Supplies:

1. Yarns: Himalay Dolphin Baby in white (off-white), green, pink for cheeks, Yarn Art Jeans in black 53, white, blue

- 2. 3.5 mm hook
- 3. Toys stuffing (sintepon, holofiber)
- 4. Scissors, large eye needle for joining parts

Abbreviations (US terms):

MR- magic/amigurumi ring

sc - single crochet stitch (the number indicates the number of sc)

dc - double crochet

tr - treble crochet

ch - chain stitch

inc - increase = 2 stitches in one stitch

dec - decrease = 2 stitches together

sl st - slip stitch

t – times (of repeat)

Eyes

Left and right eyes are crocheted different, with Yarn Art Jeans, using 2.0 mm hook

Left eye

1 rnd: work in black, 6 sc into MR = 6 sc

 $2 \, rnd$: (inc)*6t = 12 sc

 $3 \, rnd$: $(1 \, sc, \, inc)*6t = 18 \, sc$

4 rnd: work in blue, 2 sc, 3 inc, 2 sc, sl st (11 sts in blue in total), go on working in black, 10 sl st (21 sts)





5 rnd: work in white, 1 sl st, (1 sc, inc)*3t, 1 sc, 3 sl st (14 sts), fasten off.







6 rnd: turn the eye wrong side towards yourself and work 10 sl st in black. Leave 4 sc in white uncrocheted







Right eye

1 rnd: work in black, 6 sc into MR = 6 sc

 $2 \, rnd$: (inc)*6t = 12 sc

 $3 \, rnd$: $(1 \, sc, inc)*6t = 18 \, sc$

4 rnd: work in blue, 1 sl st, 2 sc, 3 inc, 2 sc, (11 sts in blue in total), go on working in black, 10 sl st

5 rnd: work in white, 3 sl st, 1 sc, (inc, 1 sc)*3t, 1 sl st (14 sts), fasten off.

6 rnd: count the 5^{th} st from the bottom of the round in white and place marker. Turn the eye wrong side towards yourself and work 9 sl st in black from the point you placed marker







Head-body

43 rnd: (dec)*6t = 6 sc, draw up the hole.

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1 rnd: work in green, chain 5, starting into the 2^{nd} st from hook work as follows: (3 sc into
1 \text{ st}, 2 \text{ sc})*2t = 10 \text{ sc}
2 \text{ rnd}: (3 \text{ inc}, 2 \text{ sc})*2t = 16 \text{ sc}
3 \text{ rnd}: (1 sc, inc)*3t, 2 sc, (1 sc, inc)*3t, 2 sc = 22 sc.
4 rnd: (2 sc, inc)*3t, 2 sc, (2 sc, inc)*3t, 2 sc = 28sc
5 rnd: (3 sc, inc)*3t, 2 sc, (3 sc, inc)*3t, 2 sc = 34sc
6 rnd: (4 \text{ sc, inc})*3t, 2 \text{ sc, } (4 \text{ sc, inc})*3t, 2 \text{ sc} = 40 \text{ sc}
7 rnd: 8 sc, (inc, 1 sc)*3t, 13 sc, (inc, 1 sc)*3t, 7 sc = 46 sc
8 -15 rnds: 46 sc
16 \text{ rnd: } 28 \text{ sc, } (\text{dec, 1 sc})*6t = 40 \text{ sc}
* to move the rounds beginning, work 12 sc, further on the rounds beginning should be in
the center of the head.
17 \, rnd: 14 \, sc, (dec, 1 \, sc)*5t, 11 \, sc = 35 \, sc
18 \text{ rnd}: 11 \text{ sc}, (dec, 1 \text{ sc})*5t, 9 \text{ sc} = 30 \text{ sc}
19 rnd: 10 sc, (dec, 1 sc)*5t, 5 sc = 25 sc
20 \text{ rnd}: 9 \text{ sc}, (\text{dec}, 1 \text{ sc})*4t, 4 \text{ sc} = 21 \text{ sc}
21-22 rnds: 21 sc, go on crocheting the body:
23 \text{ rnd}: 12 \text{ sc}, 2 \text{ inc}, 7 \text{ sc} = 23 \text{ sc}
24 rnd: 3 sc, inc, 9 sc, (inc, 1 sc)*2t, 6 sc = 26 sc
25 rnd: 2 sc, inc, 13 sc, inc, 9 sc = 28 sc, stuff a little
26 rnd: 3 sc, inc, 13 sc, inc, 10 sc = 30 sc
27 \, rnd: (4 \, sc, inc)*6t = 36 \, sc
28 rnd: 36 sc
29 \text{ rnd}: (inc, 5 \text{ sc})*3t, 18 \text{sc} = 39 \text{ sc}
30 rnd: 39 sc
31 rnd: 18 sc, inc, 13 sc, inc, 6 sc = 41 sc
32 \text{ rnd}: 7 sc, inc, 33 \text{ sc} = 42 \text{ sc}
33 \text{ rnd}: 8 sc, inc, 33 \text{ sc} = 43 \text{ sc}
34 \text{ rnd}: (inc, 3 \text{ sc})*5t, 23 \text{ sc} = 48 \text{ sc}
35-36 rnds: 48 sc
37 \, rnd: (6 sc, dec)*6t = 42 sc
38 \, rnd: (5 \, sc, \, dec)*6t = 36 \, sc
39 \text{ rnd}: (4 \text{ sc, dec})*6t = 30 \text{ sc, stuff a little}
40 \text{ rnd}: (3 \text{ sc}, \text{dec})*6t = 24 \text{ sc}
41 \, rnd: (2 \, sc, \, dec)*6t = 18 \, sc
42 \text{ rnd}: (1 \text{ sc}, \text{ dec})*6t = 12 \text{ sc}
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Tail

1 rnd: chain 2, single crochet 6 into the 2^{nd} st from hook, join in the round = 6 sc

2 rnd: (inc, 1 sc)* 3t = 9 sc.

3 rnd: (inc, 2 sc)*3t = 12 sc

4 rnd: inc, 11 sc = 13 sc

5 rnd: 2 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 8 sc = 15 sc


6 rnd: 3 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 8 sc = 17 sc

 $7 \, rnd$: $3 \, sc$, $(inc, 1 \, sc)*3t$, $8 \, sc = 20sc$

8 rnd: 20sc.

9 rnd: 4 sc, (inc, 2 sc)*3t, 7 sc = 23 sc

10 rnd: 4 sc, (inc, 3 sc)*3t, 7 sc = 26 sc, leave a yarn tail for sewing.



Legs - make 2

1 rnd: chain 2 ch in white, single crochet 6 into the 2^{nd} st from hook, join in the round= 6 sc

2 rnd: (inc)*6t = 12 sc

 $3 \, rnd$: $(1 \, sc, inc)*6t = 18 \, sc$

4 rnd: work in green through back loops only, 18 sc

5 rnd: 18 sc.

6 rnd: (3 sc, dec, 2 sc, dec)*2t = 14 sc

7 rnd: 14 sc.

8 rnd: dec, 3 sc, dec, 2 sc, dec, 3 sc = 11 sc

9 rnd: dec, 2 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 2 sc = 8 sc

10 rnd: 4 sc, fold the piece in half and single crochet 4 through both edges, leave a yarn tail for sewing.

Arms - make 2

1 rnd: chain 2 in green, single crochet 6 into the 2^{nd} st from hook, join in the round = 6 sc

2 rnd: (inc)*6t = 12 sc

3 rnd: 12 sc.

4 rnd: dec, 10 sc = 11 sc

 $5 \, rnd: dec, 9 \, sc = 10 \, sc$

6 rnd: dec, 8 sc = 9 sc

7 rnd: dec, 7 sc = 8 sc, fold the piece in half and single crochet 4 through both edges, leave a yarn tail for sewing.



Belly

1 row: chain 7, starting into the 2^{nd} st from hook work 6 sc, at the end of each row turn your work and chain 1 for turning

2 row: 3 sc, inc, 2 sc = 7 sc

3 row: 3 sc, inc, 3 sc = 8 sc

4 row: 4 sc, inc, 3 sc = 9 sc

5 row: 4 sc, inc, 4 sc = 10 sc

6 row: 5 sc, inc, 4 sc = 11 sc

7-12 rows: 11 sc

13 row: 5 sc, dec, 4 sc = 10 sc

14 row: 4 sc, dec, 4 sc = 9 sc

15 row: 4 sc, dec, 3 sc = 8 sc

16 row: 3 sc, dec, 3 sc = 7 sc, leave a yarn tail for sewing.




Spikes

Make 5 spikes different in size. Leave yarn tails for sewing.

Spike 1: chain 8, work starting into the 4^{th} st from hook. Crochet as follows: 4 tr, 3 ch, slip stitch to the last st


Spikes 2-4: chain 7, work starting into the 4^{th} st from hook. Crochet as follows: 3 tr, 3 ch, slip stitch to the last st.

Spike 5: chain 6, work starting into the 3^{rd} st from hook, Crochet as follows: 3 dc, 2 ch, slip stitch to the last st.




Assembly and decoration

Sew on the belly over rounds 24 to 38



Sew on the tail over rounds 32 to 38 at the back



Sew on legs between rounds 35-37 of the body 6sc away from the belly



Sew on arms between rounds 28 - 29



Sew on eyes between rounds 10-13



Embroider white flares and black eyelashes



Sew on the first spike over round 1. Sew on the remaining spikes 5 sc apart from each other



Finally embroider cheeks and spots $\ensuremath{\wp}$
