MATERIALS

- Stylecraft Special Chunky Col 1005 Cream, approx. 60 meters needed
- Stylecraft Special Chunky Col 1420 Camel, approx. 120 meters needed
- Stylecraft Special Chunky Col 1709 Gold, approx. 18 meters needed
- Scheepjes Stone Washed Sport Weight Col 820 Rose Quartz
- Scheepjes Stone Washed Sport Weight Col 802 Smokey Quartz
- 2mm, 2.5mm, 4.5mm crochet hook
- 2 black 12mm safety eyes
- Fibrefill
- Stitch markers, tapestry needle & scissors

SIZE

When made with the indicated yarns, it measures approximately 28cm tall. Alternatively, you may substitute with your favourite yarn brand and adjust the hook size accordingly.

ABBREVIATIONS (US terminology)

CH – chain

DC – double crochet

DEC – invisible decrease by crochet 2 stitches together

INC – increase by putting 2 single crochets in one stitch

SC – single crochet

SC3TOG – single crochet 3 stitches together (performing a decrease transforming 3 stitches into 1 stitch)

SLST – slip stitch

ST – stitch

IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ BEFORE YOU START

Because crochet work tends to slant to one side and people have different tensions when crocheting, sometimes the stitch marker should be adjusted to minimize such variations. When you finish a round and notice that the stitch marker moves right, work one stitch into the first stitch of the next round and move the stitch marker behind the last stitch. This means the second stitch of the next round is now the first. In the event that the stitch marker moves left, you need to unravel a stitch. The stitch used here is a shift stitch, it does not affect the stitch count, no stitches are added or subtracted. **All through this whole pattern, every round should begin from the centre of the back.**



EARS

(use 4.5mm hook, make 2, in camel)

Rnd 1: 5 sc in magic ring [5]

Rnd 2: inc in all 5 st [10]

Rnd 3: sc in all 10 st [10]

Rnd 4: (sc, inc) repeat 5 times [15]

Rnd 5 – 6: sc in all 15 st [15]

Rnd 7: (2 sc, inc) repeat 5 times [20]

Rnd 8: sc in all 20 st [20]

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing to the head.



HEAD

(use 4.5mm hook)

C = Camel; G = Gold; W = Cream

Rnd 1: C: ch 8, stitches are worked around both sides of the foundation chain.

Rnd 2: sc into second chain from hook, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 2 times, G: 1 sc, C: inc in last st, continue on the other side of the foundation chain, (C: 1 sc, G: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, C: inc in last st [16]

Rnd 3: inc, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, inc 2 times, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, inc [20]

Rnd 4: inc 2 times, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, inc 4 times, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, inc 2 times [28]

Rnd 5: 1 sc, inc 2 times, 1 sc, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, 1 sc, inc 2 times, 2 sc, inc 2 times, 1 sc, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, 1 sc, inc 2 times, 1 sc [36]

Rnd 6: (1 sc, inc) repeat 2 times, 2 sc, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, 2 sc, (inc, 1 sc) repeat 2 times, (1 sc, inc) repeat 2 times, 2 sc, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, 2 sc, (inc, 1 sc) repeat 2 times [44]

Rnd 7: 4 sc, (inc, 1 sc) repeat 2 times, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, 1 sc, (inc, 1 sc) repeat 2 times, 7 sc, (inc, 1 sc) repeat 2 times, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, 1 sc, (inc, 1 sc) repeat 2 times, 3 sc [52]

Rnd 8: 10 sc, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, 20 sc, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, 10 sc [52]

Rnd 9: 10 sc, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, 36 sc [52]

Rnd 10: 10 sc, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, 22 sc, W: 2 sc, C: 12 sc [52]

Rnd 11: 10 sc, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, 5 sc, G: 10 sc, C: 6 sc, W: 4 sc, C: 6 sc, G: 5 sc [52]

Rnd 12: 10 sc, (G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc) repeat 3 times, 21 sc, W: 4 sc, C: 11 sc [52]

Rnd 13: 10 sc, G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc, G: 1 sc until you reach the middle centre of back of head

Rnd 14: C: 1 sc, G: 1 sc, C: 14 sc, (inc, 3 sc) repeat 2 times, W: inc, 3 sc, colour change inc (W + C), C: 3 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 12 sc, G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc, G: 1 sc [58]



Rnd 15: C: 1 sc, G: 1 sc, C: 6 sc, G: 7 sc, inc, 3 sc, colour change inc (G + C), C: 3 sc, inc, 1 sc, W: 2 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 1 sc, C: 2 sc, inc, 3 sc, G: inc, 3 sc, inc, 6 sc, C: 5 sc, G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc, G: 1 sc [66]

Rnd 16: C: 1 sc, G: 1 sc, C: 25 sc, W: 12 sc, C: 24 sc, G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc, G: 1 sc [66]

Rnd 17: C: 1 sc, G: 1 sc, C: 25 sc, W: 13 sc, C: 23 sc, G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc, G: 1 sc [66]

Rnd 18: C: 1 sc, G: 1 sc, C: 24 sc, W: 15 sc, C: 22 sc, G: 1 sc, C: 1 sc, G: 1 sc [66]

Rnd 19: C: 1 sc, G: 1 sc, C: 24 sc, W: 15 sc, C: 25 sc [66]

Insert safety eyes between round 12 & 13, with 8 stitches apart.

Start stuffing with fibrefill, continue as you go.

Rnd 20: (9 sc, dec) repeat 2 times, 4 sc, W: 5 sc, dec, 8 sc, C: 1 sc, dec, (9 sc, dec) repeat 2 times [60]

Rnd 21: (8 sc, dec) repeat 2 times, 4 sc, W: 4 sc, dec, 8 sc, C: dec, (8 sc, dec) repeat 2 times [54]

Rnd 22: (7 sc, dec) repeat 2 times, 4 sc, W: 3 sc, dec, 7 sc, C: dec, (7 sc, dec) repeat 2 times [48]

Rnd 23: (4 sc, dec) repeat 3 times, 2 sc, W: 2 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 1 sc, C: 3 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec) repeat 2 times [40]

Rnd 24: (3 sc, dec) repeat 3 times, 2 sc, W: 1 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, 1 sc, C: 2 sc, dec, (3 sc, dec) repeat 2 times [32]

Rnd 25: (2 sc, dec) repeat 3 times, 2 sc, W: dec, 2 sc, dec, 1 sc, C: 1 sc, dec, (2 sc, dec) repeat 2 times [24]

Rnd 26: (1 sc, dec) repeat 8 times [16]

Rnd 27: dec 8 times [8]

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing to body.

Use a tapestry needle, weave the yarn tail through

front loop of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close. Pin the ears on the head for sewing, squeeze and shape it like a triangle pyramid, sew the ears to the head.





EAR FLAP

(use 2mm hook, make 2 each, in rose quartz)

Row 1: ch2, inc in 2nd chain from hook, ch 1, turn [2]

Row 2: inc, 1 sc, ch 1, turn [3]

Row 3: inc, 2 sc, ch 1, turn [4]

Row 4: inc, 3 sc, ch 1, turn [5]

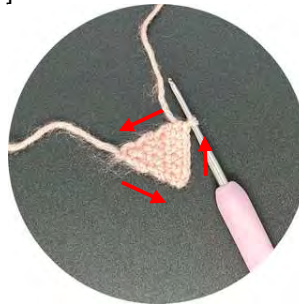
Row 5: inc, 4 sc, ch 1, turn [6]

Row 6: inc, 5 sc, ch 1, turn [7]

Row 7: inc, 6 sc [8]

Row 8: sc around all 3 sides of the triangle

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing to ear. Embroider the nose and mouth.



TAIL

(use 4.5mm hook)

C = Camel; G = Gold

Rnd 1: G: 5 sc in magic ring [5]

Rnd 2: inc in all 5 st [10]

Rnd 3 – 4: sc in all 10 st [10]

Rnd 5 – 6: C: sc in all 10 st [10]

Rnd 7: G: sc in all 10 st [10]

Rnd 8 – 9: C: sc in all 10 st [10]

Rnd 10: G: sc in all 10 st [10]

Rnd 11 – 12: C: sc in all 10 st [10]

Rnd 13: G: sc in all 10 st [10]

Rnd 14 – 15: C: sc in all 10 st [10]

Rnd 16: G: sc in all 10 st [10]

Rnd 17 – 18: C: sc in all 10 st [10]



Rnd 19: G: sc in all 10 st [10]

Rnd 20 – 22: C: sc in all 10 st [10]

Fasten off, stuff with fibrefill.

LEFT FRONT PAWS

(use 4.5mm hook, make 1, in cream)

Rnd 1: 8 sc in magic ring [8]

Rnd 2: inc in all 8 st [16]

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) repeat 8 times [24]

Rnd 4: 8 sc, (1 sc, inc) repeat 4 times, 8 sc [28]

Rnd 5: 8 sc, (1 sc, 1 dc, 1 sc) repeat 4 times, 8 sc [28]

Rnd 6: 8 sc, sc3tog 4 times, 8 sc [20]

Use a stick to help pushing out the toes.

Rnd 7: inc, 5 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 5 sc, inc [20]

Rnd 8: inc, 5 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 5 sc, inc [20]

Rnd 9: 8 sc, dec 2 times, 8 sc [18]

Rnd 10: (4 sc, dec) repeat 3 times [15]

Rnd 11: sc in all 15 st [15]

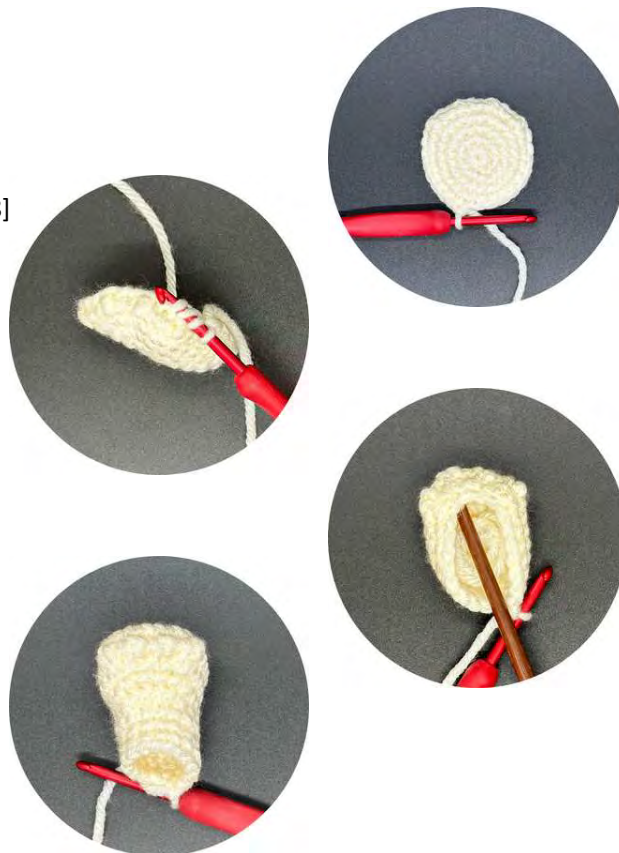
Rnd 12: (4 sc, inc) repeat 3 times [18]

Rnd 13: (2 sc, inc) repeat 3 times, 9 sc [21]

Rnd 14: (2 sc, inc) repeat 3 times, 12 sc [24]

Rnd 15: sc in all 24 st [24]

Fasten off, stuff with fibrefill.



RIGHT FRONT PAWS

(use 4.5mm hook, make 1)

C = Camel; G = Gold; W = Cream

Rnd 1: W: 8 sc in magic ring [8]

Rnd 2: inc in all 8 st [16]

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) repeat 8 times [24]

Rnd 4: 8 sc, (1 sc, inc) repeat 4 times, 8 sc [28]

Rnd 5: 8 sc, (1 sc, 1 dc, 1 sc) repeat 4 times, 8 sc [28]

Rnd 6: 8 sc, sc3tog 4 times, 8 sc [20]

Use a stick to help pushing out the toes.

Rnd 7: inc, 5 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 5 sc, inc [20]
Rnd 8: inc, 5 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 5 sc, inc [20]
Rnd 9: **C:** 8 sc, dec 2 times, 8 sc [18]
Rnd 10: 4 sc, **G:** dec, 4 sc, dec, 1 sc, **C:** 3 sc, dec [15]
Rnd 11: sc in all 15 st [15]
Rnd 12: 4 sc, color change inc (**C + G**), **G:** 4 sc, inc, 1 sc, **C:** 3 sc, inc [18]
Rnd 13: 9 sc, (inc, 2 sc) repeat 3 times [21]
Rnd 14: 5 sc, **G:** 7 sc, inc, 2 sc, color change inc (**G + C**), **C:** 2 sc, inc, 2 sc [24]
Rnd 15: sc in all 24 st [24]
 Fasten off, stuff with fibrefill.



BACK PAWS

(use 4.5mm hook, make 2)

C = Camel; G = Gold; W = Cream

Rnd 1: **W:** 8 sc in magic ring [8]
Rnd 2: inc in all 8 st [16]
Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) repeat 8 times [24]
Rnd 4: sc in all 24 st [24]
Rnd 5: 8 sc, (1 sc, inc) repeat 4 times, 8 sc [28]
Rnd 6: 8 sc, (1 sc, 1 dc, 1 sc) repeat 4 times, 8 sc [28]
Rnd 7: 8 sc, sc3tog 4 times, 8 sc [20]
Rnd 8: inc, 5 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 5 sc, inc [20]
Rnd 9: inc, 5 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 5 sc, inc [20]
Rnd 10: 8 sc, dec 2 times, 8 sc [18]
Rnd 11: (4 sc, dec) repeat 3 times [15]
Rnd 12: sc in all 15 st [15]
Rnd 13: **C:** (4 sc, inc) repeat 3 times [18]
Rnd 14: (5 sc, inc) repeat 3 times [21]
Rnd 15: (6 sc, inc) repeat 3 times [24]
Rnd 16: (7 sc, inc) repeat 3 times [27]



Fasten off on the first piece, leave a few inches tail for sewing close the hole between the connecting point of the back paws, **DO NOT** fasten off on the second piece which will be the left back paw. Stuff the paws with fibrefill. Use stitch markers to mark the stitches that we will connect the paws together to form the body.

BODY

Rnd 17: with the hook still attached to the 2nd piece of back paw, crochet 19 sc on the 2nd piece (or whatever number of stitches till where you put the stitch marker), then 27 sc on the 1st piece, finish the round at this point, you should be at the centre of the back, this will be the starting point of the next round. Use yarn tail of 1st piece to sew close the hole at connection point.



Rnd 18: 3 sc, (2 sc, inc) repeat 2 times, 36 sc, (inc, 2 sc) repeat 2 times, 3 sc [58]

Rnd 19: 3 sc, (2 sc, inc) repeat 2 times, 12 sc, inc, 14 sc, inc, 12 sc, (inc, 2 sc) repeat 2 times, 3 sc [64]

Rnd 20: 28 sc, **W:** dec, 1 sc, inc 2 times, 1 sc, dec, **C:** 28 sc [64]

Rnd 21: 27 sc, **W:** dec, 2 sc, inc 2 times, 2 sc, dec, **C:** 27 sc [64]

Rnd 22: 26 sc, **W:** dec, 2 sc, (inc, 2 sc) repeat 2 times, dec, **C:** 24 sc, 2 sc on tail+body [64]

Rnd 23: 3 sc on tail+body, 22 sc, **W:** dec, 4 sc, inc 2 times, 4 sc, dec, **C:** 19 sc, **G:** 4 sc, 2 sc on tail [64]

Rnd 24: **G:** 3 sc on tail, 4 sc, **C:** 18 sc, **W:** 1 sc, inc, 10 sc, inc, 1 sc, **C:** 25 sc [66]



Rnd 25: **G:** 1 sc, **C:** dec, 22 sc, **W:** 16 sc, **C:** 23 sc, dec [64]

Rnd 26: **G:** 1 sc, **C:** 3 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc, (5 sc, dec) repeat 2 times, 1 sc, **W:** 14 sc, **C:** 1 sc, (dec, 5 sc) repeat 2 times, inc, 2 sc, **G:** 2 sc, inc, 4 sc [64]

Rnd 27: 9 sc, **C:** 16 sc, **W:** 14 sc, **C:** 25 sc [64]

Rnd 28: **G:** 1 sc, **C:** 24 sc, **W:** 14 sc, **C:** 25 sc [64]

Rnd 29: **G:** 1 sc, **C:** 25 sc, **W:** 12 sc, **C:** 19 sc, **G:** 7 [64]

Rnd 30: 3 sc, dec, 3 sc, **C:** dec, 3 sc, dec, 11 sc, **W:** 12 sc, **C:** 11 sc, (dec, 3 sc) repeat 3 times [58]

Rnd 31: **G:** 1 sc, **C:** 20 sc, dec, **W:** 11 sc, **C:** 1 sc, dec, 21 sc [56]

Rnd 32: G: 1 sc, C: 21 sc, W: 10 sc, C: 21 sc, G: 3 sc [56]

Rnd 33: G: 4 sc, C: dec, 4 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 5 sc, W: 9 sc, C: 6 sc, (dec, 4 sc) repeat 3 times [50]

Rnd 34: G: 1 sc, C: 19 sc, W: 9 sc, C: 21 sc [50]

Rnd 35: G: 1 sc, C: 3 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 9 sc, W: 7 sc, C: 10 sc, dec, 4 sc, G: dec, 4 sc [46]

Rnd 36: 6 sc, C: 13 sc, W: 7 sc, C: 20 sc [46]

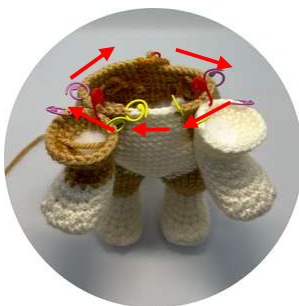
Rnd 37: G: 1 sc, C: 19 sc, W: 6 sc, C: 20 sc [46]

Use stitch markers to mark the stitches where the front paws (8 stitches each side) would be placed, leave 6 stitches apart between the paws. Start stuffing with fibrefill, continue as you go.



Rnd 38: G: 1 sc, C: 11 sc, 8 sc on 1stpaw+body, W: 6 sc, C: 8 sc on 2ndpaw+body, 7 sc, G: 5 sc [46]

Rnd 39: 6 sc, C: 5 sc, dec (decrease by joining 1 sc on body and 1 sc on left paw), 4 sc, W: 10 sc, dec (decrease by joining 1 sc on left paw and 1 sc on body), 4 sc, dec (decrease by joining 1 sc on body and 1 sc on right paw), C: 14 sc, dec (decrease by joining 1 sc on right paw and 1 sc on body), 11 sc [58]



Rnd 40: G: 1 sc, C: 3 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 5 sc, W: 14 sc, C: 15 sc, (dec, 4 sc) repeat 2 times [54]

Rnd 41: G: 1 sc, C: 7 sc, dec, 7 sc, W: 6 sc, dec, 3 sc, C: 1 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 5 sc, G: 3 sc [50]

Rnd 42: G: 4 sc, C: 3 sc, dec, 9 sc, W: 4 sc, dec, 1 sc, C: 1 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 7 sc [46]

Rnd 43: G: 1 sc, C: 5 sc, dec 2 times, 11 sc, W: 3 sc, C: 12 sc, dec 2 times, 6 sc [42]

Rnd 44: G: dec, C: 19 sc, dec, 19 sc [40]

Rnd 45: (3 sc, dec) repeat 8 times [32]

Rnd 46: (2 sc, dec) repeat 8 times [24]

Rnd 47: (1 sc, dec) repeat 8 times [16]

Rnd 48: dec 8 times [8]

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing to the head. Use a tapestry needle, weave the yarn tail through front loop of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close.



METATARSAL PAD

(use 2mm hook for front paws and 2.5mm hook for back paws, make 2 each, in rose quartz)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: inc in all 6 st [12]

Rnd 3: inc 6 times, stop here

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing to paw.

TOE BEAN

(use 2mm hook for front paws and 2.5mm hook for back paws, make 8 each, in rose quartz)

Rnd 1: ch 3, sc in 2nd chain from hook, 1 sc

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing to paw.



ASSEMBLE

Use pins to fix the head to the body, sewing tightly.
