Jake and the Never land Pirates is one of my favorite shows that my son is watching, it's cute and funny and the most important of all it's a bit educational. I love Disney's productions, and like so many times before, I don't really care for humans I always love the animal characters best. So I knew right away I will make Skully for my son, I didn't gave it to him right away, he had to find it using the pirate map my husband made. Let me tell you - he was delighted:)

Crochet Skully, when finished, is 18 cm (7 inches). It's perfect to put on your shoulder and shout "Yo ho ho":)





Materials

List of all the materials you will need for the parrot:

 yarn (I use 55% cotton yarn which meterage is 174 yards (159 meters) for 50 g, weight Sport / 5 ply (12 wpi), Gauge 24 to 30 st is 4 inches (10 cm)

You can use the colors you like, but below is the list of colors I used:

- o darker green head, body, wings
- o lighter green belly
- o light yellow circles behing eyes
- o dark yellow (almost orange) beak, legs
- o white eyes, skulls
- o black bandana (hat)
- o blue -tail
- o red -end of tail
- 3 mm hook
- · cotton wool or other filling
- · a bit of black felt or black material for pupils
- needle, thread, scissors, etc.

Head (Make 1)

start with dark green yarn

R1: 6 sc in MR (6)

R2: inc around (12)

R3: * sc, inc *X6 (18)

R4: sc, inc, sc 3, inc 2, sc 4, inc 2, sc 3, inc, sc (24)

R5: sc 6, inc 3, sc 6, inc 3, sc 6 (30)

R6: sc 4, inc, sc 3, inc 2, sc 10, inc 2, sc 3, inc, sc 4 (36)

R7: * sc 5, inc * X6 (42)

R8: sc 13, inc 3, sc 8, inc 3, sc 15 (48)

R9: * sc 7, inc * X6 (54)

R10: * sc 8, inc * X6 (60)

R11: sc around (60)

R12: sc around (60)

R13: * sc 9, inc * X6 (66)

R14 - R19: sc around (66)

R20: * sc 10, inc * X6 (72)

R21 - R22: sc around (72)

R23: sc 71, ss (72) FO green

change to dark yellow

R24: BLO ss 72 (72)

R25: BLO sc 72 (72)(continued on next page)









R26 - R27: sc around (72)

R28: * sc 10, dec * X6 (66)

R29: * sc 9, dec * X6 (60)

R30: * sc 8, dec * X6 (54)

R31: sc around (54)

R32: * sc 7, dec * X6 (48)

R33: * sc 6, dec * X6 (42)

R34: sc around (42)

R35: * sc 5, dec * X6 (36)

R36: sc around (36)

R37: sc around (36)

R38: * sc 4, dec * X6 (30)

R39: sc around (30)

R40: * sc 3, dec * X6 (24)

Circles under eyes (Make 2)

light yellow yarn

R1: sc 6 in MR (6)

R2: * sc, inc, 3scin1 * X2 (12)

R3: * sc 3, inc 3 * X2 (18)

R4: * sc 2, inc * X6 (24)

R5: * sc 3, inc * X6 (30)

R6: sc 7, inc 3, sc 12, inc 3, sc 5 (36)

R7: * sc 2, inc * X12 (48) FO



Eye (Make 2)

white yarn

R1: sc 6 in MR (6)

R2: inc around (12)

R3: * sc, inc * X6 (18)

R4: * sc 2, inc * X6 (24)

R5: * sc 3, inc * X5, sc 3, ss (29) FO



Cut two pupils from black felt.

Make it only a bit smaller than eyes.



Bandana (Make 1)

black yarn

R1: 6 sc in MR (6)

R2: inc around (12)

R3: * sc, inc *X6 (18)

R4: sc, inc, sc 3, inc 2, sc 4, inc 2, sc 3, inc, sc (24)

R5: sc 6, inc 3, sc 6, inc 3, sc 6 (30)

R6: sc 4, inc, sc 3, inc 2, sc 10, inc 2, sc 3, inc, sc 4 (36)

R7: * sc 5, inc * X6 (42)

R8: sc 13, inc 3, sc 8, inc 3, sc 15 (48)

R9: * sc 7, inc * X6 (54)

R10: * sc 8, inc * X6 (60)

R11 - R12: sc around (60)

R13: sc around (60) FO



Bandana knot (Make 1)

black yarn

R1: 10 sc in MR (10)

R2: sc 10 (10)

R3: dec 5 (5)

R4: ch 5, sc in 2-nd ch, hdc 2, sc,

R5: ch 5, sc in 2-nd ch, hdc 2, sc, ss in row 3 FO



Skull (Make 3)

white yarn

R1: 9 ch, ss in 1-st ch

R2: 6 ch, ss 2 ch away from ss from R1 (see the 1-st photo)

R3: ss around this 2 loops to this point (it's 14 ss for me)

R4: ch, dc in same stitch You started ch, IncDC FO

I know it can be hard the first time you make it, If you don't like the effect try again, but remember you can shape it more when sewing it to bandana, so it doesn't have to be perfect!





Bones (Make 3)

white yarn

R1: 3 ch, ss in 2-nd ch, 2 ch, ss in 2-nd ch, ss in very first ch You made in this Row.

R2: 5ch, 2ch, ss in 2-nd ch, 2ch, ss in 2-nd ch, ss in 5-th ch from the begining of this row. FO



Side of the beak (Make 2) (it's the place where smile ends)

dark yellow yarn

R1: 7 ch (7)

R2: sc 6 (6)

R3: dec, sc 2, dec (4)

R4: sc, dc 2, sc (4) FO



Body (Make 1)

start with lighter green

R1: 6 sc in MR (6)

R2: * sc, inc, 3scin1 * X2 (12)

R3: * sc 3, inc 3 * X2 (18)

R4: * sc 2, inc * X6 (24)

R5: * sc 3, inc * X6 (30)

R6: sc 7, inc 3, sc 12, inc 3, sc 5 (36)

R7: sc around (36)

R8: * sc 5, inc * X6 (42)

R9: sc around (42)

R10: * sc 6, inc * X6 (48)

R11: sc around (48)

R12: sc 47, ss (48) FO light green

change to dark green

R13: BLO ss 48 (48)

R14: BLO sc 48 (48)

R15 - R16: sc around (48)

R17: dec, sc 6, dec, sc, dec, sc 6, dec, sc 11, dec, sc 11 (42)

R18: sc 42 (42)

R19: dec, sc 3, dec, sc 2, dec, sc 2, dec, sc 3, dec, sc 10, dec, sc 10 (36)

R20: sc, dec, sc 2, dec, sc 2, dec, sc 2, dec, sc 8, dec, sc 3, dec, sc 6 (30)

R21: sc 30 (30)

R22: sc, dec, sc 2, dec, sc 2, dec, sc 4, dec, sc 3, dec, sc 3, dec, sc 3 (24) (continued on next page)







R23: sc 24 (24)

R24: dec, sc, dec, sc, dec, sc 13 (20)

STUFF

R25: dec, sc, dec, sc, dec, sc 6, dec, sc 4 (16)

R26: dec 2, sc 3, dec, sc 2, dec, sc 3 (12)

R27: sc 12 (12)

R28: dec 6 (6)

R29: sc 6 (6)

R30: skip 1, ss, skip 1, ss FO



Wing (Make 2)

dark green yarn

R1: 6 sc in MR (6)

R2: inc around (12)

R3: * sc, inc * X6 (18)

R4 - R6: sc 18 (18)

R7: * sc 7, dec * X2 (16)

R8: * sc 6, dec * X2 (14)


R9: sc 14 (14)

R10: * sc 2, dec, sc, dec * X2 (10)

R11: sc around (10)

R12: dec 5 (5)

R13: skip 1, sc, skip 1, sc FO




Feathers (Make 6 - 3 for each wing)

dark green yarn

R1: 4 sc in MR (4)

R2: sc 4 (4)

R3: sc 4 (4) FO



Leg base (Make 2)

dark yellow yarn

R1: 6 sc in MR (6)

R2: * sc 2, 3scin1 * X2 (10)

R3: sc 10 (10)

R4: * sc 3, inc 2 * X2 (14)

R5: sc 3, inc 3, sc 4, inc 3, sc (20) FO




Fingers (Make 6- 3 for each leg) dark yellow yarn

R1: 7 sc in MR (7)

R2: sc around (7)

R3 - R5: sc around (7)

R6: sc 6, ss (7) FO





Tail (Make 1)

red yarn

R1: sc 4 in MR (4)

R2: sc 4 (4)

R3: inc, sc, inc, sc (6)

R4: * sc 2, inc * X2 (8)

R5: sc 8 (8) FO

Tail feathers (Make 3)

blue yarn

R1: 4 sc in MR (4)

R2 - R3: sc 4 (4)

R4: sc 4 (4) FO




We will start by making head.

Sew felt pupils to white eyes. Note that the pupils are directed a bit inwards.

With white yarn make two white dots as light reflections.

Sew finished eyes to yellow circles.







Sew the side of the beak to both sides of the head.



Sew yellow circles to the head.



Sew three skulls and three bones on bandana



Sew bandana on the back of the head.



Sew the knot on the bottom of bandana.



Take the dark yellow yarn and try to shape the beak a bit more, point it downwards.




With black yarn make a smile




That is how my smile looks from the bottom.



Stuff legs and sew three fingers to each leg.



Sew three feathers to tail.



Sew the tail to the pointy point of the body :)



Sew two feathers at the top of the wing, one feather on the side.



Sew wings on each side of the body.

The side feathers should be directed toward the tail.



Sew legs to the body.



We have the body and the head.

If you want your Skully to stand you should find the perfect point to place the head.



Sew head to the body very, very, very firmly and...

... we are done!
