 sc in the magic ring [4]

Rnd 2: (1 sc, 1 inc) x 2 [6]

Rnd 3: (1 sc, 1 inc) x 3 [9]

Rnd 4: 9 sc [9]

Rnd 5: (2 sc, 1 inc) x 3 [12]

Rnd 6: (5 sc, 1 inc) x 2 [14]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew the ear to the head between Rnd 2 and 8.



# COLLAR

Begin with red yarn:

Rnd 1: Chain 61

Rnd 2: 1 slst on the 2nd chain from the hook,

15 slst, 4 sc, 5 hdc, 4 dc, 2 inc-tr, 4 dc, 5 hdc,

4 sc, 16 sist [60]





# **LEGS**

Begin with white yarn:

Rnd 1: 8 sc in the magic ring [8]

Rnd 2: 8 inc [16]

Rnd 3: (3 sc, 1 inc) x 4 [20]

Rnd 4: 4 sc, (1 sc, 1 dec) x 4, 4 sc [16]

Rnd 5: 4 sc, 4 dec, 4 sc [12]

Rnd 6: sc in all 12 st [12]

Rnd 7: (3 sc, 1 inc) x 3 [15]

Rnd 8 - Rnd 12: sc in all 15 st [15]

Rnd 13: 2 sc [2]

Fasten off.









# **PAWS**

Begin with white yarn:

Rnd 1: 6 sc in the magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: 6 inc [12]

Rnd 3: (2 sc, 1 inc) x 4 [16]

Rnd 4 - Rnd 5: sc in all 16 st [16]

Rnd 6: 8 dec [8]

Work the next through both layers.

Rnd 7: 4 sc [4]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew the paw on rnd 5 the body.









# BODY

Begin with yellow yarn:

Rnd 1: 9 Chain, 1 sc on the 2nd chain from the hook,

6 sc, 4 sc in the last st, 6 sc on the other side of the

chain, 3 sc in the last st [20]

Rnd 2: 1 inc, 3 sc, 1 inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 7 sc, 2 inc [27]

Rnd 3: 1 sc, 1 inc, (4 sc, 1 inc) x 2, (sc, 1 inc) x 2, 7 sc,

(sc, 1 inc) x 2 [34]

Rnd 4: 1 sc, 1 inc, (5 sc, 1 inc) x 2, (2 sc, 1 inc) x 2, 9 sc,

1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc [41]

Rnd 5: BLO [8 sc, 2 inc, 10 sc, 2 inc, 15 sc, 2 inc, 2 sc] [47]

Rnd 6: (2 sc, 1 inc) x 8, 19 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc [57]

Rnd 7 - Rnd 9: sc in all 57 st [57]

Rnd 10: 26 sc, 3 dec, 19 sc, 3 dec [51]

Rnd 11: (4 sc, 1 dec) x 4, 8 sc, 1 dec, 7 sc, 1 dec, 8 sc [45]

Rnd 12: 29 sc, 5 sist through leg 1 and body, 2 sc, 5 sist through leg 1 and body, 4 sc [45]

Rnd 13: <yellow> 28 sc, <white> 1 inc, 10 sc on leg 1, 2 sc, 10 sc on leg 2, 1 inc, <yellow> 3 sc [57]

Rnd 14: <yellow> 29 sc, <white> 1 inc, 9 sc, 2 dec, 9 sc, 1 inc, <yellow> 4 sc [57]

Rnd 15: <yellow> (1 dec, 4 sc) x 5, <white> 10 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc, <yellow> 5 sc [51]

Rnd 16: <yellow> 26 sc, <white> 20 sc, <yellow> 5 sc [51]

Rnd 17: <yellow> (1 dec, 7 sc) x 3, <white> 18 sc, <yellow> 6 sc [48]

Rnd 18: <yellow> 24 sc, <white> 18 sc, <yellow> 6 sc [48]

Rnd 19: <yellow> (4 sc, 1 dec) x 4, 1 sc, <white> 3 sc, 1 dec, (4 sc, 1 dec) x 2, <yellow> 4 sc, 1 dec [40]

Rnd 20: <yellow> 22 sc, <white> 13 sc, <yellow> 5 sc [40]

Rnd 21: <yellow> 22 sc, <white> 13 sc, <yellow> 5 sc [40]

Fill the body with stuffing material.

Rnd 22: <yellow> (3 sc, 1 dec) x 4, 3 sc, <white> 1 dec, (3 sc, 1 dec) x 2, <yellow> 3 sc, 1 dec [32]

Rnd 23: <yellow> 19 sc, <white> 9 sc, <yellow> 4 sc [32]

Fasten off.


Fill the body with stuffing material.











# **TAIL**

Begin with white yarn:

Rnd 1: 6 sc in the magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: 6 inc [12]

Rnd 3: (1 sc, 1 inc) x 6 [18]

Rnd 4: (2 sc, 1 inc) x 6 [24]

Rnd 5 - Rnd 6: sc in all 24 st [24]

Change yellow yarn:

Rnd 7: 24 sc [24]

Rnd 8: (6 sc, 1 dec) x 3 [21]

Rnd 9 - Rnd 10: sc in all 21 st [21]

Rnd 11: (5 sc, 1 dec) x 3 [18]

Rnd 12 - Rnd 17: sc in all 18 st [18]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew the tail to the body between round 7 and 11.

















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
