THIS PATTERN IS SUITABLE FOR THOSE WITH BEGINNER CROCHET SKILLS AND HAVE KNOWLEDGE OF MAGIC RING/CIRCLE, CROCHETING IN SPIRALS, CHAIN, SINGLE CROCHET, DOUBLE CROCHET, SINGLE CROCHET INCREASE AND INVISIBLE DECREASE, BASIC SEWING TECHNIQUES.

THE TOY ISN'T SUITABLE FOR VERY SMALL CHILDREN, OR ONES WHO PLAY ROUGH!

**Marker** – it is the mark of the beginning of the row - i.e. the place, where ends one row and begins the next one. I use a thin contrast thread as a marker. The marker is thrown in the process of crocheting from the right side to the wrong side and from the wrong side to the right side and is placed between the last stitch of one row and the first stitch of the next row.

As a rule the toys are crocheted in a spiral: without sl st and ch. At the same time the beginning of the row moves to the right step by step. That's why it is necessary to align the marker.

In the description of the details I point the place where the marker should go, for example, along the middle of the back part of the leg.

As soon as you've noticed that the marker moved from the middle, you should crochet a shift stitch.

I.e. you crochet the row to the end and crochet the first stitch of the next row, and put the marker here. The number of stitches in the row is the same!

### ABBREVIATIONS

ch – chain

sc – single crochet

dc – double crochet

sl st – slip stitch

dec – decrease, crochet 2 stitches together

incdc – increase, crochet 2 dc in one stitch

inc – increase, crochet 2 sc in one stitch

dec dc – decrease, crochet 2 dc together

hdc – half double crochet

inc hdc – crochet two hdc in one stitch

( )x X – repeat those in brackets x times

(number) – the number of stitches in a row

## necessary materials

1. Yarn Gazzal cotton baby (60% cotton, 40% acrylic. 50 rp/225 m light blue, light pink, light yellow, cream-colored, white, brown, light orange)
2. The hook № 1.75,
3. beads
4. Stuffing (synthetic fluff or hollufayber)
5. A wire for the frame, an adhesive plaster on a fabric basis or a paper sticky tape 2 cm wide
6. A thin plastic for strengthening of the sole.
7. 5 mm black eyes
8. transparent glue
9. decorative ribbon or lace

## legs

Yarn gazzal cotton baby brown

6 ch

1 rnd: in the second loop from the hook 3 sc, 3 sc, in the last loop of the chain 3 sc, 3 sc. put the marker (12)

2 rnd : inc×3, 3 sc, inc×3, 3 sc (18)

3 rnd: (inc, sc)×3, 3 sc, (inc, sc)×3, 3 sc (24)

4 rnd: (inc, 2 sc)×3, 3 sc, (inc, 2 sc)×3, 3 sc (30)

\*I advice to crochet the legs simultaneously. Crochet one foot, crochet the second one right away. Then the gauge appeared to be similar and the legs will be of the equal size

Put the crocheted foot on a sheet of a cardboard and outline it with pencil.

Step 2 mm inside from the contour and draw one more contour. Cut the cardboard along the inner contour.

The received template should be a little bit smaller than the foot.

Take a plastic, fix a cardboard template on a plastic with the help of the a sticky tape and cut out the insole

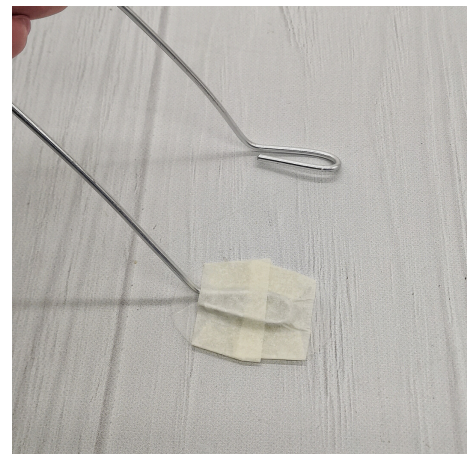
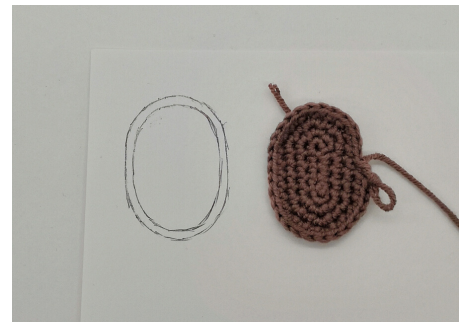
Try on the insole. If necessary you can cut it a little

Take a wire

Cut a piece approx. 25 cm ( 9.84 inches) long

Make a loop approx. 2 cm ( 0.8 inches) long at the end of a wire

With the help of an adhesive plaster fix this loop on the insole



5 rnd: 30 sc for the back loops only  
crochet 6 sc till the middle of the heel and move the marker here. The marker should go along the middle of the back of the leg

Change the color to the light pink

6,7rnd: 30 sc

8 rnd: 10 sc, dec×5, 10 sc (25)

Change yarn to white

Insert the insole in the foot.

9 rnd: for the back loop only 7 sc, dec×5, 8 sc (20)

10 rnd: 7 sc, dec×3, 7 sc (17)

11 rnd: 5 sc, dec×3, 6 sc (14)

12 - 15 rnd : 14 sc

Stuff the foot tightly.

16 rnd: 13 sc, inc (15)

17, 18 rnd: 15 sc

Change yarn to cream-colored

Stuff the leg gradually.

19 rnd: 14 sc, inc (16)

20, 21 rnd: 16 sc

22 rnd: 15 sc, inc (17)

23 -35 rnd: 17 sc



Fasten off and cut the yarn . Crochet the second leg similarly, do not cut the yarn

Decorate legs with decorative ribbon or lace and beads

Connect the legs

36 rnd: 4 sc along right leg, 4 ch, further go to the left leg 17 sc, 4 sc along the chain, 19 sc, put the marker. The marker should go along the middle of the back

37 rnd: 2 sc, inc, 36 sc, inc, 2 sc (44)

Connect the wires from the legs and twist them

38 - 40 rnd: 44 sc

41 rnd: 13 sc, dec, 14 sc, dec, 13 sc (42)

42 rnd: 42 sc

43 rnd: 2 sc, dec, 34 sc, dec, 2 sc (40)

44 rnd: 9 sc, dec, 18 sc, dec,, 9 sc (38)

45 rnd: 3 sc, dec, (8 sc, dec)×3 , 3 sc (34)

46 rnd: 7 sc, dec, 16 sc, dec, 7 sc (32)

47 rnd: 2 sc, dec, 7 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec, 7 sc, dec, 2 sc (28)

Change the color to the white

48 rnd : 28 sc

49 rnd: for the back loops only 28 sc

50 - 57 rnd: 28 sc

Stuff the body



## Skirt

light yellow yarn

28 ch, close in a circle

1 rnd: (sc, inc)×14 (42)

2 rnd: (2 sc, inc)×14 for the front loops only (56)

3 rnd: for the front loops only (4 sc, 3 ch, from the second loop from hook 2 sc along the chain)×14

Fasten off and cut the yarn

Attach the light orange yarn to the back loops of third row

4 rnd: (3 sc, inc)×3, (3 hdc, inc hdc)×1, (3 dc, inc dc)×6, (3 hdc, inc hdc)×1, (3 sc, inc)×3 (70)

5,6 rnd: 15 sc, 5 hdc, 30 dc, 5 hdc, 15 sc (70)

Change yarn to light blue

7 rnd: for the back loops only 70 sc

8 rnd: 2 ch, 69 dc, sl st (70)

Change yarn to light pink

9 rnd: for the back loops only 70 sc

10 rnd: 2 ch, 69 dc, sl st (70)

Fasten off and cut the yarn and hide the end

Attach the white yarn to the back loops of second row

1 rnd: 2 ch, dc, inc dc, (2 dc, inc dc)×13, sl st (56)

2 rnd: 2 ch, 2 dc, inc dc, (3 dc, inc dc)×13, sl st (70)

3, 4 rnd: 2 ch, 69 dc, sl st

5 rnd: 2 ch, 24 dc, 20 dc for the back loop only, 25 dc, sl st

6, 7 rnd: 2 ch, 69 dc, sl st

Fasten off and cut the yarn and hide the end

Attach the light yellow yarn to the front loops of 5th row

1 rnd: 20 sc, turn

2 rnd: ch, skip one loop, 19 sc, turn

3 rnd: 3 ch, from the second loop from the hook 2 sc along the chain, skip one loop, 2 sc,

4 ch, from the second loop from the hook 3 sc along the chain, 3 sc on the main rnd,

4 ch, from the second loop from the hook 3 sc along the chain, 3 sc on the main rnd,

3 ch, from the second loop from the hook 2 sc along the chain, 3 sc on the main rnd,

5 ch, from the second loop from the hook 4 sc along the chain, 3 sc on the main rnd,

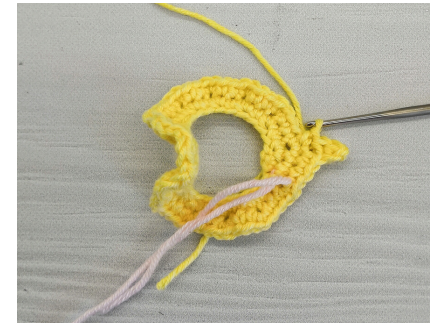
4 ch, from the second loop from the hook 3 sc along the chain, 2 sc on the main rnd,

3 ch, from the second loop from the hook 2 sc along the chain, 1 sc on the main rnd, sl st

Fasten off, cut the yarn

Sew the yellow parts to the skirt

Sew a skirt to the body





## arms

white yarn

1 rnd: 6 sc in the magic ring (6)

2 rnd: (inc, sc)×3 (9)

3-6 rnd: sc (9)

Cut a piece of wire approx. 12 cm (4.72 inches) long. Bend a loop approx. 1 cm (0.4 inches) long and wind a loop with an adhesive plaster.

Insert a wire in the hand.

Stuff the arm gradually

7 rnd: sc, dec, 4 sc, dec (7)

8 rnd: sc, (7)

9 rnd: 3 sc, inc, 3 sc (8)

Change yarn to cream-color

10 - 16 rnd: sc (8)

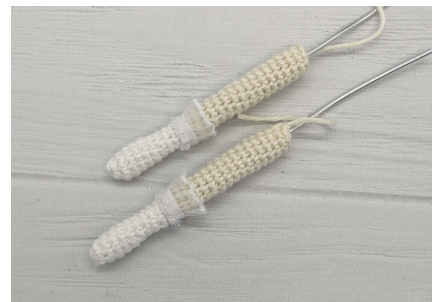
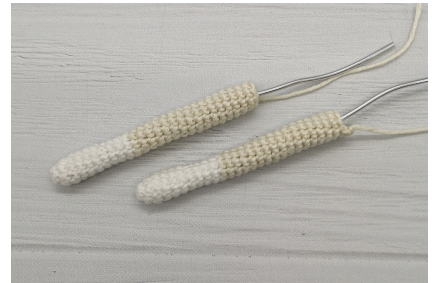
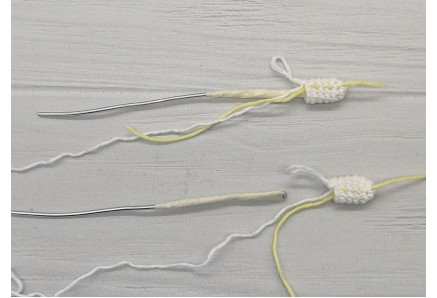
17 rnd: 3 sc, inc, 4 sc (9)

18-27 rnd: sc (9)

Stuff the arm

Fasten off and cut the yarn. Crochet the second arm similarly

Decorate arms with decorative ribbon or lace and beads



## Crochet in the arms.

cream-color yarn

58 rnd: 6 sc along the back, crochet together the stitches of the body and the stitches of the left arm 3 sc, 11 sc along the front, 3 sc the stitches of the body and right arm together, 5 sc along the back

Pay attention that the arms should be placed at the sides of the body, correct, if necessary

59 rnd: 5 sc along the back, dec (crochet together a stitch of the back and a stitch of the left arm), 4 sc along the left arm, dec (a stitch of the left arm and a stitch of the front together), 9 sc along the front, dec (a stitch of the front and a stitch of the right arm together), 4 sc along the right arm, dec (a stitch of the right arm and a stitch of the back together), 4 sc along the back (30)

60 rnd: 30 sc

61 rnd : 3 sc, (dec, 2 sc) ×2, dec, 5 sc, (dec, 2 sc) ×2, dec, 2 sc (24)



62 rnd: 2 sc, dec, (1 sc, dec)×2, 5 sc, dec, (1 sc, dec)×2, 1 sc (18)

63 rnd : (1 sc , dec) ×6 (12)

64 rnd: (2 sc, dec) ×3 (9)

65, 66 rnd : 9 sc

67 rnd: (2 sc, inc) ×3 (12)

68 rnd: (1 sc, inc) ×6 (18)

69 rnd: sc, inc, (2 sc, inc) ×5 , sc (24)

70 rnd: (3 sc, inc) ×6 (30)

71 rnd: 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc) ×5, 2 sc (36)

72 rnd: (5 sc, inc) ×6 (42)

73 rnd: 3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc) ×5, 3 sc (48)

74 rnd: (7 sc, inc) ×6 (54)

75 rnd: 4 sc, inc, (8 sc, inc) ×5, 4 sc (60)

Stuff the neck tightly.

76 - 86 rnd: 60 sc

87 rnd: 4 sc, dec, (8 sc, dec) ×5, 4 sc (54)

88 rnd: (7 sc, dec) ×6 (48)

89 rnd: 3 sc, dec, (6 sc, dec) ×5, 3 sc (42)

90 rnd: (5 sc, dec) ×6 (36)

91 rnd: 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec) ×5, 2 sc (30)

Stuff the head

92 rnd: (3 sc, dec) ×6 (24)

93 rnd: 1 sc, dec, (2 sc, dec) ×5, 1 sc (18)

94 rnd: (sc, dec) ×6 (12)

95 rnd: dec×6 (6)

Cut the yarn, tighten the opening. Hide the end

\*the head and neck should be stuffed very tight. Otherwise the head will dangle

## hair

### Light pink yarn

1 rnd: 6 sc in magic ring,

2 rnd: inc×6 (12)

3 rnd : (1 sc , inc) ×6 (18)

4 rnd: sc, inc, (2 sc, inc) ×5 , sc (24)

5 rnd: (3 sc, inc) ×6 (30)

6 rnd: 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc) ×5, 2 sc (36)

7 rnd: (5 sc, inc) ×6 (42)

8 rnd: 3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc) ×5, 3 sc (48)

9 rnd: (7 sc, inc) ×6 (54)

10-18rnd: 54 sc, do not cut the yarn

Try the hat on your head. It should be tightly wrapped around the heady



### strands of hair:

crochet for the front loops only

(50 ch, from the second loop from the hook 49 sc along the chair, 3 sl st for the front loop only of the main rnd)×18

If desired, you can add yellow strands. To do this, you need to change the yarn. Do not cut the pink yarn, crochet the strand with yellow yarn, then cut the yellow yarn, fasten and continue crocheting with pink yarn

Do not cut the yarn

### Hair bang

for the back loops only

(10 ch, from the second loop from the hook 9 sc along the chair, 2 sl st for the front loop only of the main rnd)×18

Do not cut the yarn, leave the tail for sewing

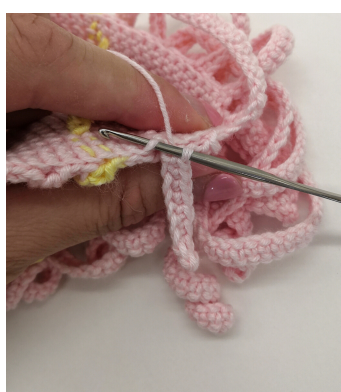
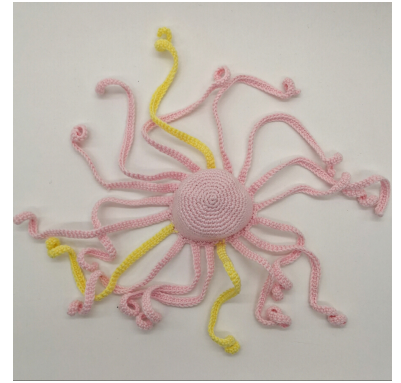
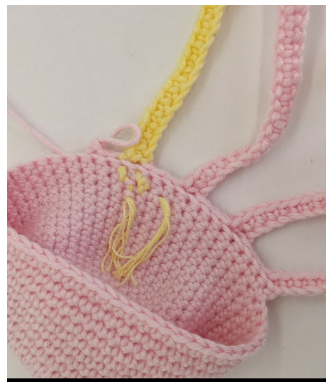
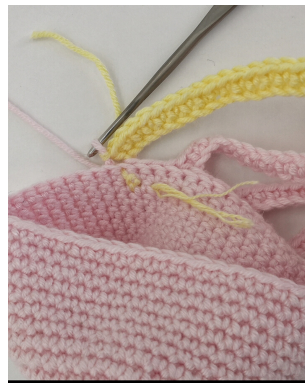
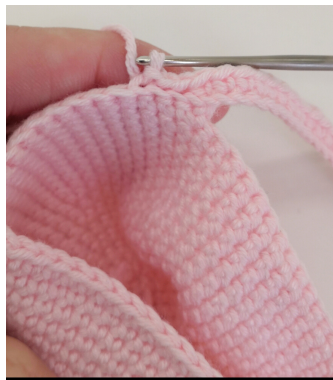
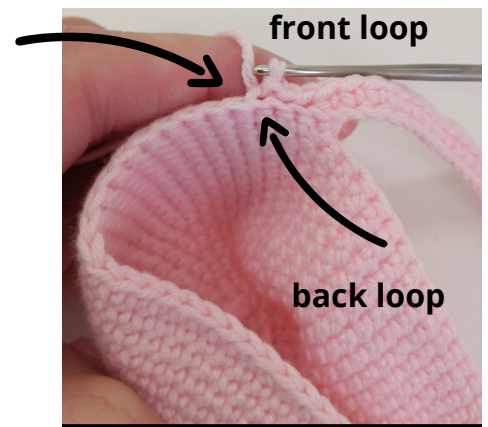
use pins to attach the wig to the head.

carefully sew each strand. of bang

Tie your hair in tails with silicone elastic bands

Crochet two chains of 50 . Wrap them around strands of hair

Stick eyes with glue between row 84-85



## jacket

Light yellow yarn

37 ch

1 rnd: , from the second loop from the hook 3 sc, inc×2, 8 sc, inc×2, 6 sc, inc×2, 8 sc, inc×2, 3 sc, turn

2 rnd; ch, 4 sc, skip 12 loops, 4 ch, 10 sc, skip 12 loops, 4 ch, 5 sc, turn

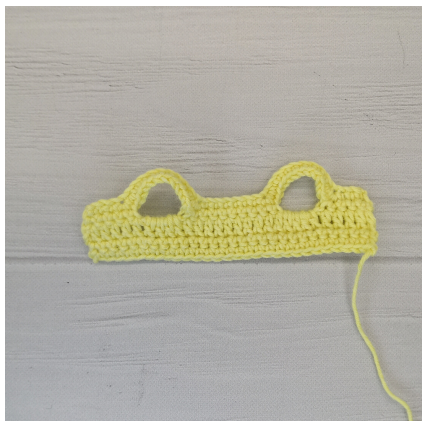
3 rnd: 2 ch, 4 dc, 4 dc along the chair, 10 dc, 4 dc along the chair, 5 dc, turn (28)

4 rnd: ch, 27 sc

leave the tail for sewing

Decorate your jacket with beads or buttons

Put the jacket on the doll, sew the back seam. Decorate your hair with beads
